

## NPDES Stormwater Multi Sector Generic Permit Guidance Sector C: Chemical and Allied Products Manufacturing Facilities

## Sector C - Chemical and Allied Products Manufacturing

Facilities of the Multi-Sector Generic Permit (MSGP) covers storm water discharges associated with industrial activities at facilities primarily engaged in the manufacture of chemicals and allied products. This sector of industry includes facilities which manufacture a broad range of products including plastic and synthetic materials, detergents, paints and varnishes, drugs, fertilizers and pesticides, adhesives, inks, explosives, artist's inks and paints, and organic and inorganic chemicals used for industrial purposes.

The following requirements were established by EPA under the nonstructural conditions to identify specific practices that must be implemented by all permittees:

Industrial facilities which have the potential to discharge stormwater to surface waters of the State or into a municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) and fall under any one of the 11 categories of industrial activities identified in 40 CFR 122.26(b)(14), may require coverage under the Multi-Sector Generic Permit.
