

Appendices provide in-depth discussion and enumeration of concepts, data, external stakeholder recommendations, interagency guidance on best management practices, and source references supplemental to the resource management and land use components of the unit chapters.

- **Acquisition Histories**
Chronologically lists the acquisitions that collectively comprise each unit; also including any easements, subleases, or encumbrances.
- **Arthropod Control Plans**
Plans and associated records for management of mosquitoes within DRP lands.
- **Division of Historical Resources Procedures**
Definitions, responsibilities, authorities, and best management practices for management of cultural resources. References to external information resources are provided.
- **Gopher Tortoise Recipient Site Analysis**
Analysis of using DRP lands as potential recipient sites for gopher tortoises. Data, analysis, and maps are provided.
- **Land Management Reviews**
Reports of the land management reviews for all DRP lands greater than 1,000 acres within the subject district. Includes scores, agency comments, and DRP responses.
- **Local Government Comprehensive Planning Compliance**
Record of outreach to the local jurisdictions that govern the lands within which the parks are located. Includes acknowledgement by local agencies that the unit chapters are consistent with respective comprehensive plans for the purposes of land use designations, zoning, ordinances, etc.
- **Public and Inter-Agency Participation**
 - *Tables of Meetings*
Two tables are provided – one for the general public meetings and another for the advisory group meetings. The tables include essential details of locations, subject units, and noticing through the Florida Administrative Register (FAR).
 - *General Public Meeting Summaries*
Narrative descriptions of the general public meetings that were conducted as open houses at accessible civic venues in population centers of the counties corresponding to the subject units, including essential comments and paraphrasing of other significant points.
 - *Regional Advisory Group Summaries*
Include categorized listing of all appointed advisory group members and detailed summaries of comments, questions, general discourse regarding the planning process and contents of the plan sections.

- **Soil Type Descriptions**

Alphabetized narratives to briefly explain the composition and characteristics of the soil types distributed throughout the subject DRP district.

- **Species Matrices**

Matrices with species on the X-axis and parks on the Y-axis.

- *Districtwide Flora, Fauna, Fungi Matrix*
Species recorded in the parks of the subject DRP district.
- *Districtwide Imperiled Species Matrix*
Imperiled species recorded in the parks of the subject DRP district.
- *Districtwide Invasive Species Matrix*
Invasive species recorded in the parks of the subjective DRP district.

- **Timber Assessments**

Analyses of timber management needs by park, including inventory, overstory conditions, and details on potential timber removal to improve or restore natural communities.
