FINAL ORDER MODIFYING CONDITIONS OF CERTIFICATION

Dear Mr. Raffenberg:

On April 13, 2003, the Florida Siting Board issued a Site Certification to Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) for the construction and operation of Manatee Electric Power Generation Facility Unit 3 (Manatee Unit 3.) in Manatee County. The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has modified the Conditions of Certification (Conditions) for Manatee Unit 3 by Final Order on three other occasions.

The Department has reviewed FPL's petition dated August 1, 2016 for a modification to Manatee Unit 3's Conditions of Certification to construct and operate a technician building pursuant to Section 403.516(1)(c), Florida Statutes (F.S.). Additionally, the Department has considered modifications pursuant to 403.516(1)(c), F.S., to incorporate a uniform set of general conditions consistent with recent site certifications, and to update antiquated specific conditions that are no longer applicable or consistent with current regulations.

On October 20, 2016, all parties to the certification proceeding were provided notice of the Department's intent to modify the Conditions for Manatee Unit 3. On October 27,

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2016, notice of the Department's intent to modify the Conditions for Manatee 3 was also published in the Florida Administrative Register (FAR).

Pursuant to Section 403.516, F.S., and Rule 62-17.211, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), all parties to the certification proceeding have 45 days from the issuance of notice in which to file a written objection to the modification. Pursuant to Section 403.516, F.S., and Rule 62-17.211, F.A.C., any person who is not already a party to the certification proceeding and whose substantial interests will be affected by the requested modification has 30 days from the date of publication of the public notice in the FAR to object in writing. Failure to act within the time frame constitutes a waiver of the right to become a party.

These timeframes have expired and no objections to the modification have been received by the Department. Therefore, the Conditions for Manatee 3 are modified as described in the Department's Notice of Intent to Modify the Conditions of Certification dated October 20, 2016, which can be downloaded from the following file transfer protocol (ftp) site:

Any party to this Order has a right to seek judicial review of it pursuant to Section 120.68, F.S. by filing a Notice of Appeal, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection in the Office of General Counsel, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, M.S. 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000, and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal, accompanied by the applicable filing fees, with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date this Order is filed with the Clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection.
