## FINAL ORDER MODIFYING CONDITIONS OF CERTIFICATION

Dear Mr. Carpinone:

On August 17, 1981, the Florida Siting Board issued a Site Certification to Tampa Electric Company (TEC) for the construction and operation of Big Bend Unit 4 in Hillsborough County. On July 29, 2019, the Florida Siting Board issued a Site Certification to TEC for existing Units 1, 2, and 3, and authorization to construct and operate the Big Bend Unit 1 Modernization Project at its existing Big Bend Power Station (Big Bend). The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has modified the Conditions of Certification (Conditions) for Big Bend by Final Order on nineteen other occasions.

On October 22, 2019, TEC submitted a request to the Department to extend the December 31, 2019, deadline to complete the lining of the East Coalfield Runoff Pond. The Department has reviewed the information provided by TEC on October 22, November 14, and November 15, 2019, and determined that TEC has implemented reasonable measures to stabilize pond water levels prior to beginning dewatering activities, and that additional time is needed to achieve further water level reductions. Therefore, the deadline for the lining of the East Coalfield Runoff Pond will be extended to December 31, 2020.

On December 12, 2019, all parties to the certification proceeding were provided notice of the Department's intent to modify the Conditions for Big Bend. On December 17, 2019, notice of the Department's intent to modify the Conditions for Big Bend was also published in the Florida Administrative Register (FAR).

Pursuant to Section 403.516, F.S., and Rule 62-17.211, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), all parties to the certification proceeding have 45 days from the issuance of notice in which to file a written objection to the modification. Pursuant to Section 403.516, F.S., and Rule 62-17.211, F.A.C., any person who is not already a party to the certification proceeding and whose substantial interests will be affected by the requested modification has 30 days from the date of publication of the public notice in the FAR to object in writing. Failure to act within the time frame constitutes a waiver of the right to become a party.

These timeframes have expired, and no objections to the modification have been received by the Department. Therefore, the Conditions of Certification for Big Bend are modified as follows:

The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date this Order is filed with the Clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection.
