The 2019 [Florida Circumnavigational Saltwater Paddling Trail](#) Reunion and Gathering is rapidly approaching! The weekend offers CT paddlers and supporters an opportunity to reunite, share stories, and learn more about the trail.

WHEN: April 19-21, 2019

WHERE: Beautiful [Tomoka State Park](#) in Ormond Beach. FPTA covers fees for weekend camping in the Youth Group Camp area, dinner Friday night, and breakfast Saturday and Sunday. You will have to pay admission to get in the park. Bring your own camping gear and food for lunches.

The program will feature our current class of CT paddlers, those who have recently completed the trail, and the FPTA volunteers who support them. Please be ready to share up to 20 of your best photos for 5-10 minute presentations to increase awareness of the trail and advise prospective thru-paddlers.
