[3] The appropriation for each agency is based on the life to date amount appropriated by the Legislature each fiscal year, as well as adjustments to appropriation. A breakdown of adjustments to appropriation is reflected on the individual sheets for each Fiscal Year Appropriation.

[7] 2013-2014 Division of State Lands received a \$60M Florida Forever Trust Fund Appropriation (\$50M is funded with cash proceeds from the sale of surplus conservation lands and \$10M is funded with cash from the Land Acquisition Trust Fund) and a \$10M General Revenue Appropriation. GAA 1544. *The Legislature reverted the \$10M in GR the following year and appropriated \$10M in Florida Forever for the Water Management Districts (Appropriated in the Office of Water Policy). In addition, \$49M of the \$50M Appropriation was reverted in March 2015 and the remaining \$1M Appropriation was reverted in June 2016 as there were no surplus conservation lands sold to support the appropriation.*
