



Compliance Calendar for Florida Perchloroethylene Dry Cleaners

2025

This calendar is designed for Perchloroethylene Dry Cleaners. It summarizes environmental regulations and provides a place for you to keep required records. Keep these records at your facility for five years.

Environmental Regulations

Dry cleaners are facilities engaged in the cleaning of fabrics in a nonaqueous solvent by means of one or more washes in a solvent, extraction of excess solvent by spinning, and drying by tumbling in an airstream. Such facilities include dry to dry machines, filter and purification systems; emission control equipment; waste disposal systems; holding tanks; pumps and attendant piping and valves.

Dry cleaning facilities utilizing the solvent perchloroethylene, or “perc”, which is considered an air toxic or hazardous pollutant, are eligible to operate in Florida under the terms of an air general permit (AGP) pursuant to the requirements of **Rule 62-210.310(5)(f), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)**.

An AGP is an authorization by rule to construct or operate a specific type of air pollutant emitting facility. Use of such authorization by any individual facility does not require action by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). The terms and conditions of an AGP are set forth in the rule, rather than in a separately issued air construction or air operation permit.

Dry cleaners that use only petroleum based cleaning solvents may qualify for an exemption under **Rule 62-210.300(3)(a)(25), F.A.C.**, provided the solvent consumption is less than 3,250 gallons per year.

Perc Purchases Running Total (July 2025 example)

Record the date you purchased perc. If you bought 15 gallons, record this amount and add it to the subtotal. This amount will also go on next year's calendar for this same month. The 12-month running total is now 60 gallons. Record 60 gallons on next month's form.

Running total from last month (June 2025)	Previous 12-month's total	55 gallons
Enter the amount of perc you bought during this same month last year, from last year's records or calendar. Subtract this amount. (July 2024)	Subtract	10 gallons
This is your 12-month running total if you do not buy perc this month	Subtotal	45 gallons

Facts

Condenser Temperature Log:

- Check the outlet temperature of the refrigerated condenser every week.
- Record the temperature and date in the space provided.
- In the block marked “Is temp. less than or equal to 45° F (7.2° C)?” check “yes” or “no”. If you checked “no”, the machine must be repaired.
- If you buy 140 gallons or more of perc per year, you must check your machine weekly for leaks and record the results.
- If you buy less than 140 gallons of perc per year, you must conduct and record leak inspections at least every other week.
- Record the results of the inspections on the calendar. If leaks are found, they must be repaired within 24 hours. Indicate in the “Date Repaired” block when repairs are completed. If parts must be purchased, indicate the dates they are ordered, and the date installed. Parts must be ordered within two working days of leak detection and installed within five working days of receipt.

If you are a Florida dry cleaner that uses perc, you need to be permitted with the Division of Air Resources Management and you need to be registered with the Division of Waste.

Division of Waste Management: 850-245-8705

Federal EPA ID Number: As a dry cleaner, it is likely that you are a small quantity generator of hazardous waste. Call the contact number above for your required Federal ID number.

Dry Cleaning Facility Registration: Dry cleaning facilities and wholesale supply facilities that use dry cleaning solvents are required to be registered with the Division of Waste Management. Regulated solvents include: perchloroethylene (“perc”), tetrachloroethylene, valcene, carbon tetrachloride, and other petroleum-based solvents. The Waste Division issues invoices each November for a \$100 annual registration fee due from every facility that operated in the calendar year. You must be registered in order to purchase perc from your supplier.

Dry Cleaning Solvent Cleanup Program: Dry cleaning facilities and wholesale supply facilities that reported dry cleaning solvent contamination to FDEP no later than December 31, 1998, may be eligible for site rehabilitation assistance. Call the contact number above for more information on this program and to see if your facility is eligible.

Septic Tank Recommendations: Check with your Local County Health Department.

Sewer Recommendations: Check with your Local public/private utility.
