Required under Florida Statutes 253 & 259, a Unit Management Plan (UMP) is a planning document that is prepared for all 175 state parks and trails. The purpose of this meeting is to receive public input on the draft UMP update for Ravine Gardens State Park.

## **Resource Management Objectives**

#### **Hydrological Management**

• Conduct/obtain an assessment of the park's hydrological restoration needs.

#### **Natural Communities Management**

• Conduct natural community/habitat improvement activities on four acres of upland hardwood forest natural community.

### **Imperiled Species Management**

- Develop/Update baseline imperiled species occurrence inventory lists for plants and animals.
- Monitor and document four selected imperiled animal species in the park.
- Monitor and document one selected imperiled plant species in the park.

### **Non-Native and Nuisance Species Management**

- Annually treat five infested acres of invasive plant species in the park.
- Implement control measures on two nuisance species in the park.

### **Cultural Resource Management**

- Assess and evaluate all 12 recorded cultural resources in the park.
- Bring one of 12 recorded cultural resources into good condition.
