- Connect Campground to Central Waste Services
- Add Paddle Craft drop-off at Main Headspring
- Enhanced safety for Swimming Area
- Redesign Main Parking Lot to enhance Visitor Safety
- Remove asphalt and Restore unused areas of Parking Lot
