Annual Mining and Reclamation Report

General Instructions: This form shall be used to comply with the requirements of Chapter 62C-16, F.A.C., for an annual mining and reclamation report. Guidance in filling out the application may be obtained by contacting the department at the above address. Complete and submit this form as follows:

1. Fill in the blanks on pages two and three of this form and provide the appropriate signature.
2. Respond to each item in Part IV, using additional pages, as needed. Identify all responses by part and item number. Repeat the appropriate question or request and follow it with your response. All additional pages of text shall be in the standard format, include the heading ATTACHMENT in the upper right corner, and be numbered.
3. Provide the maps and aerial photographs requested in Parts V and VI.
4. All maps, aerial photographs, drawings, cross sections, and additional pages of text shall comply with the application standards in section 62C-16.0036, F.A.C. In addition, the standard format shall be 8½ X 11 with a 1" margin on all sides. Single spacing is preferred for text with double spacing between paragraphs and items. Maps may be larger than 8½ X 11, but shall have a one-inch margin on all sides.
5. Submit pages two and three and all attachments to the department as follows:
 - a. The report shall be unbound, be of reproducible quality, and bear an original signature.
 - b. All maps or aerial photographs that are larger than 8½ X 11 shall be submitted rolled rather than folded.

Part IV. Mining and Reclamation Activities

1. Provide a written description of all new sites disturbed by mining operations by section, township, range, and county. The actual number of acres shall be given for each section.
2. Provide an accounting of the materials encountered as described in paragraph 62C-16.0051(2)(b) and how they were handled.
3. Provide a description of reclamation and restoration activities, including the acreage completed of each phase, carried out during the previous year for each reclamation parcel.
4. Identify any changes in the information required under paragraph 62C-16.0041(1)(k), as shown in the approved conceptual plan.
5. Please provide actual completion dates for mining, waste disposal, and reclamation and restoration activities for acres mined in the previous calendar year for each reclamation parcel. Identify any changes in the beginning or ending dates for mining operations in approved parcels.

Part V. Maps

1. Provide a map which shows all lands disturbed by mining operations within the mine through the previous calendar year, and identify as follows, including acreages for each area:
 - a. Disturbed by mining operations, but not mined, before July 1, 1975.
 - b. Disturbed by mining operations, but not mined, after June 30, 1975, specifying the year.
 - c. Mined prior to July 1, 1975.
 - d. Mined after June 30, 1975, specifying the year.
2. Provide a map which shows all reclamation parcels delineated after June 30, 1975, including their current status and acreage of reclamation, and the location of all permitted water discharge points, including their identification number and the permitting agency.
3. Provide a map which shows all sites used or under construction for waste disposal, including the type of waste, the acreage of each site, and the beginning and ending dates for disposal.

Part VI. Aerial Photographs

Provide recent aerial photographs of all disturbed and mined lands, including the area within one mile of such lands within the mine boundary. The photographs shall be taken after December 1st of the report year, but as close as reasonably possible to December 31st, of the report year. This shall not be construed as a requirement for multiple, or serial, aerial photography. The copies submitted to the department shall be acceptable quality sepias and include the date flown, scale, and locations of section corners.
