Background

Hugh Taylor Birch State Park is a 175.96 -acre property located in Broward County, in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida. The park is managed by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Recreation and Parks (DRP).

Improvements

The following developments/improvements are proposed for the updated Hugh Taylor Birch State Park management plan:

- Historic preservation improvements to Terramar Visitor House
- New pedestrian path off E. Sunrise Blvd
- New boardwalk over Long Lake
- Continued road maintenance on two-mile loop
- Pavilion improvements throughout the park
- Potential flood adaptations at North Day Use Area
- New interpretive seating area near south end of Long Lake
