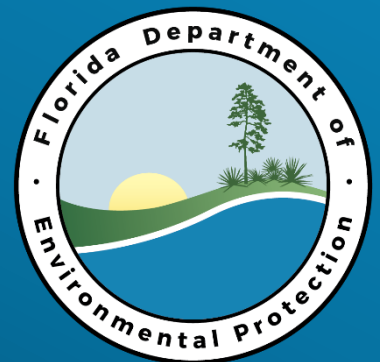

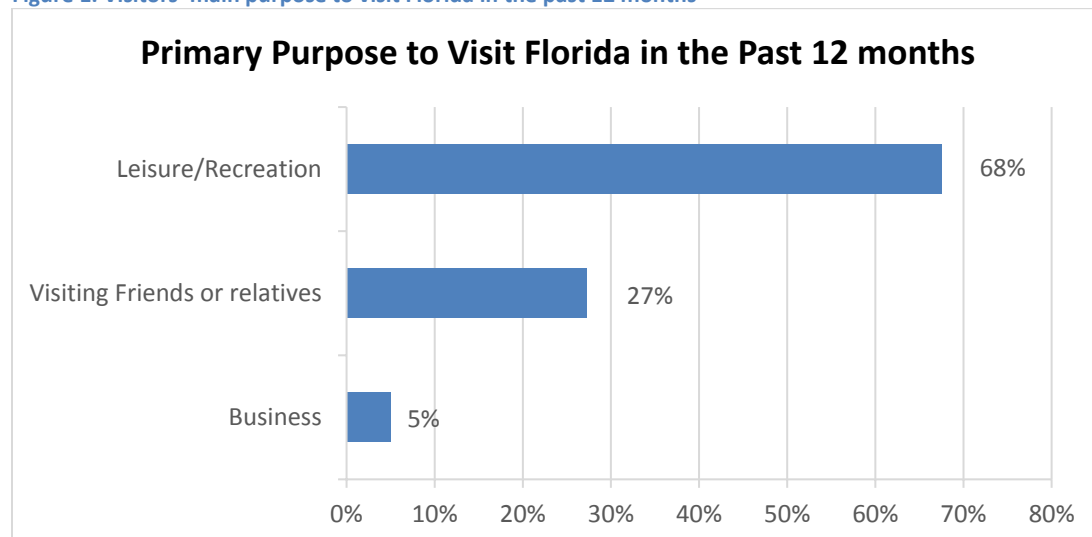
Figure 157. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Monroe County	117

Figure 2. Resident Participation in Recreational Activities in the past 12 months: Statewide

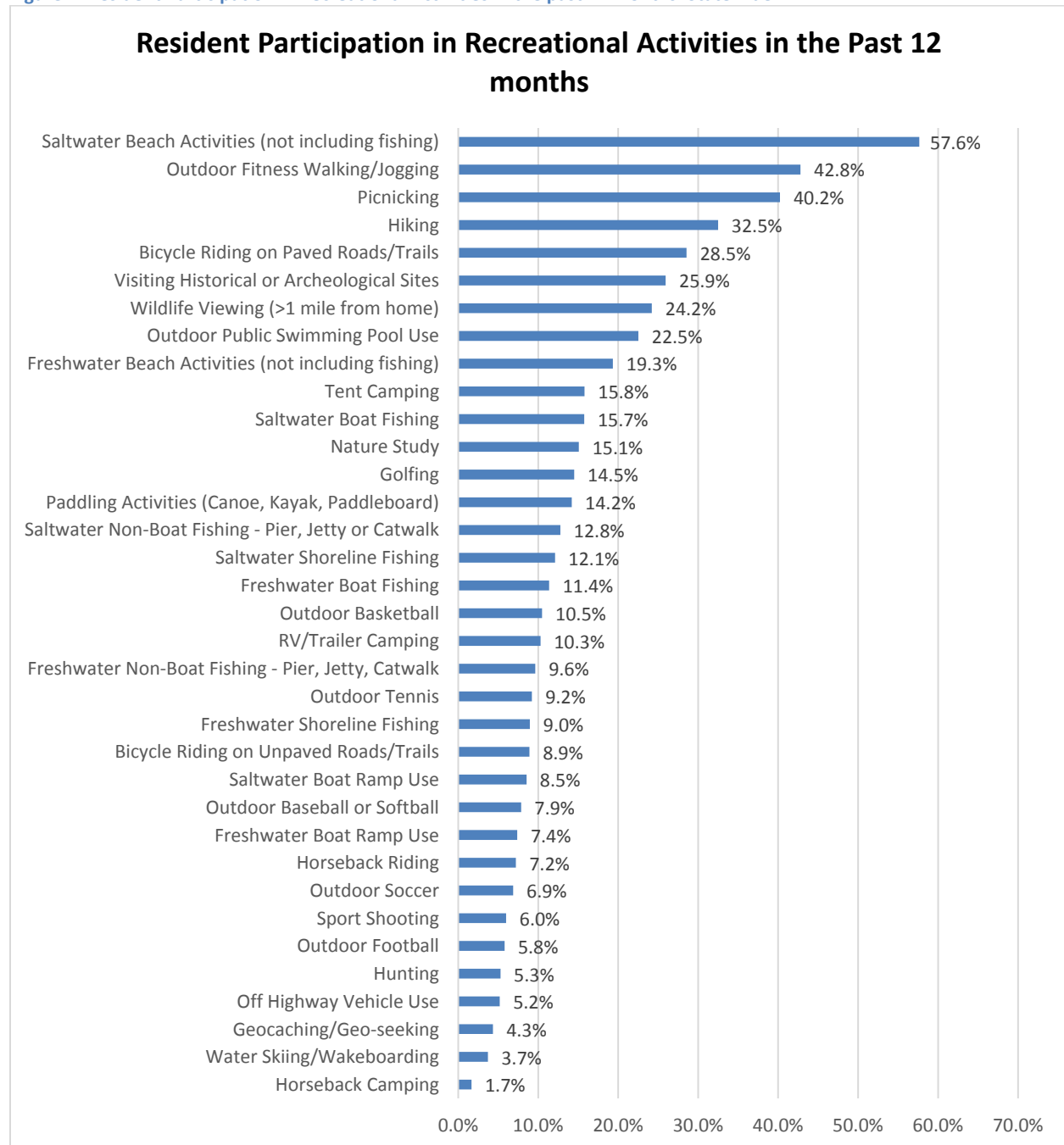


Figure 3. Visitor Participation in Recreational Activities in the Past 12 months: Statewide

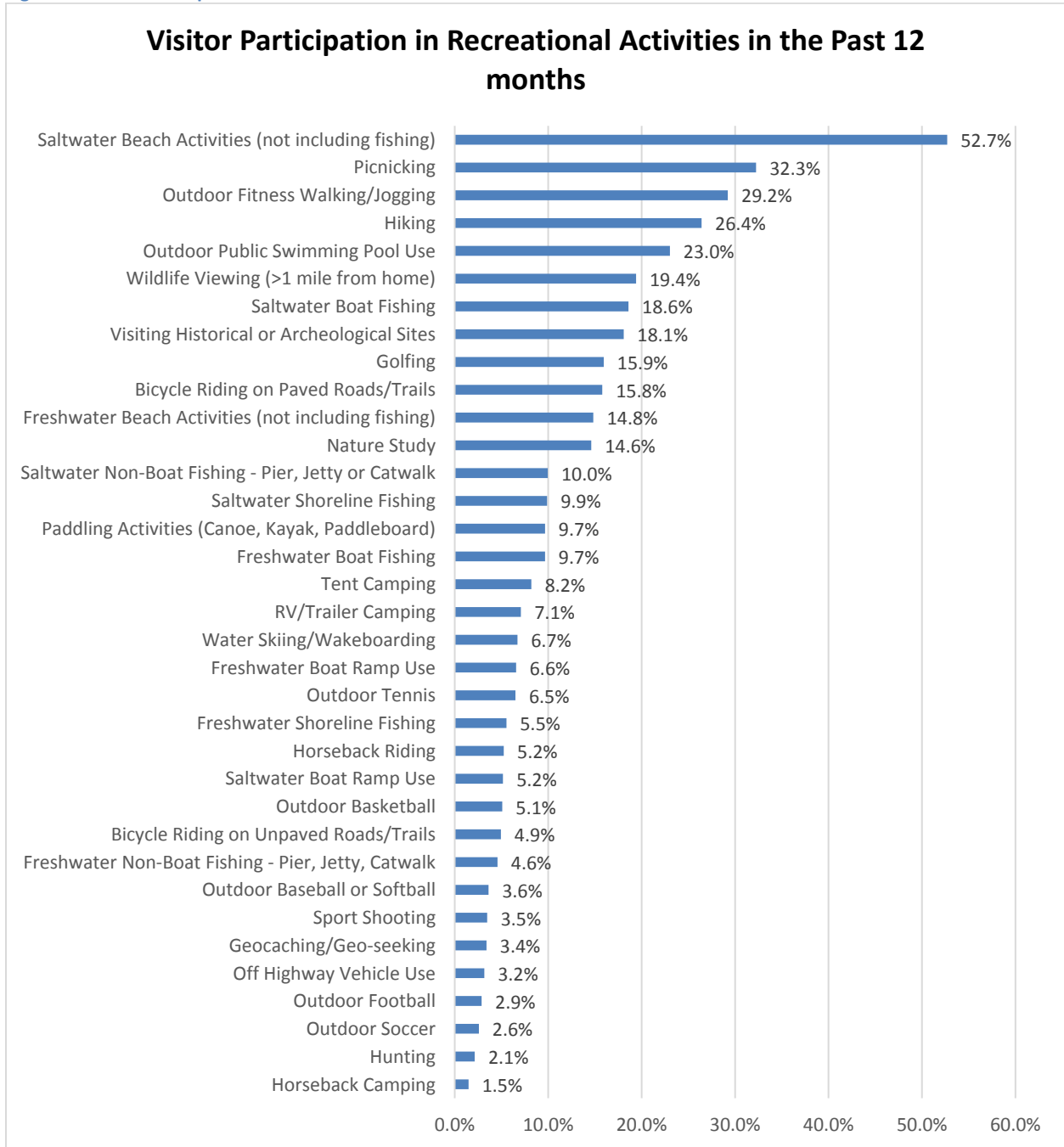


Figure 4. Overall Activity Participation: Residents and Visitors combined

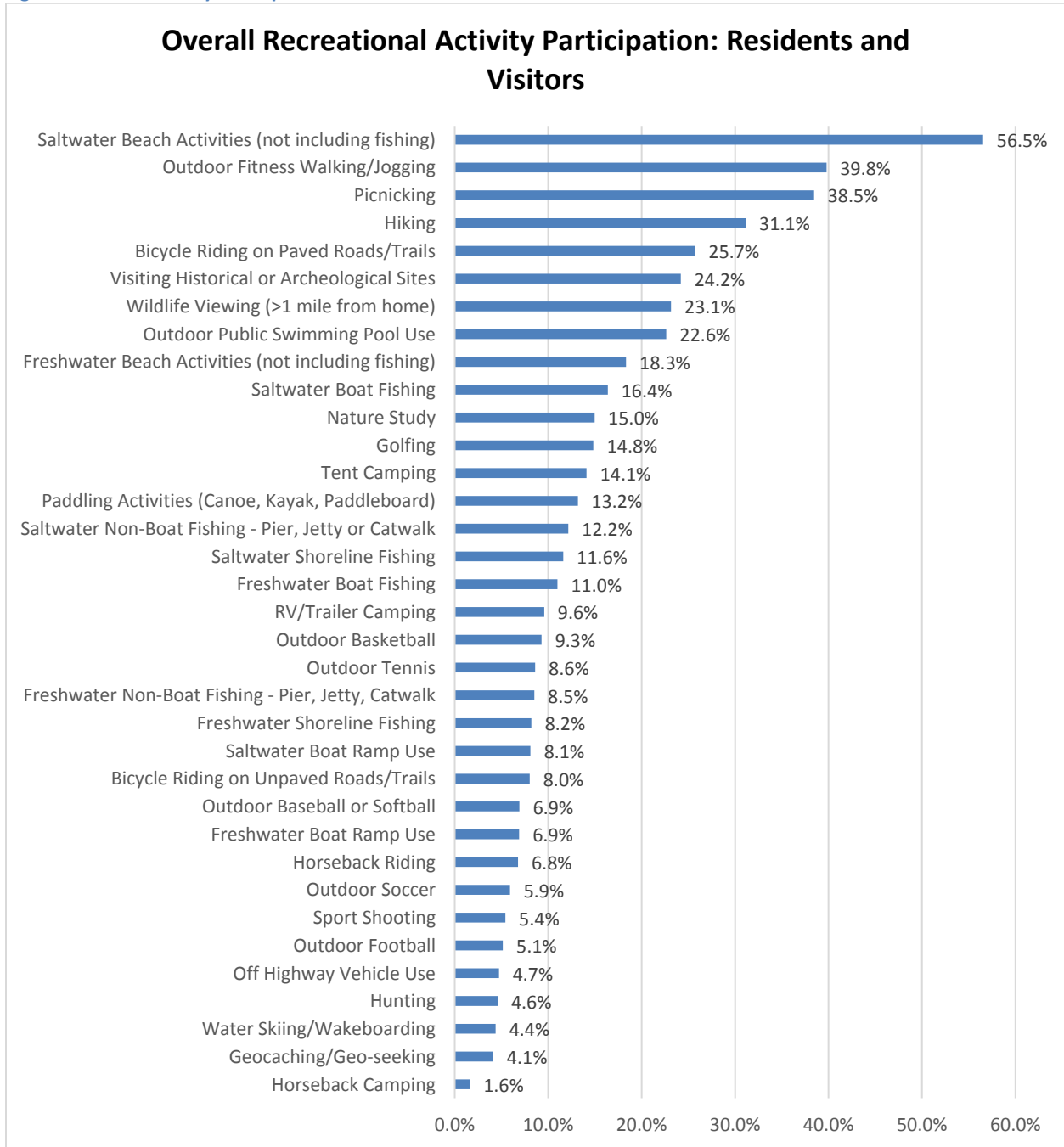


Figure 5. Recreational Activity Resident Respondents Participated the most in the past 12 months

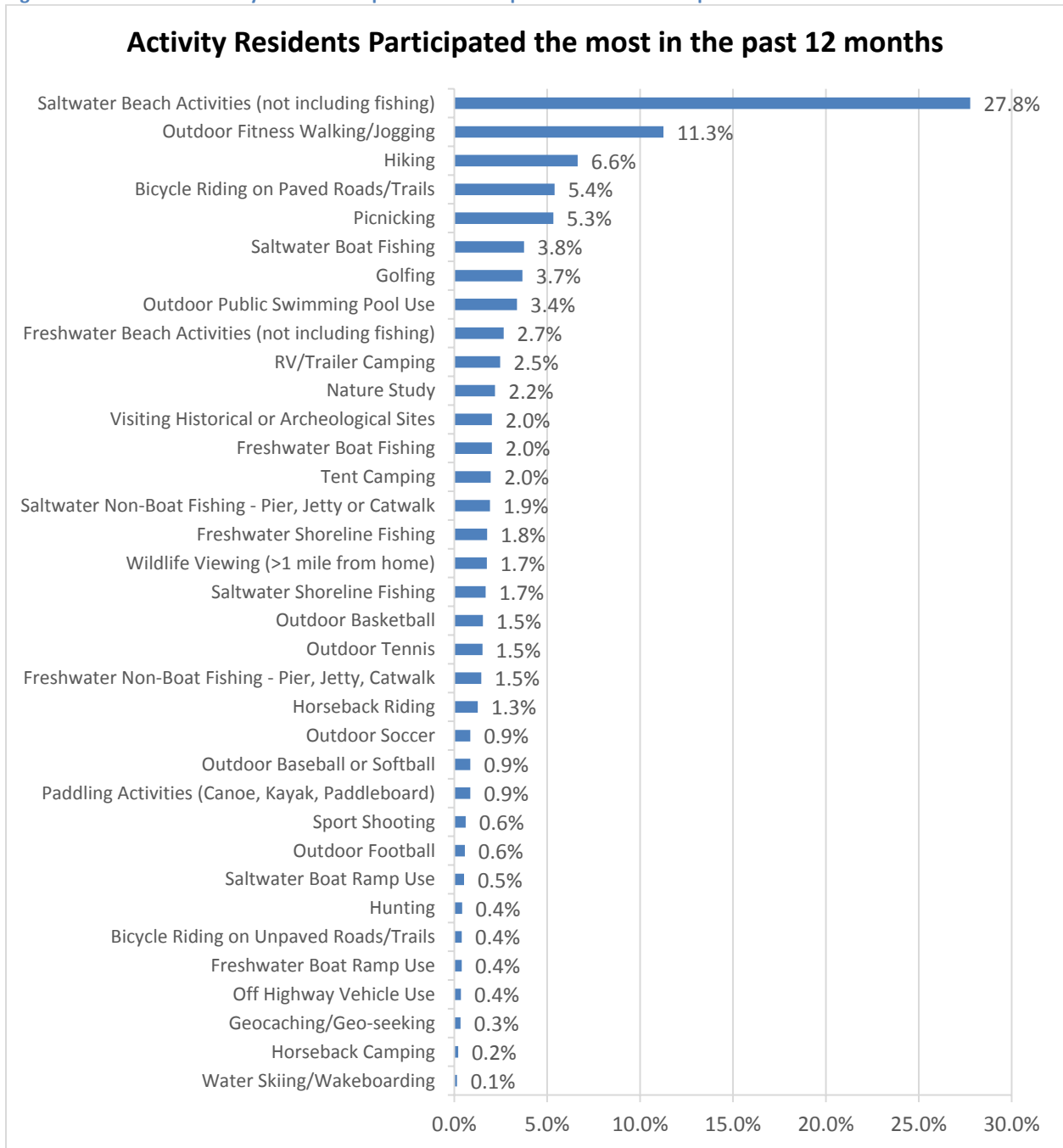


Figure 6. Share of Residents that include each Activity in their Top 3 of most participation in the past 12 months

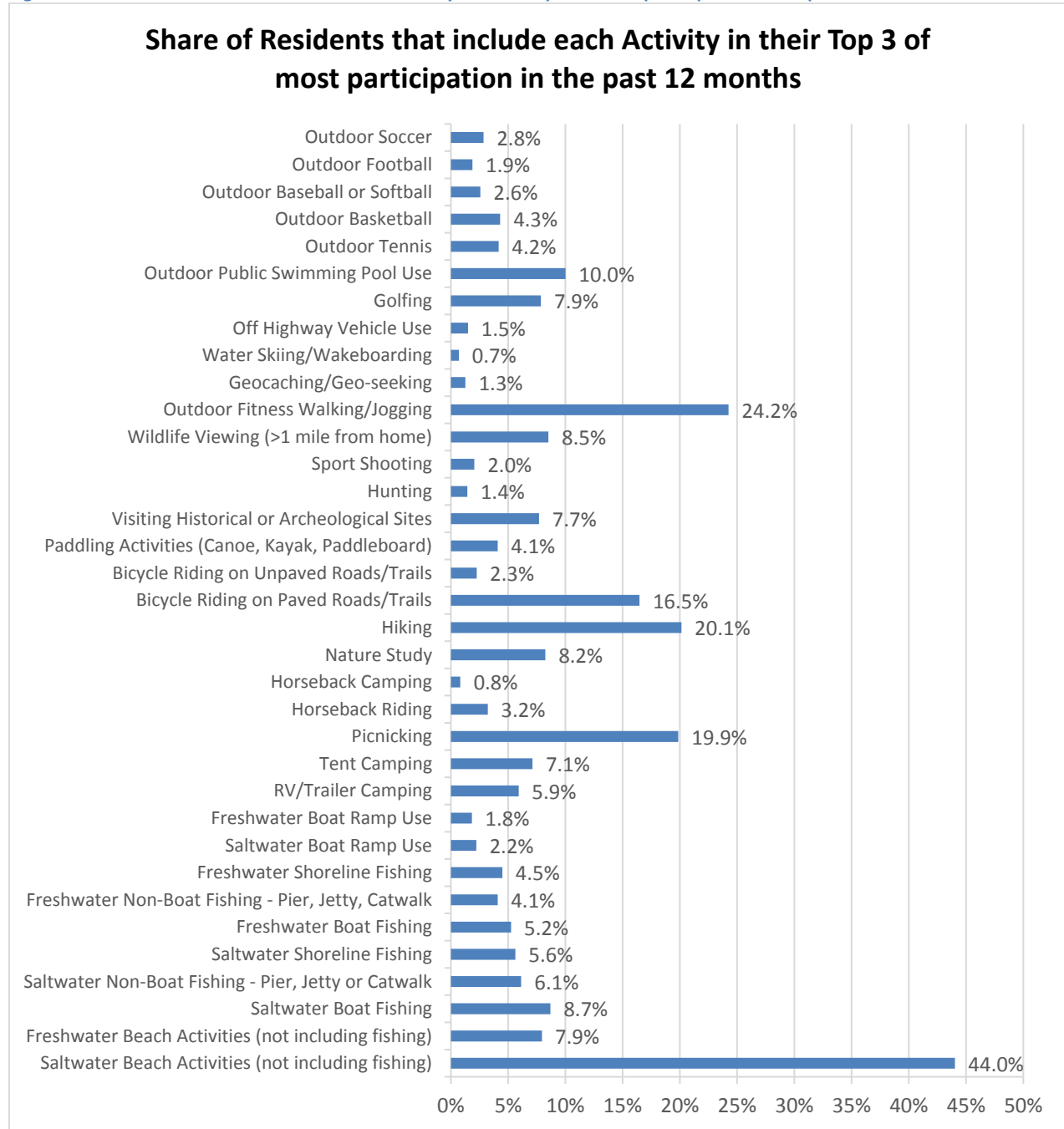


Figure 7. Recreational Activities Visitors Participated the most in the past 12 months

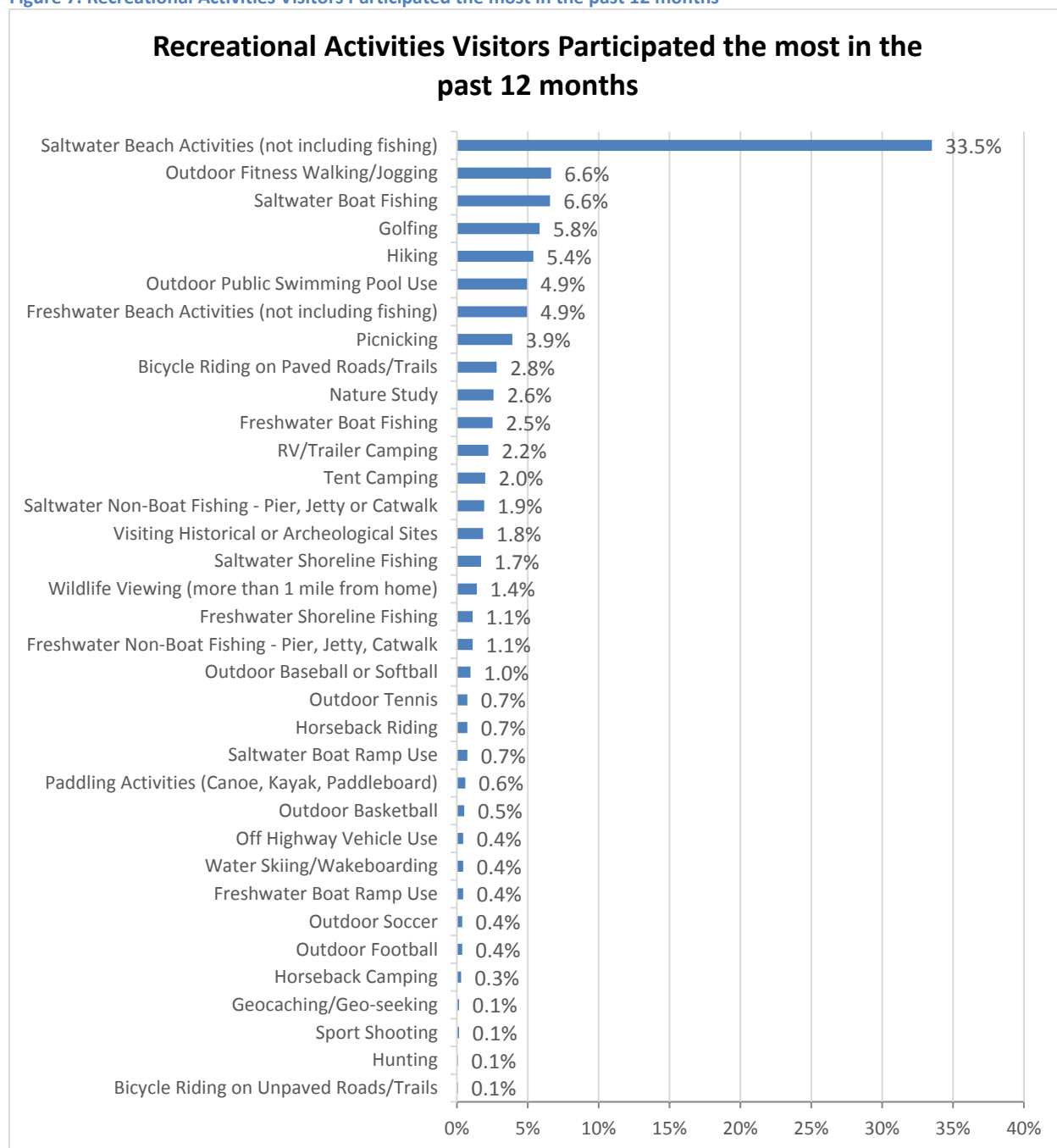
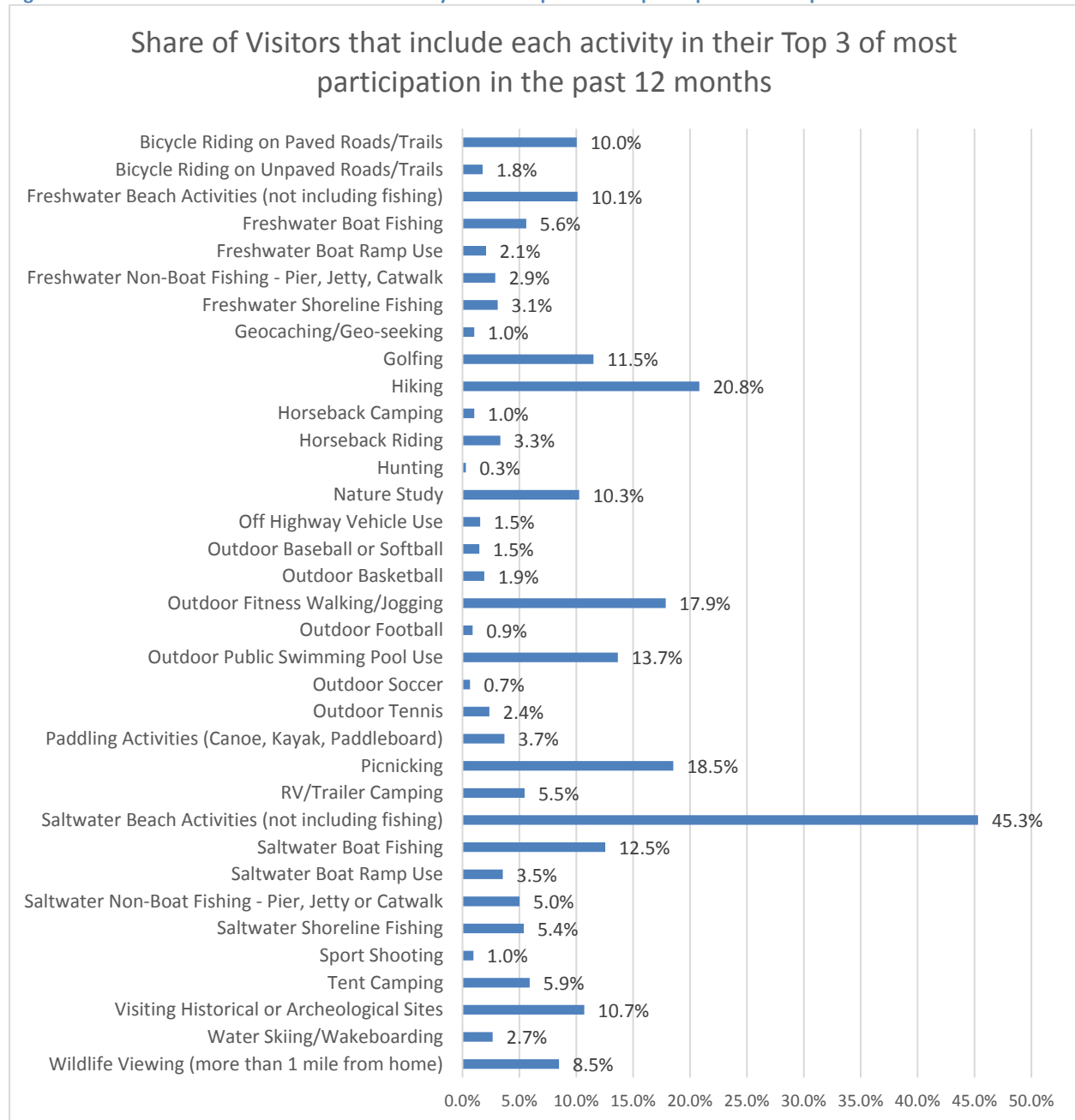


Figure 8. Share of Visitors that include each Activity in their Top 3 of most participation in the past 12 months

Figure 9. Central SCORP Region Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreation Activities

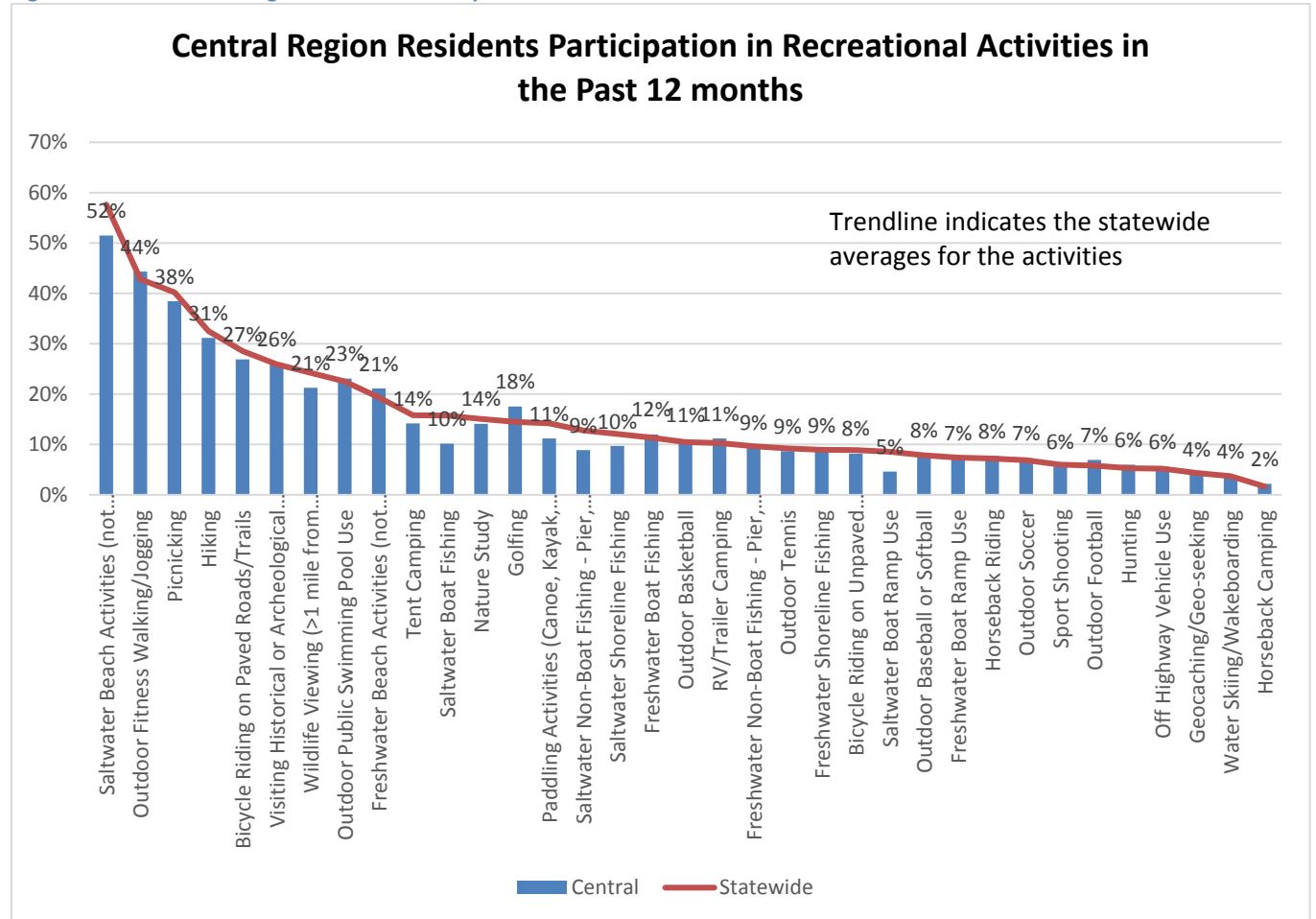


Figure 10. Central East SCORP Region Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreation Activities

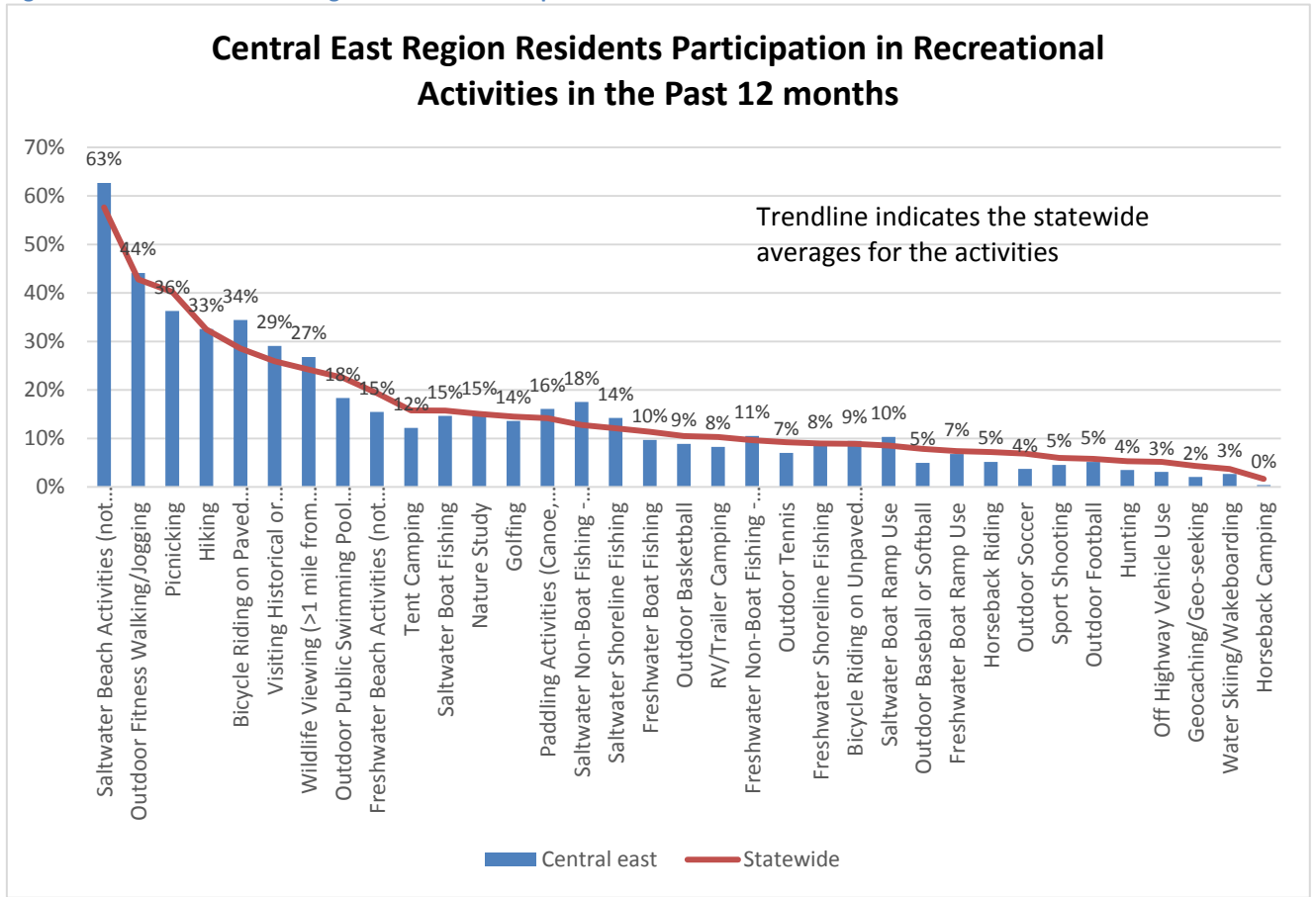


Figure 11. Central West SCORP Region Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreation Activities

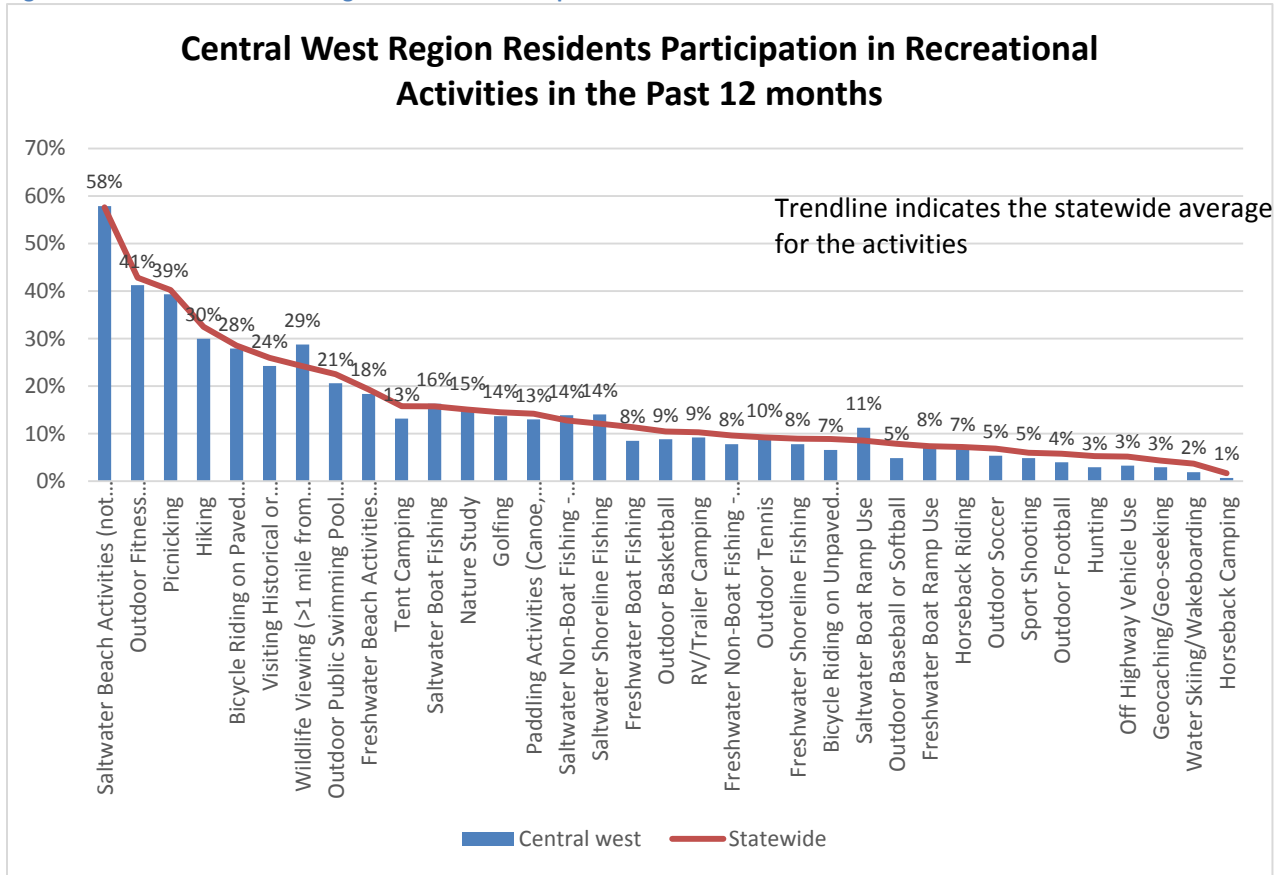


Figure 12. North Central SCORP Region Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreation Activities

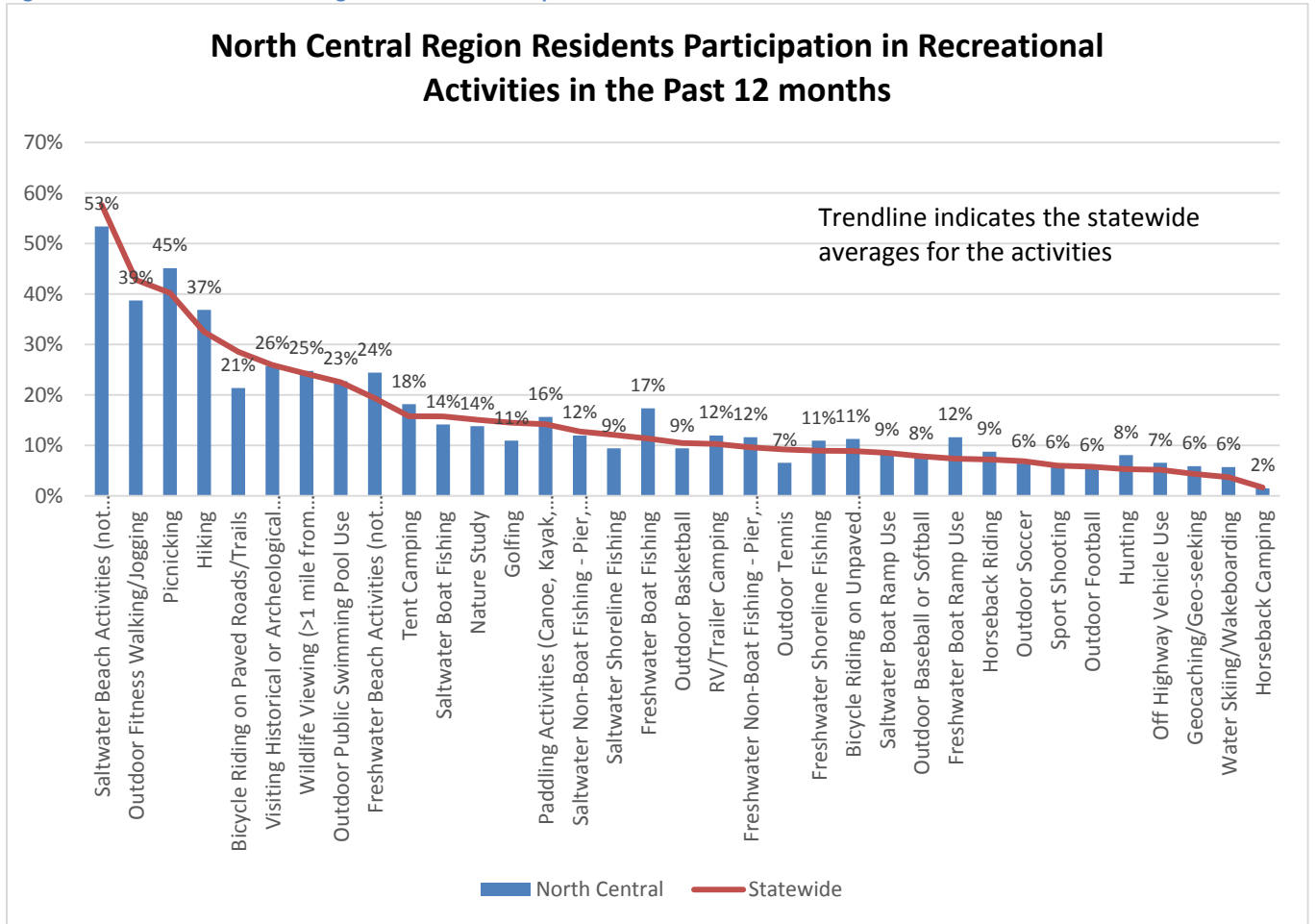


Figure 13. Northeast SCORP Region Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreation Activities

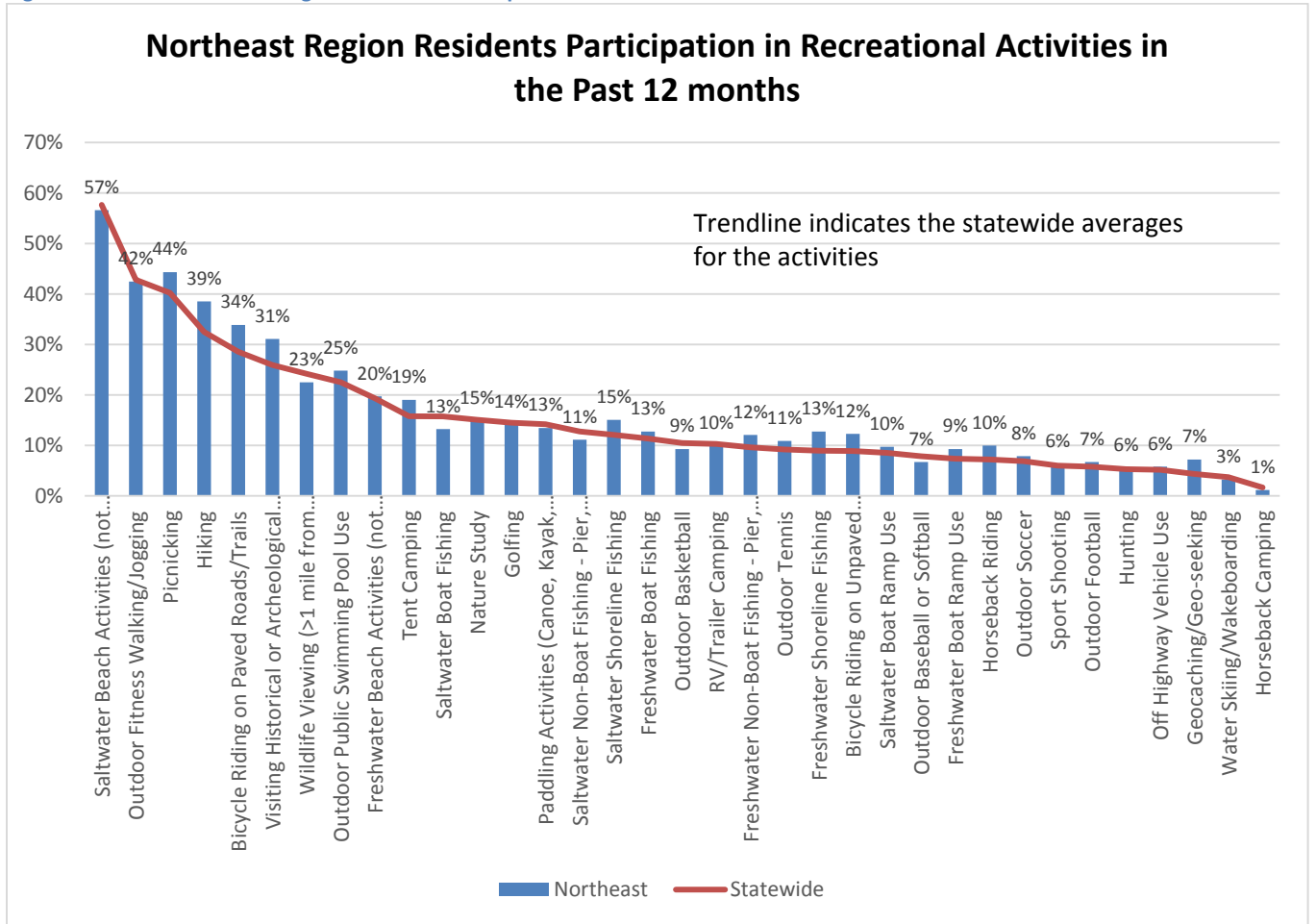


Figure 14. Northwest SCORP Region Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreation Activities

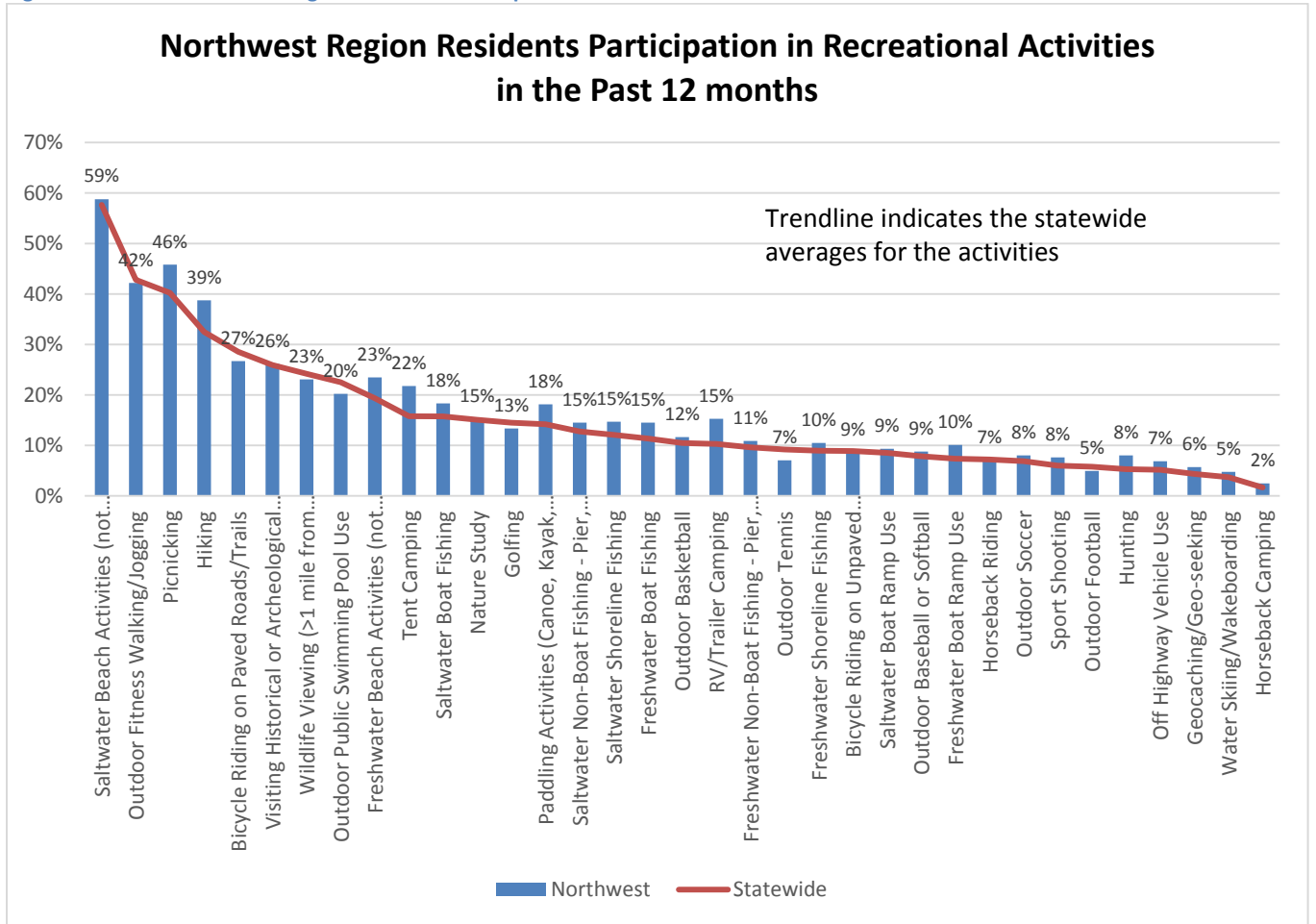


Figure 15. Southeast SCORP Region Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreation Activities

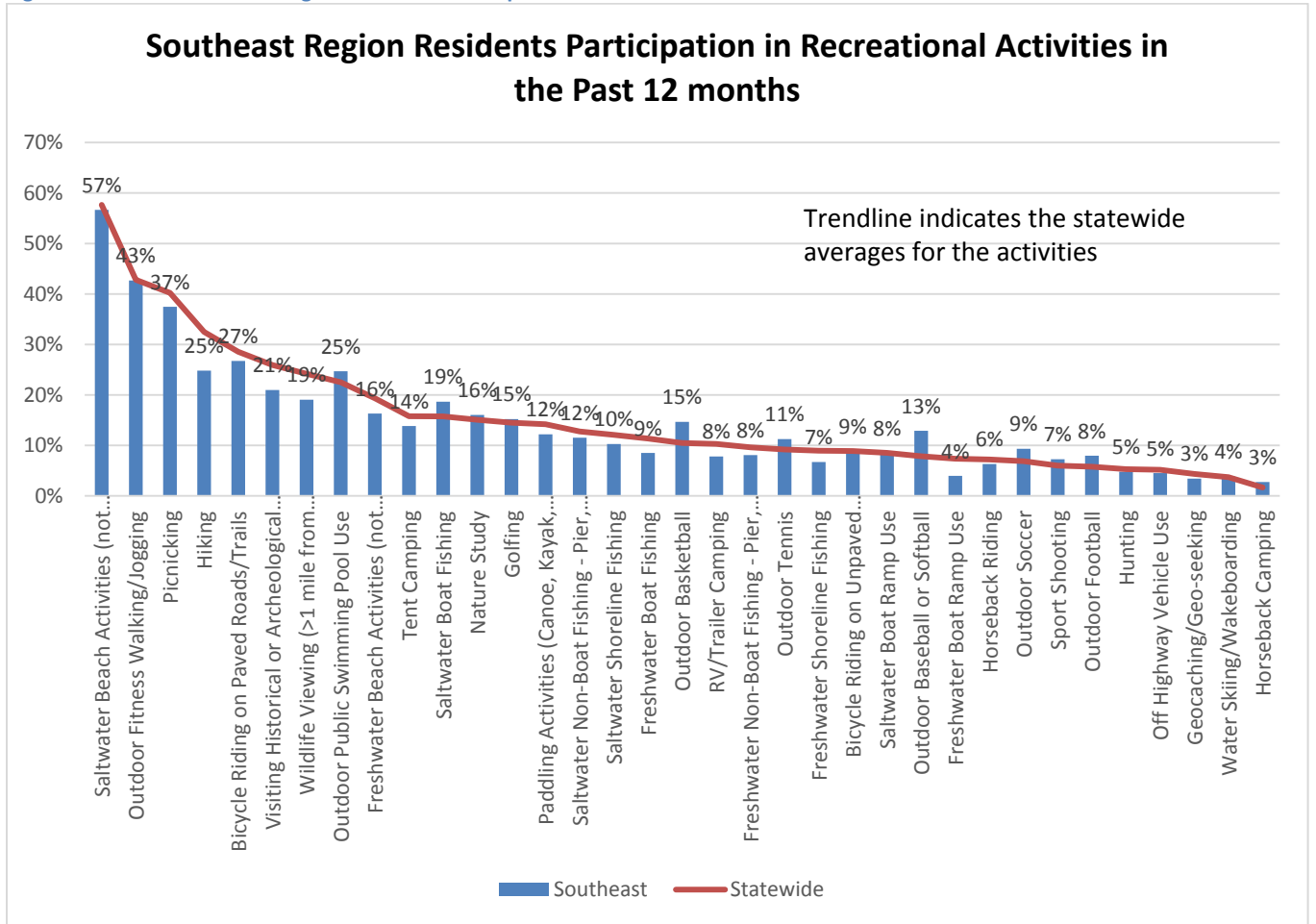
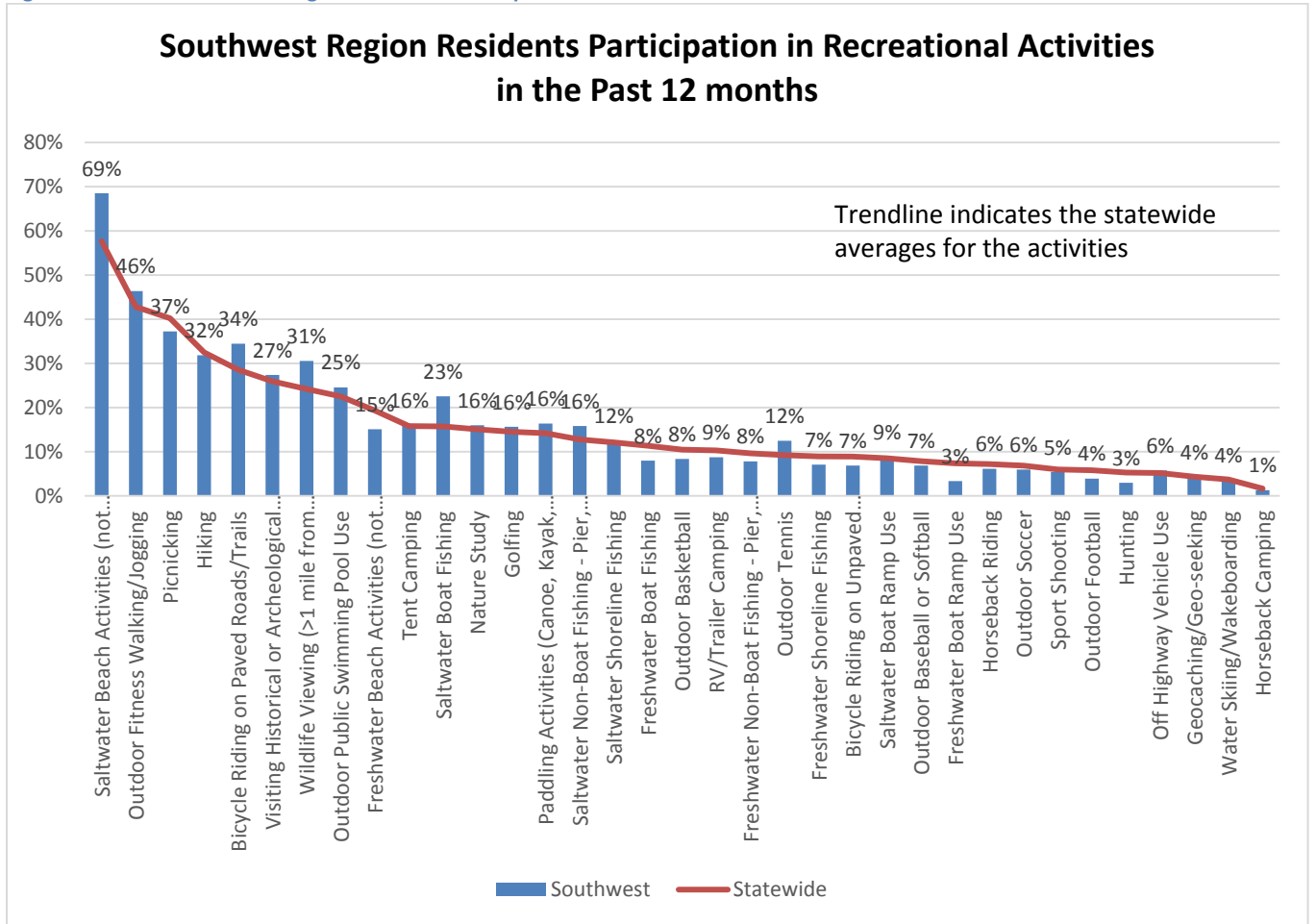


Figure 16. Southwest SCORP Region Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreation Activities

Figure 17. Resident Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Central SCORP Region

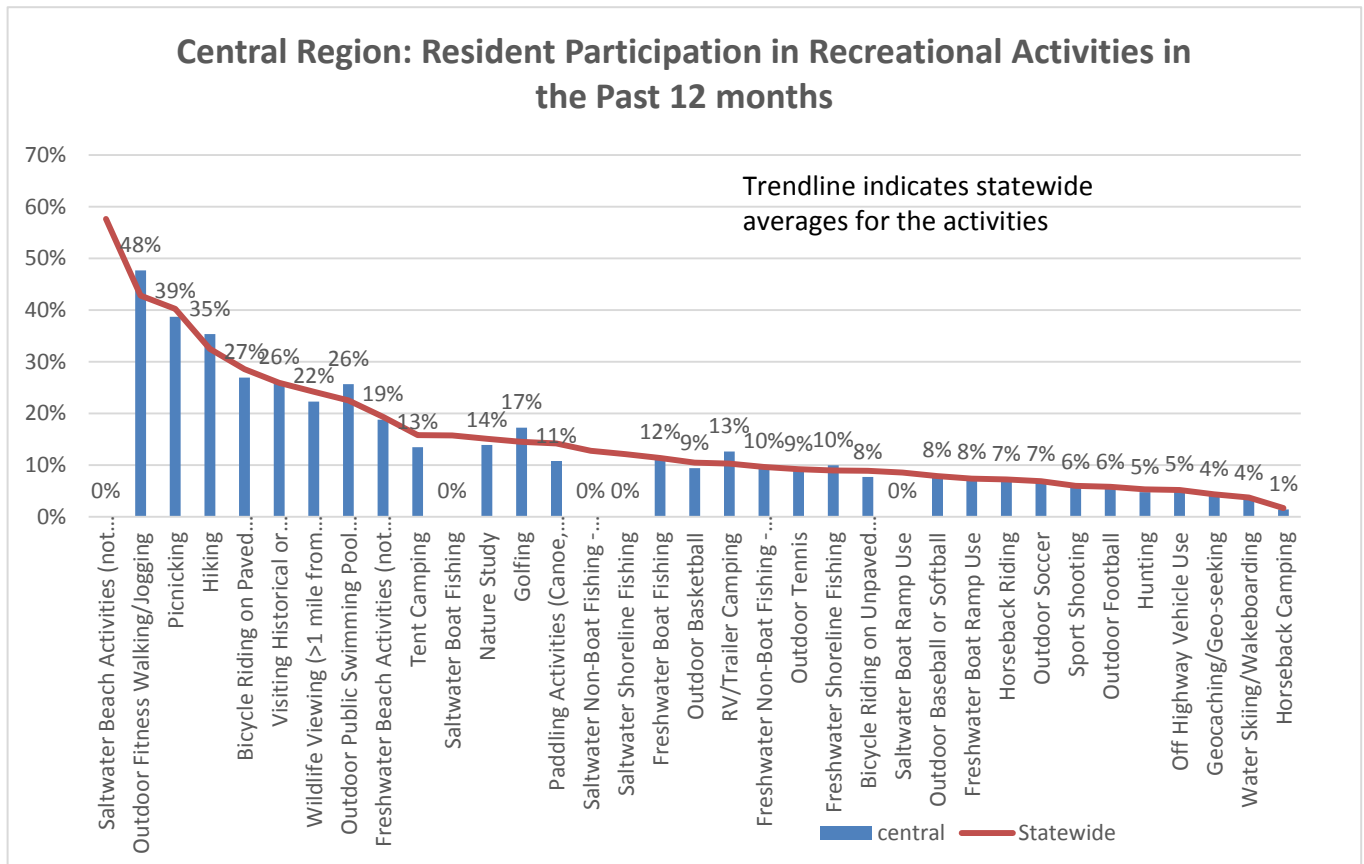


Figure 18. Resident Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Central East SCORP Region

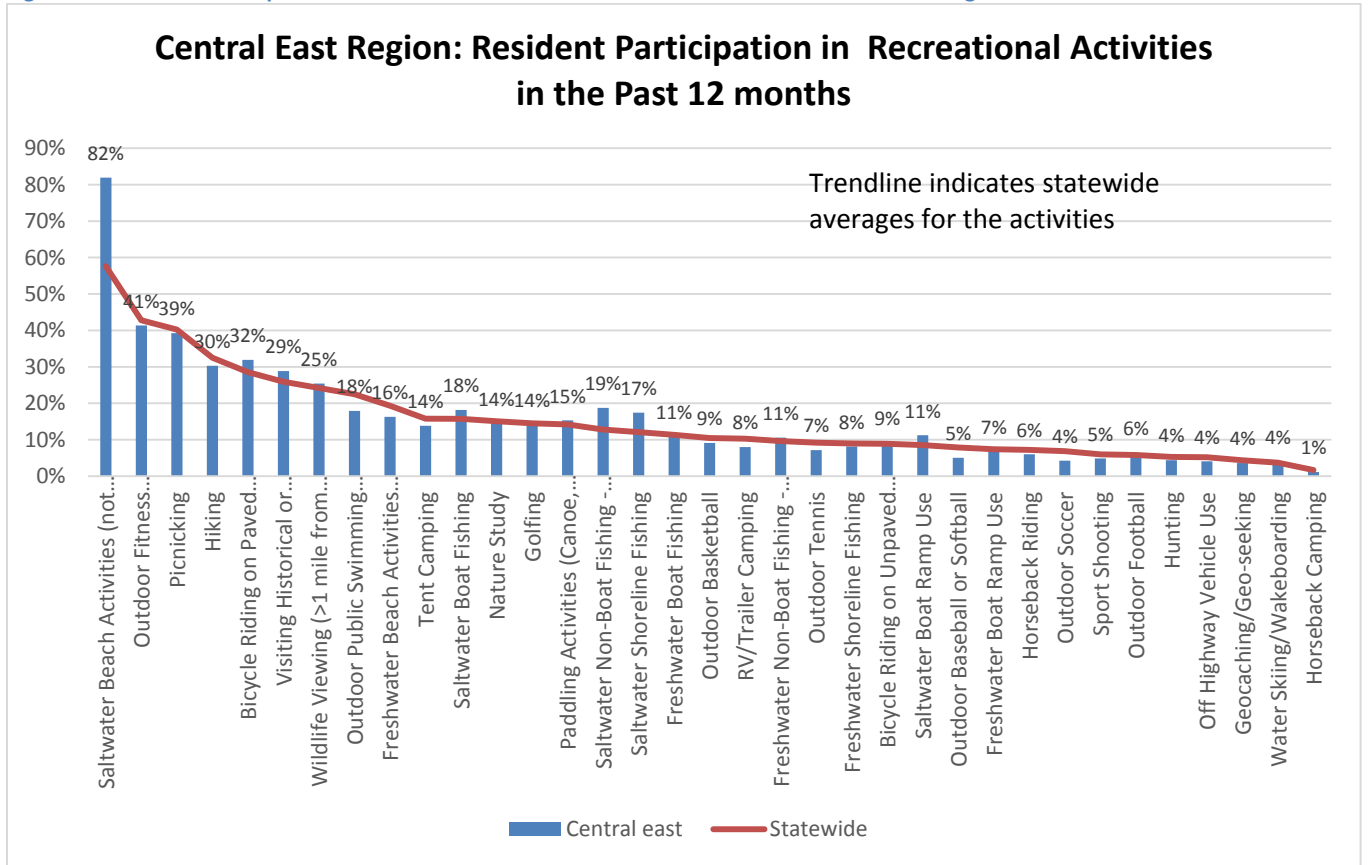


Figure 19. Resident Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Central West SCORP Region

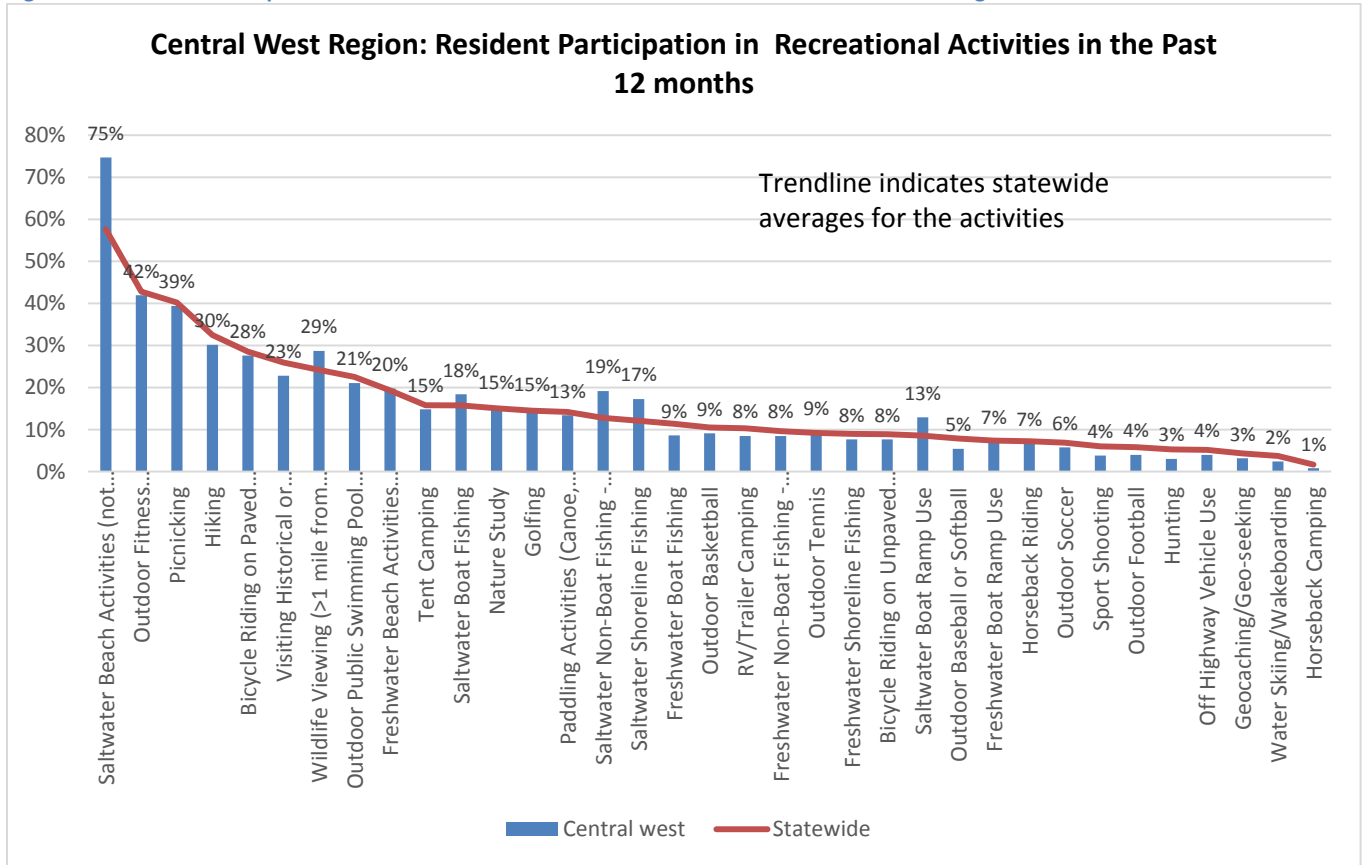


Figure 20. Resident Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the North Central SCORP Region

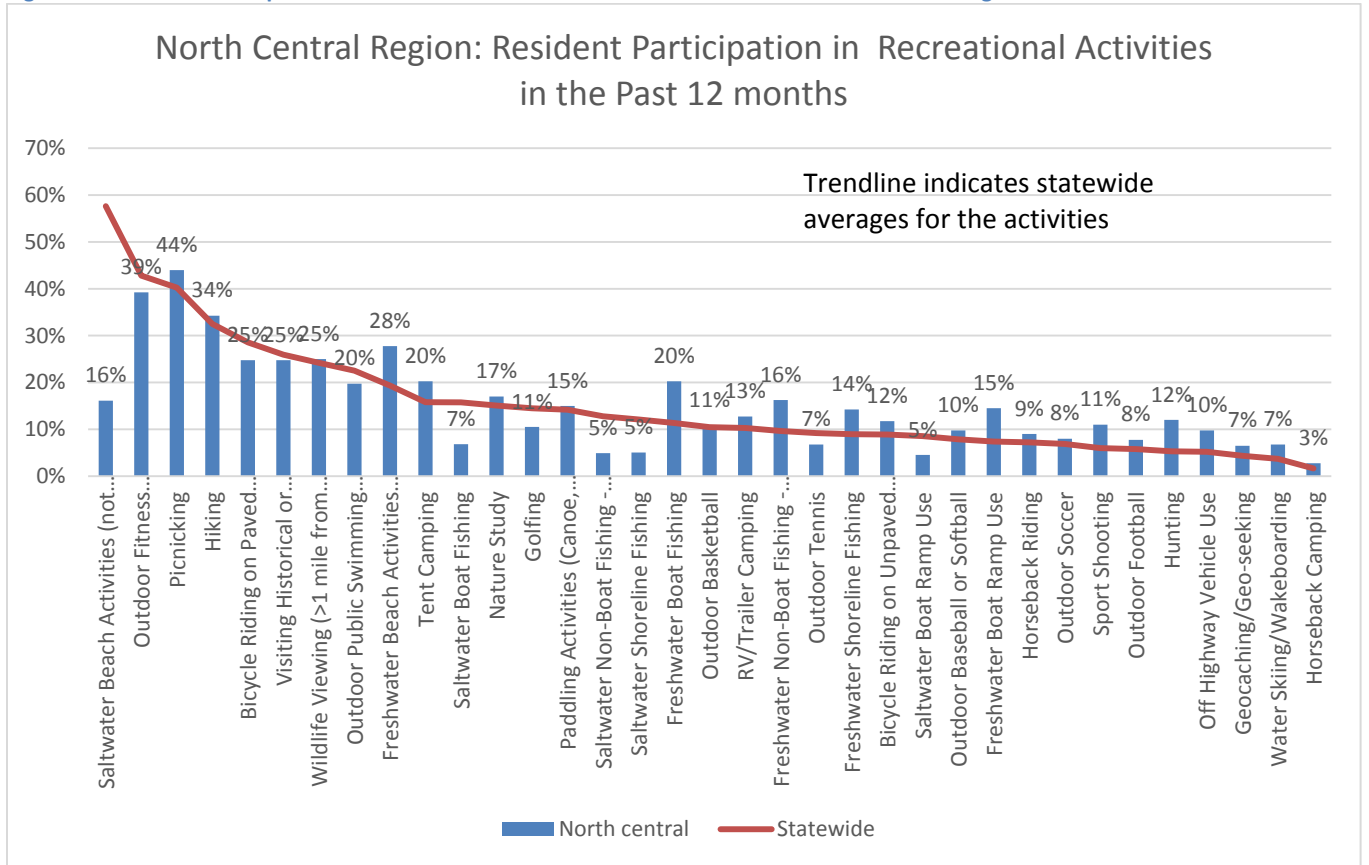


Figure 21. Resident Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Northeast SCORP Region

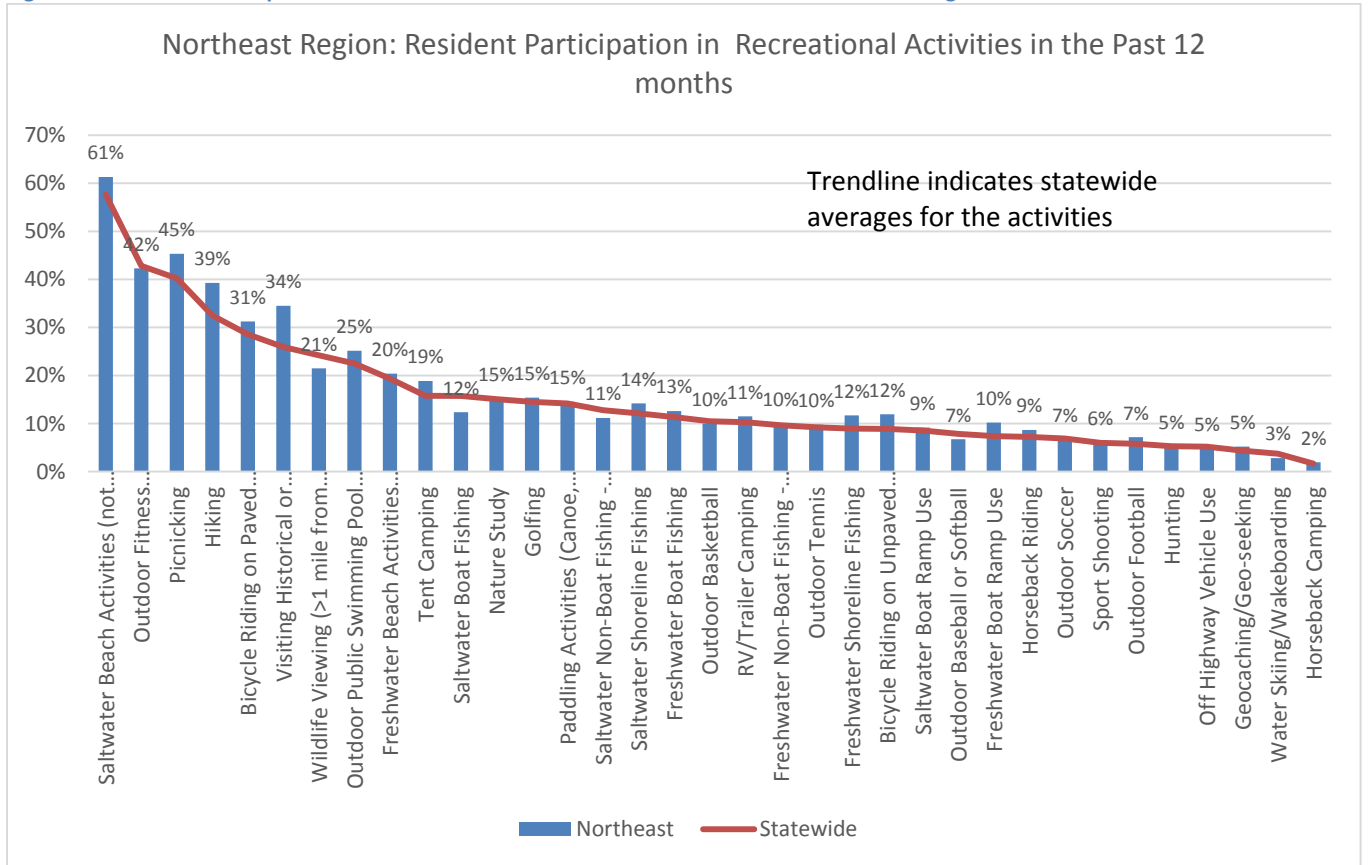


Figure 22. Resident Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Northwest SCORP Region

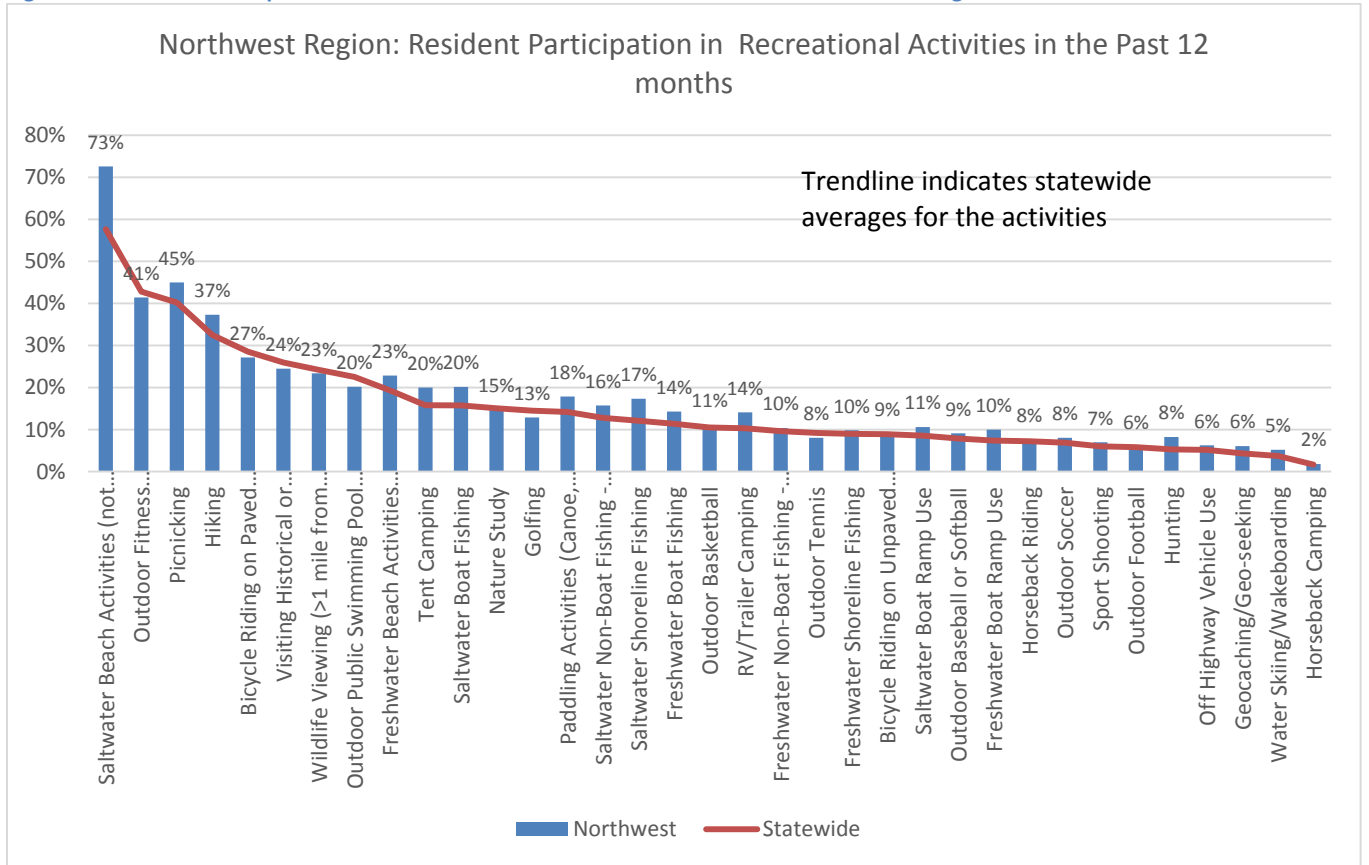


Figure 23. Resident Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Southeast SCORP Region

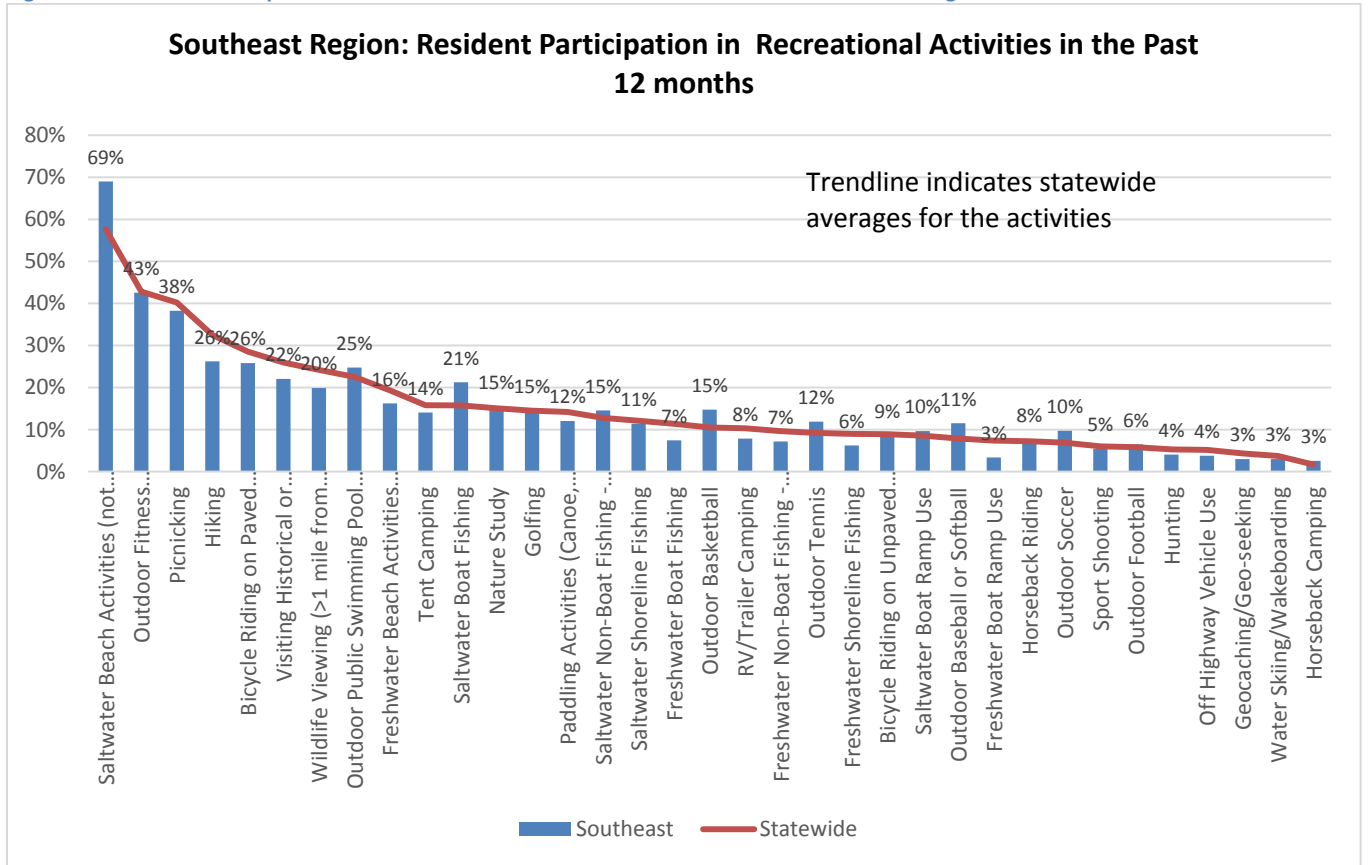


Figure 24. Resident Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Southwest SCORP Region

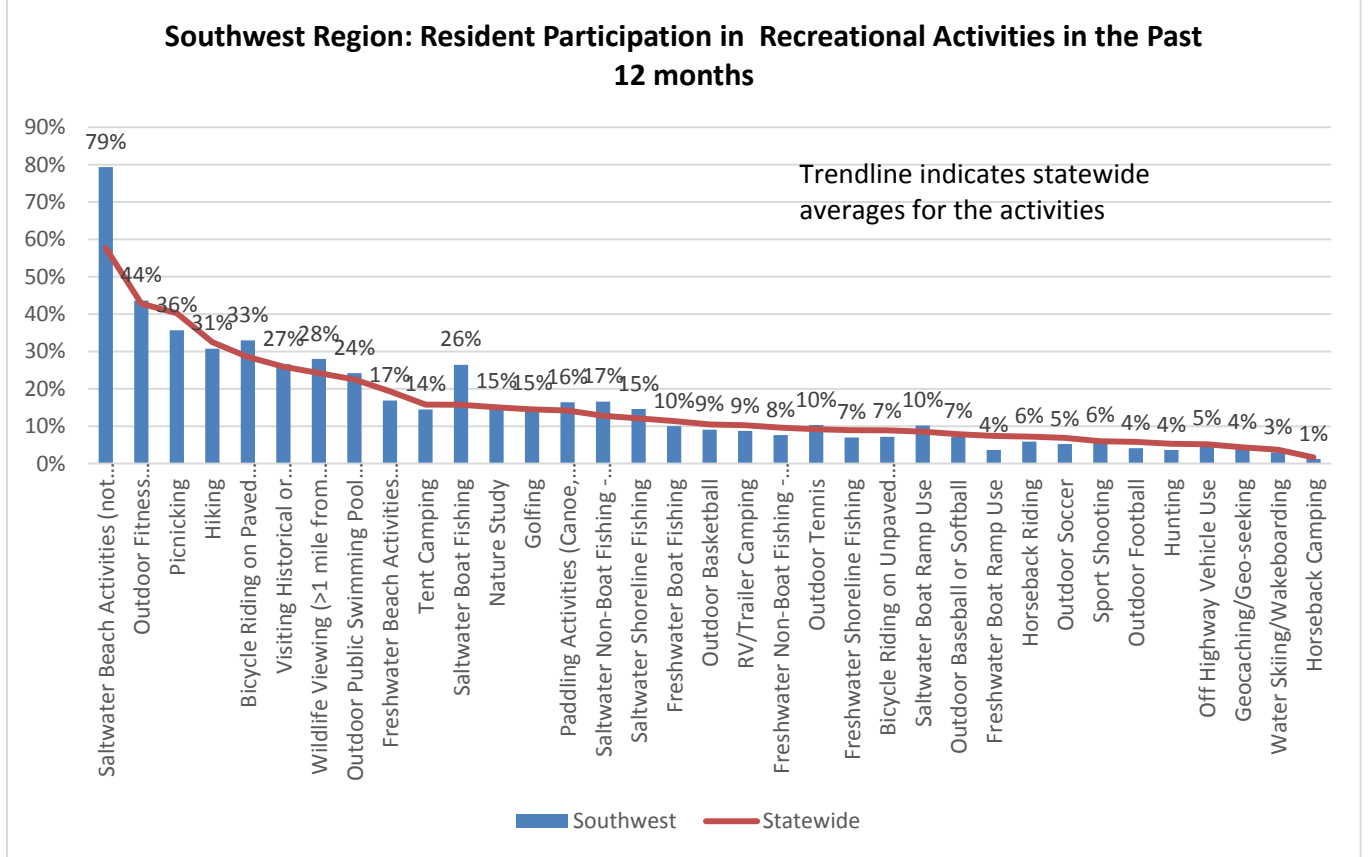


Figure 25. Bicycle Riding on Paved Roads/Trails by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

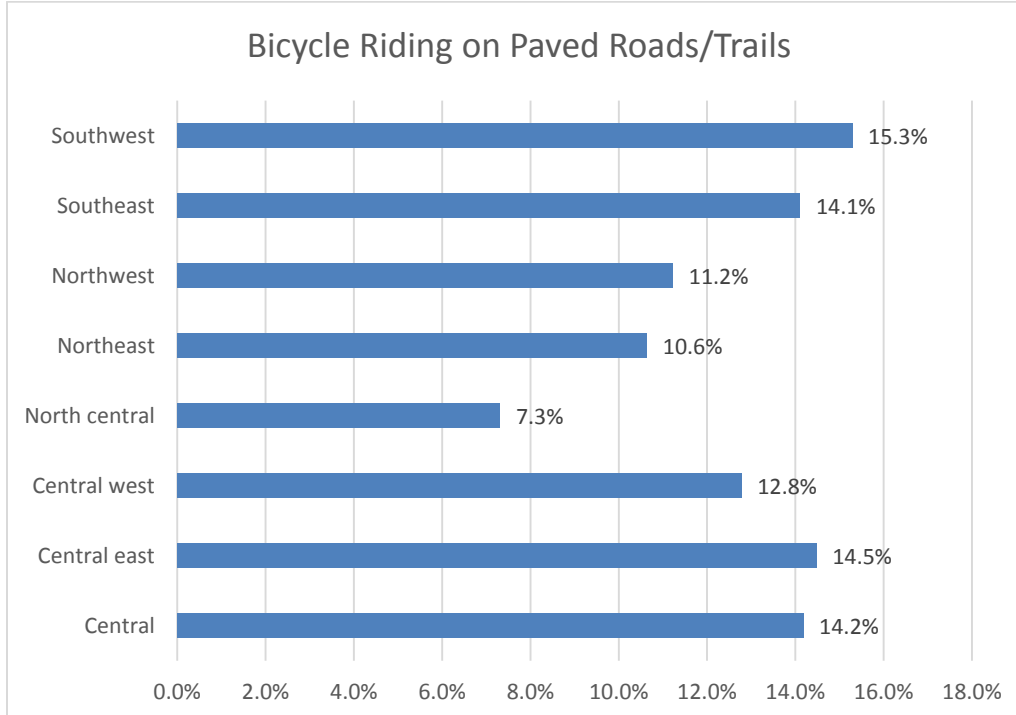


Figure 26. Bicycle Riding on Unpaved Roads/Trails by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

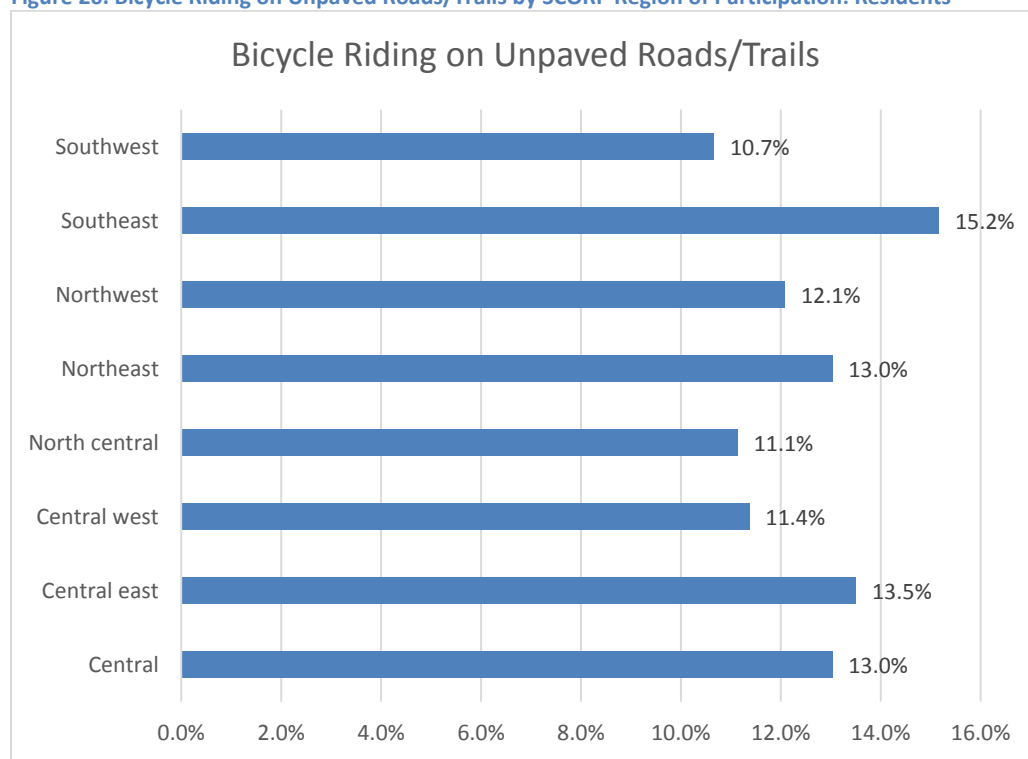


Figure 27. Freshwater Beach Activities by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

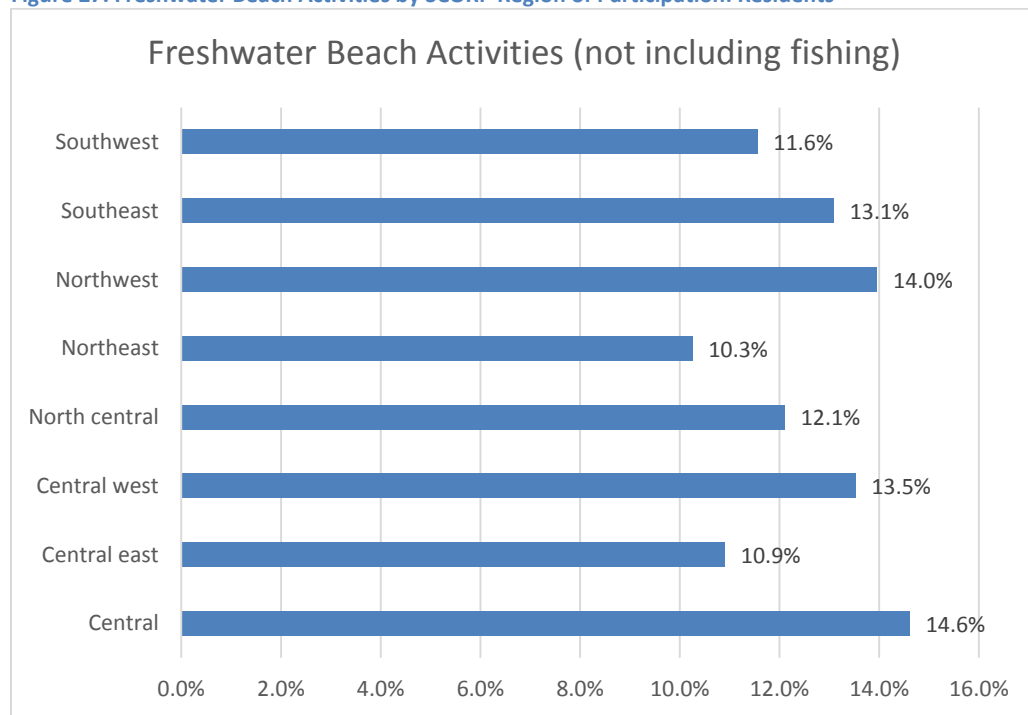


Figure 28. Freshwater Boat Fishing by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

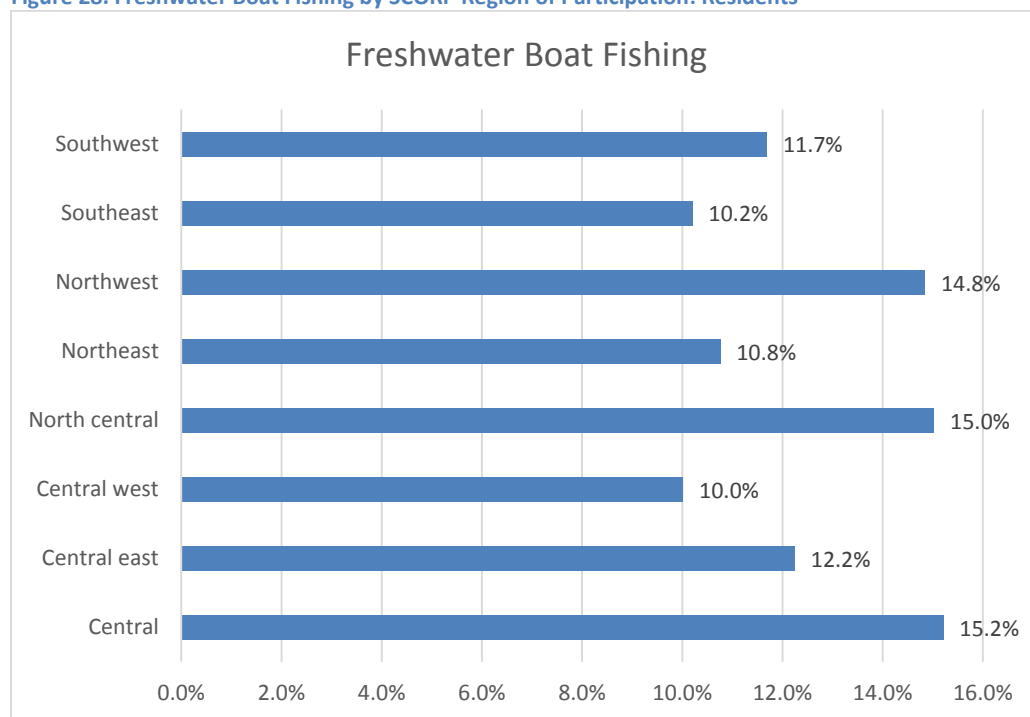


Figure 29. Freshwater Boat Ramp use by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

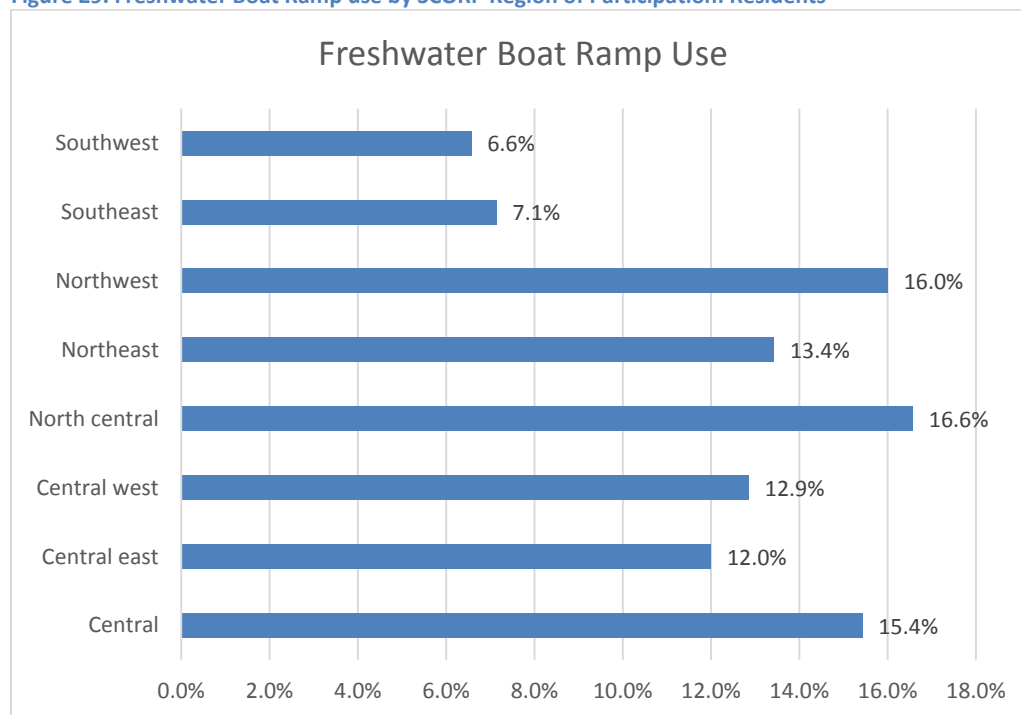


Figure 30. Freshwater Non-boat Fishing by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

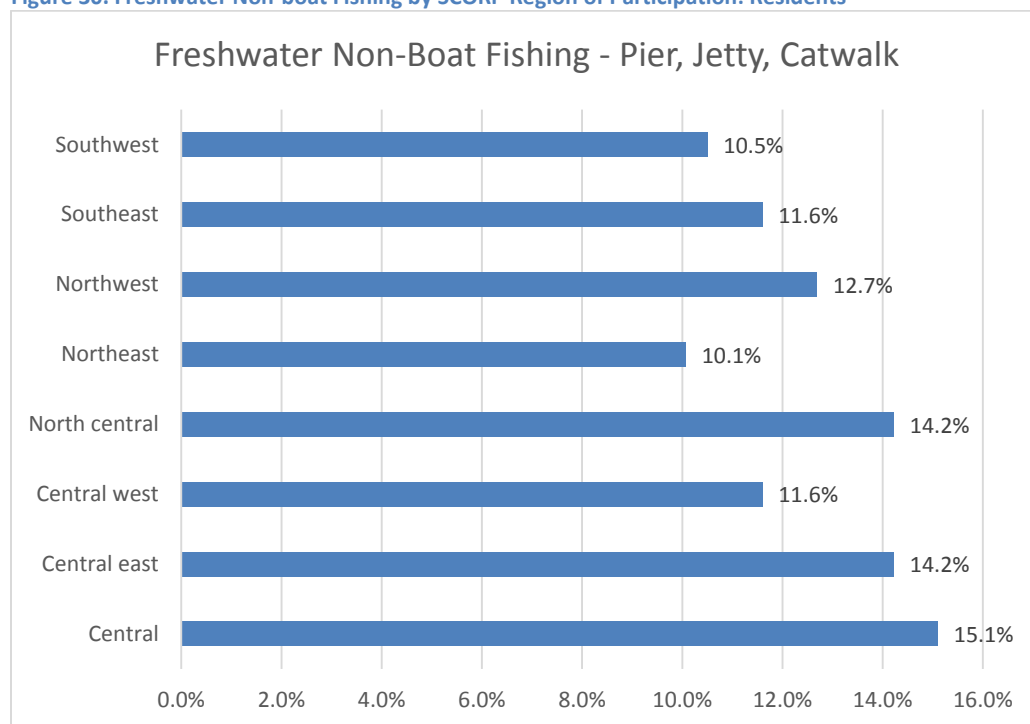


Figure 31. Freshwater Shoreline Fishing by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

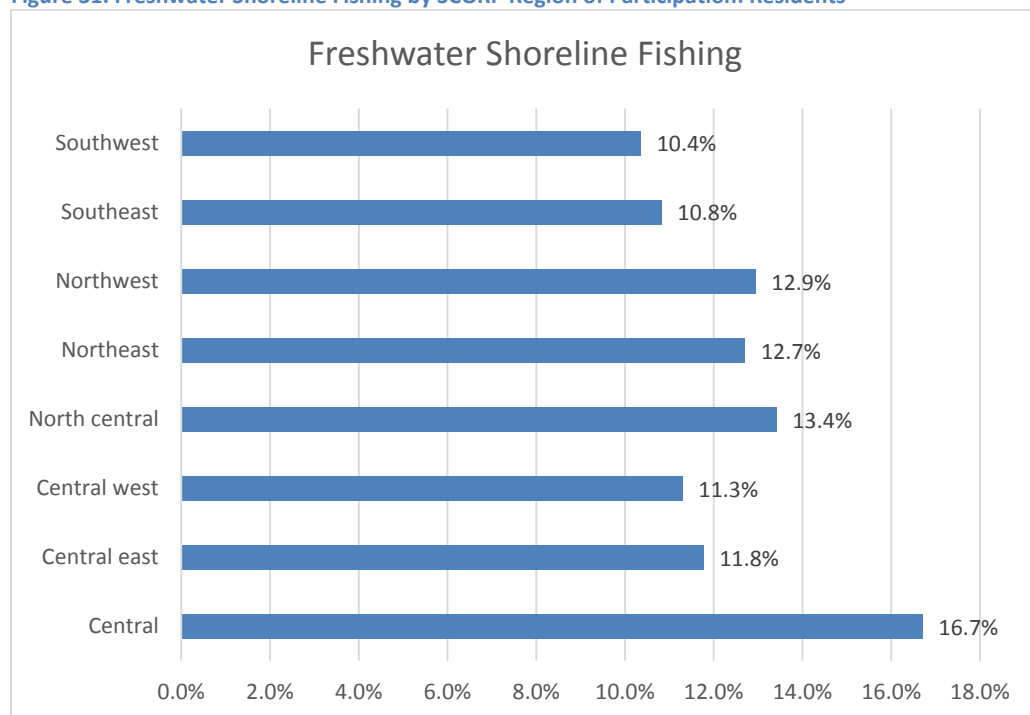


Figure 32. Geocaching by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

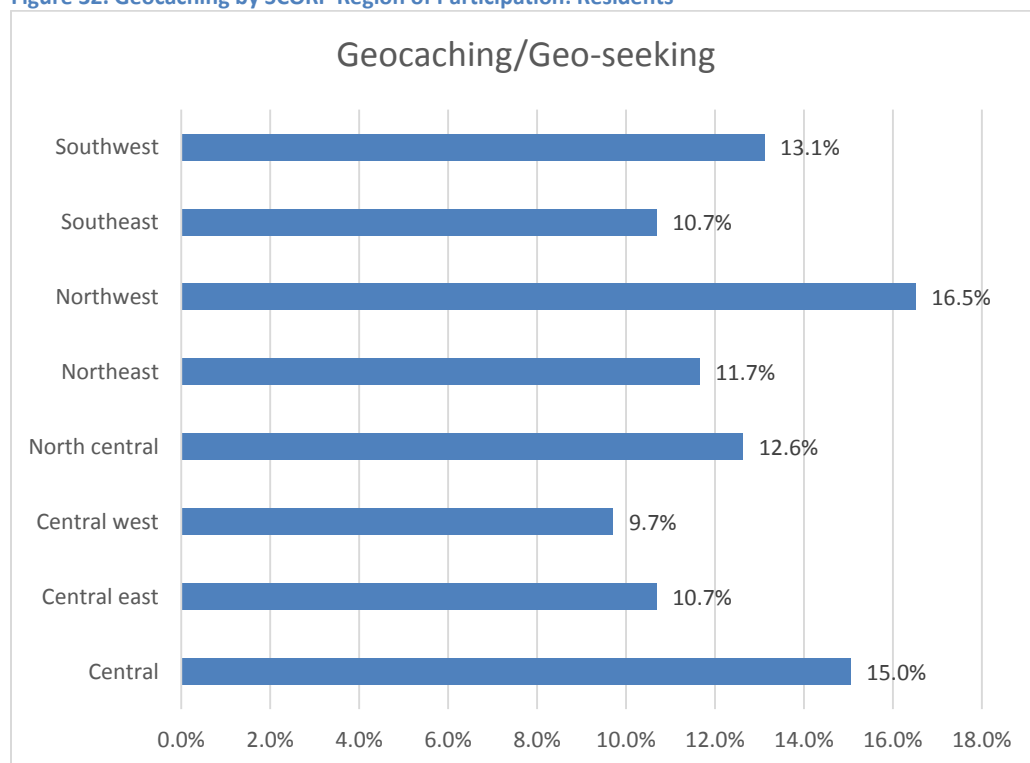


Figure 33. Golfing by SCORP Region of Participation by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

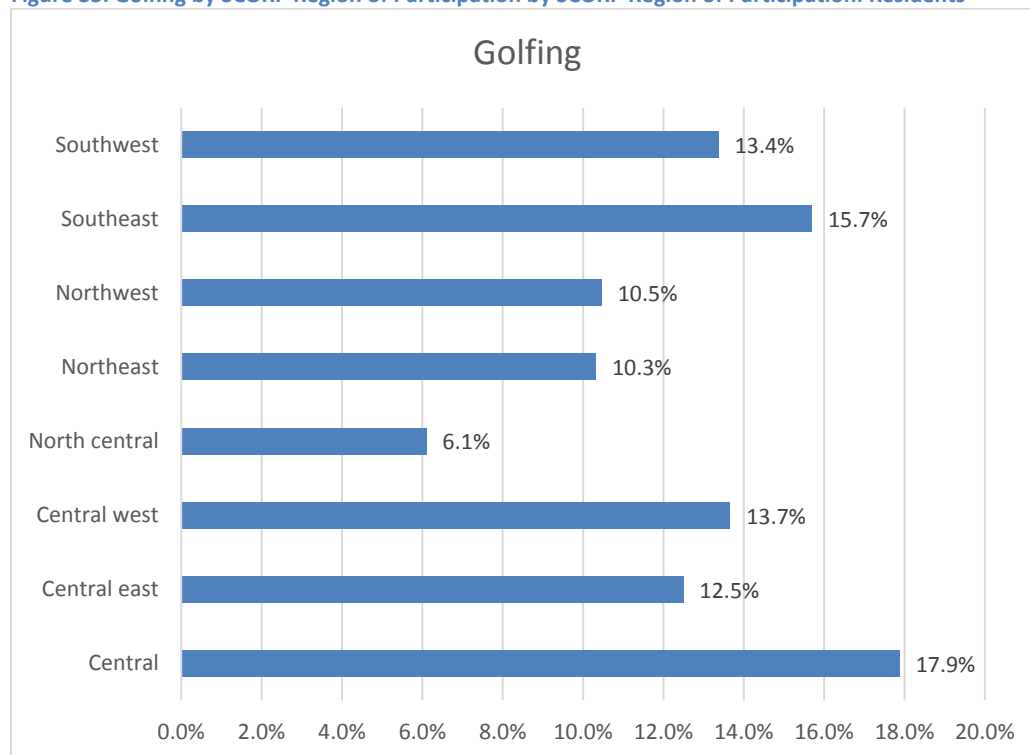


Figure 34. Hiking by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

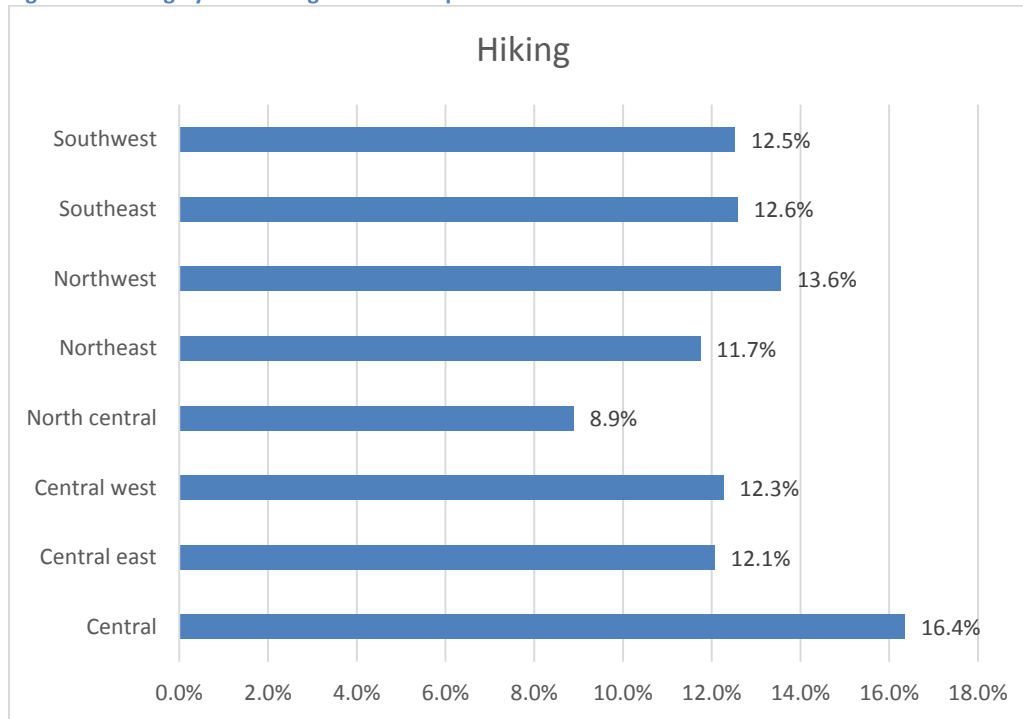


Figure 35. Horseback Camping by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

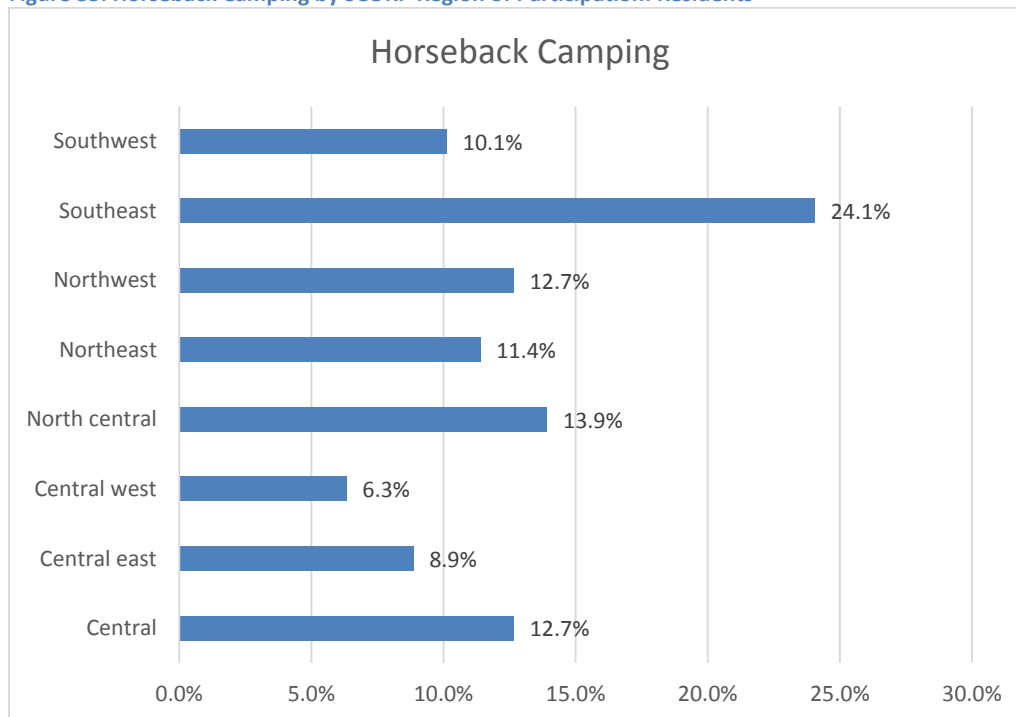


Figure 36. Horseback Riding by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

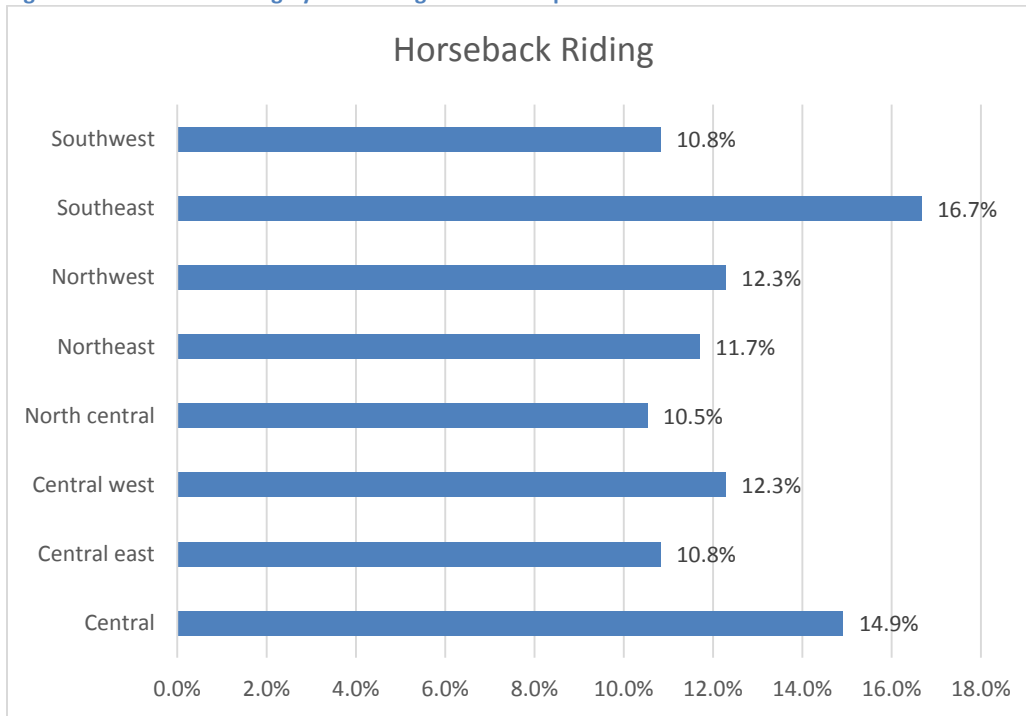


Figure 37. Hunting by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

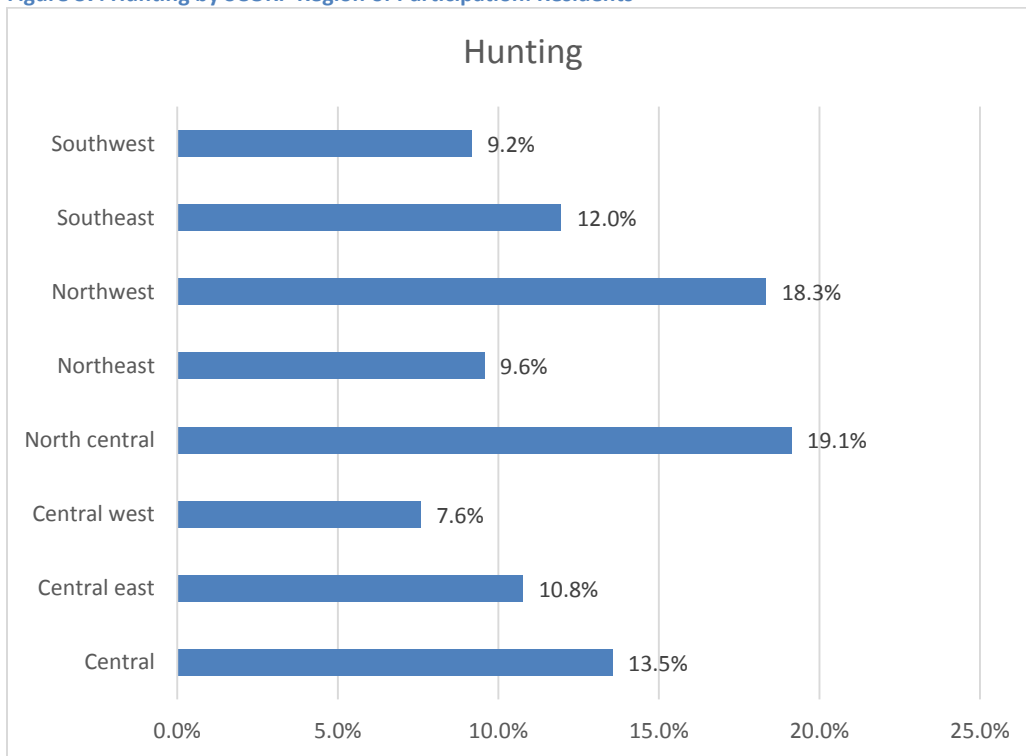


Figure 38. Nature Study by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

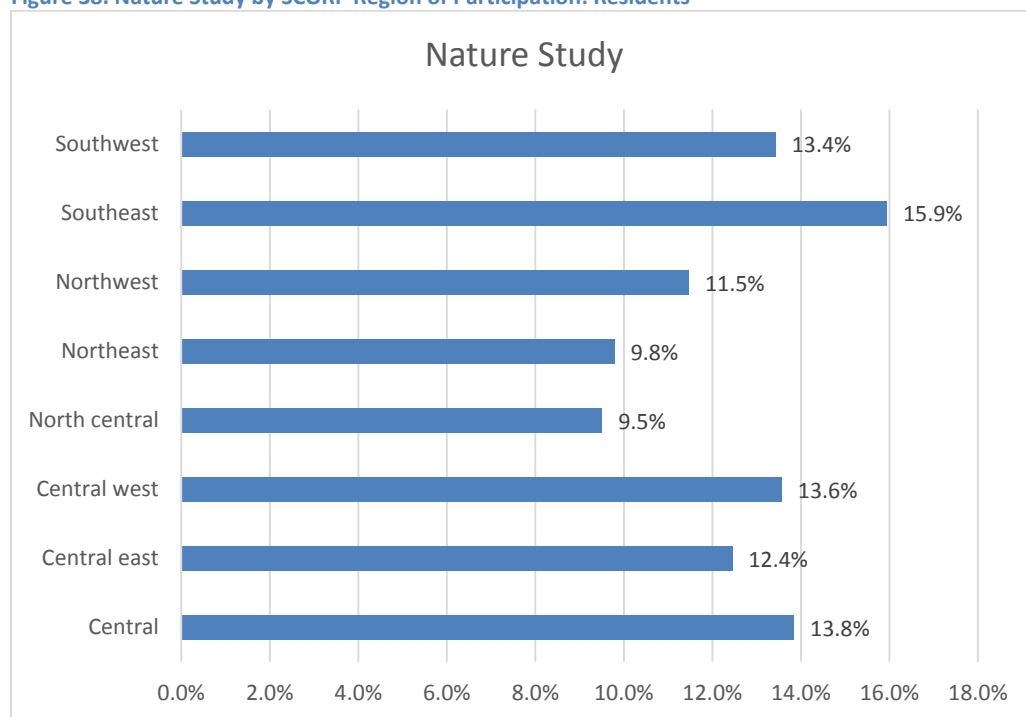


Figure 39. Off Highway Vehicle Use by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

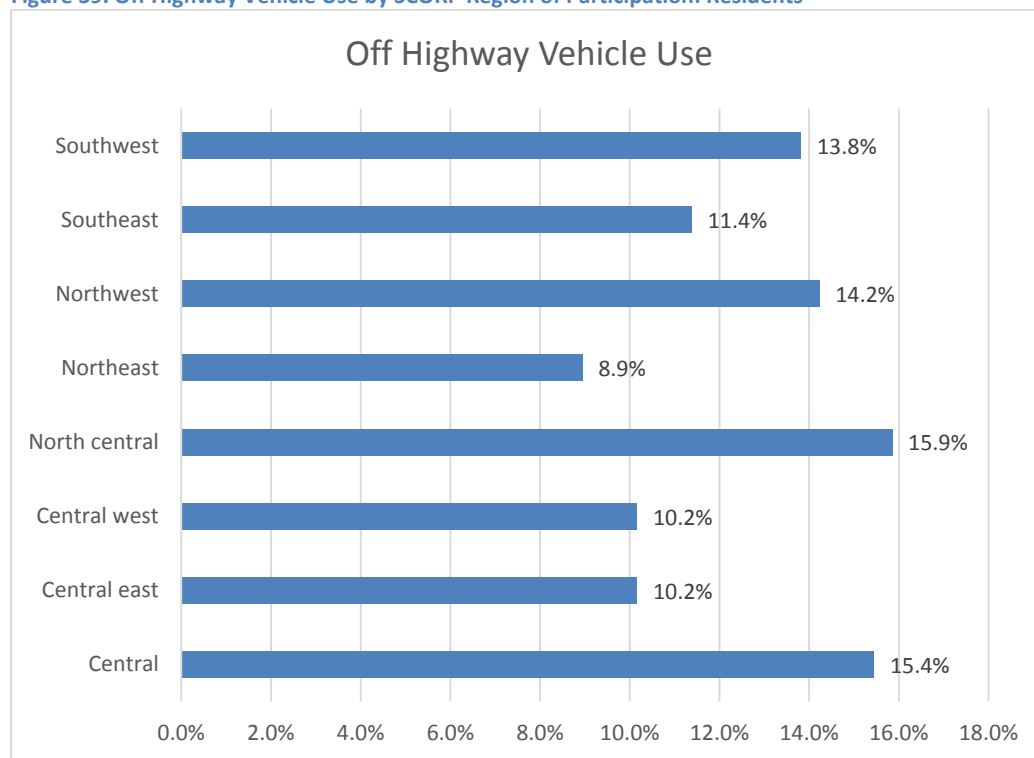


Figure 40. Outdoor Baseball or Softball by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

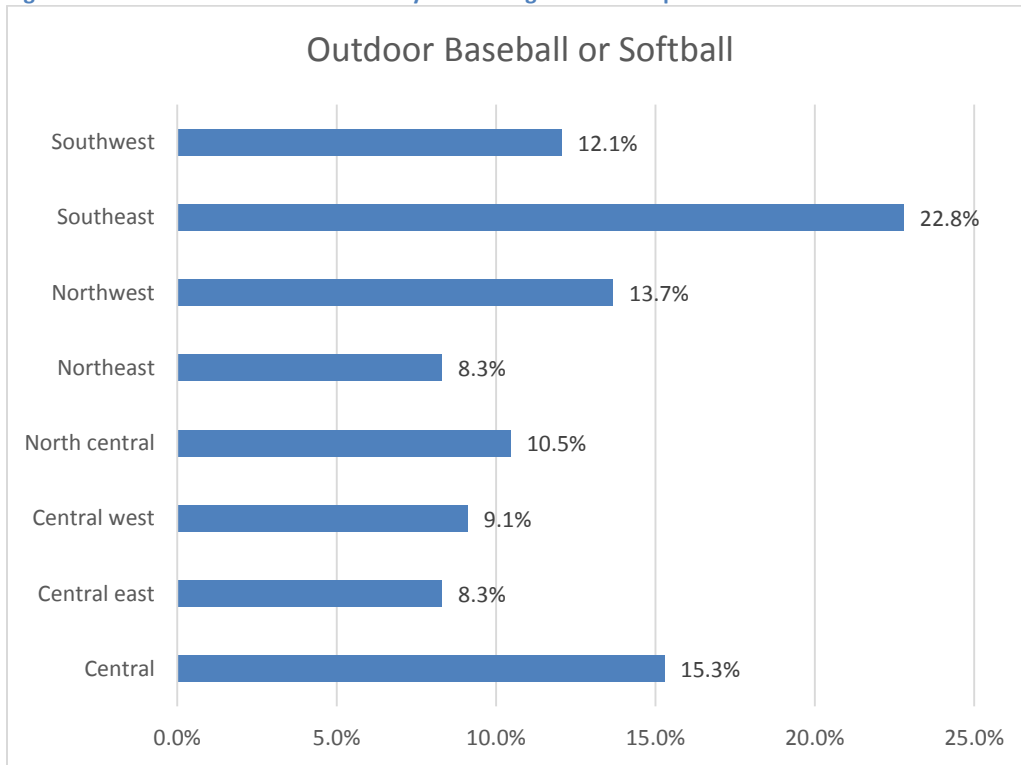


Figure 41. Outdoor Basketball by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

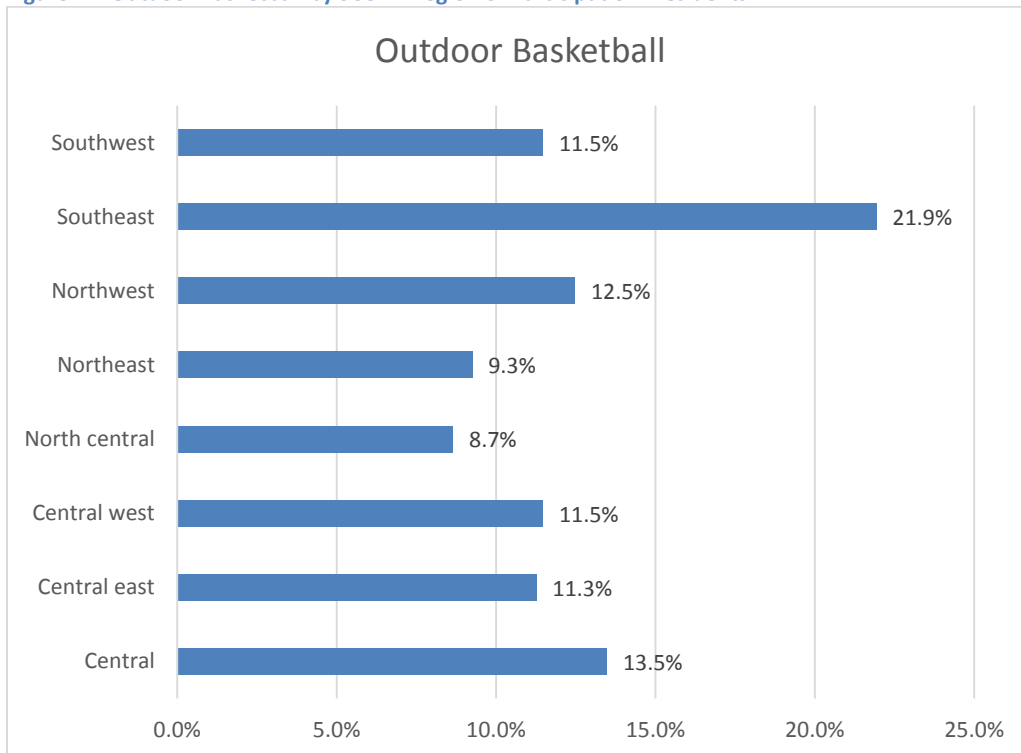


Figure 42. Outdoor Fitness Walking/Jogging by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

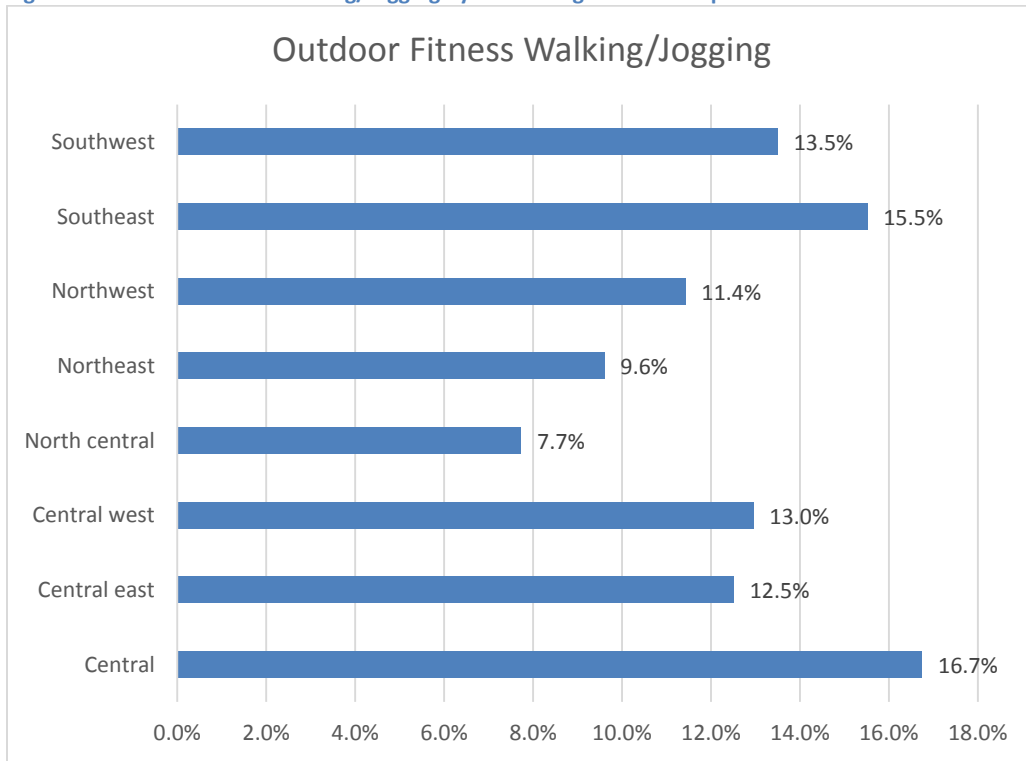


Figure 43. Outdoor Football by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

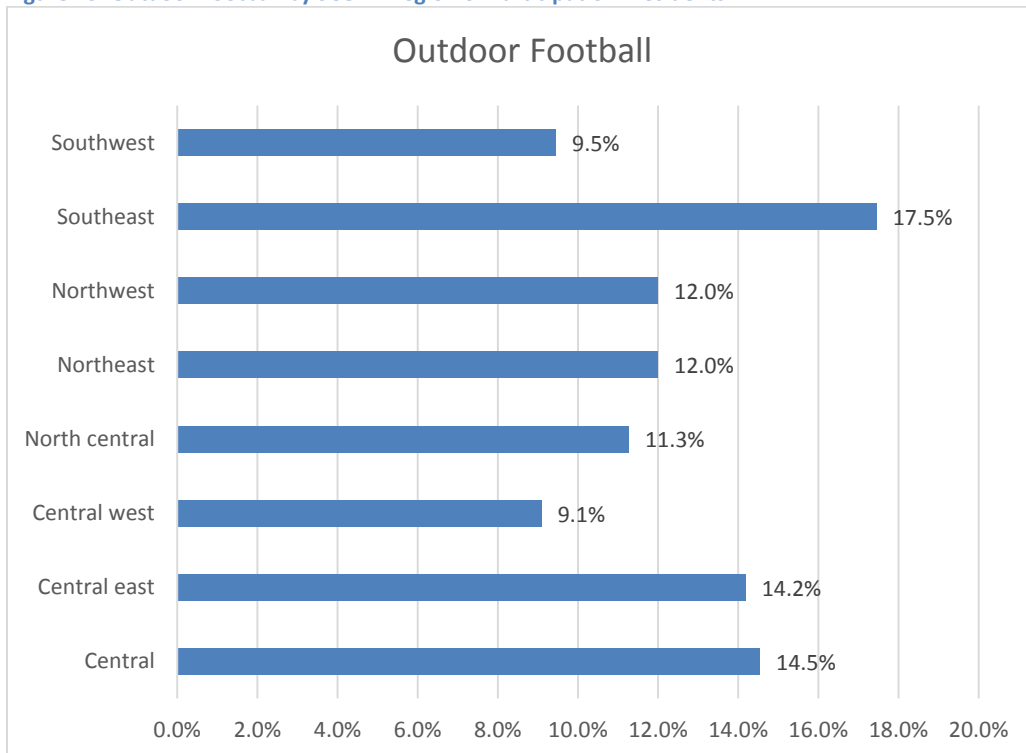


Figure 44. Outdoor Public Swimming pool use by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

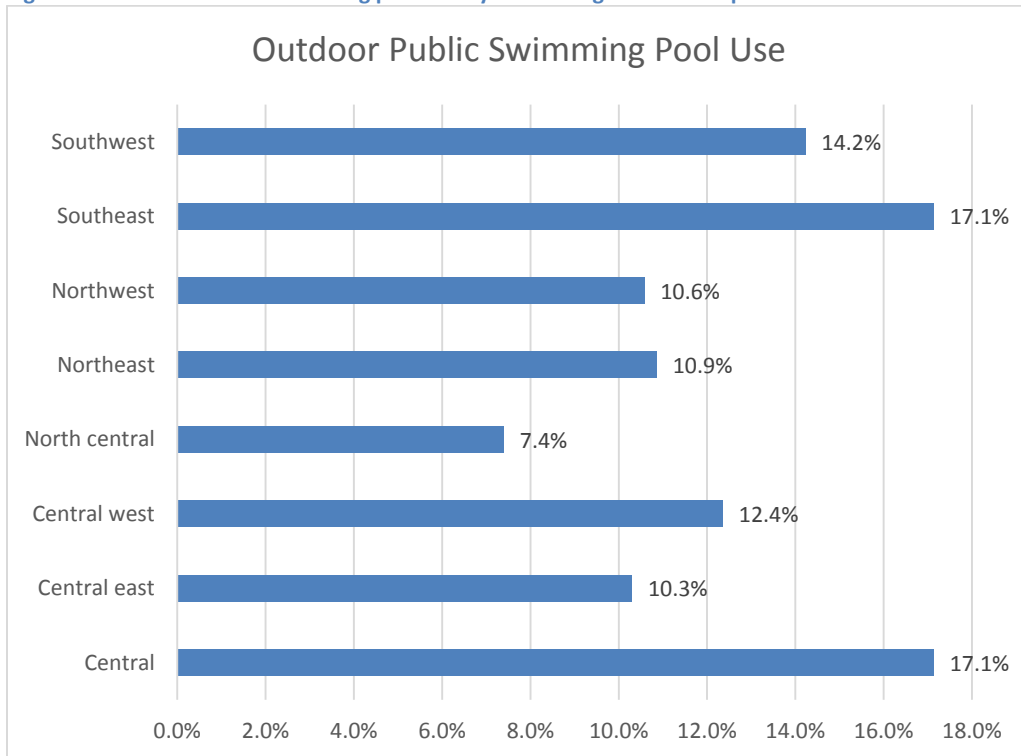


Figure 45. Outdoor Soccer by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

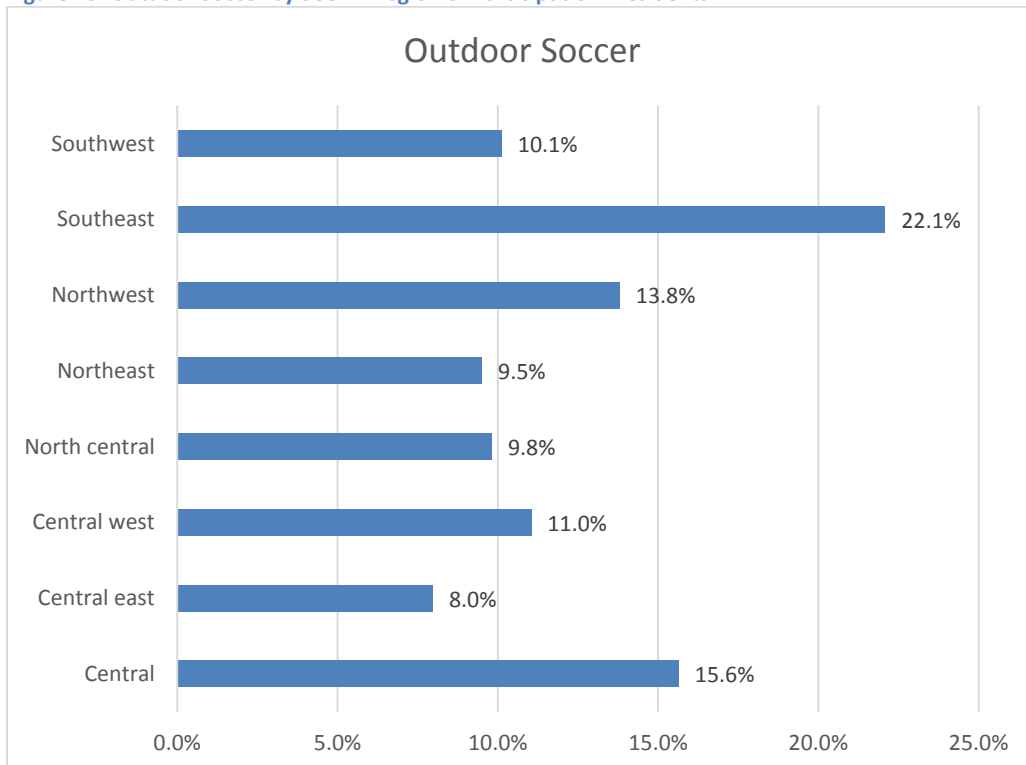


Figure 46. Outdoor Tennis by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

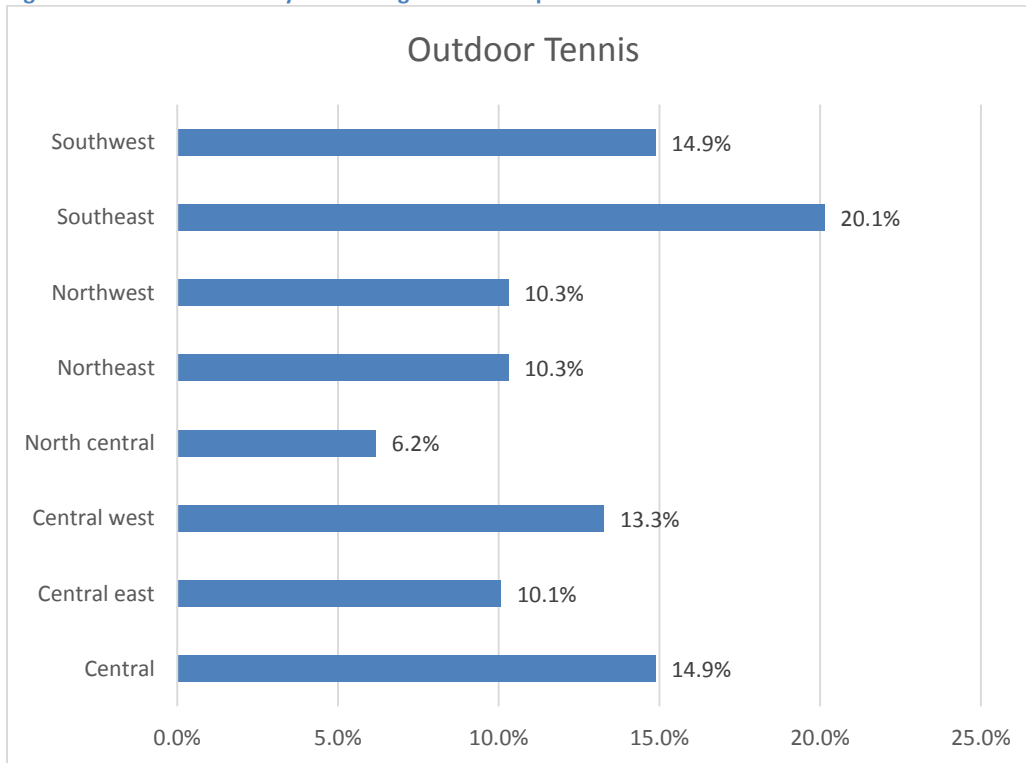


Figure 47. Paddling Activities by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

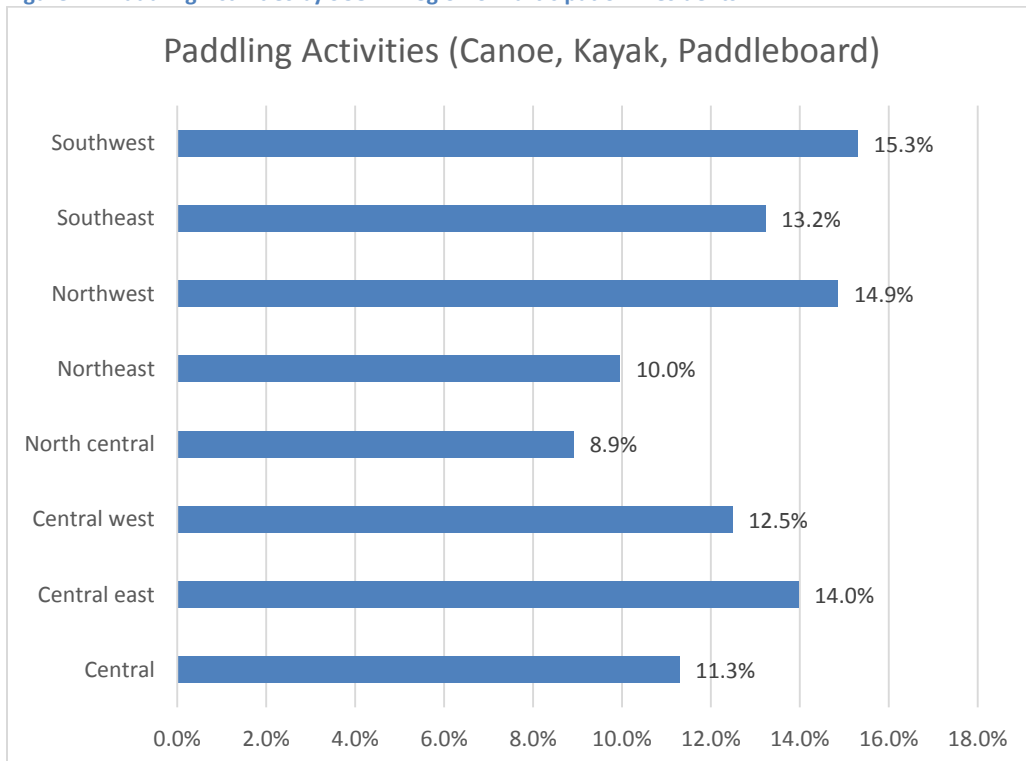


Figure 48. Picnicking by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

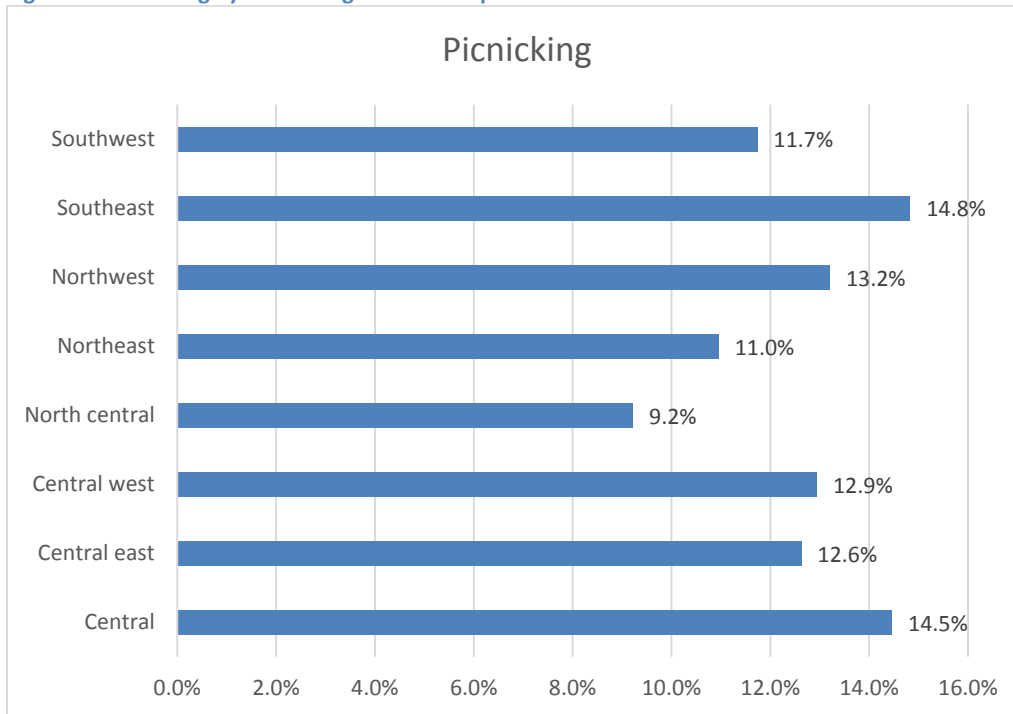


Figure 49. RV/Trailer Camping by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

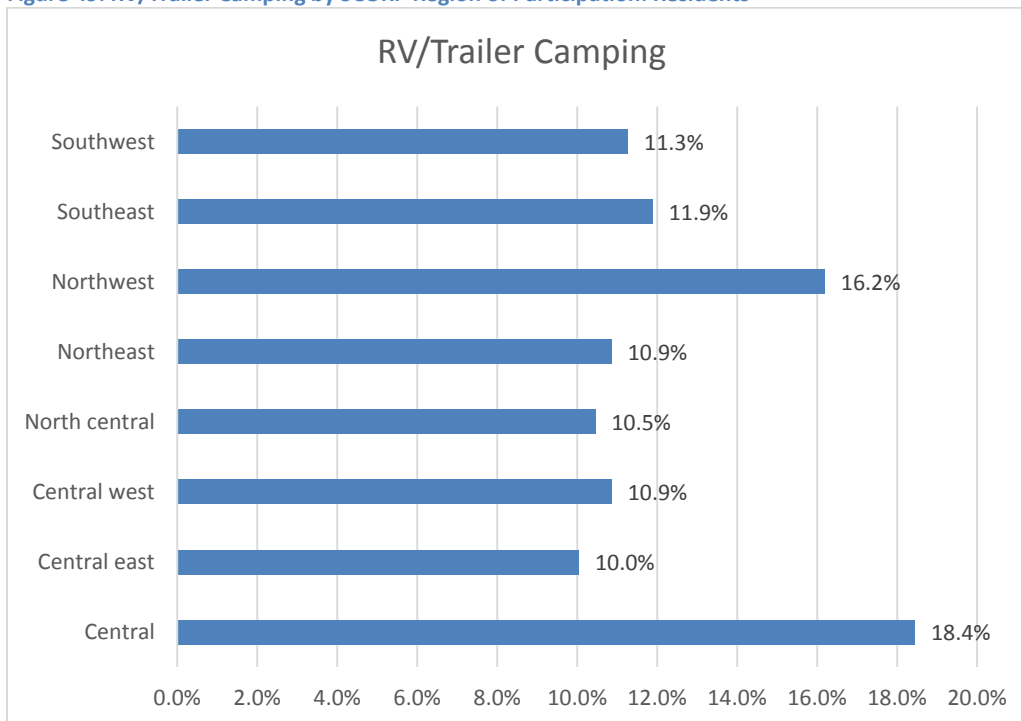


Figure 50. Saltwater Beach Activities by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

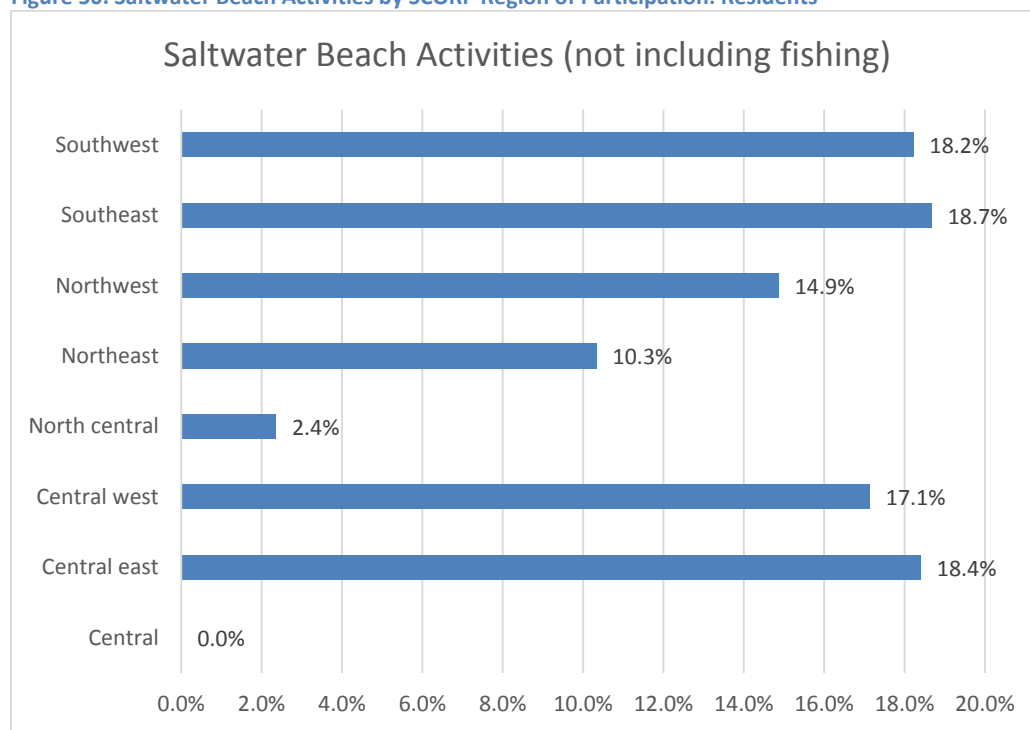


Figure 51. Saltwater Boat Fishing by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

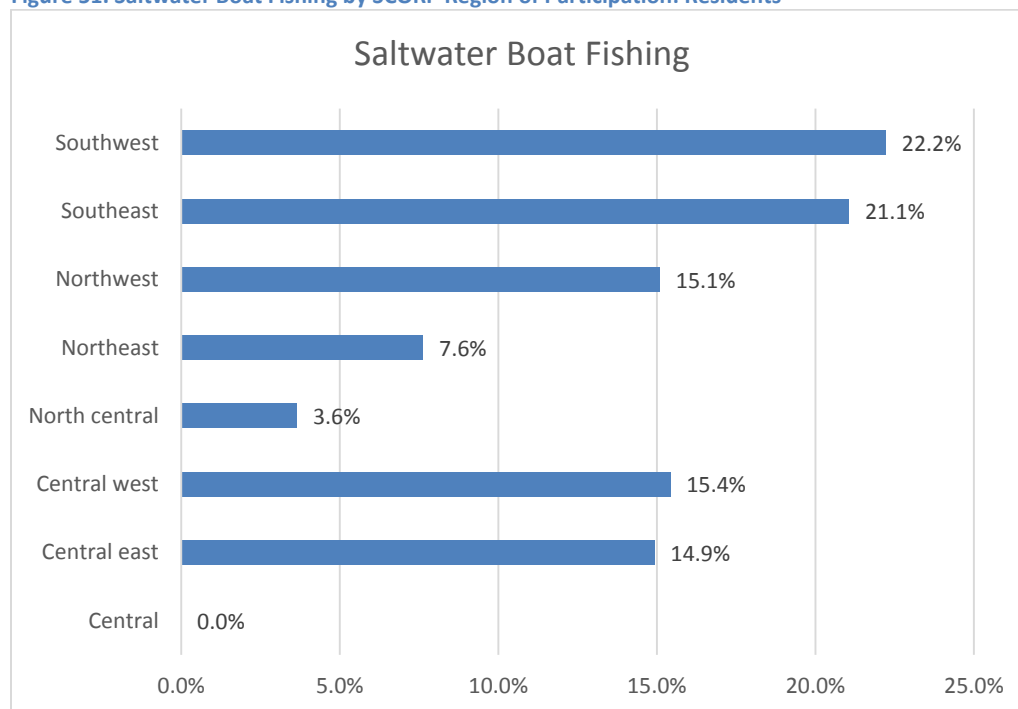


Figure 52. Saltwater Boat Ramp Use by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

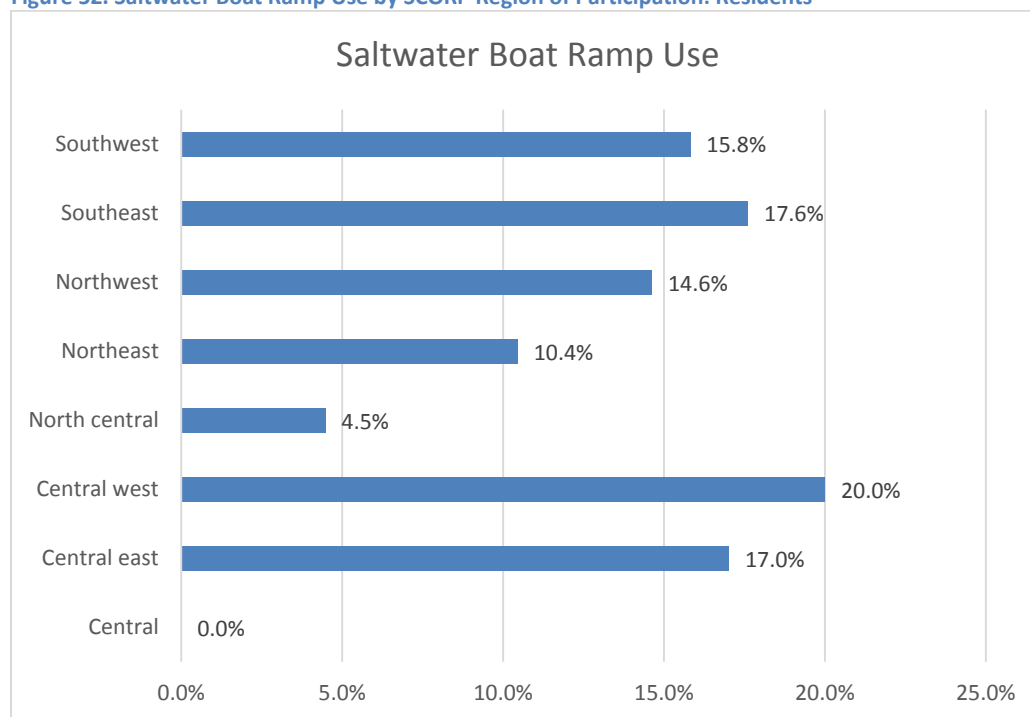


Figure 53. Saltwater Non-boat Fishing by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

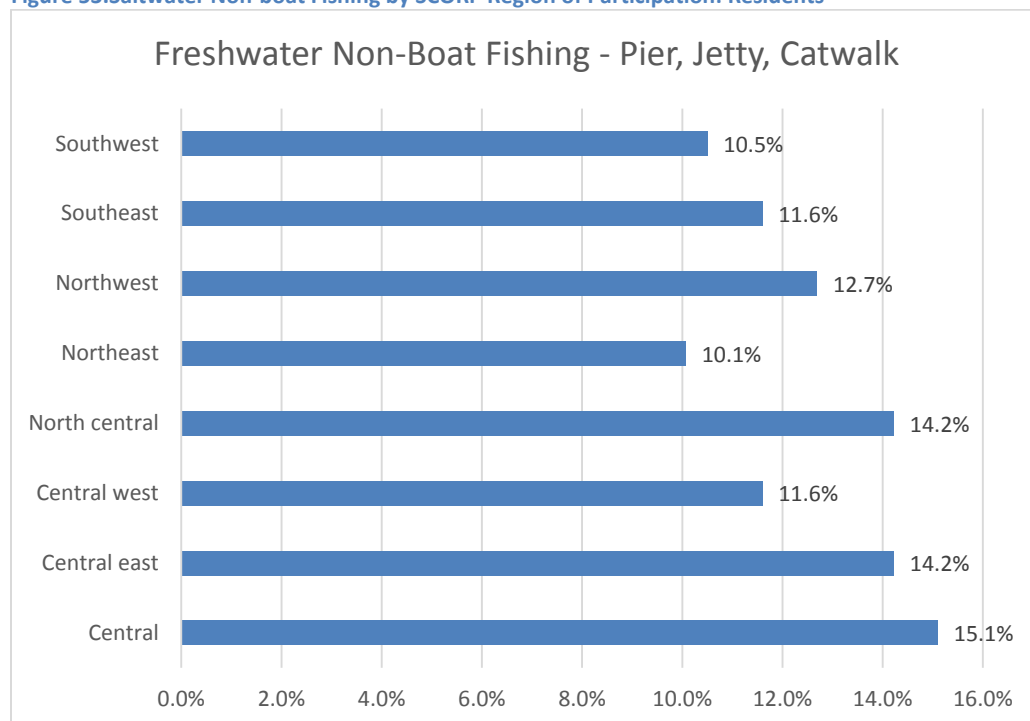


Figure 54. Saltwater Shoreline Fishing by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

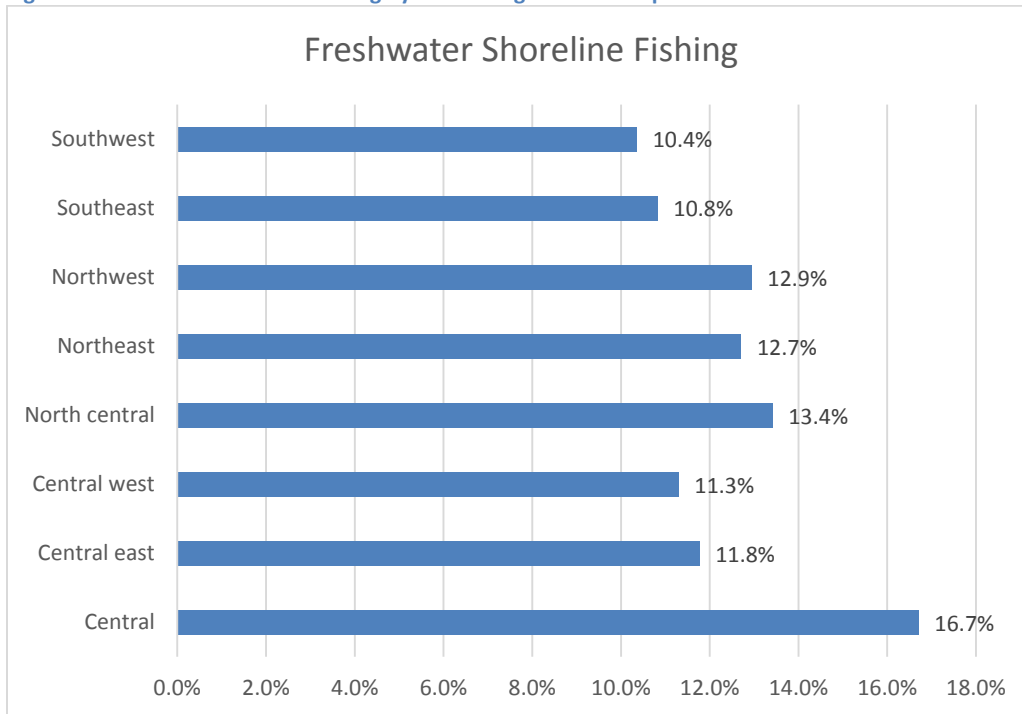


Figure 55. Sport Shooting by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

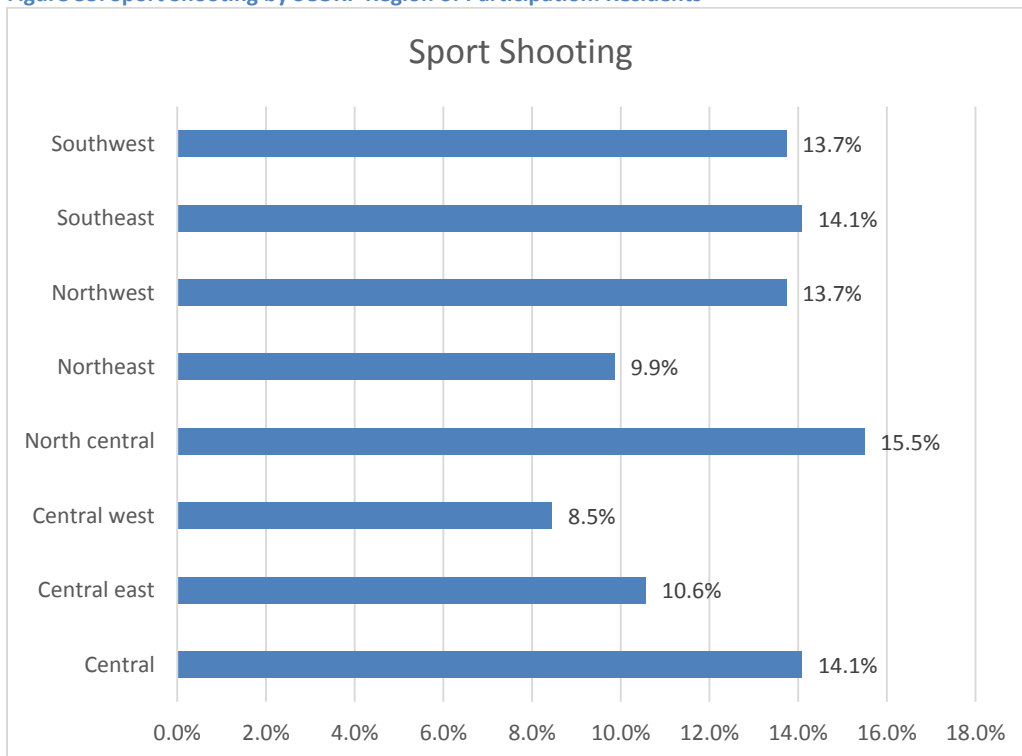


Figure 56. Tent Camping by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

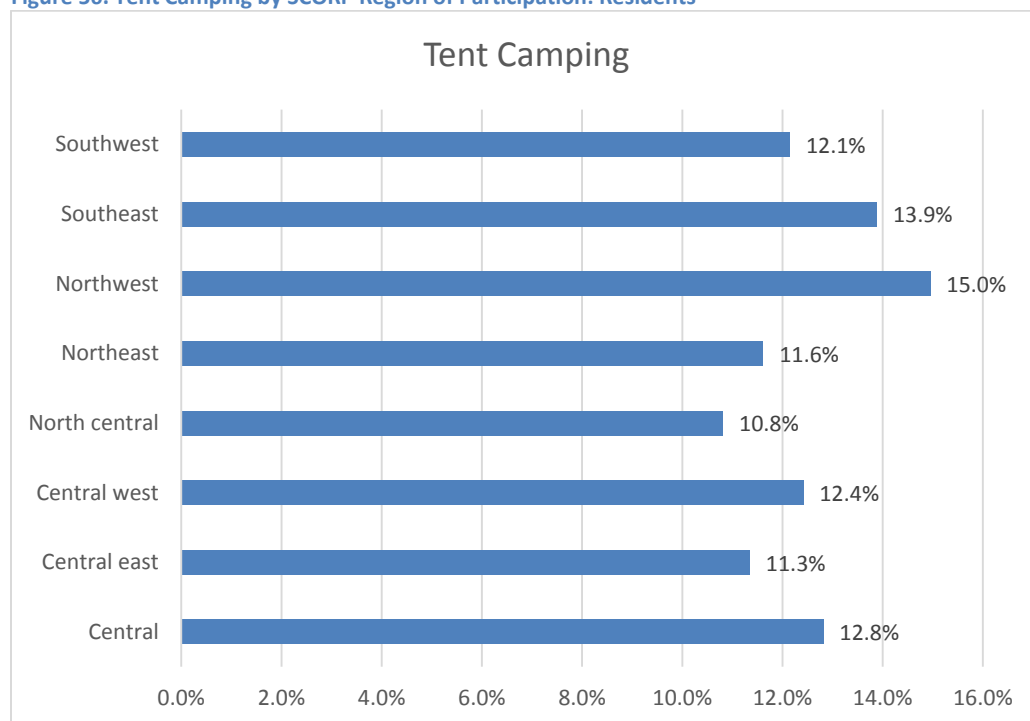


Figure 57. Visiting Historical or Archeological Sites by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

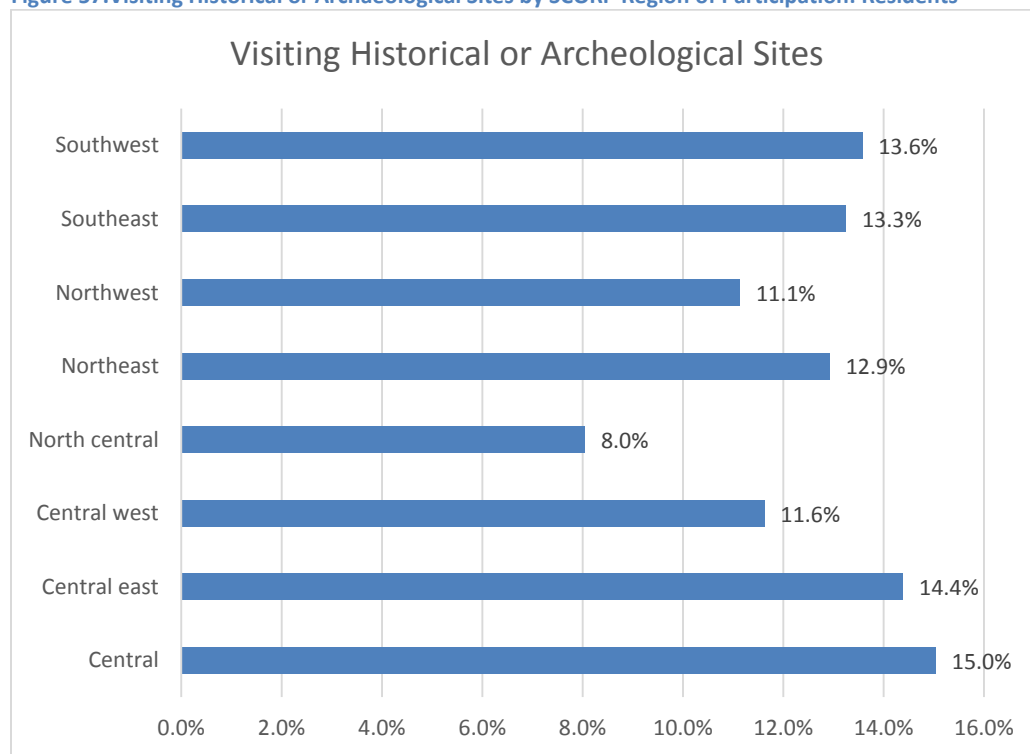


Figure 58. Water Skiing by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

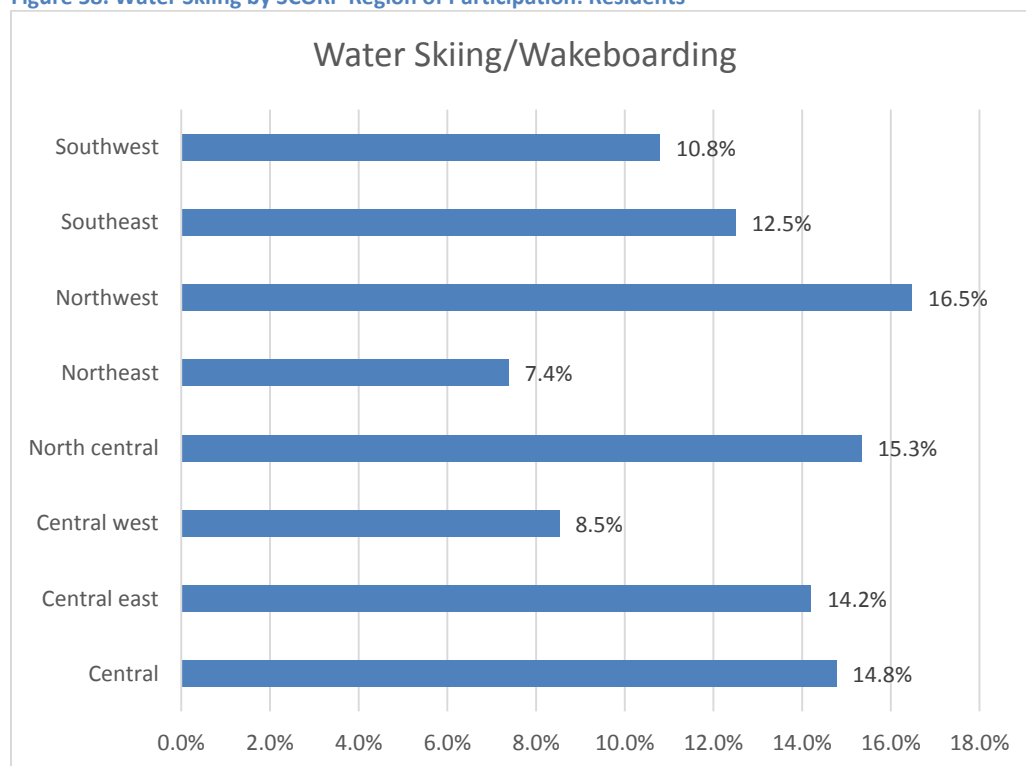
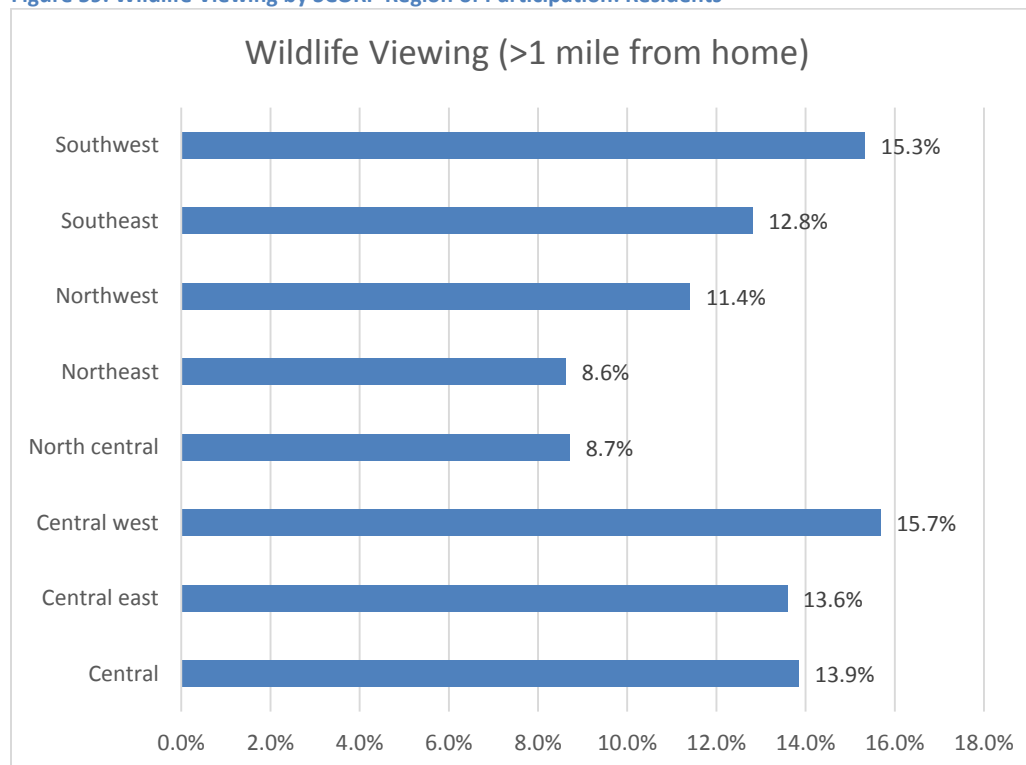


Figure 59. Wildlife Viewing by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

Figure 60. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Central SCORP Region

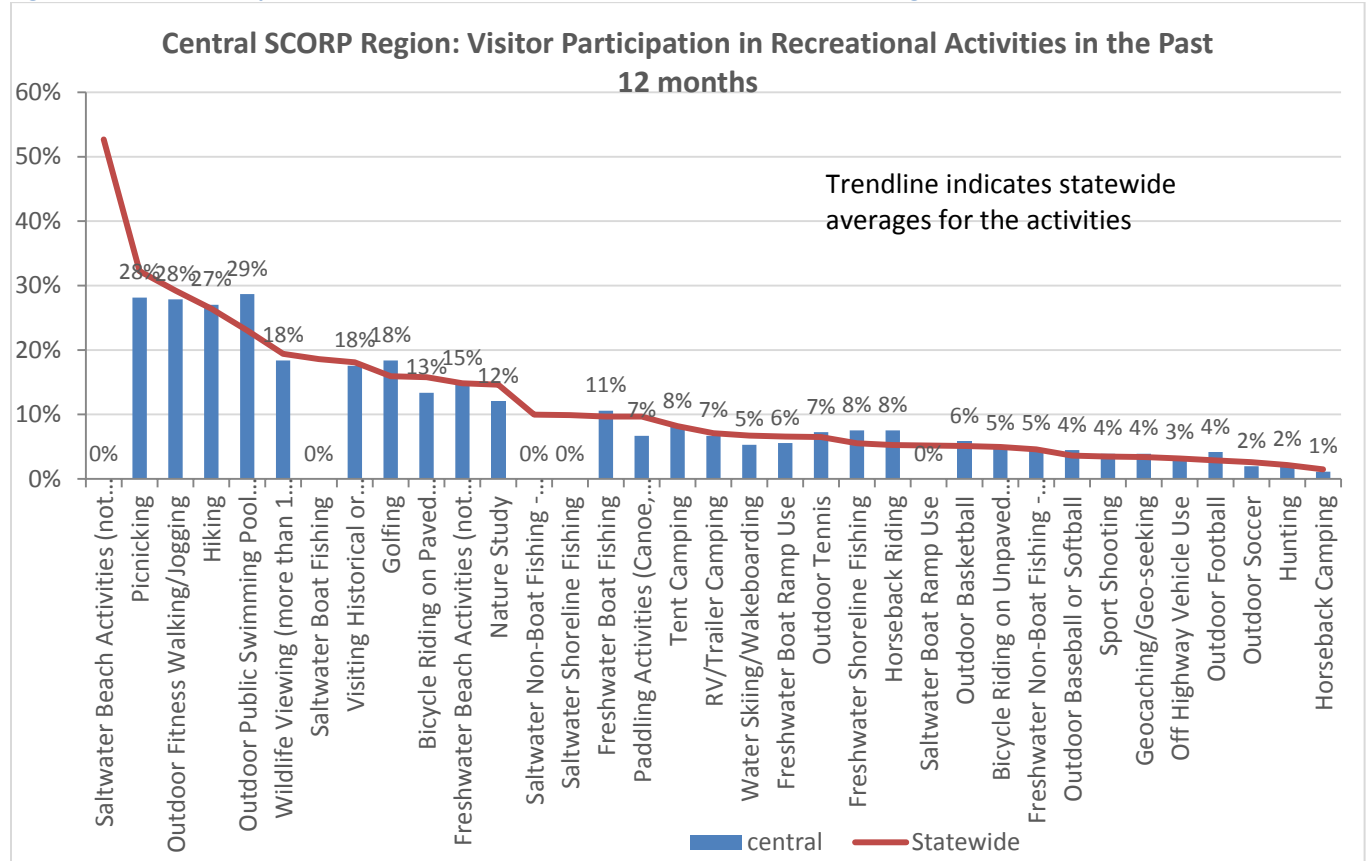


Figure 61. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Central East SCORP Region

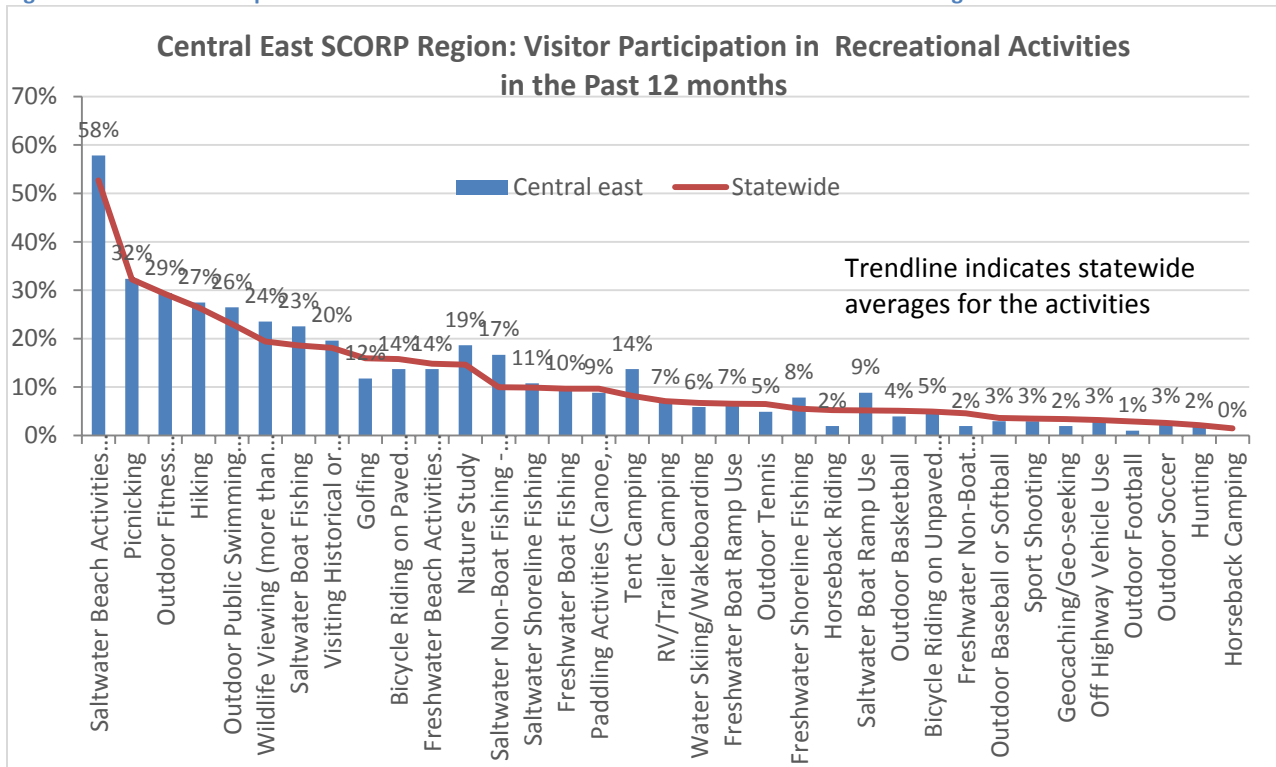


Figure 62. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Central West SCORP Region

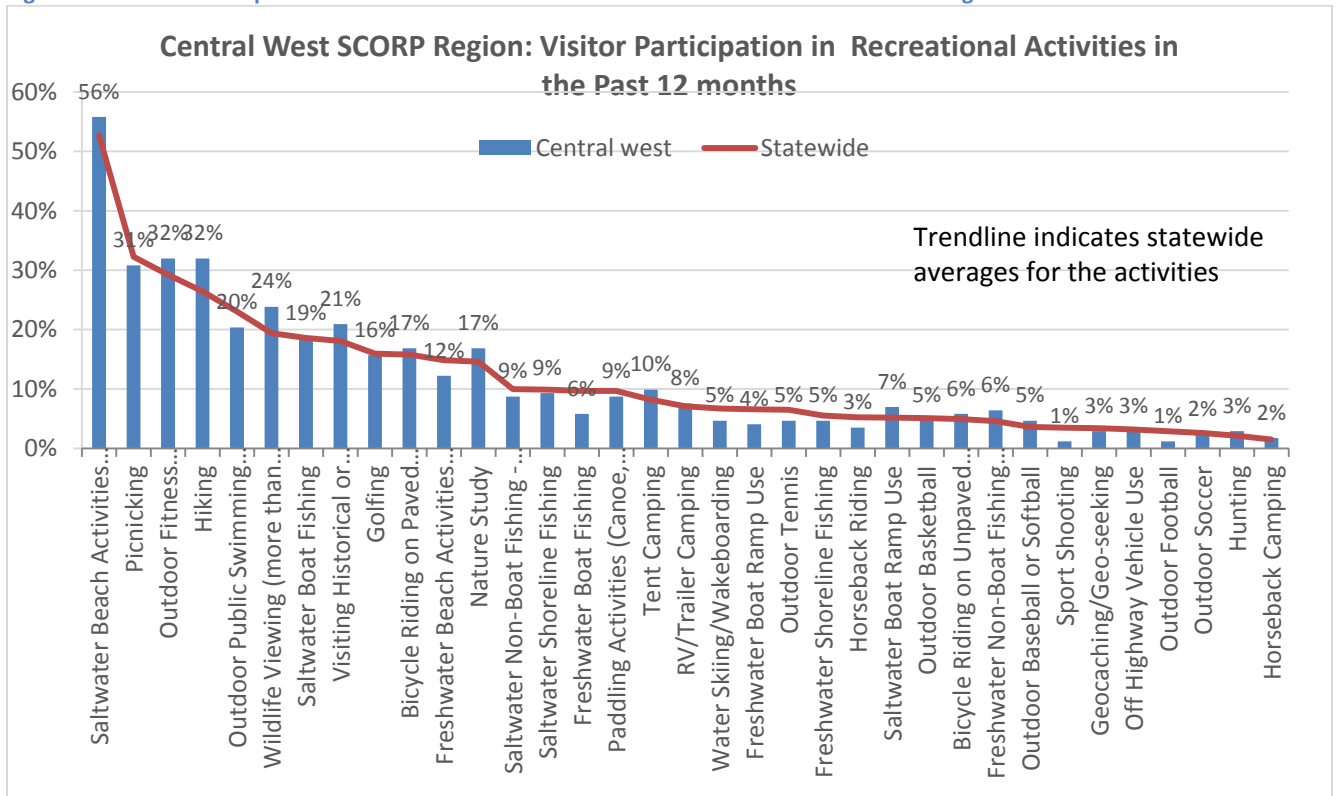


Figure 63. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the North Central SCORP Region

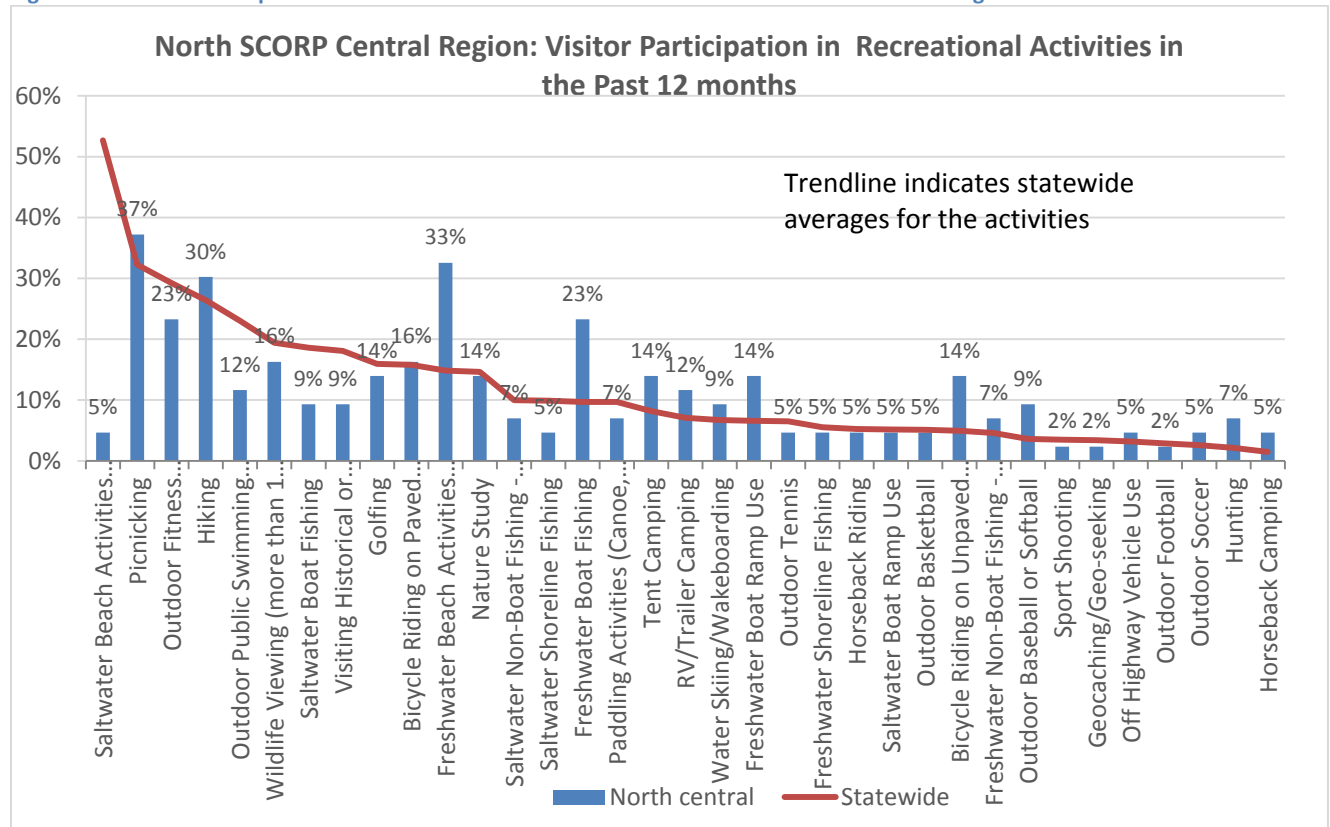


Figure 64. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Northeast SCORP Region

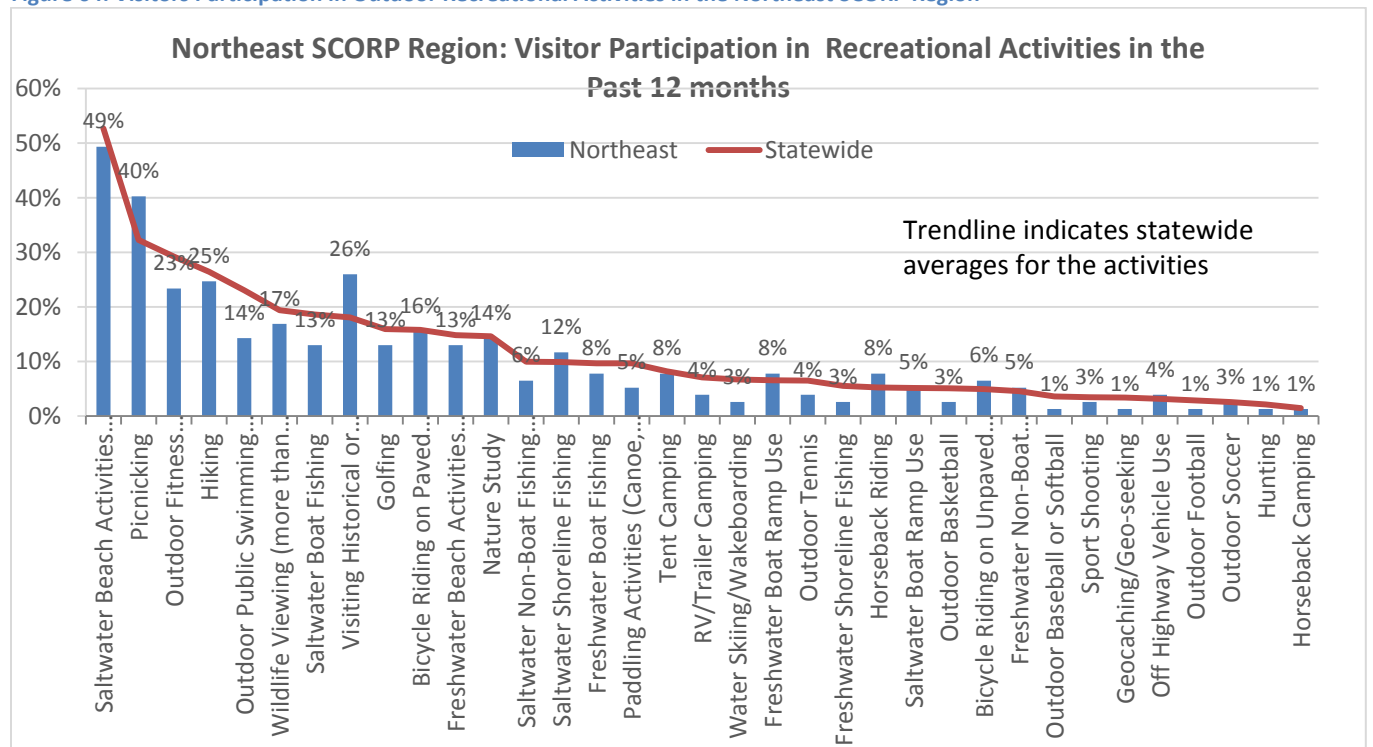


Figure 65. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Northwest SCORP Region

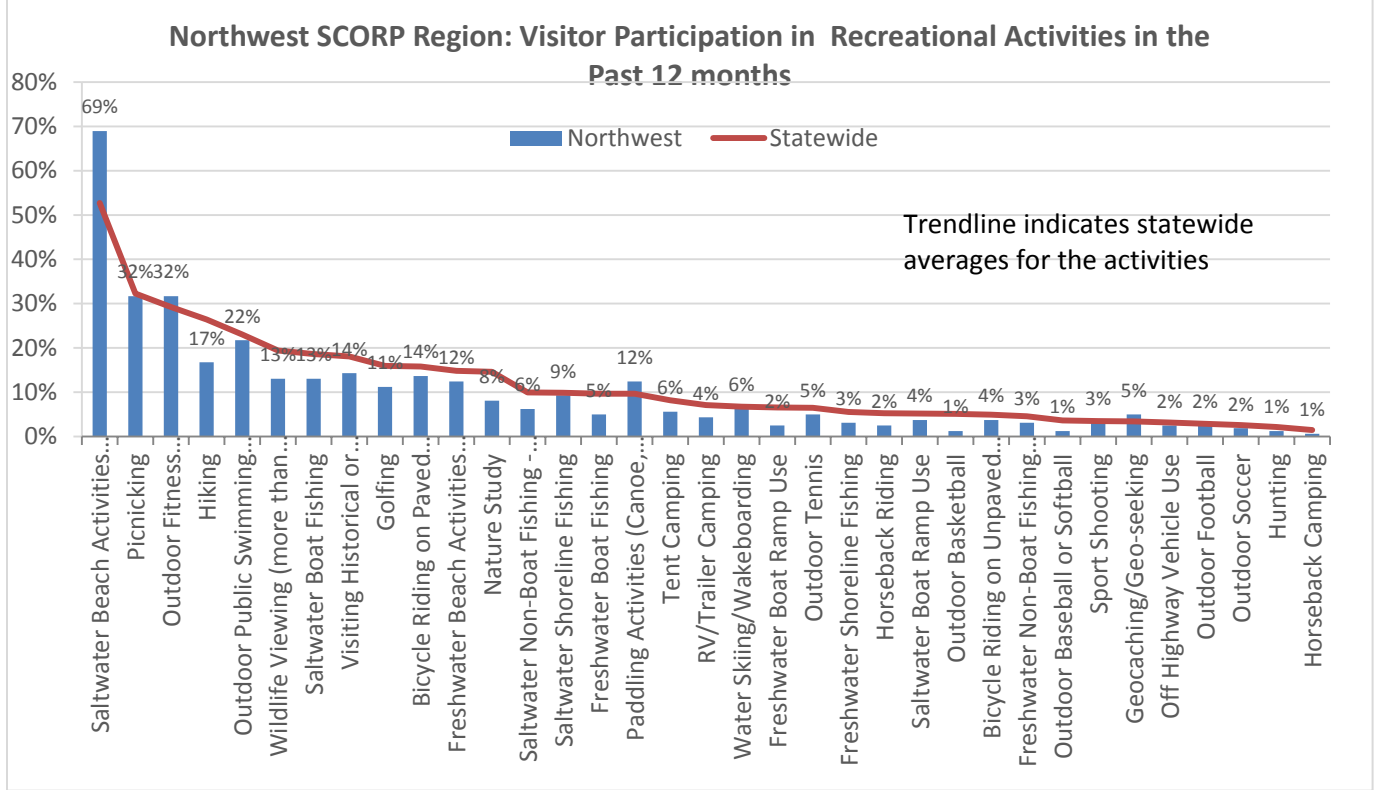


Figure 66. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Southeast SCORP Region

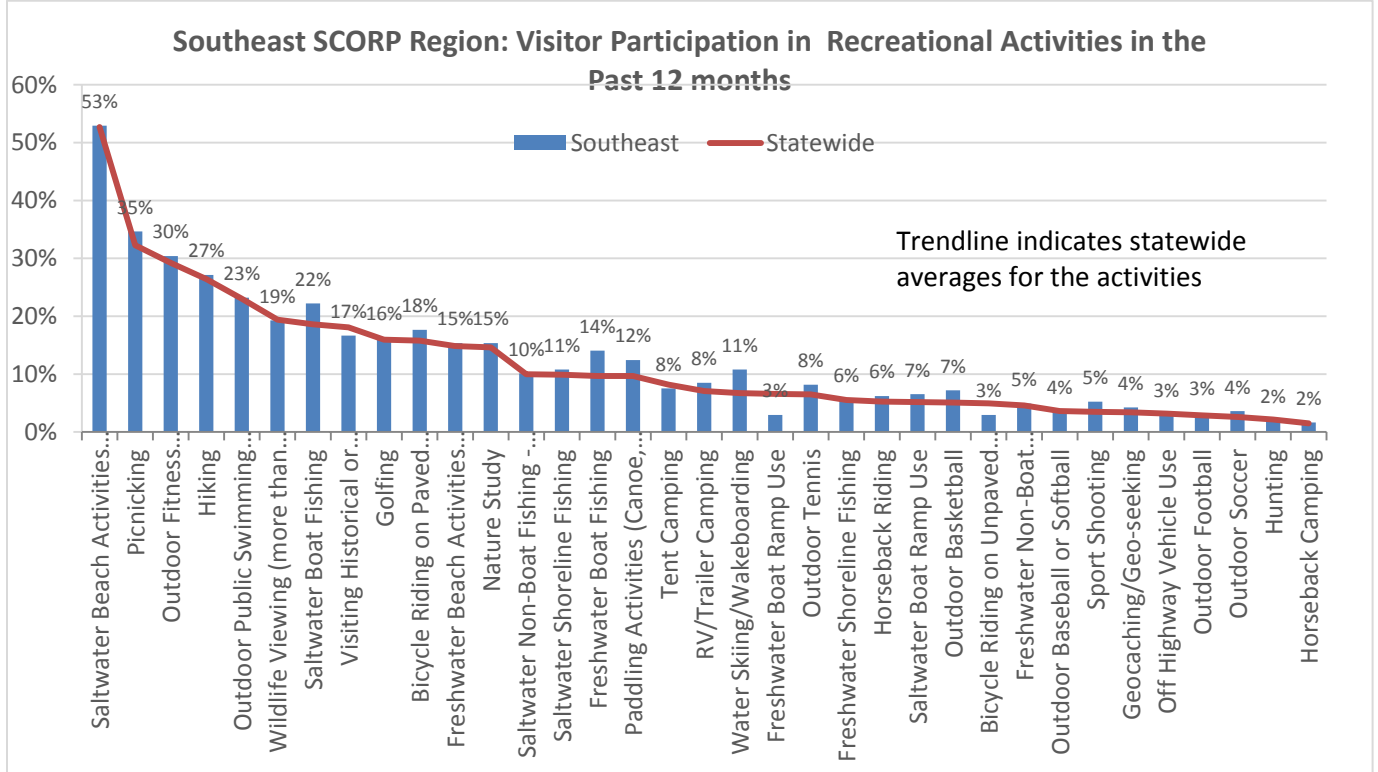


Figure 67. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in the Southwest SCORP Region

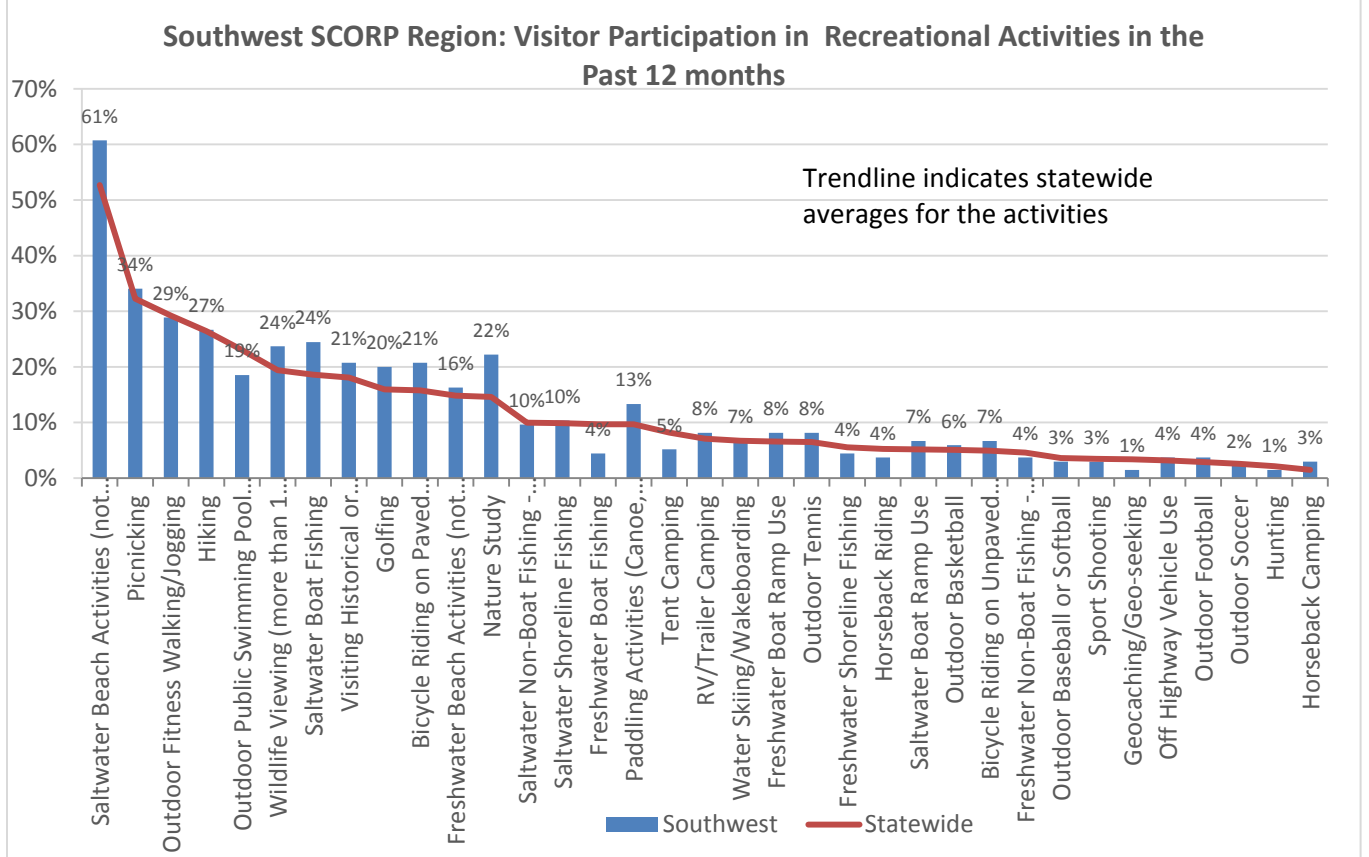


Figure 68. Bicycle Riding on Paved Roads/Trails by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

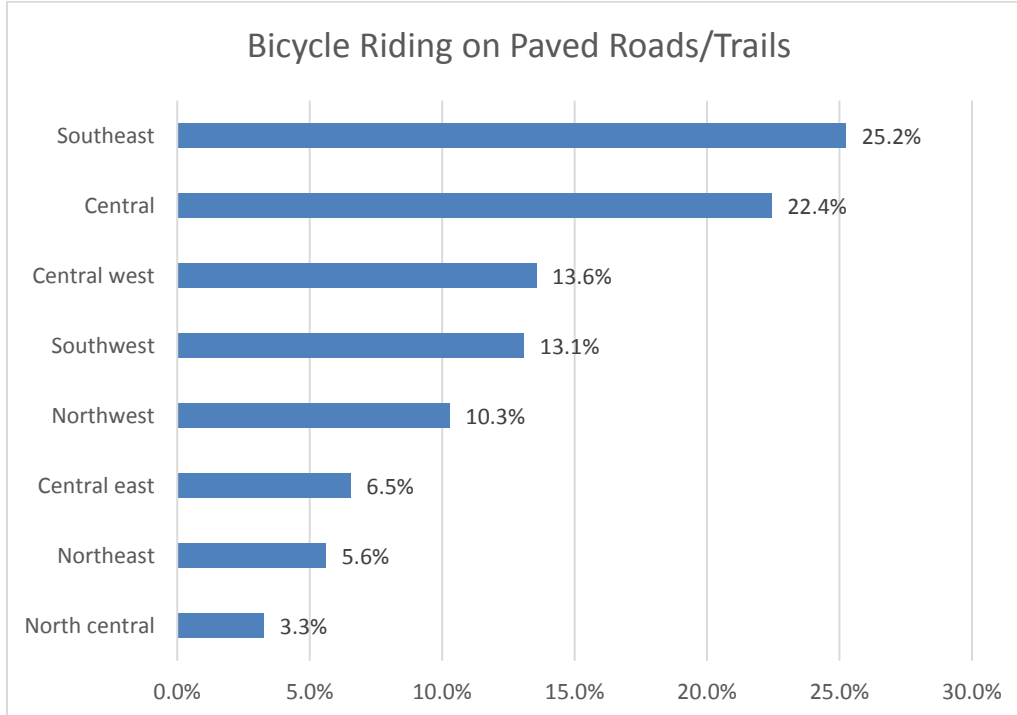


Figure 69. Bicycle Riding on Unpaved Roads/Trails by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

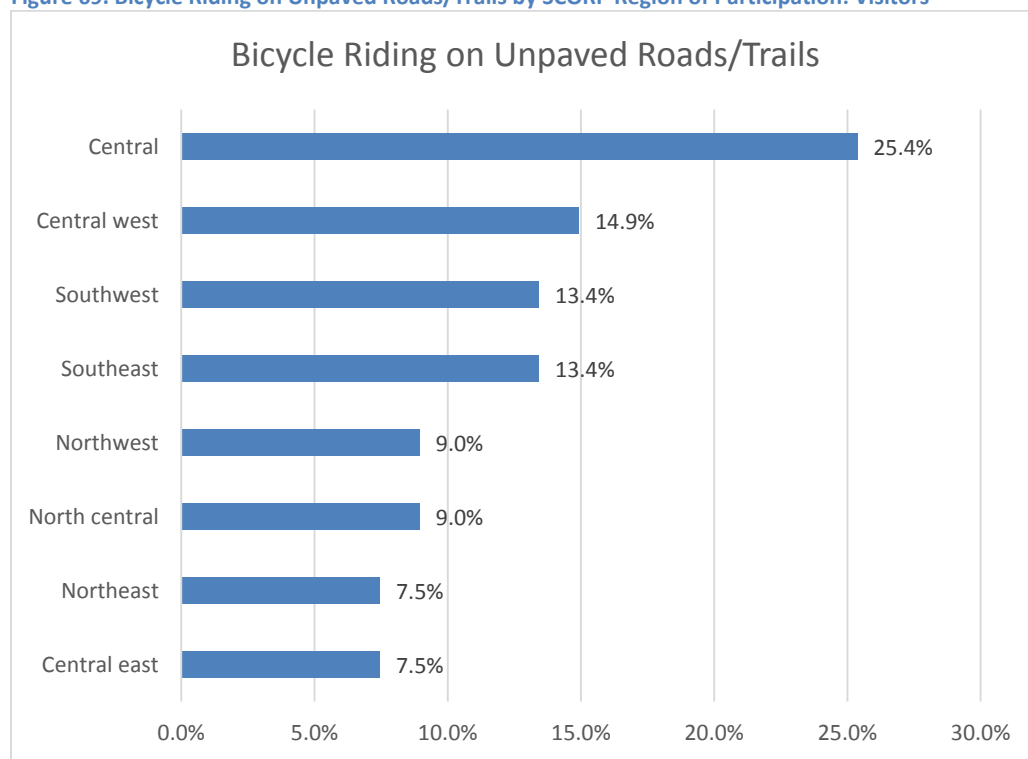


Figure 70. Freshwater Beach Activities by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

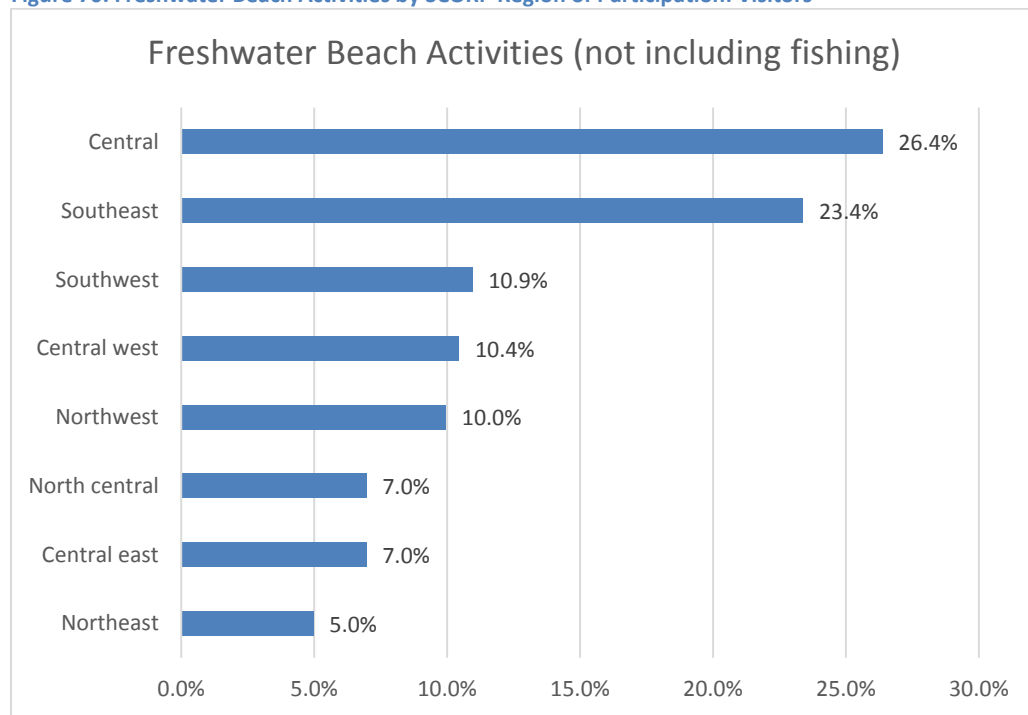


Figure 71. Freshwater Boat Fishing by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

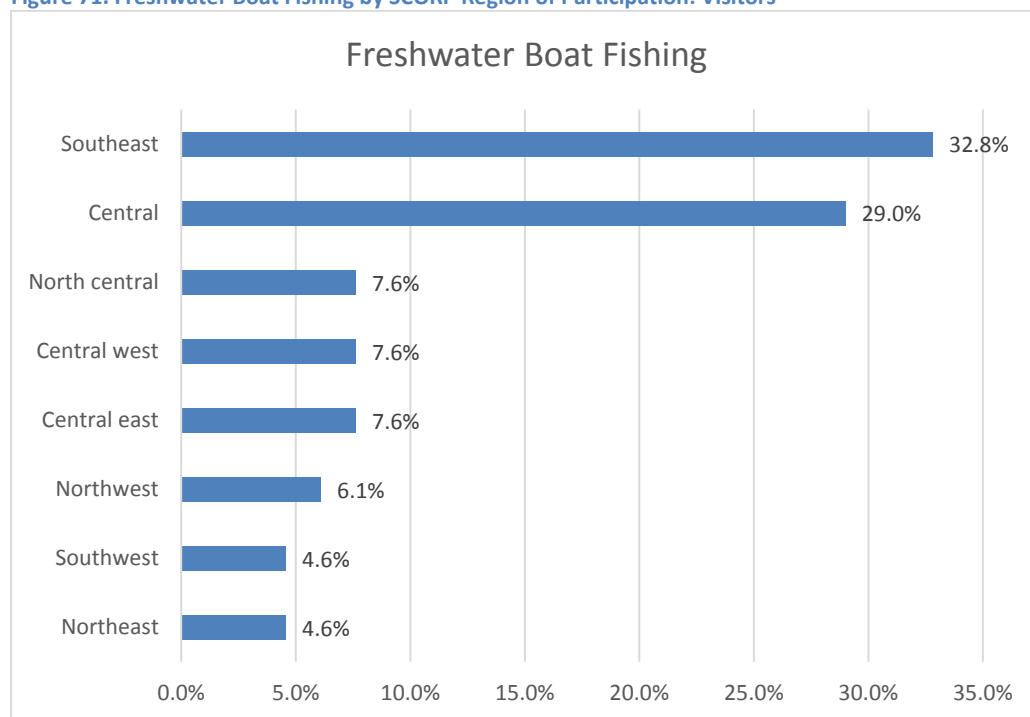


Figure 72. Freshwater Boat ramp use by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

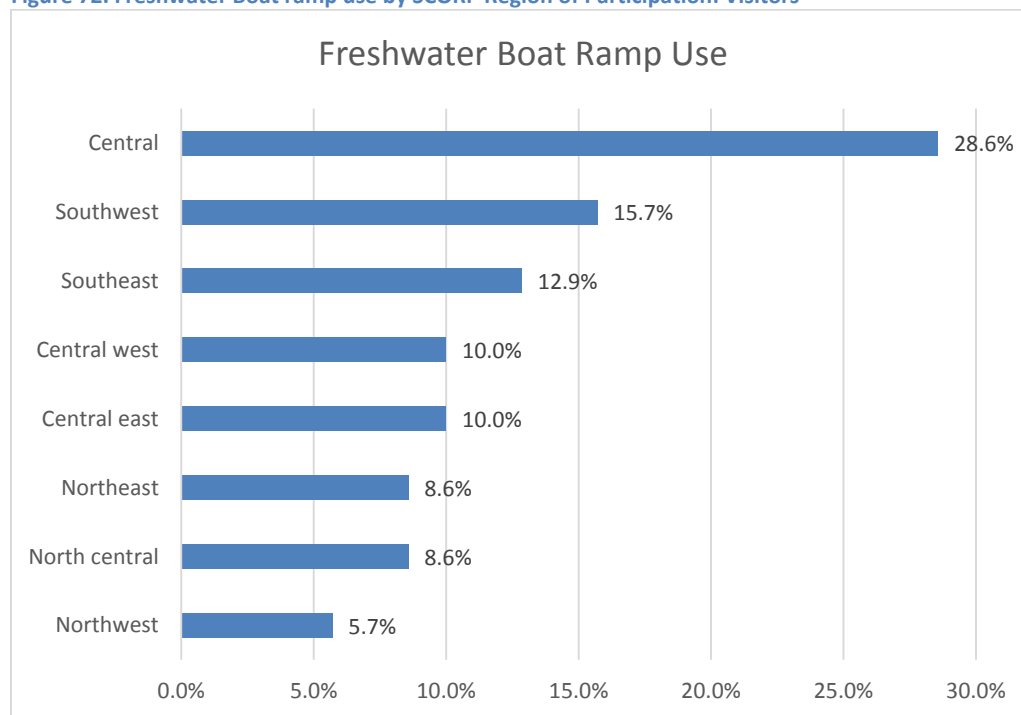


Figure 73. Freshwater Non-boat Fishing by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

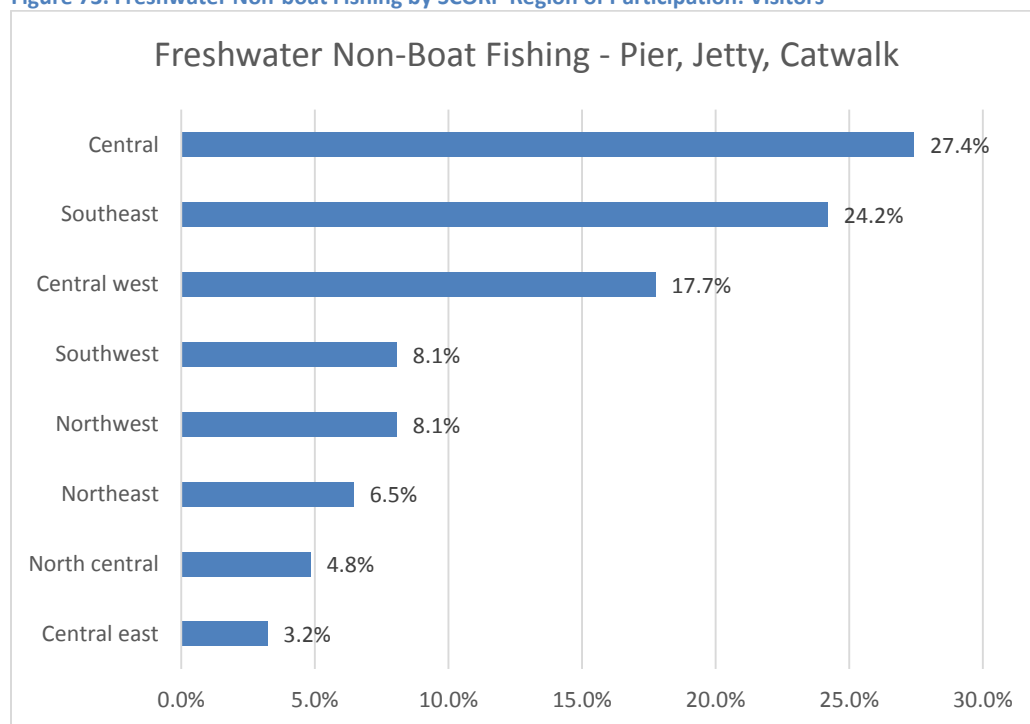


Figure 74. Freshwater Shoreline Fishing by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

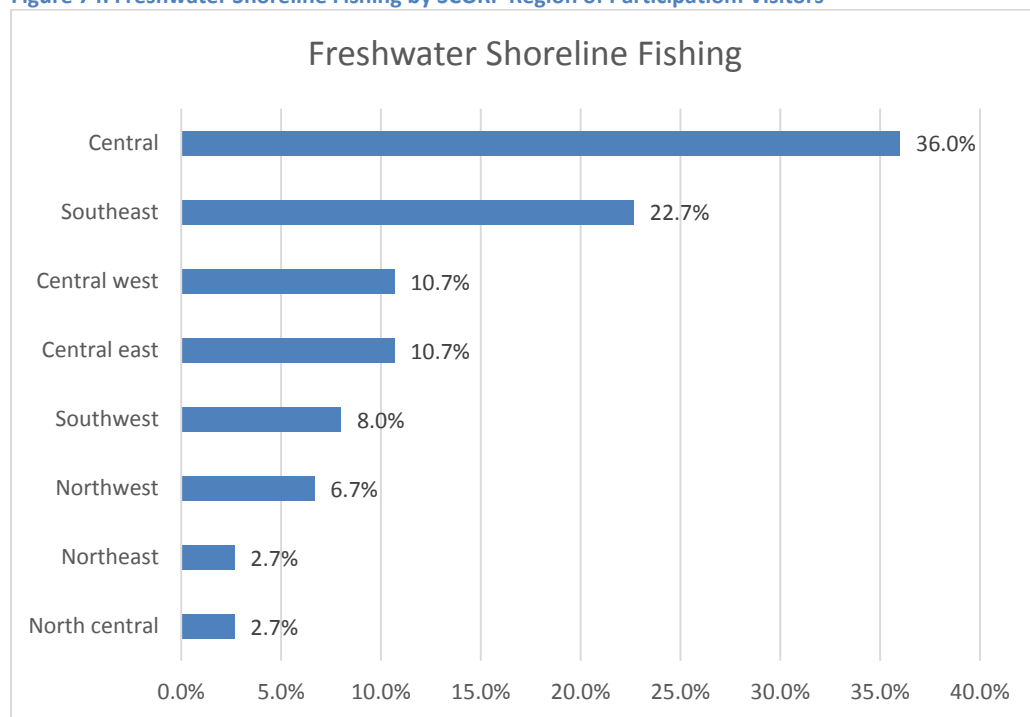


Figure 75. Geocaching by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

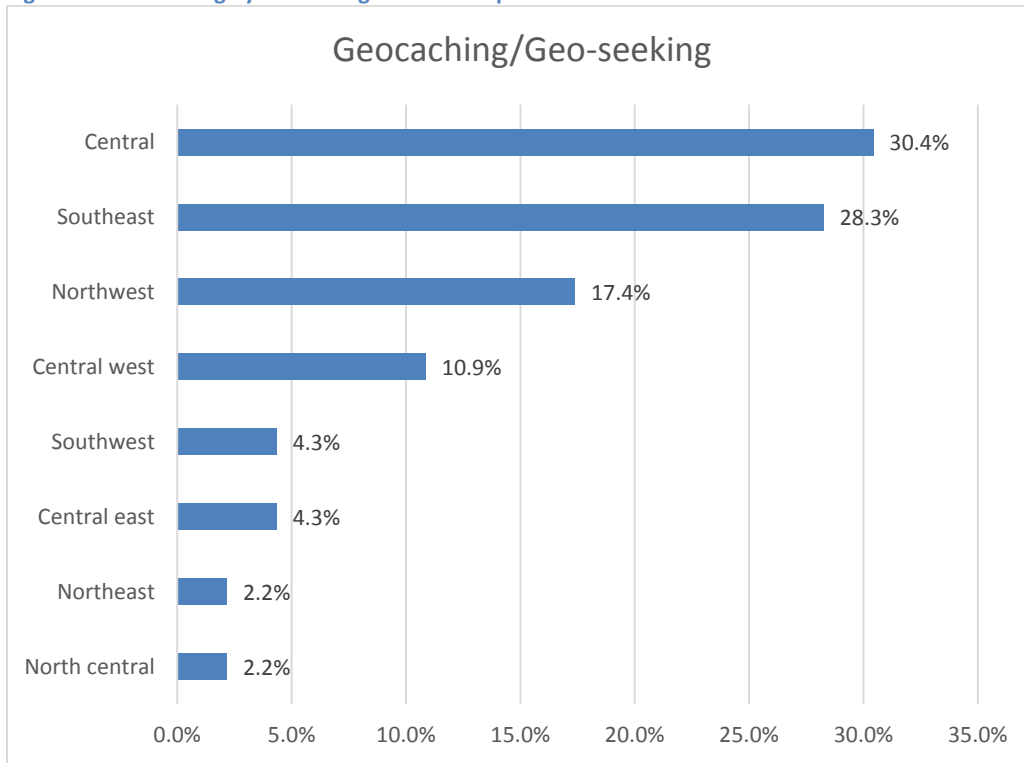


Figure 76. Golfing by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

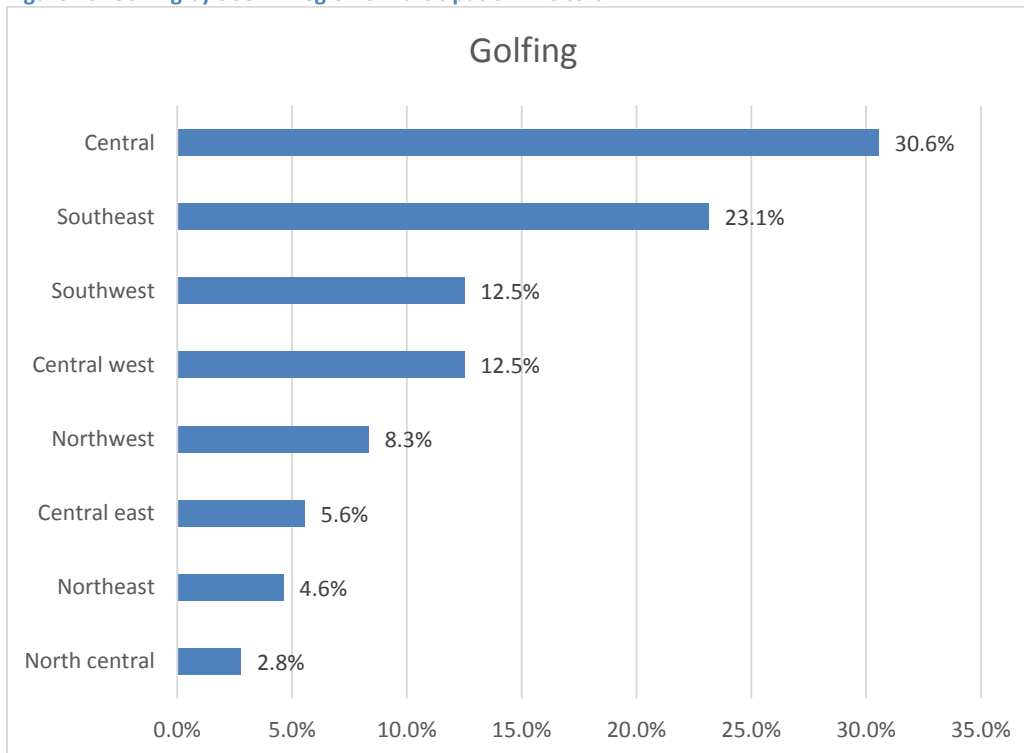


Figure 77. Hiking by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

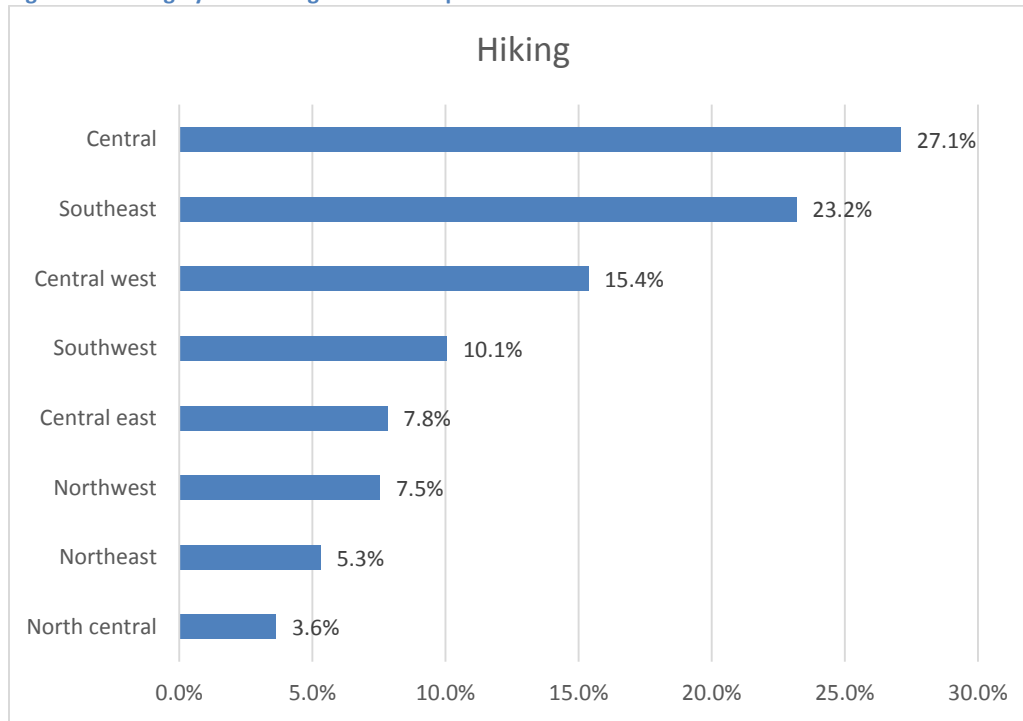


Figure 78. Horseback Camping by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

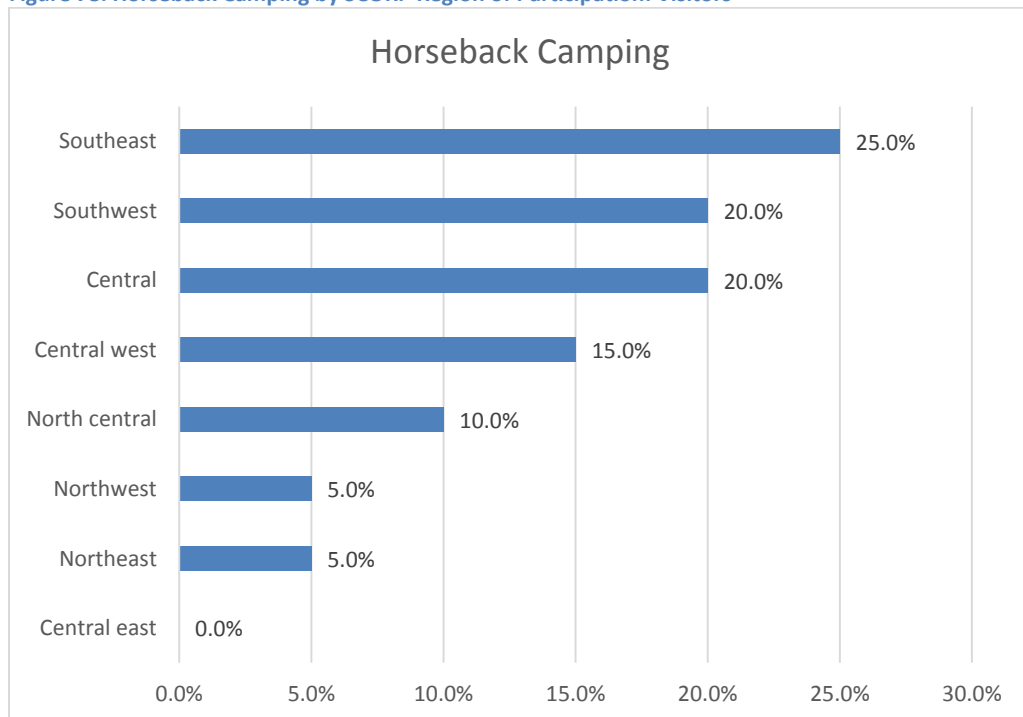


Figure 79. Horseback Riding by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

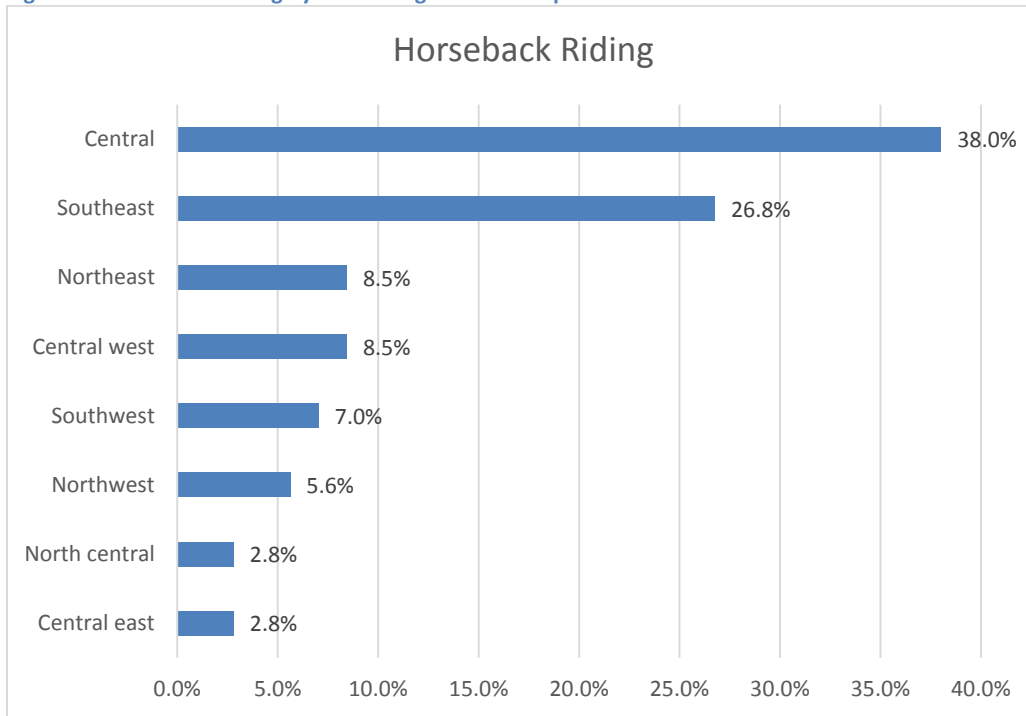


Figure 80. Hunting by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

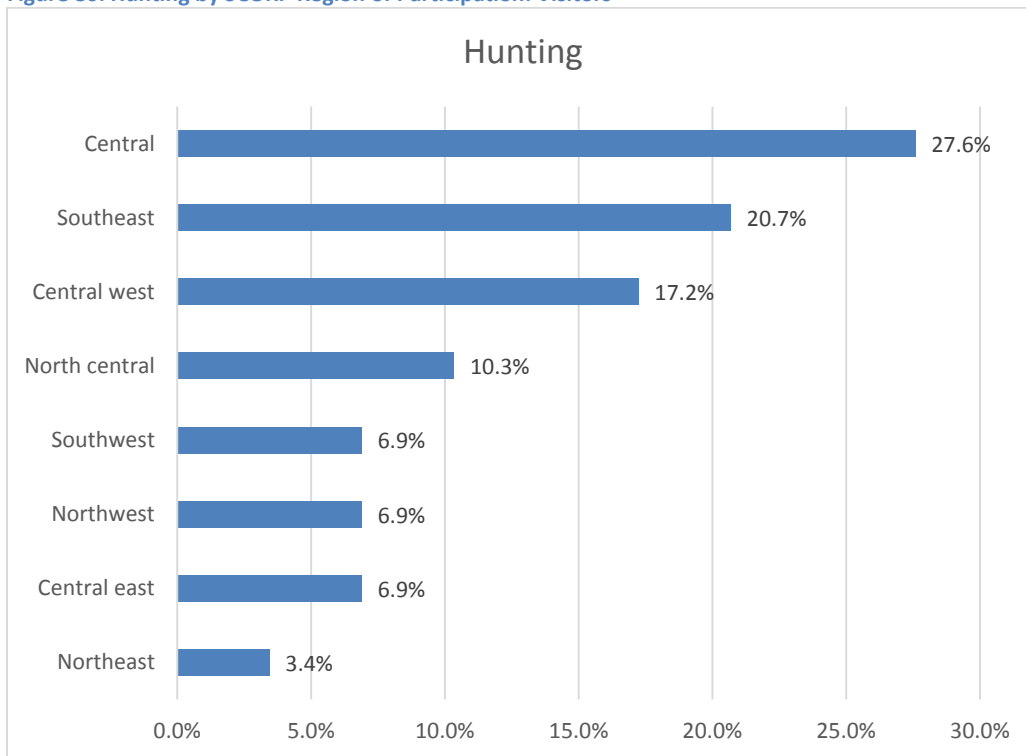


Figure 81. Nature Study by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

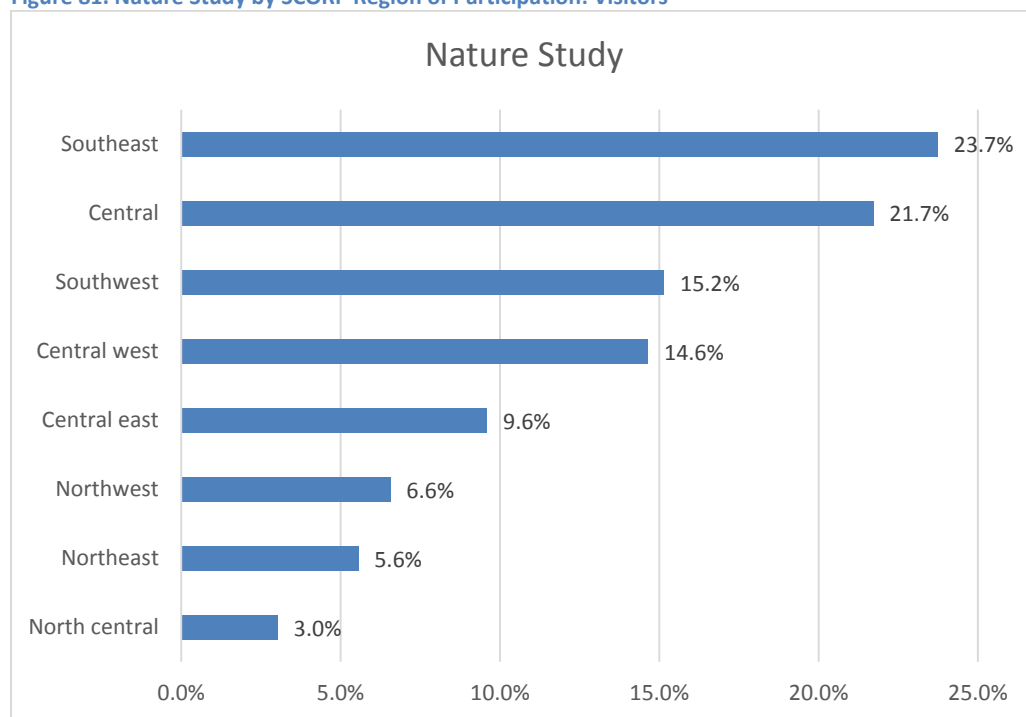


Figure 82. Off Highway Vehicle Use by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

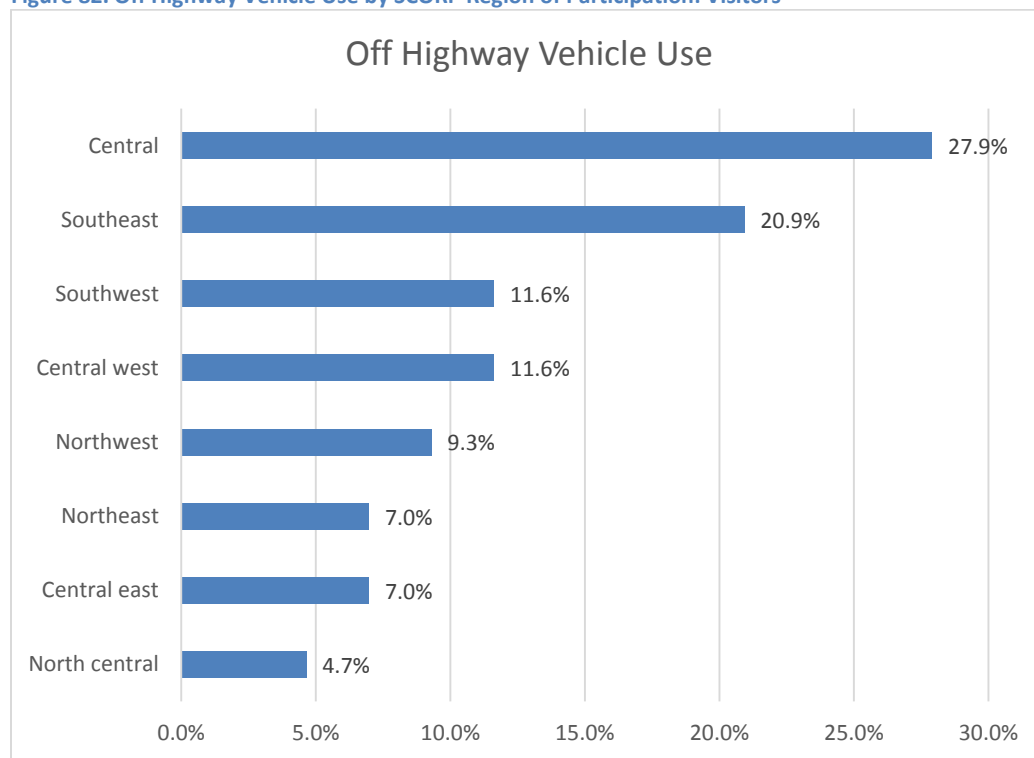


Figure 83. Outdoor Baseball or Softball by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

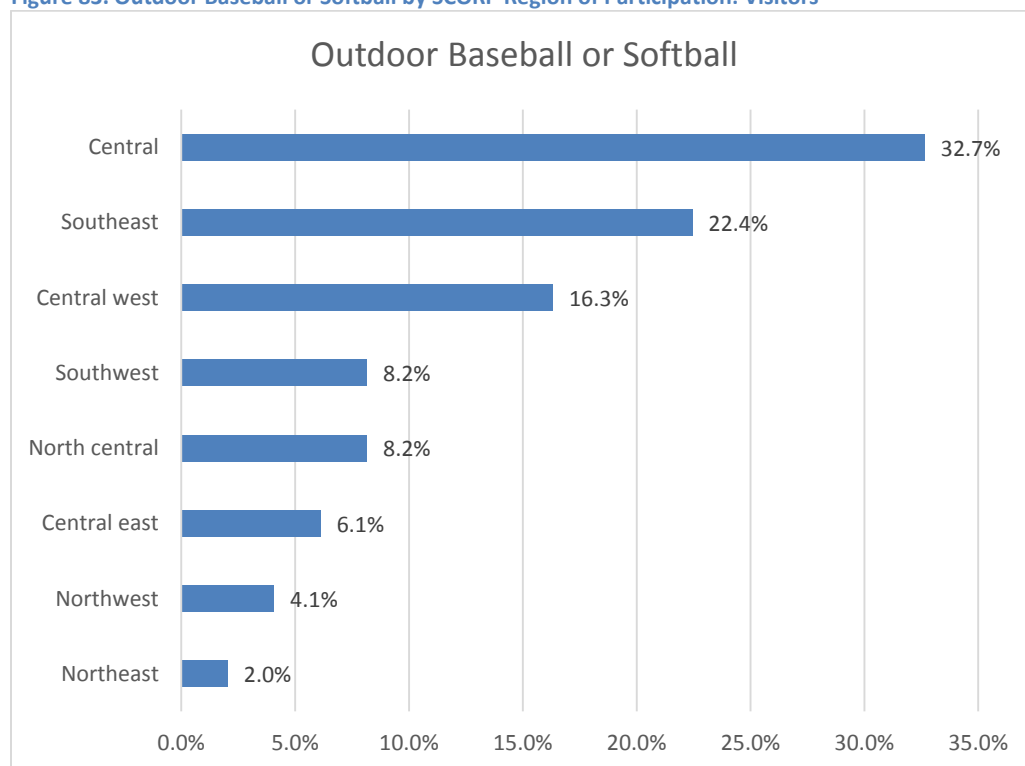


Figure 84. Outdoor Basketball by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

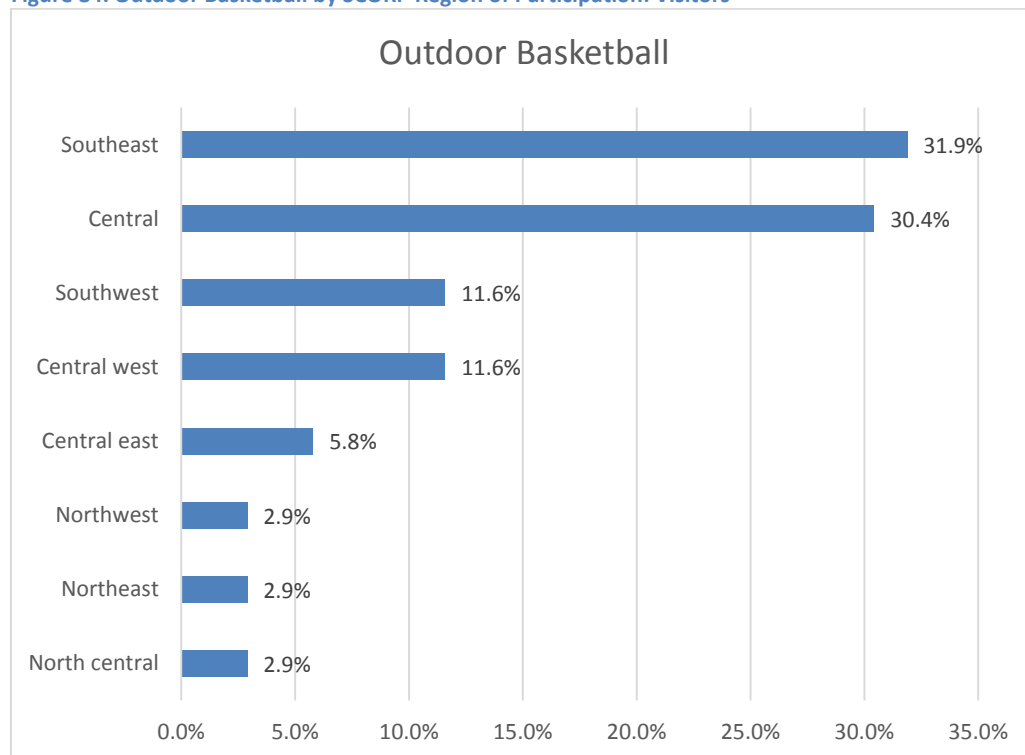


Figure 85. Outdoor Football by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

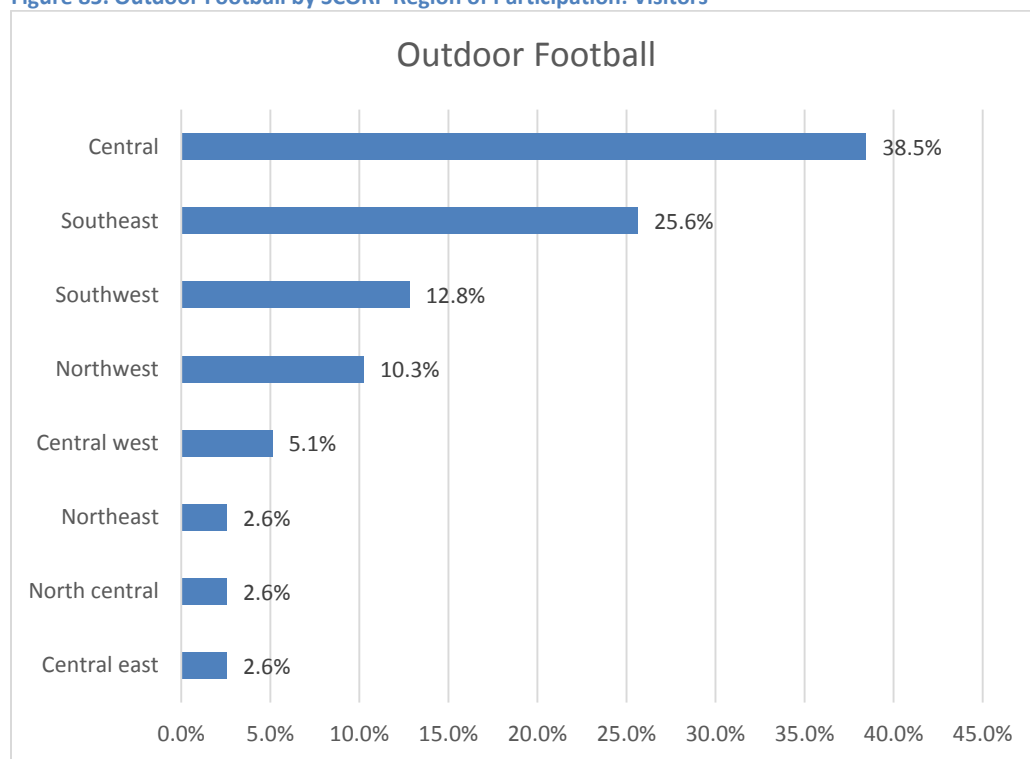


Figure 86. Outdoor Fitness/Jogging by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

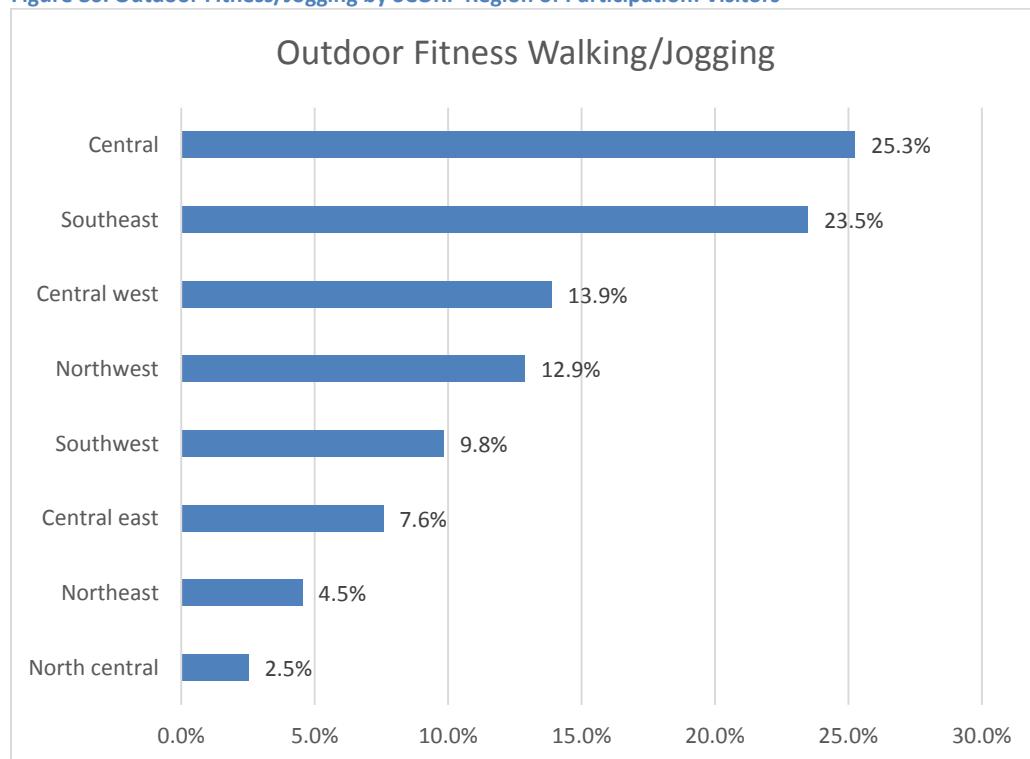


Figure 87. Outdoor Public Swimming Pool Use by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

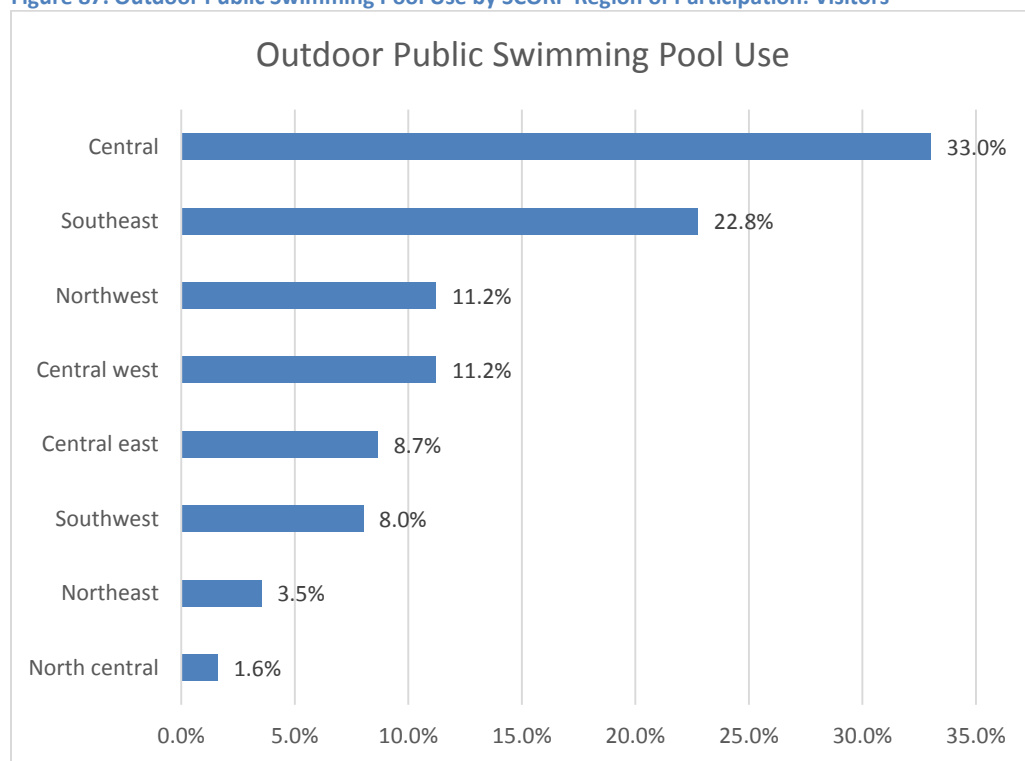


Figure 88. Outdoor Soccer by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

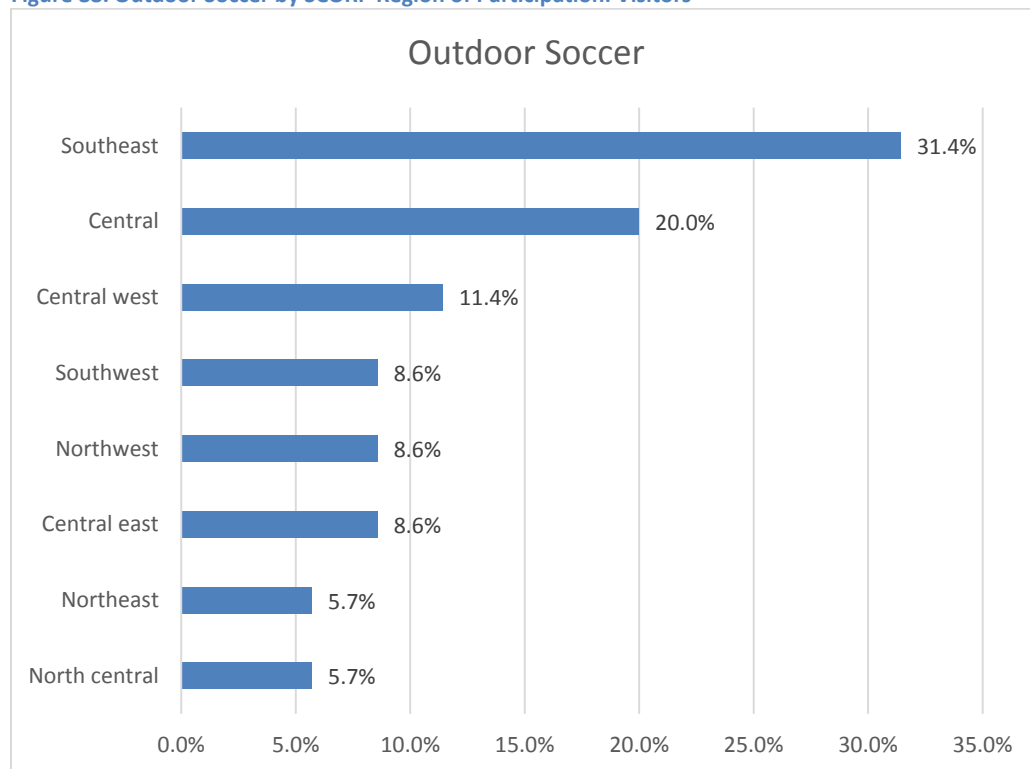


Figure 89. Outdoor Tennis by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

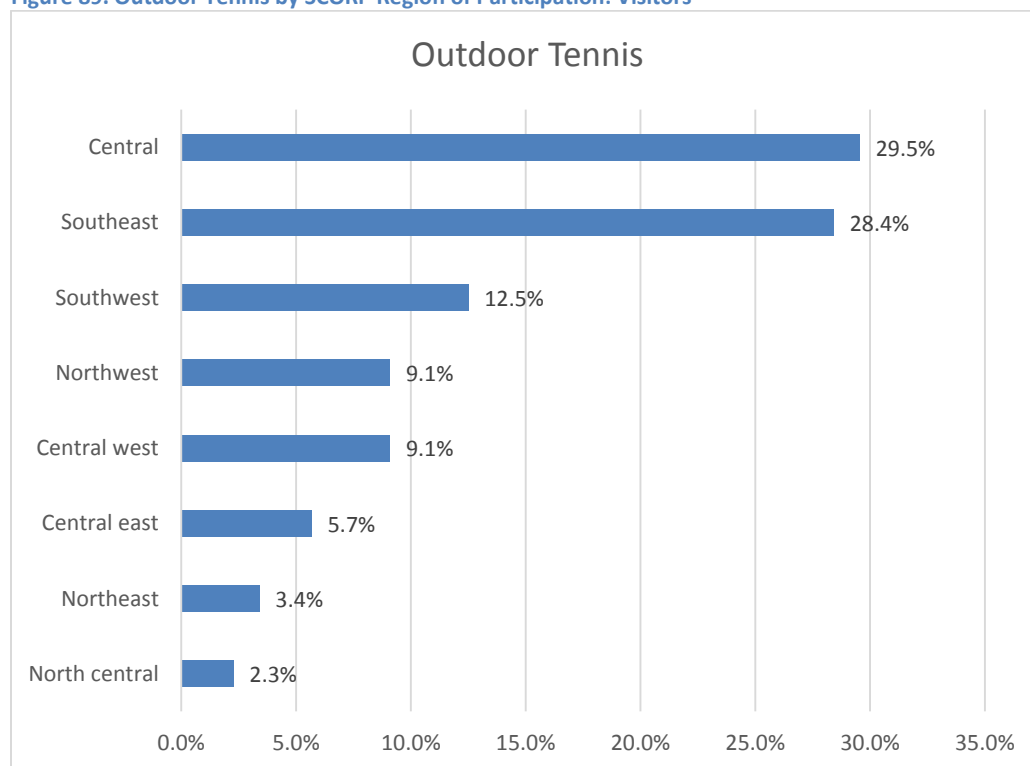


Figure 90. Paddling Activities by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

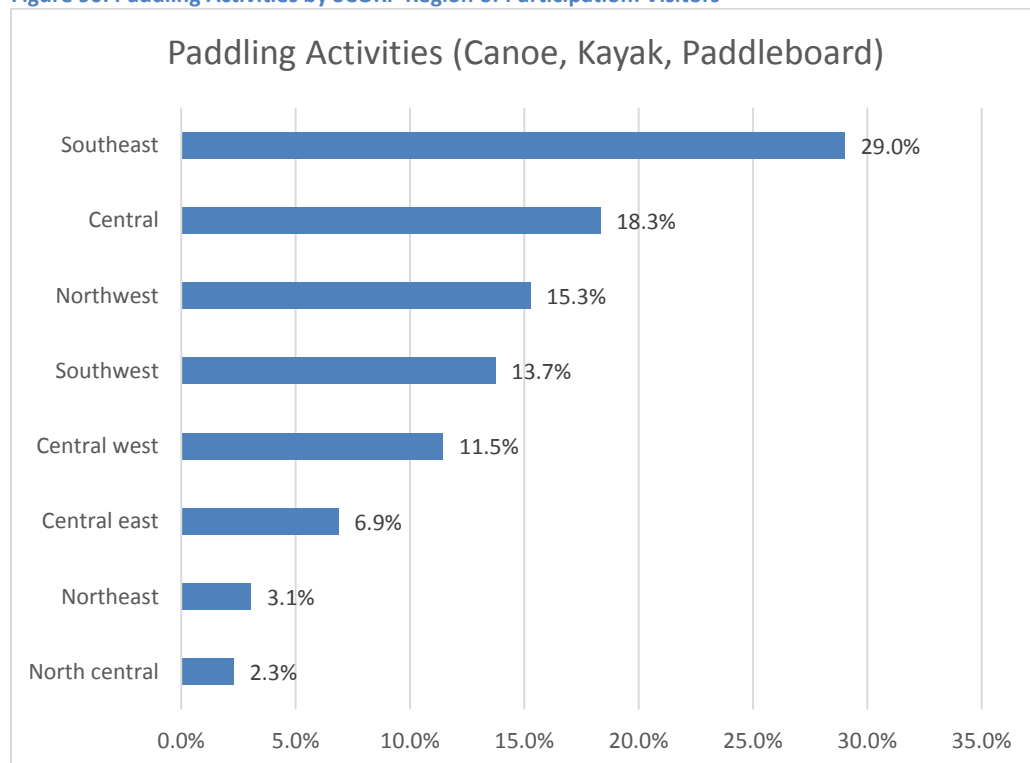


Figure 91. Picnicking by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

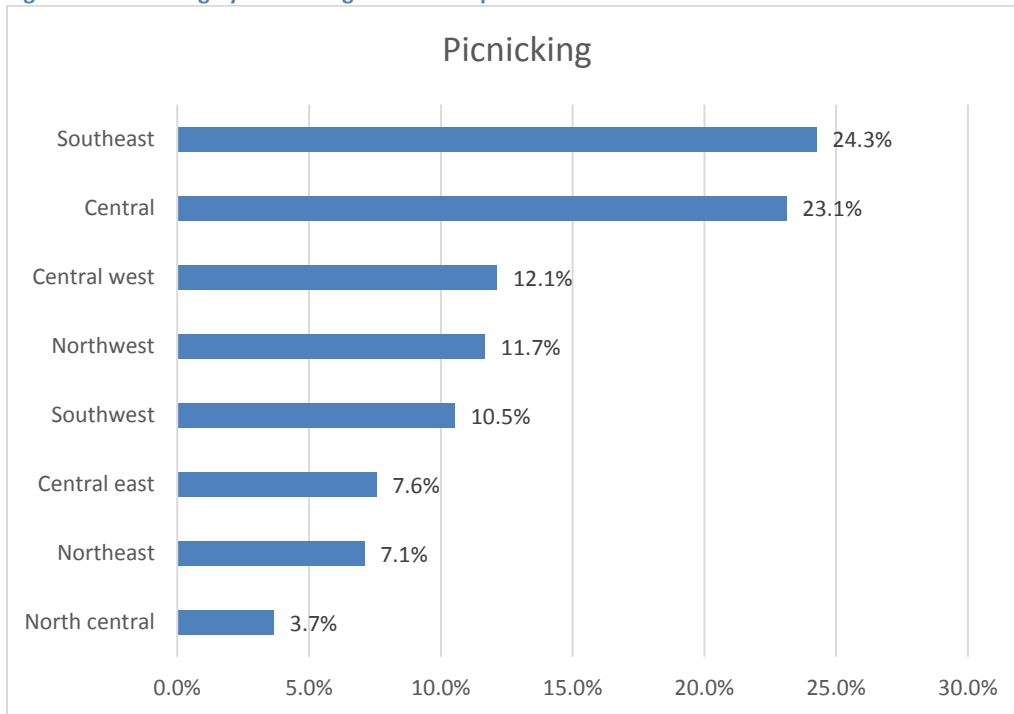


Figure 92. RV/Trailer Camping by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

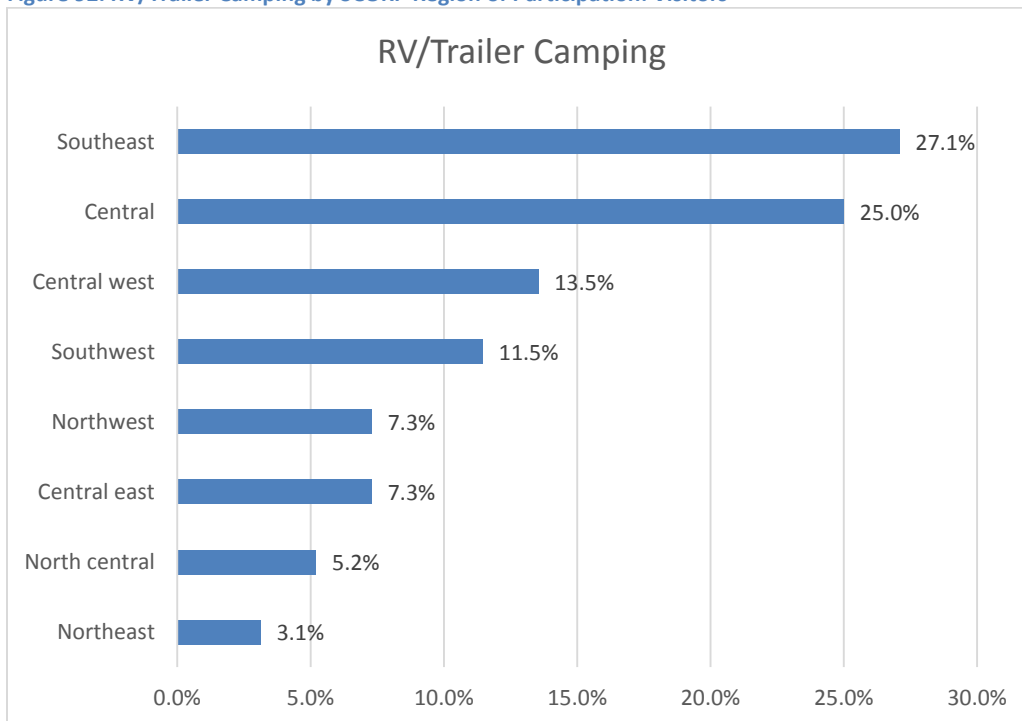


Figure 93. Saltwater Beach Activities by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

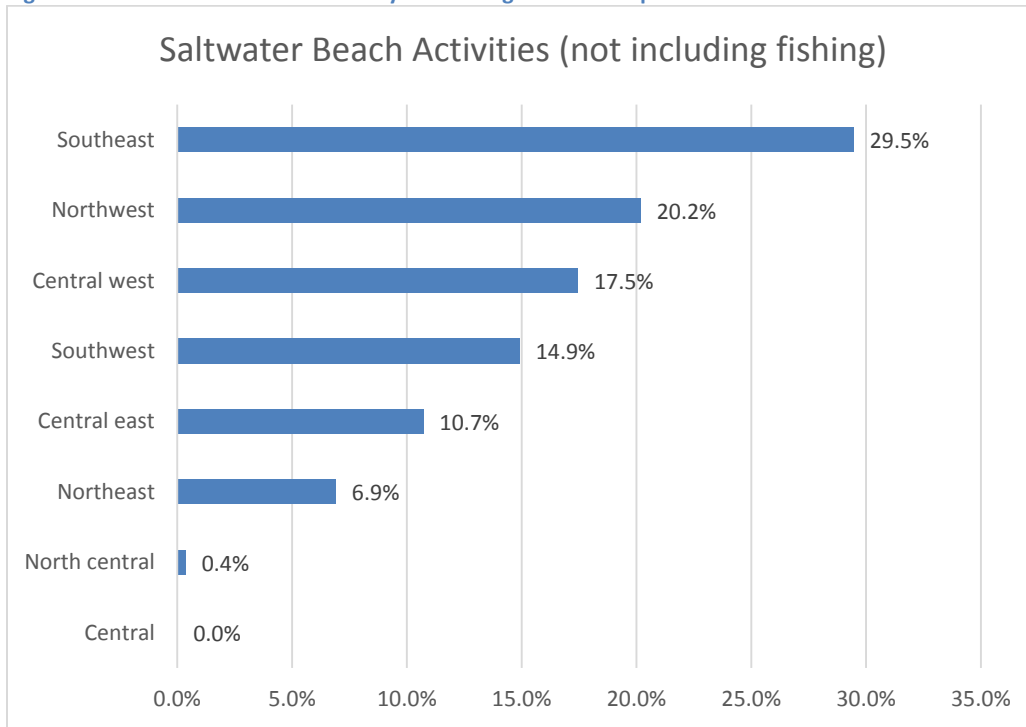


Figure 94. Saltwater Boat Fishing by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

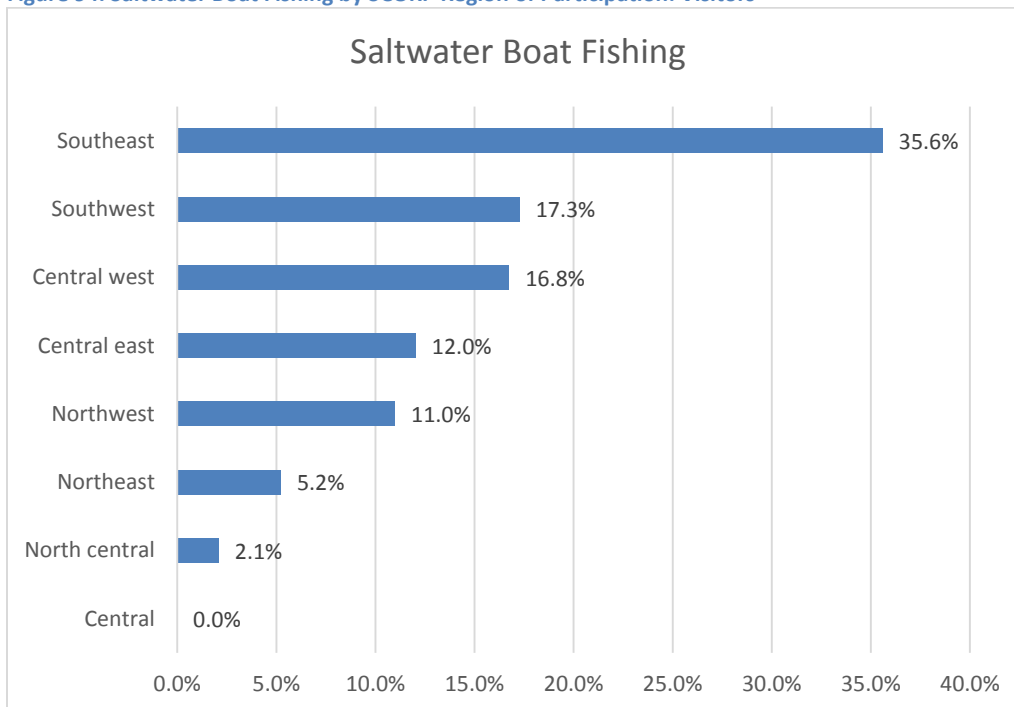


Figure 95. Saltwater Boat Ramp Use by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

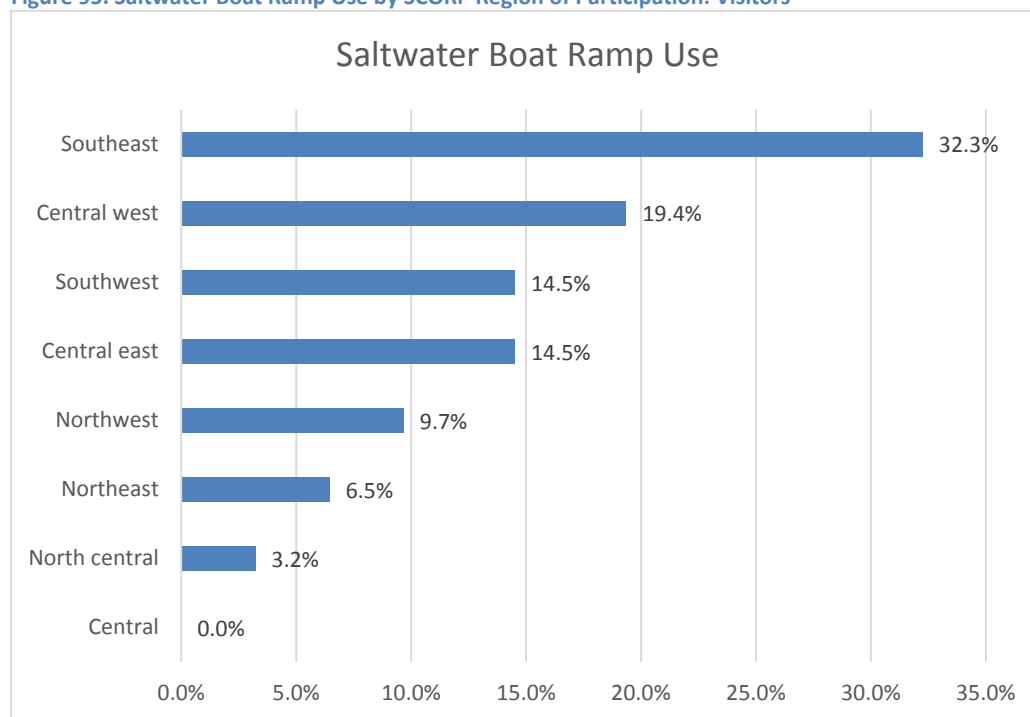


Figure 96. Saltwater Non-boat Fishing by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

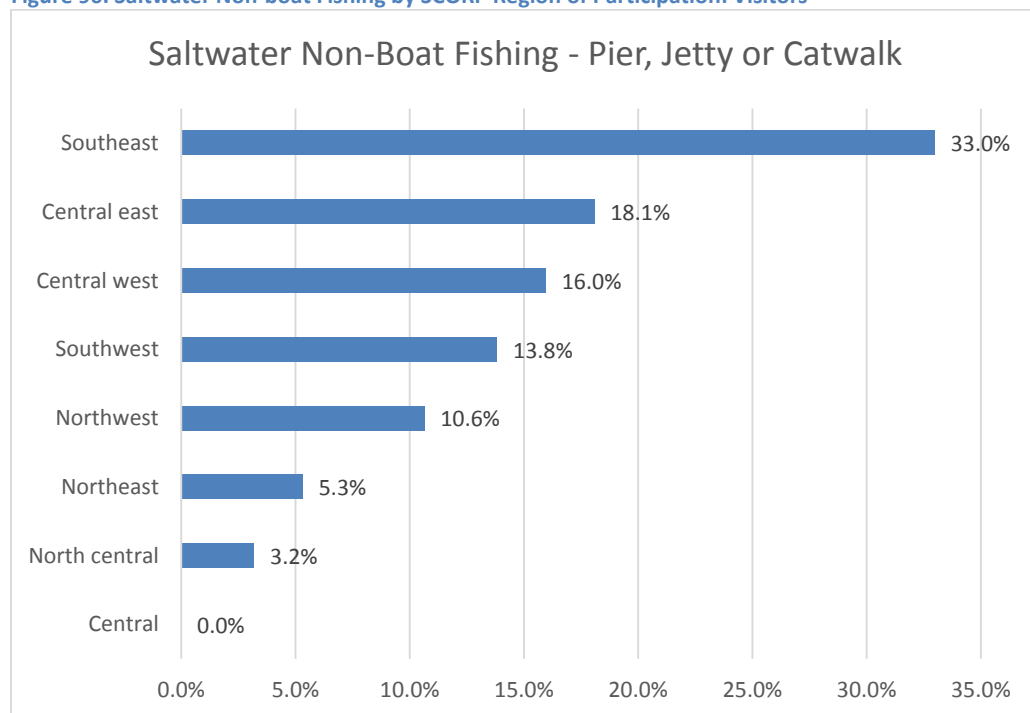


Figure 97. Saltwater Shoreline Fishing by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

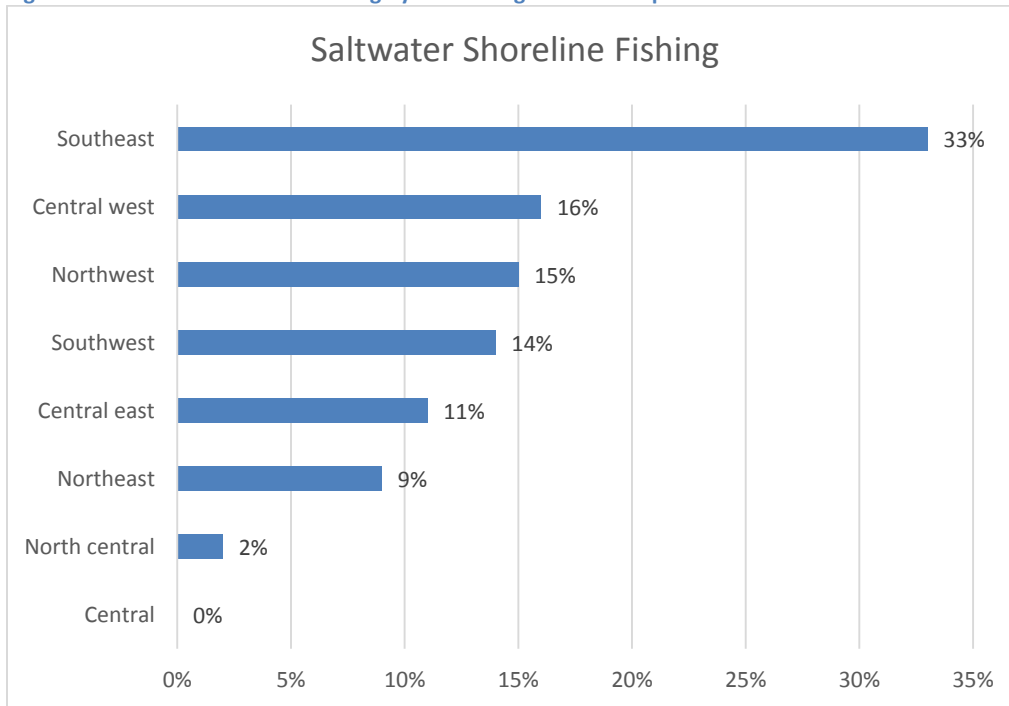


Figure 98. Sport Shooting by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

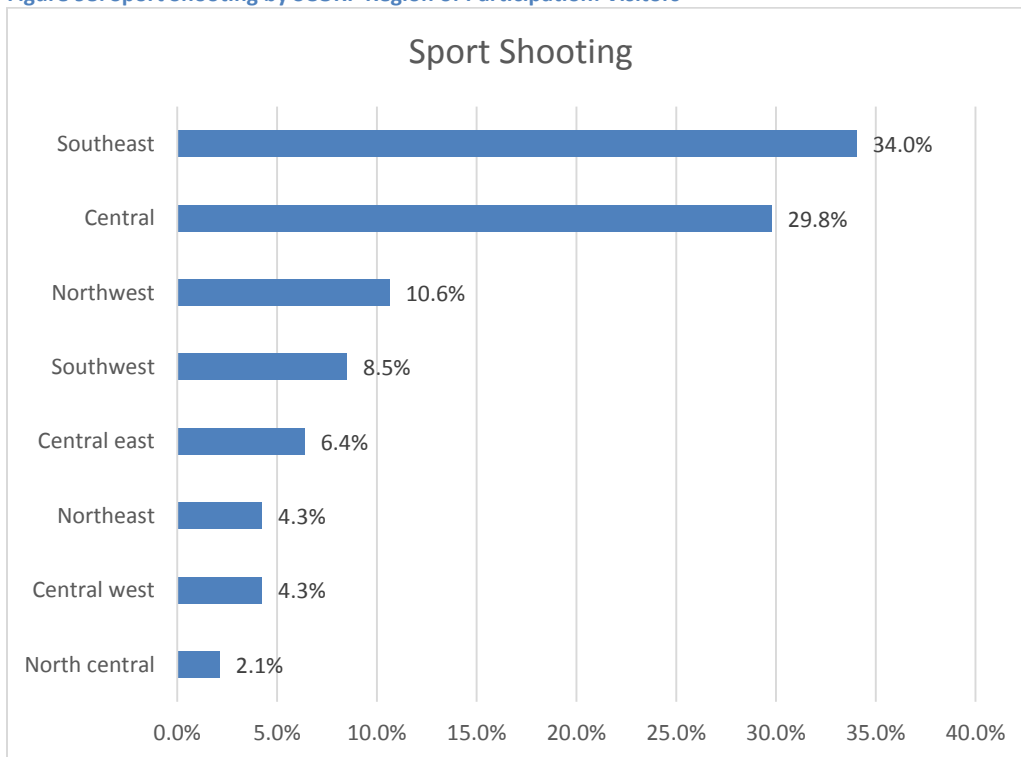


Figure 99. Tent Camping by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

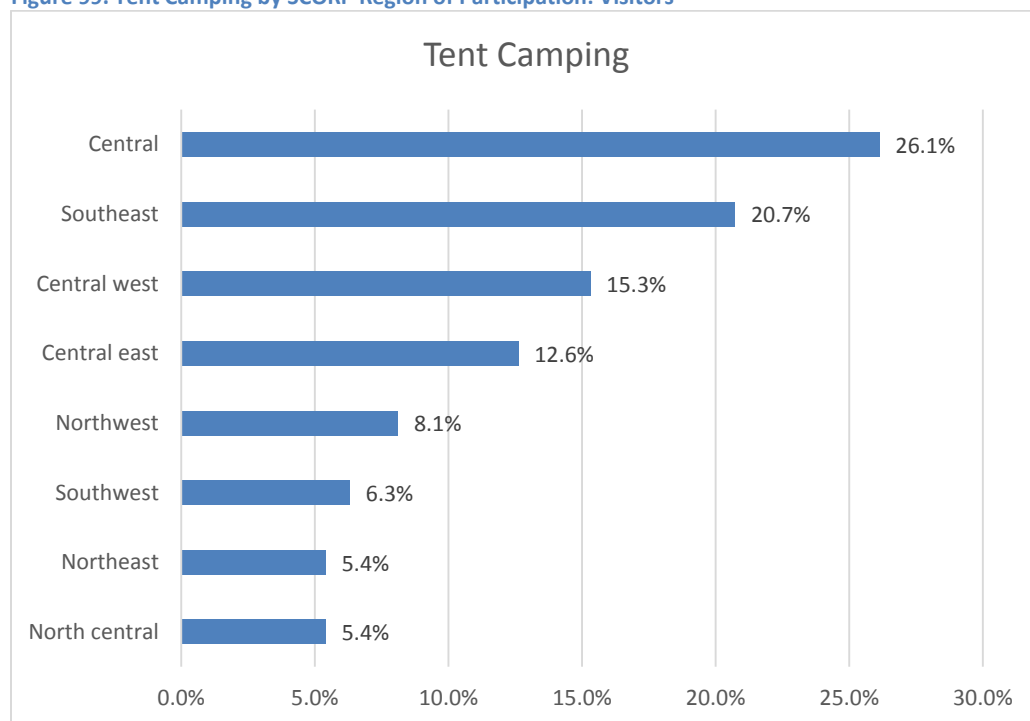


Figure 100. Water Skiing by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

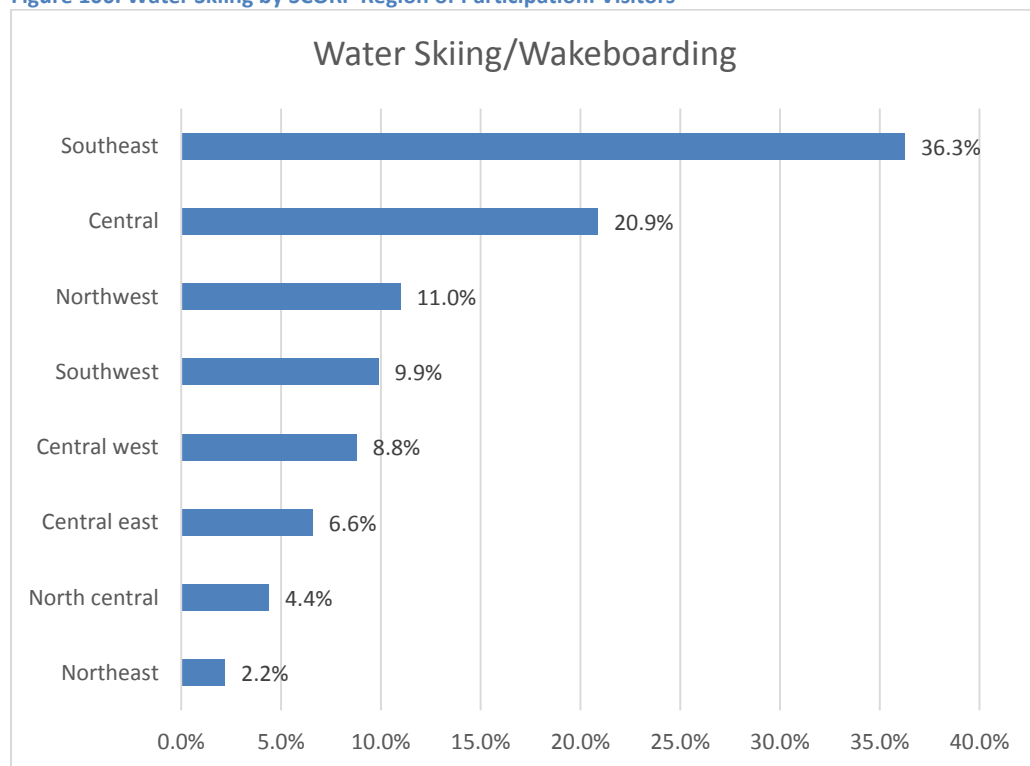


Figure 101. Visiting Historical or Archaeological Sites by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

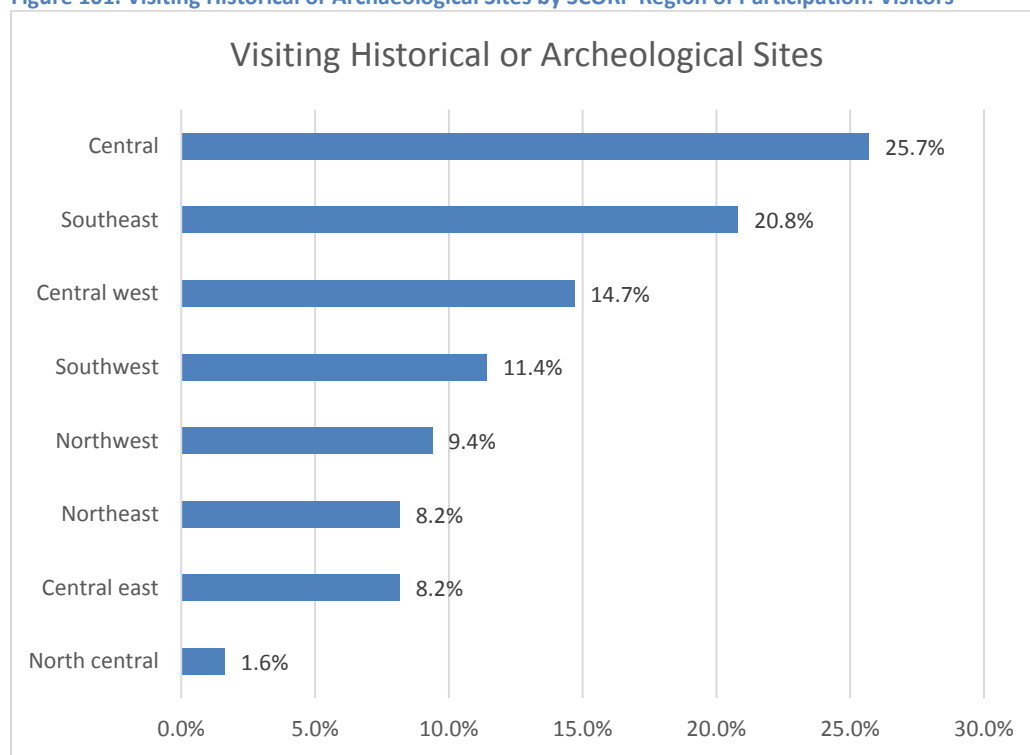


Figure 102. Wildlife Viewing by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

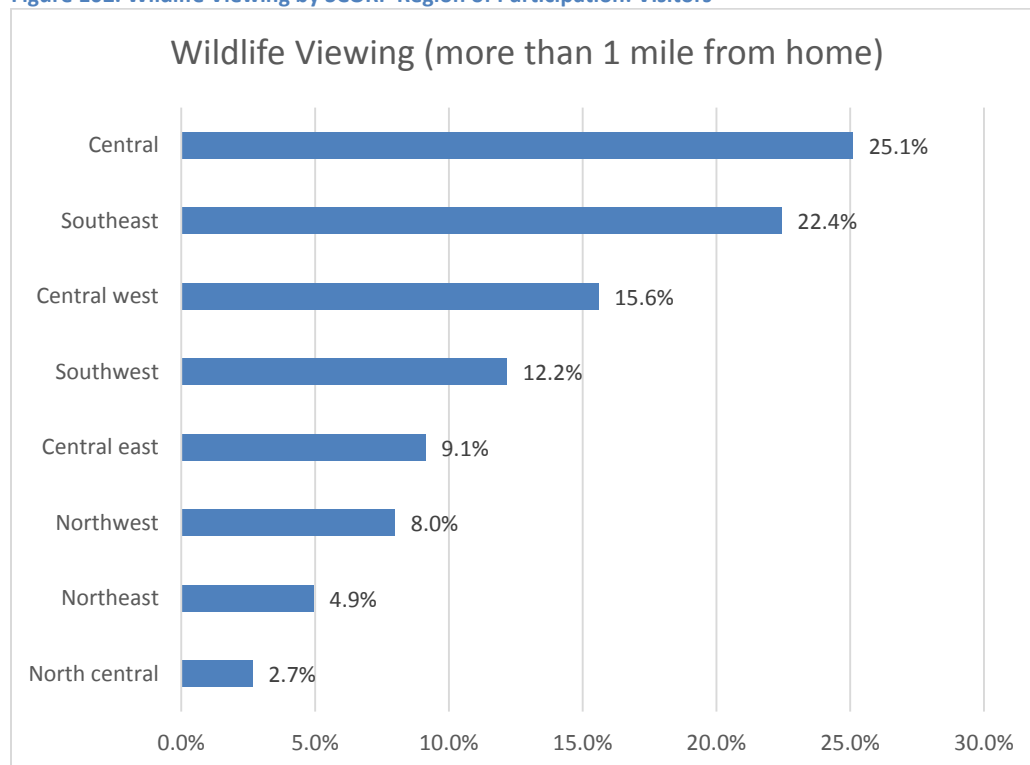


Figure 103. Where Saltwater Fishing Occurs: Residents Statewide

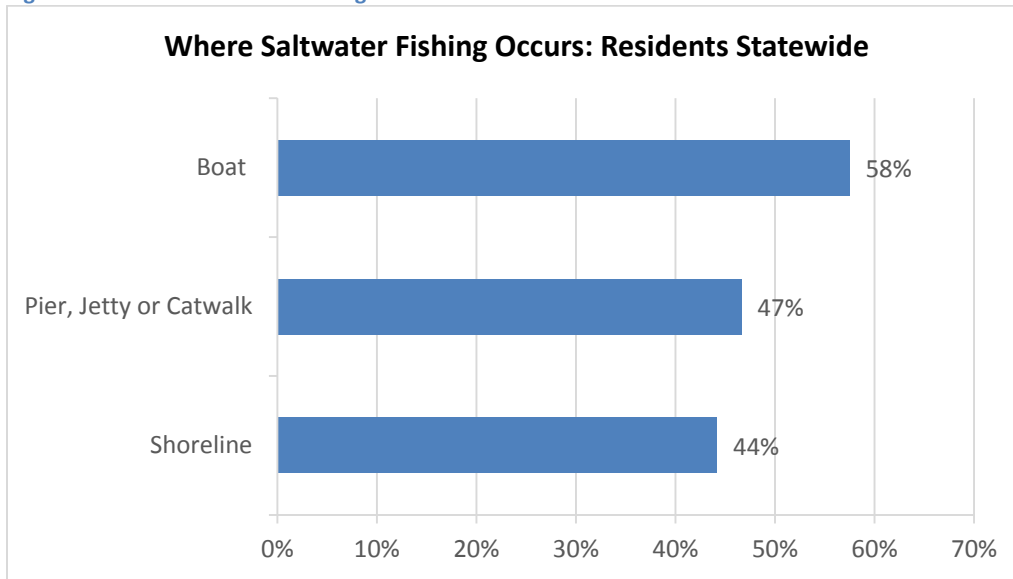


Figure 104. Where Saltwater Fishing Occurs: Visitors Statewide

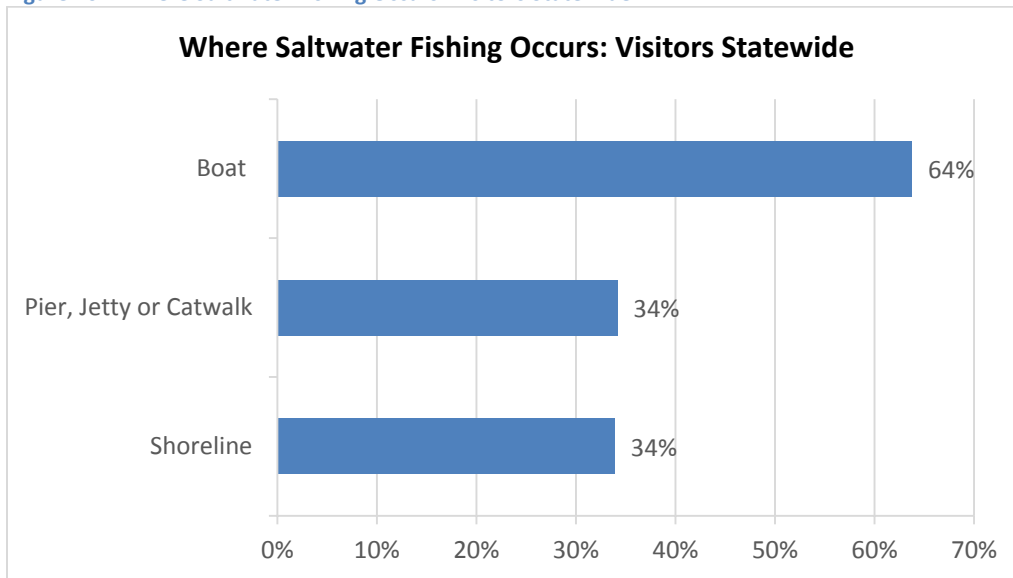


Figure 105. Where Saltwater Fishing Occurs by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

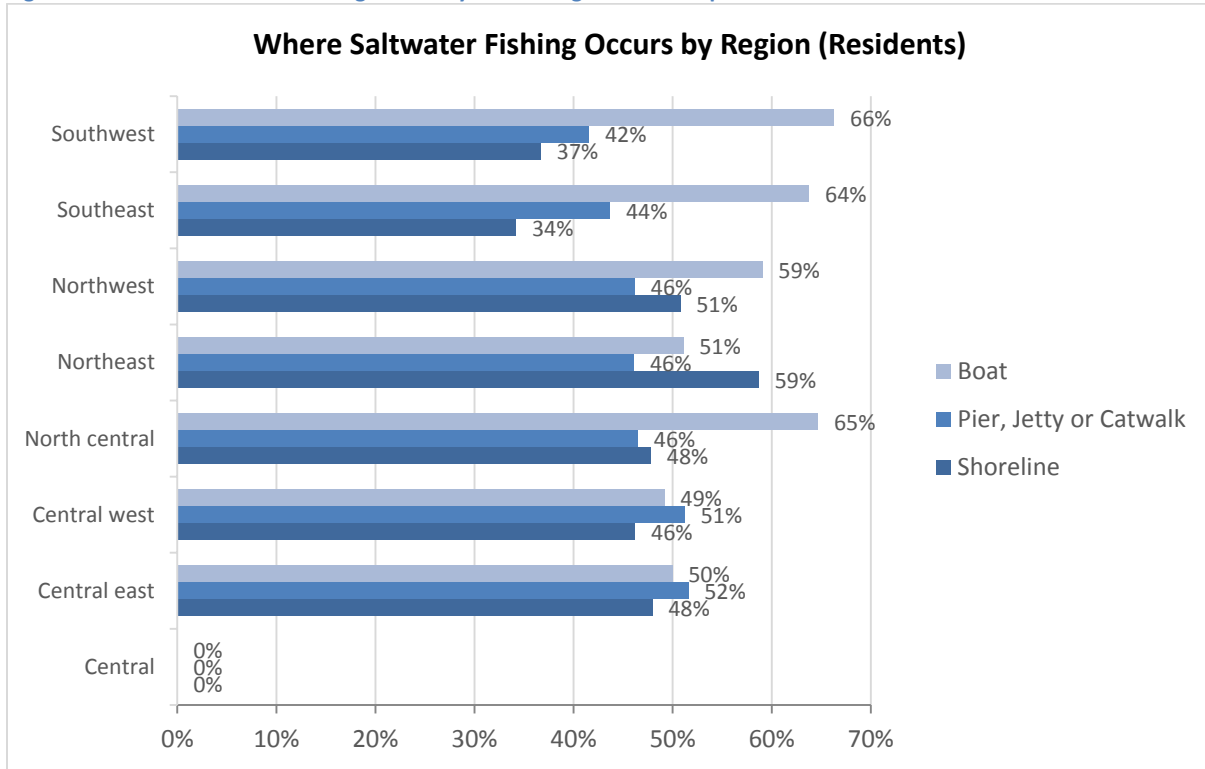


Figure 106. Where Saltwater Fishing Occurs by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

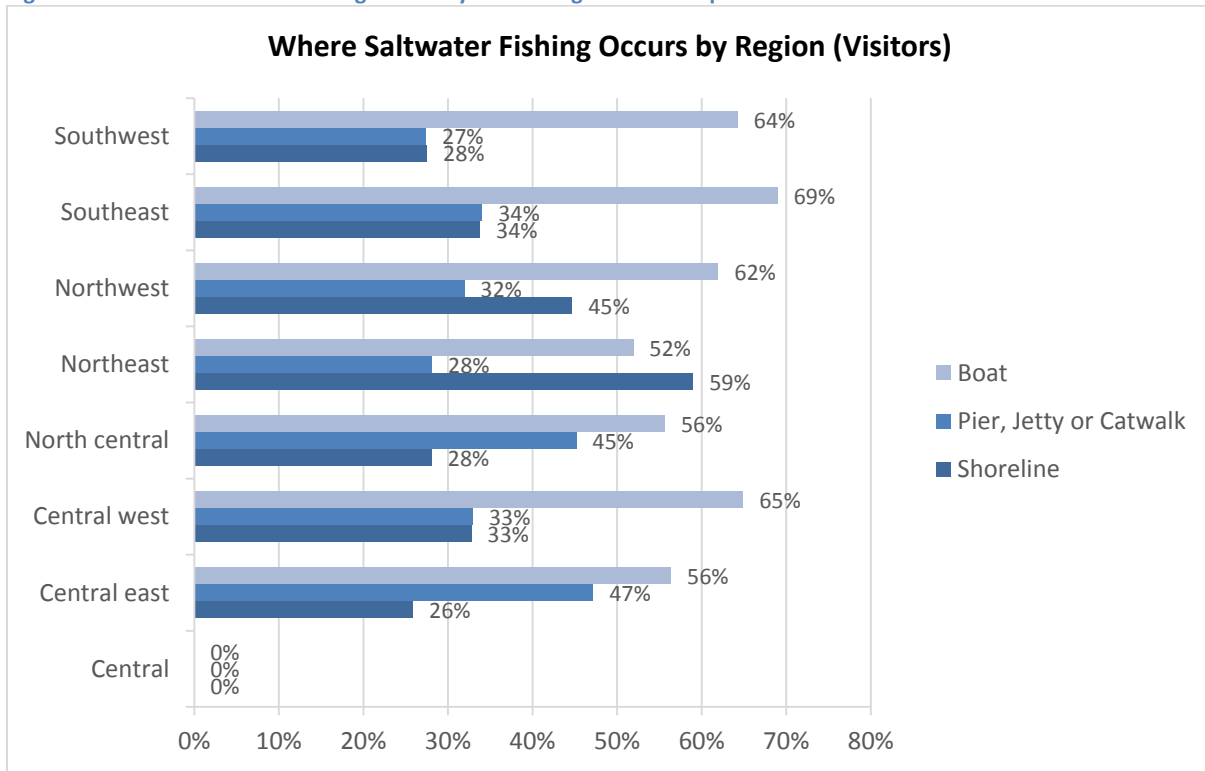


Figure 107. Where Freshwater Fishing Occurs: Residents Statewide

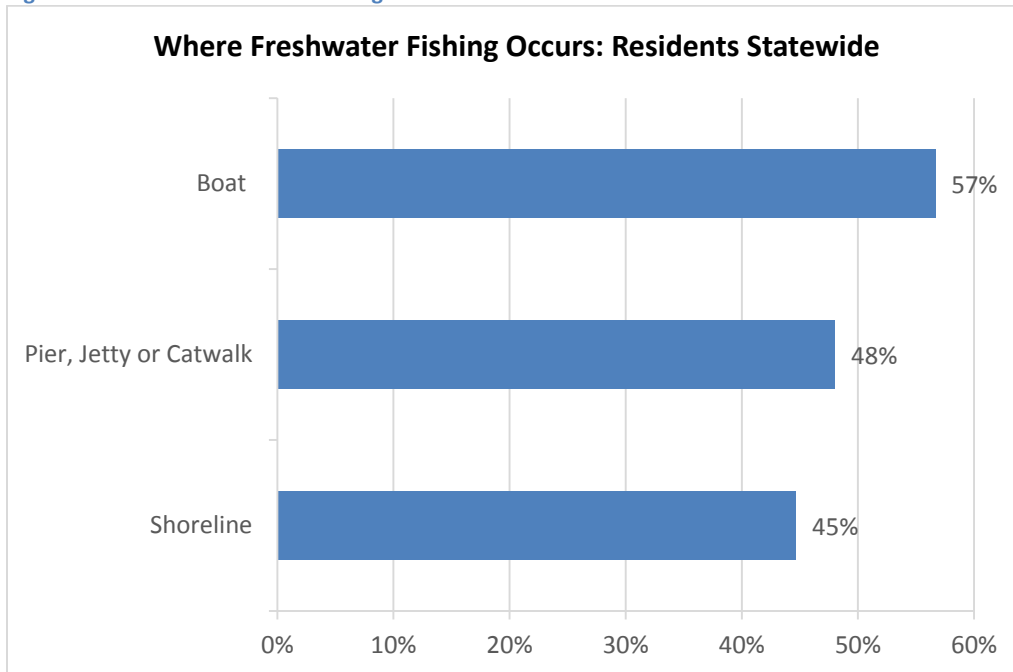


Figure 108. Where Freshwater Fishing Occurs: Visitors Statewide

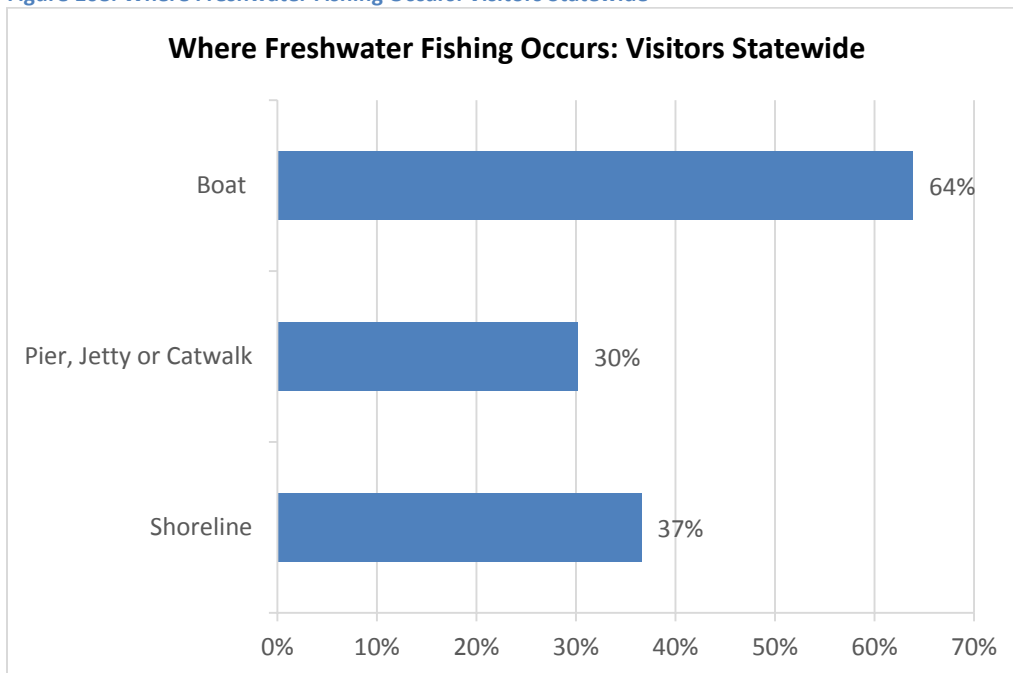


Figure 109. Where Freshwater Fishing Occurs by SCORP Region of Participation: Residents

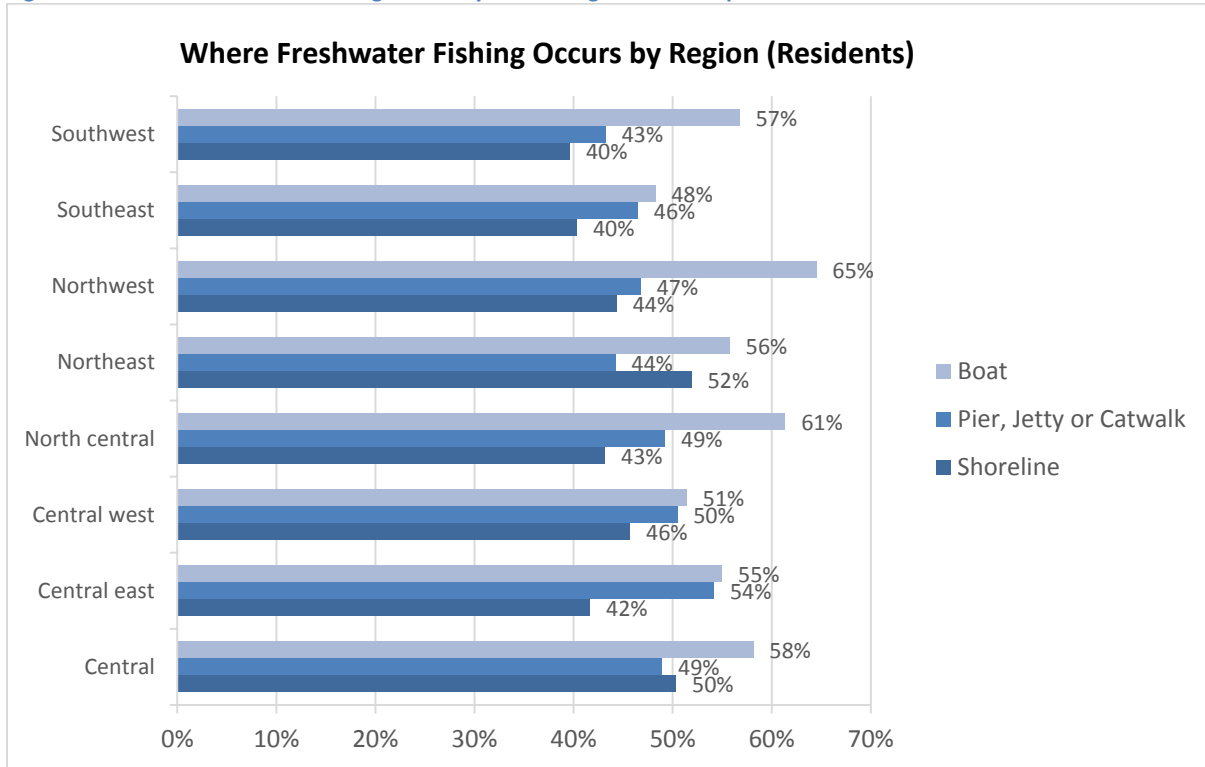


Figure 110. Where Freshwater Fishing Occurs by SCORP Region of Participation: Visitors

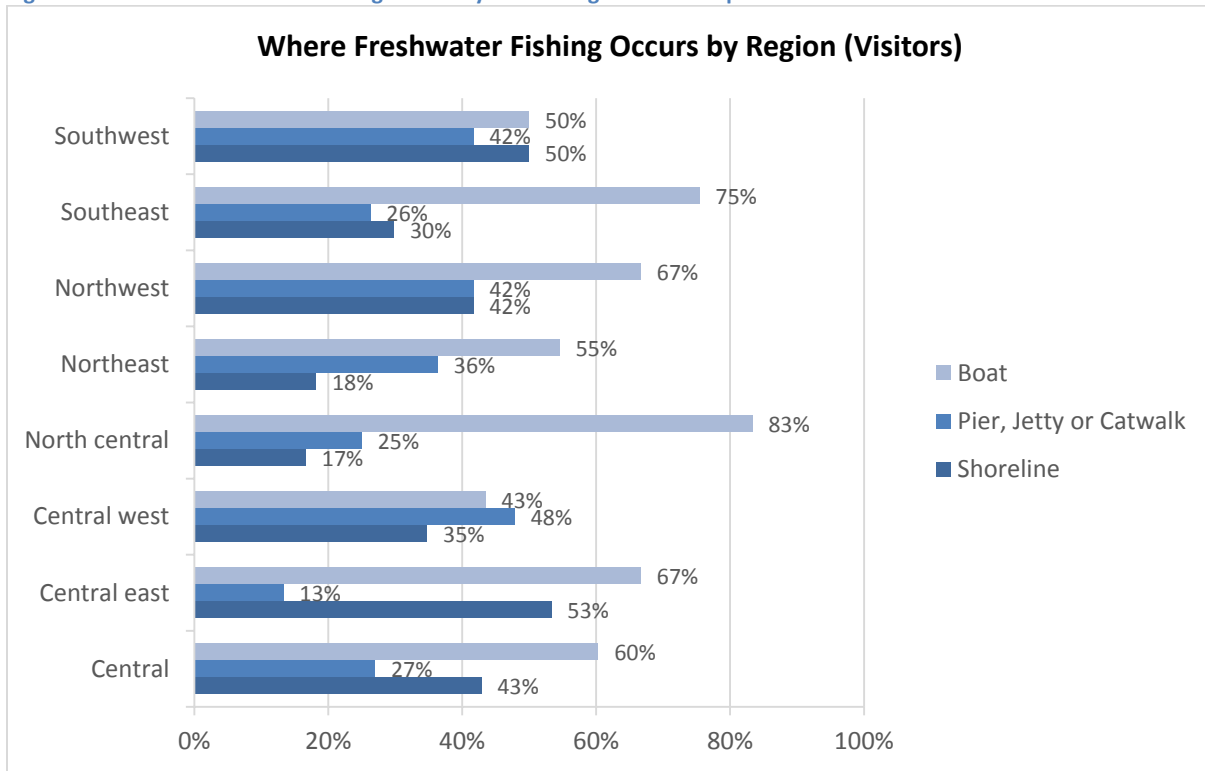


Figure 111. Where Bicycle Riding Occurs: Residents Statewide

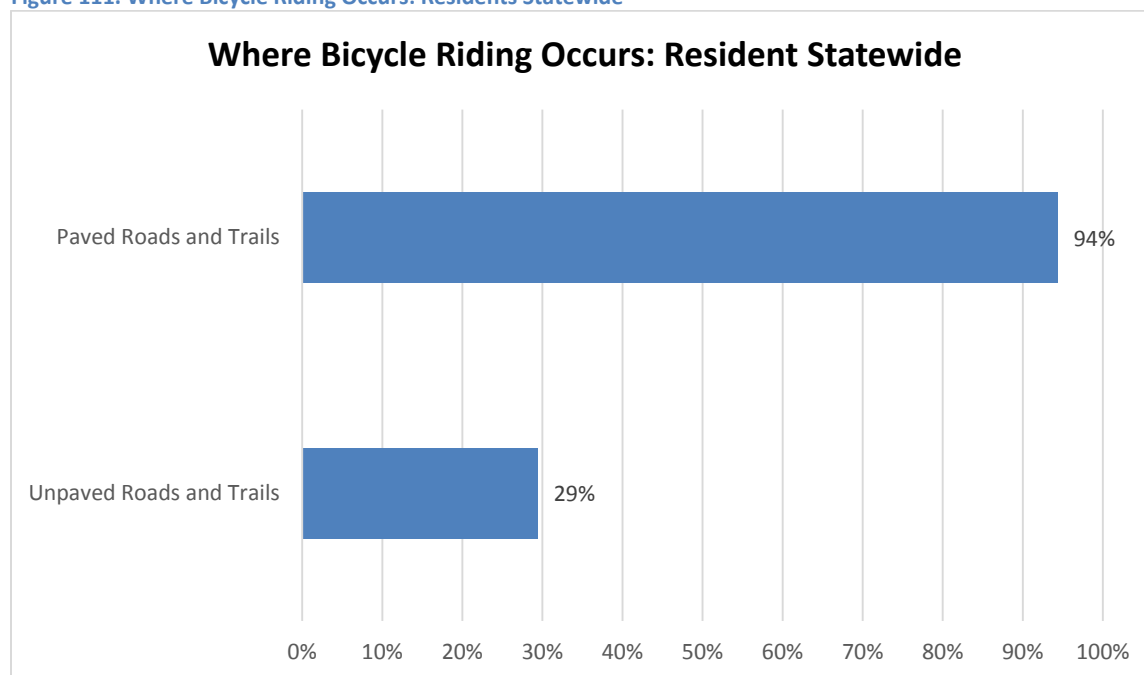


Figure 112. Where Bicycle Riding Occurs: Visitors Statewide

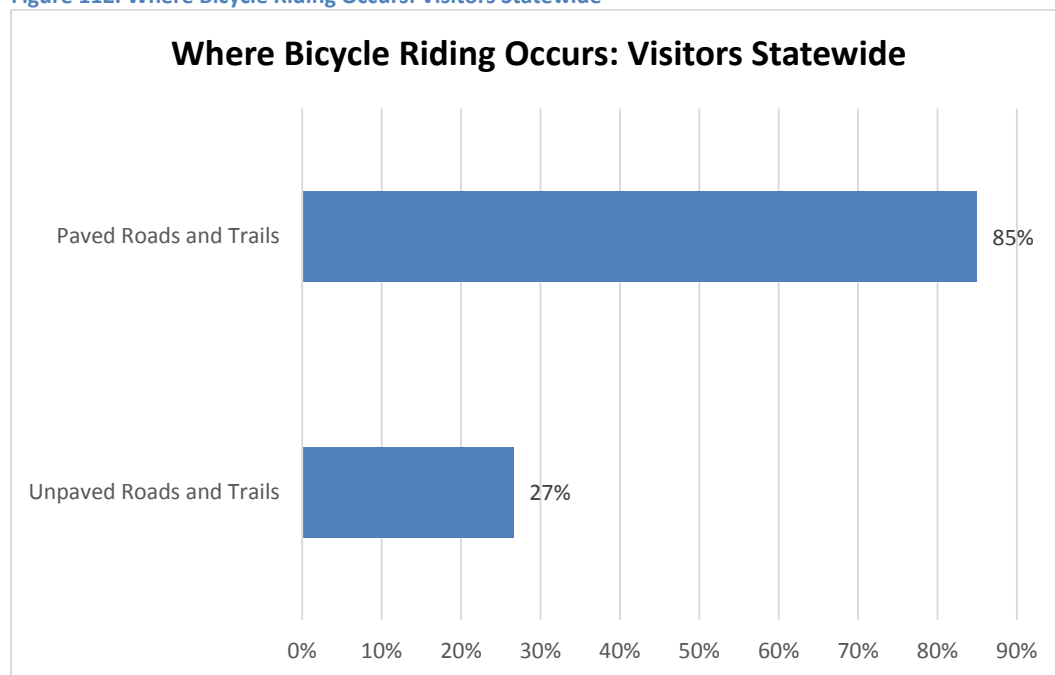


Figure 113. Where Bicycle Riding Occurs by SCORP Region: Residents

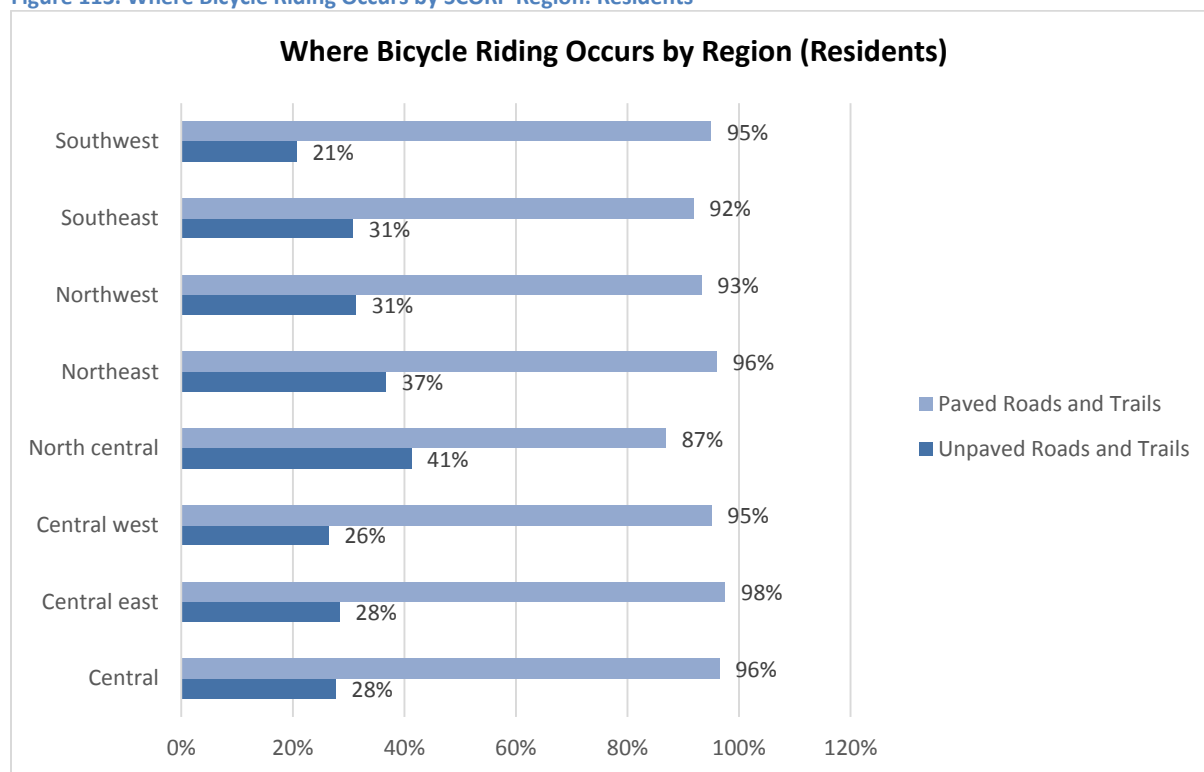
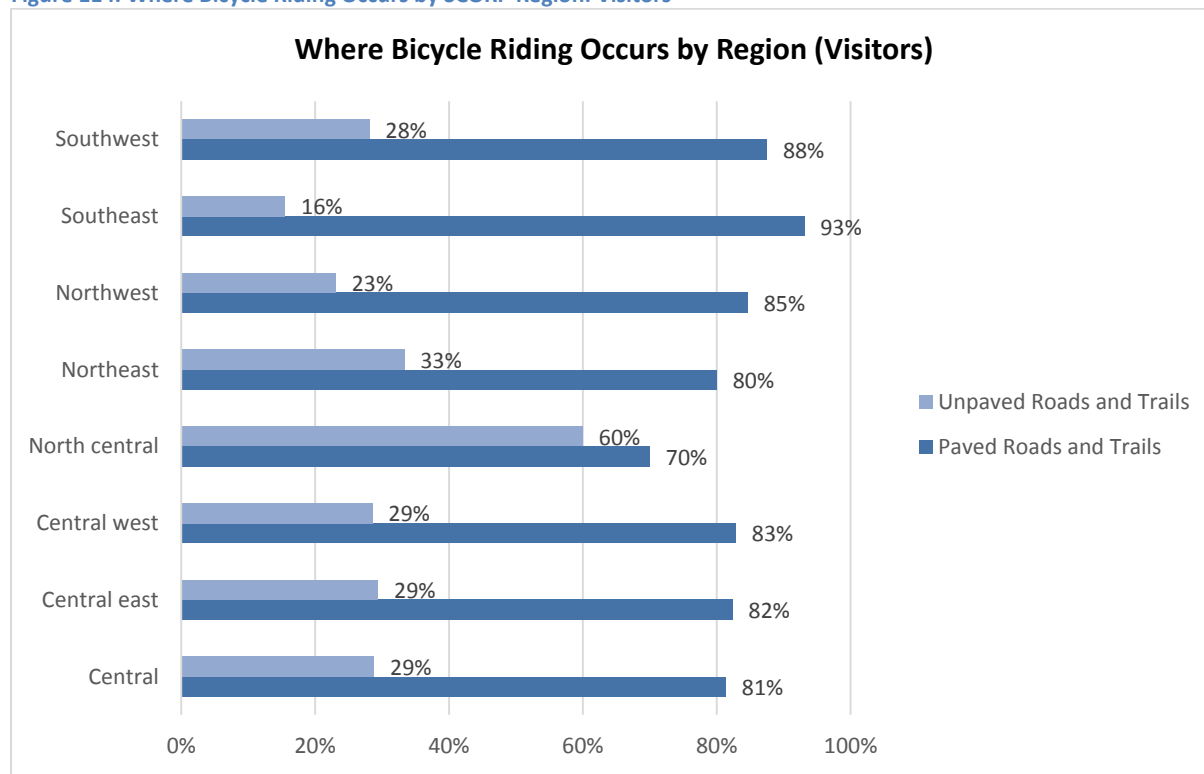


Figure 114. Where Bicycle Riding Occurs by SCORP Region: Visitors

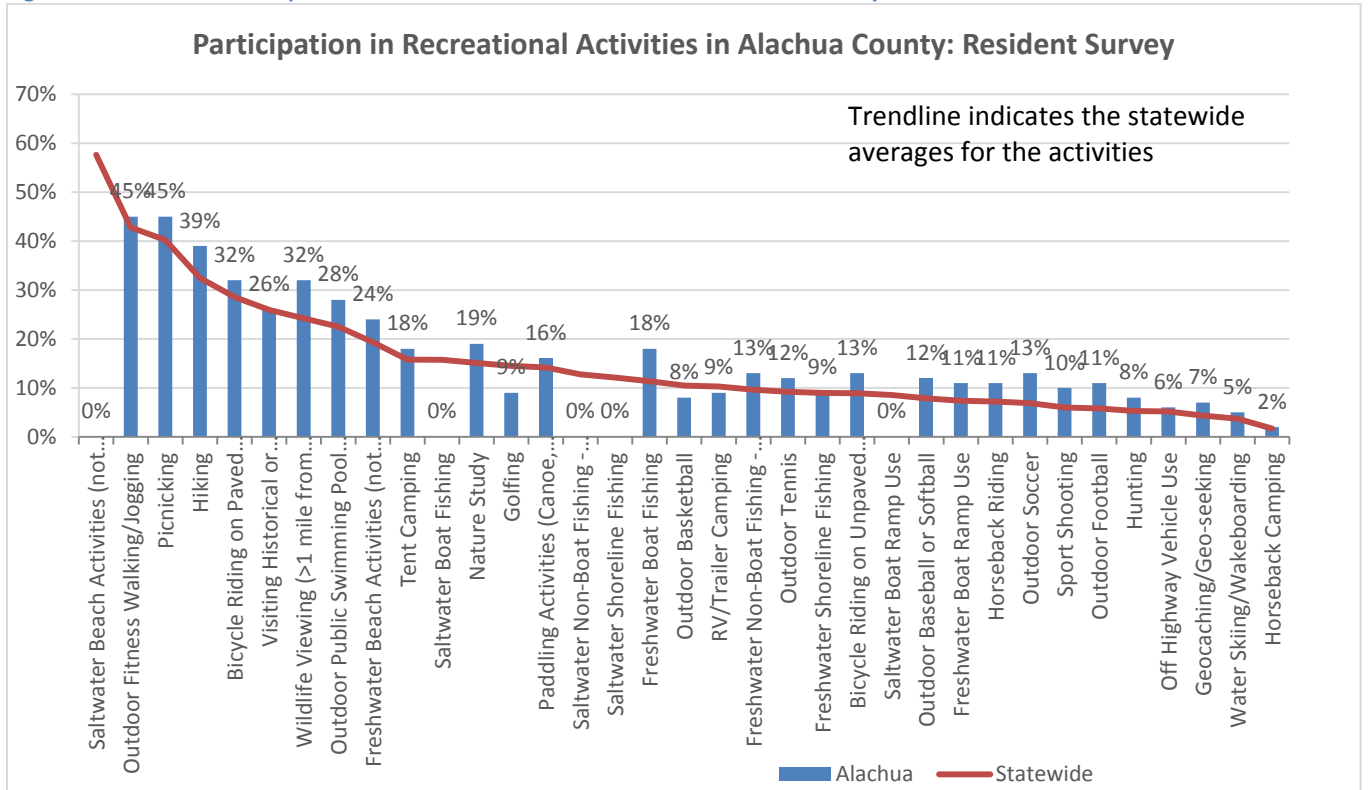


Figure 116. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Baker County

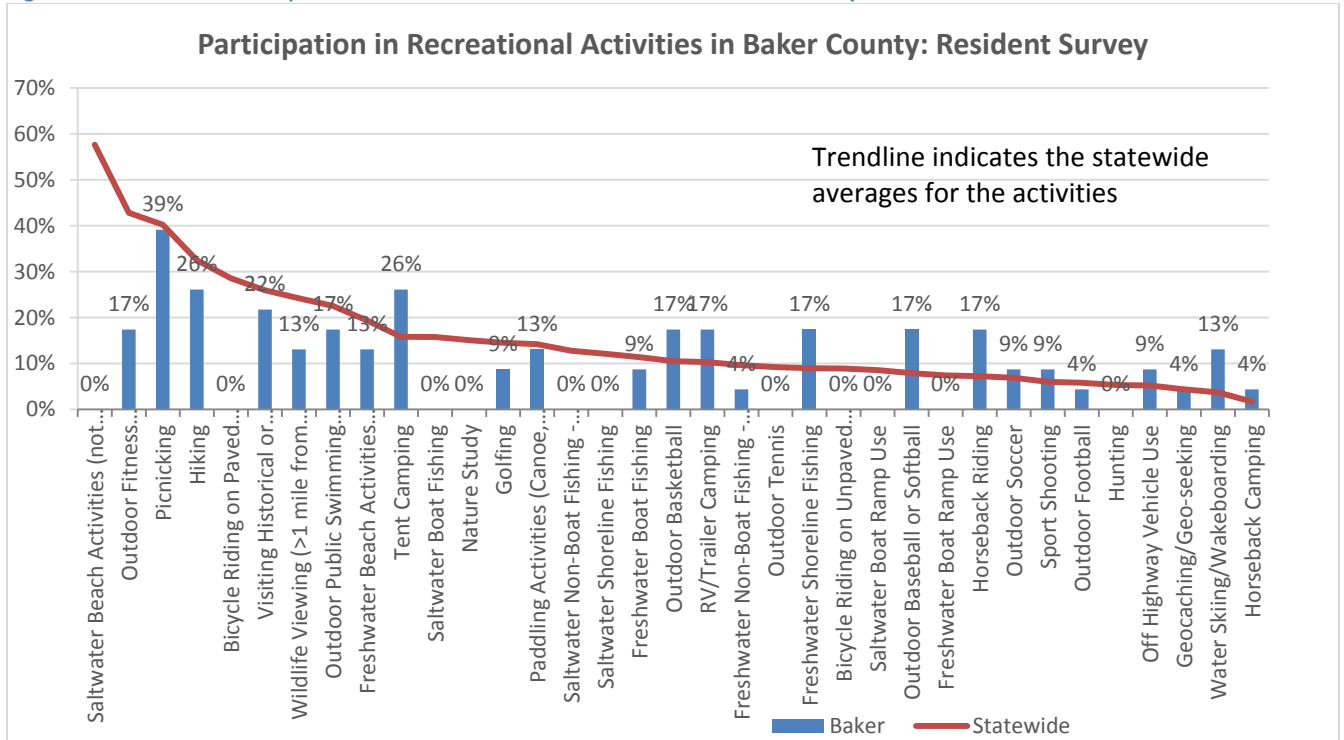


Figure 117. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Bay County

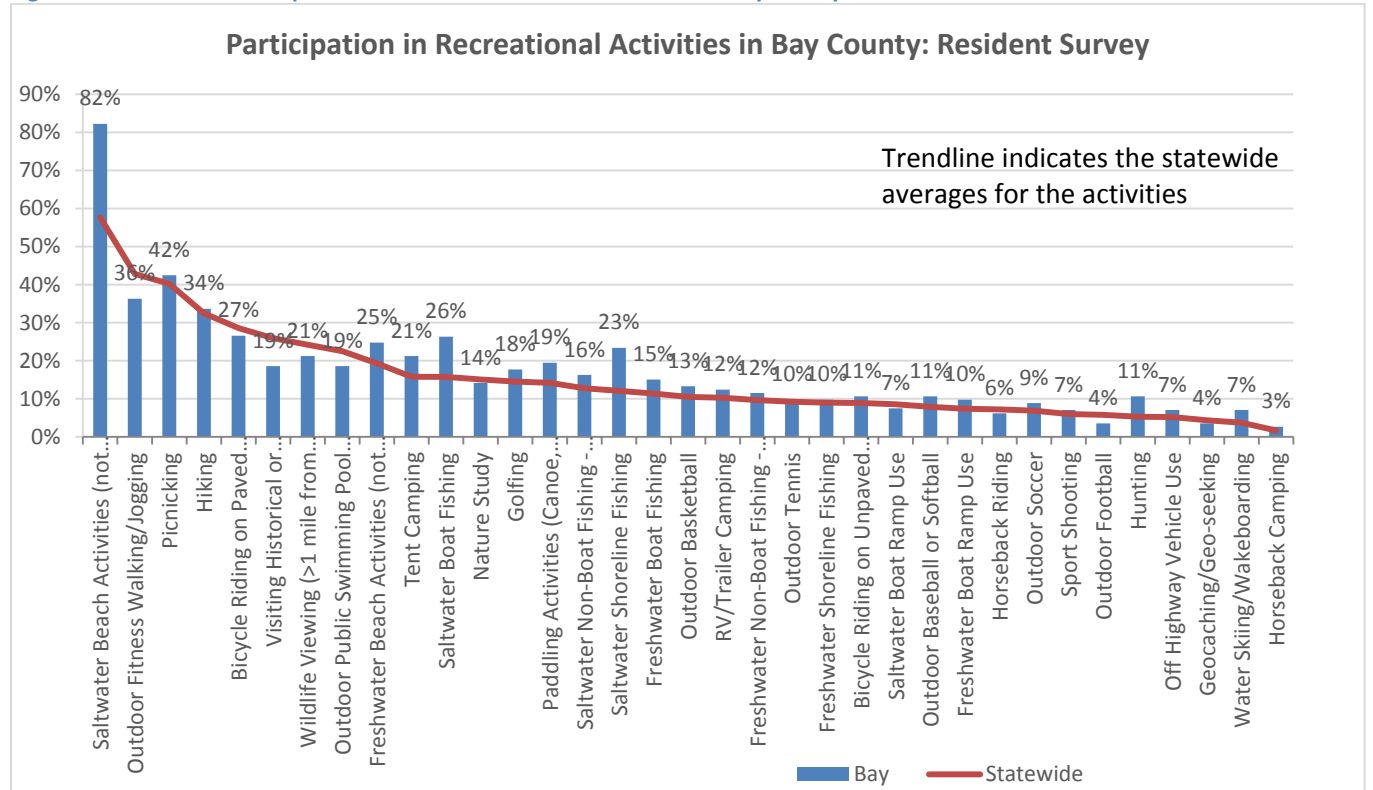


Figure 118. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Bradford County

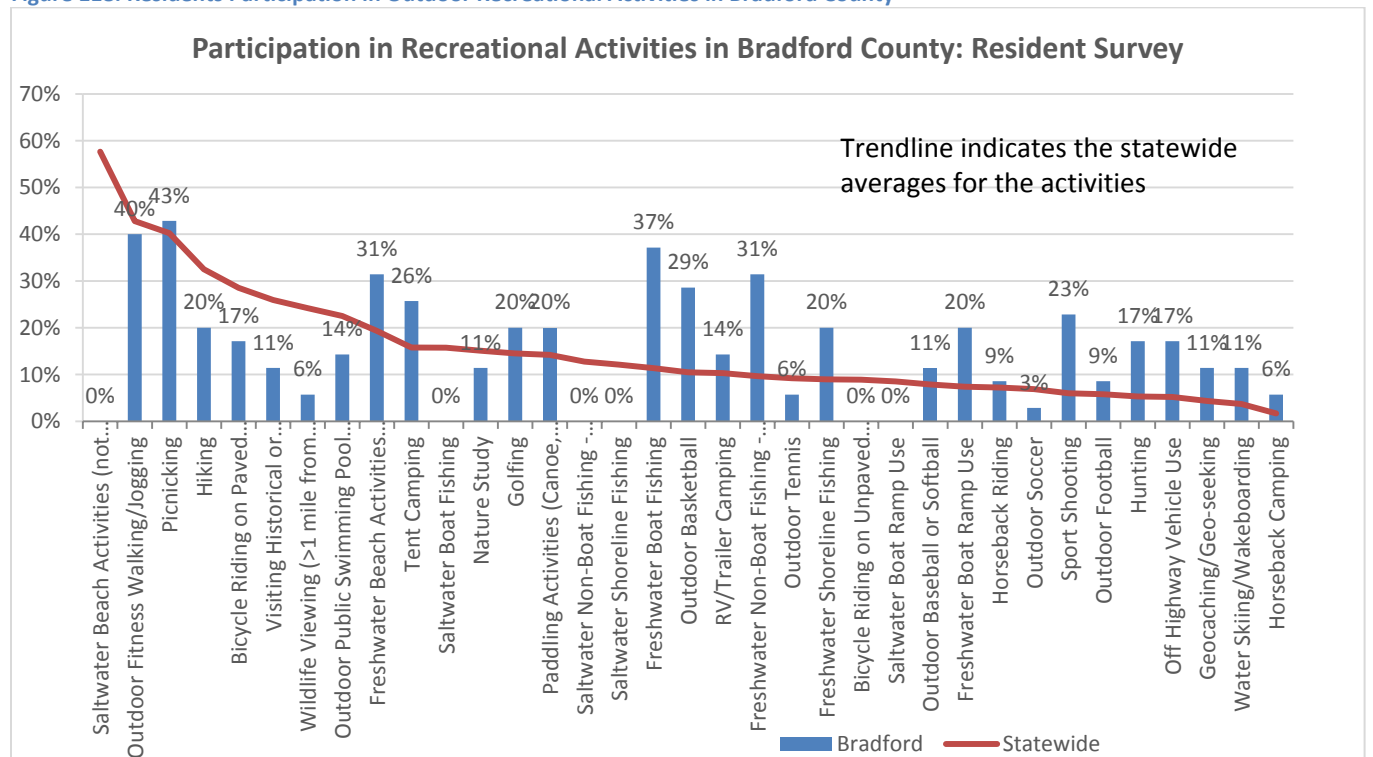


Figure 119. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Brevard County

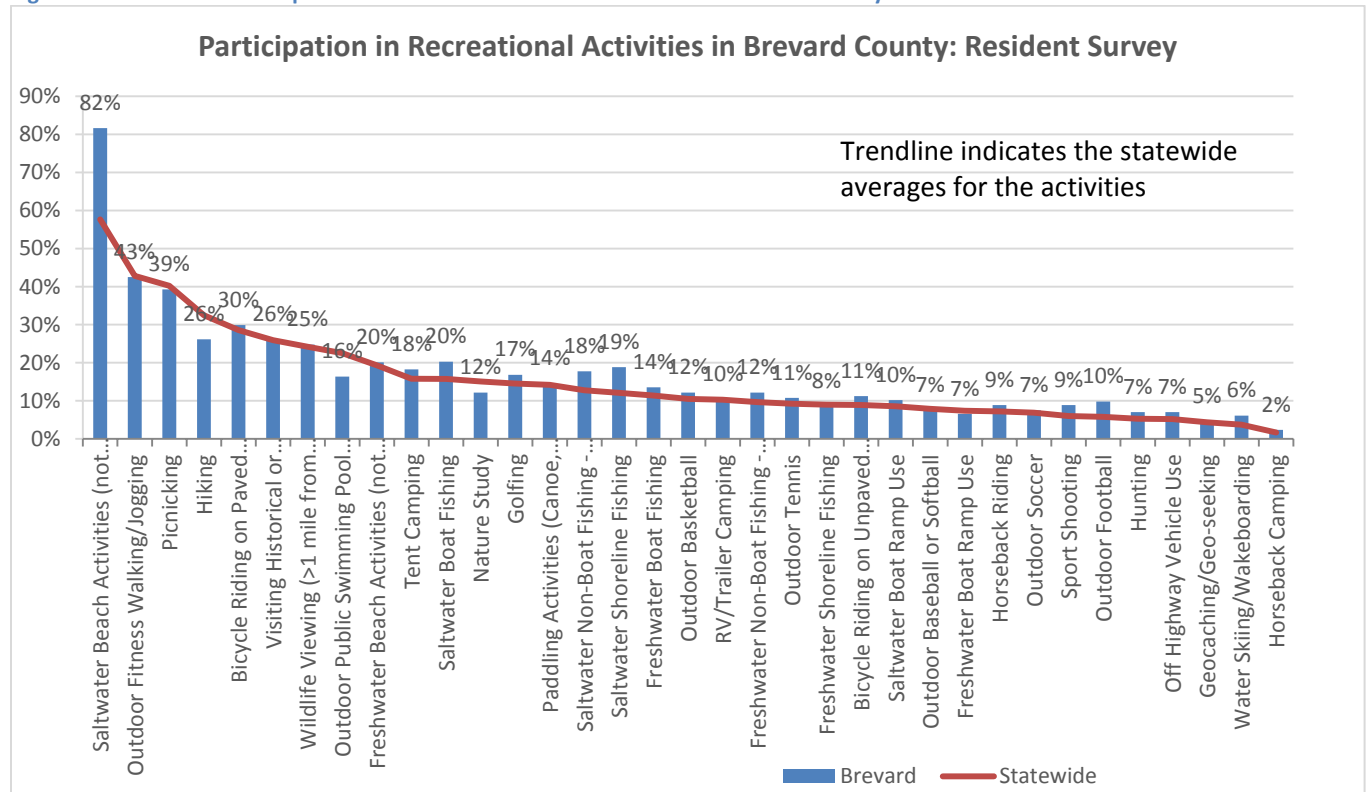


Figure 120. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Broward County

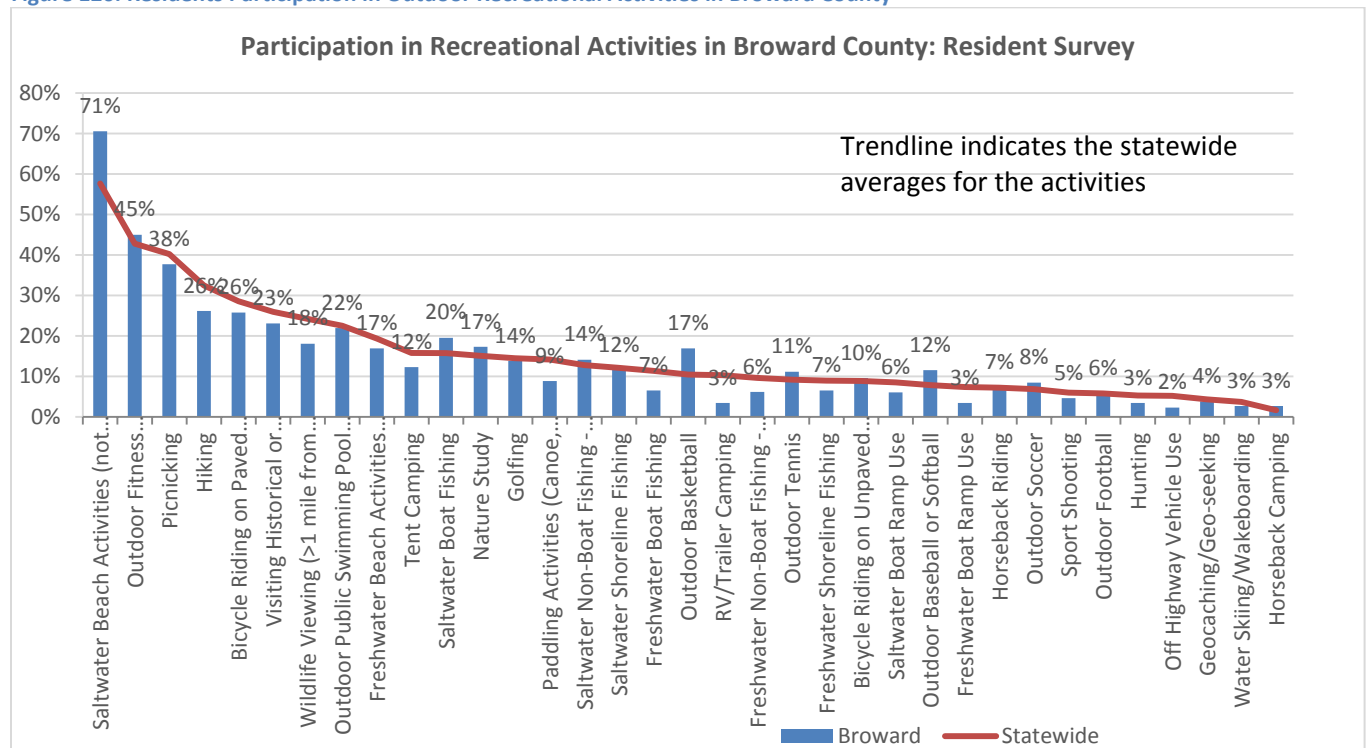


Figure 121. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Calhoun County

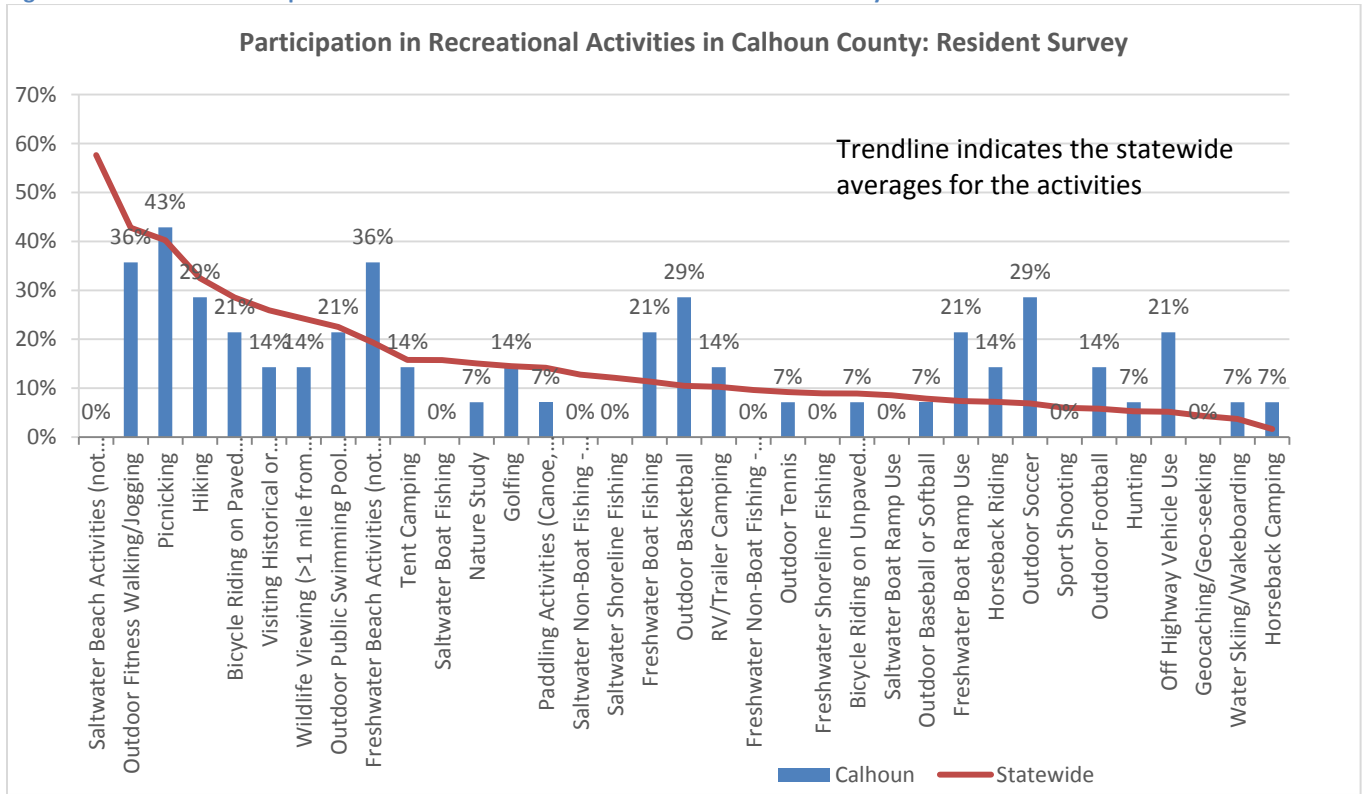


Figure 122. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Charlotte County

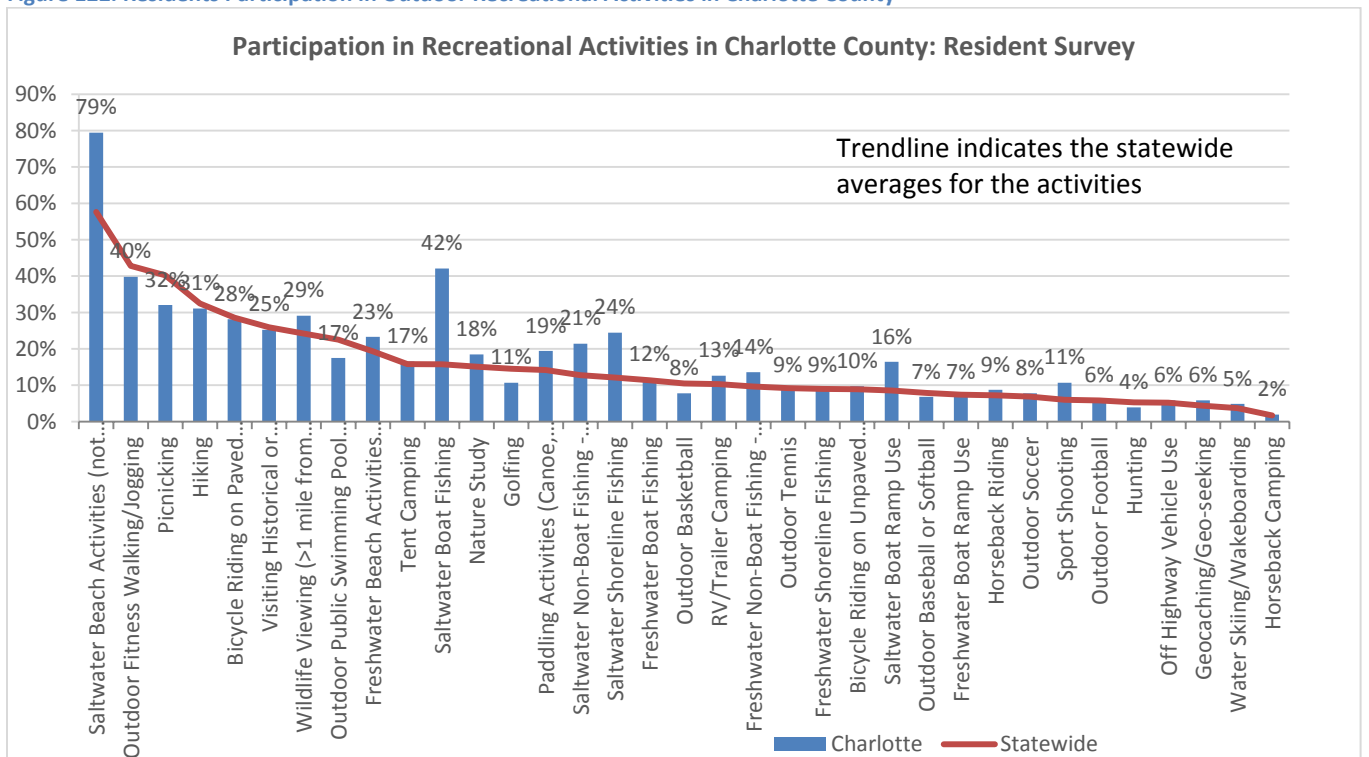


Figure 123. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Citrus County

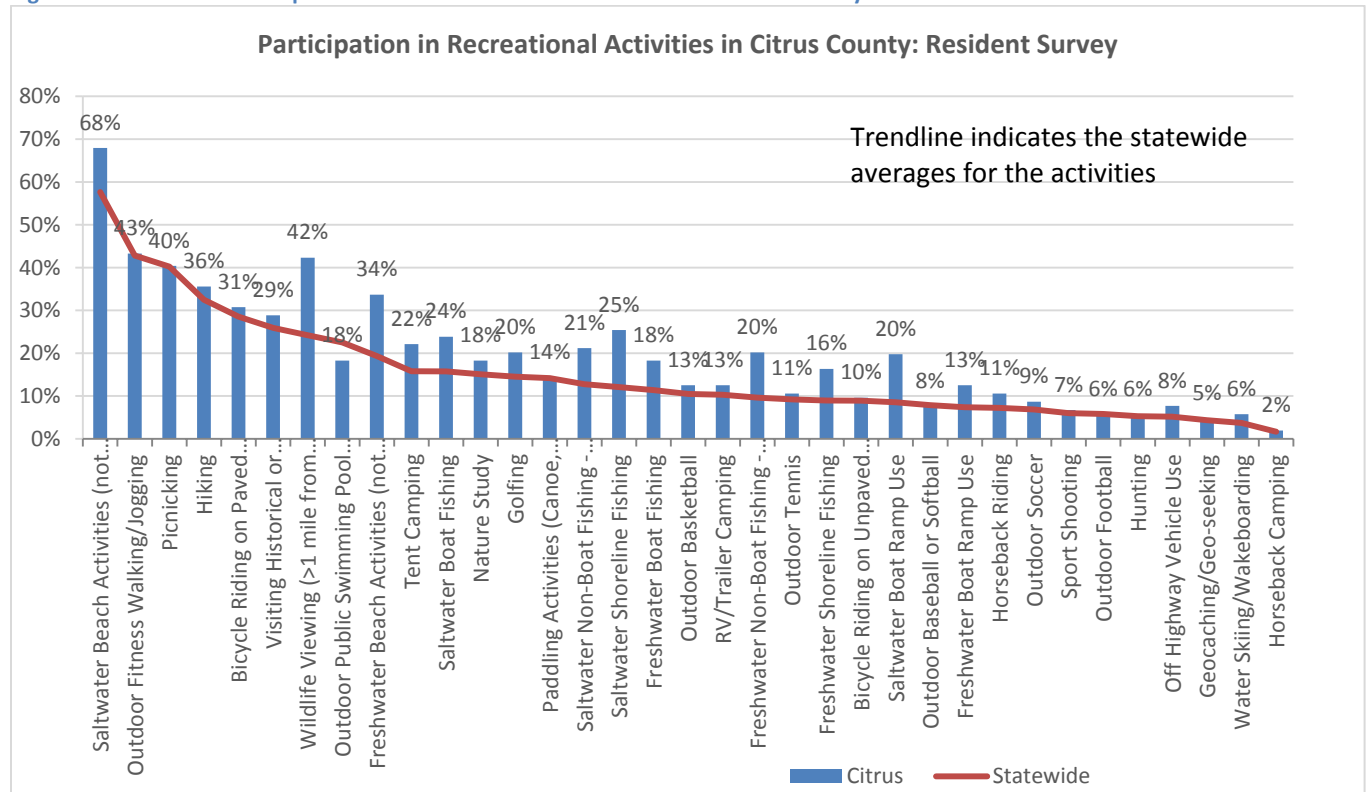


Figure 124. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Clay County

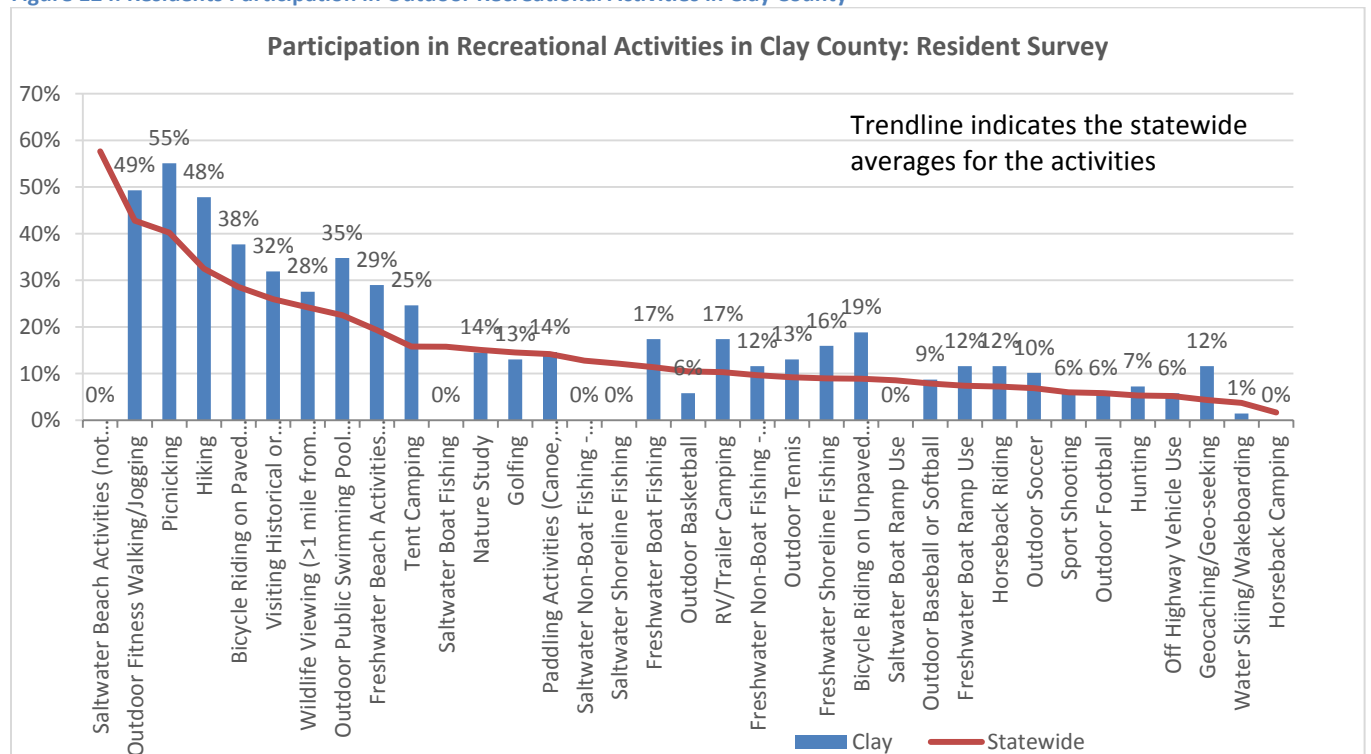


Figure 125. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Collier County

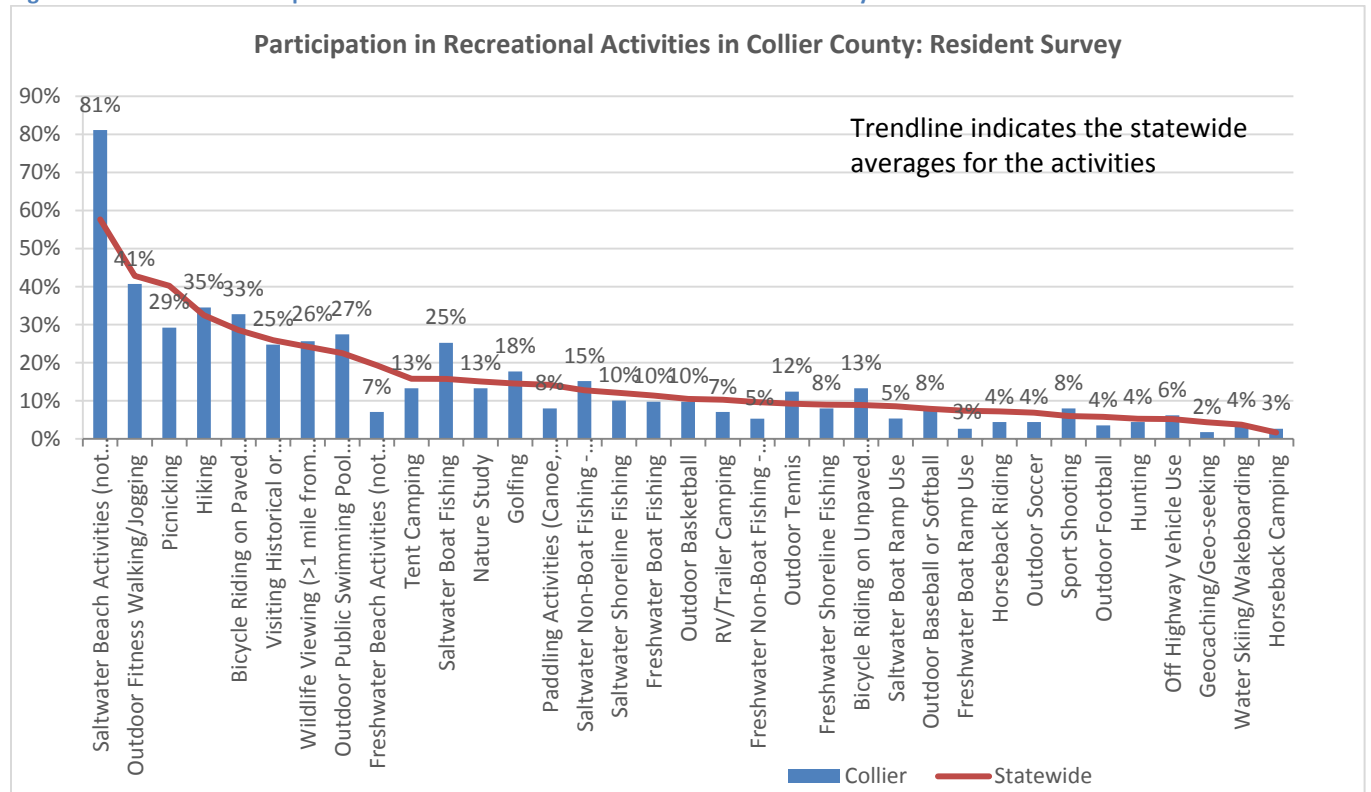


Figure 126. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Columbia County

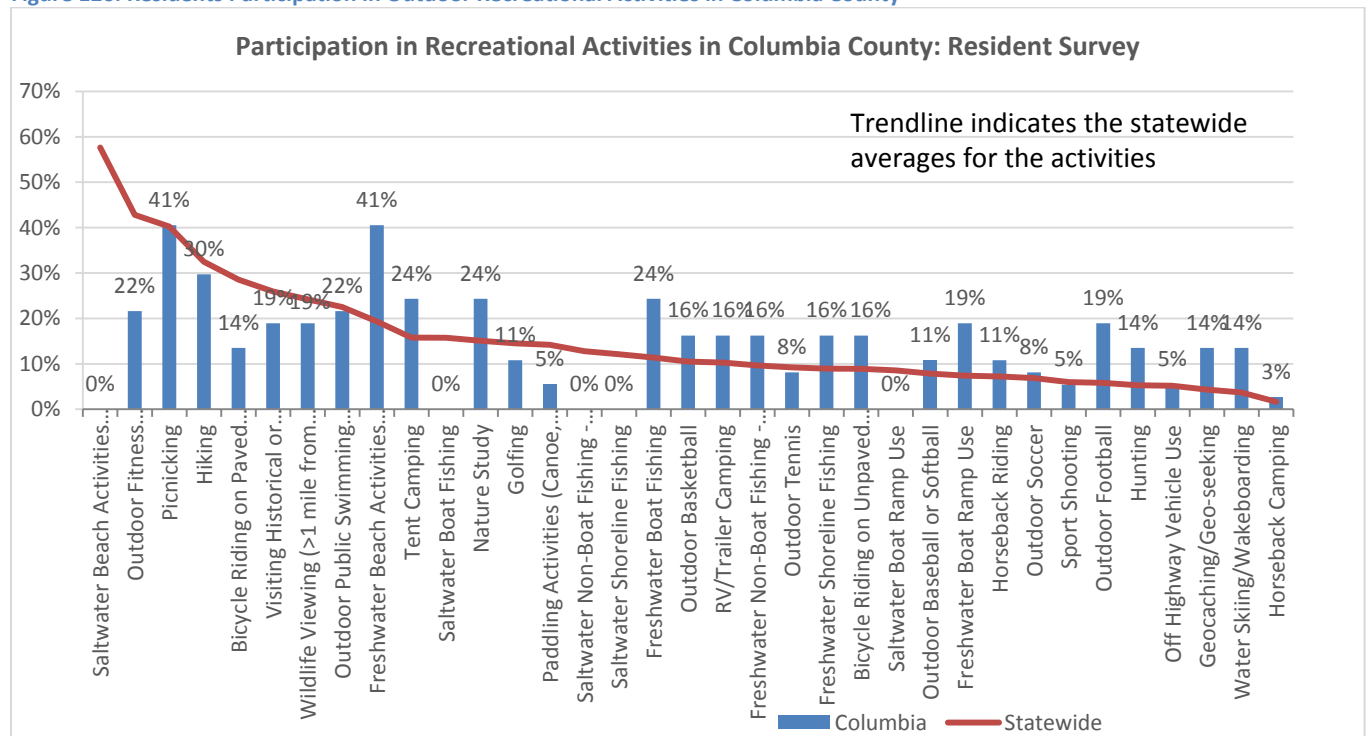


Figure 127. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in DeSoto County

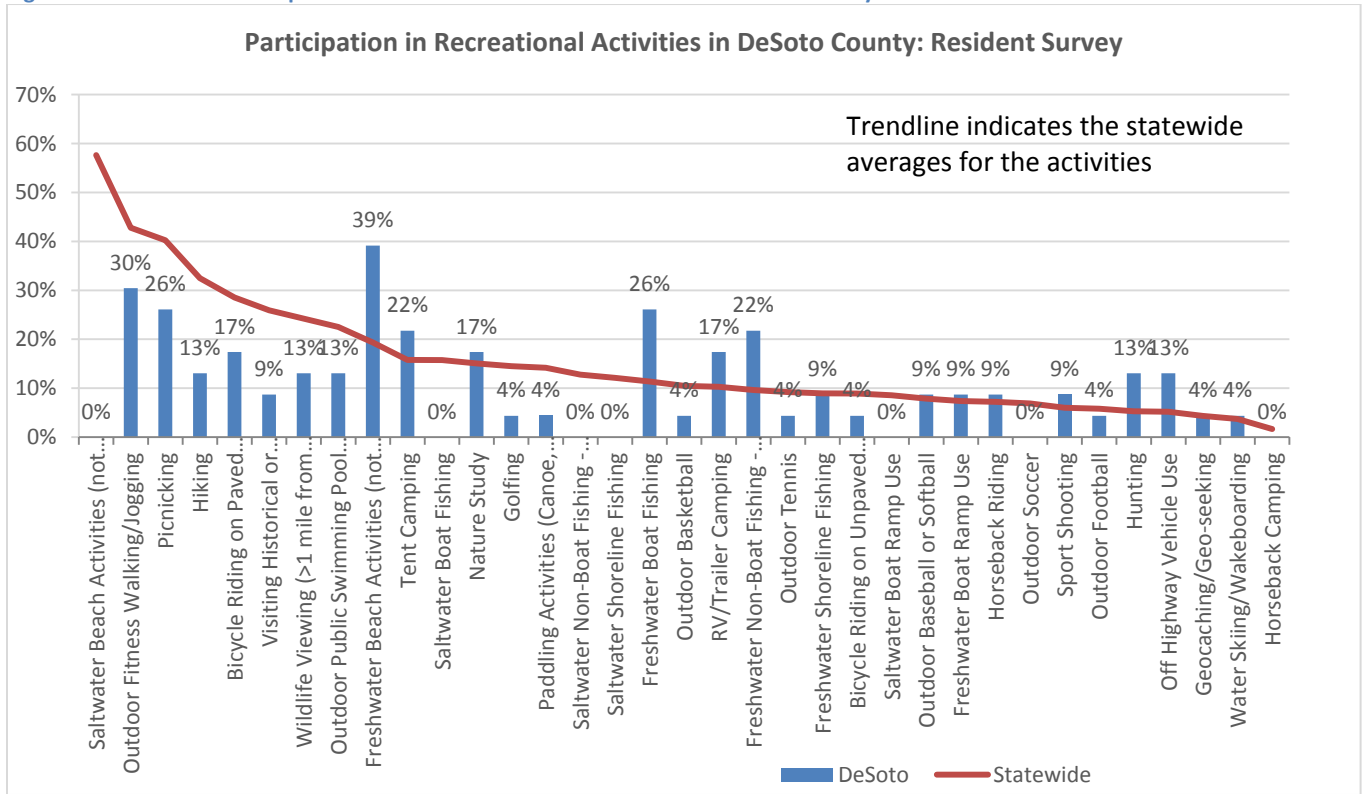


Figure 128. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Dixie County

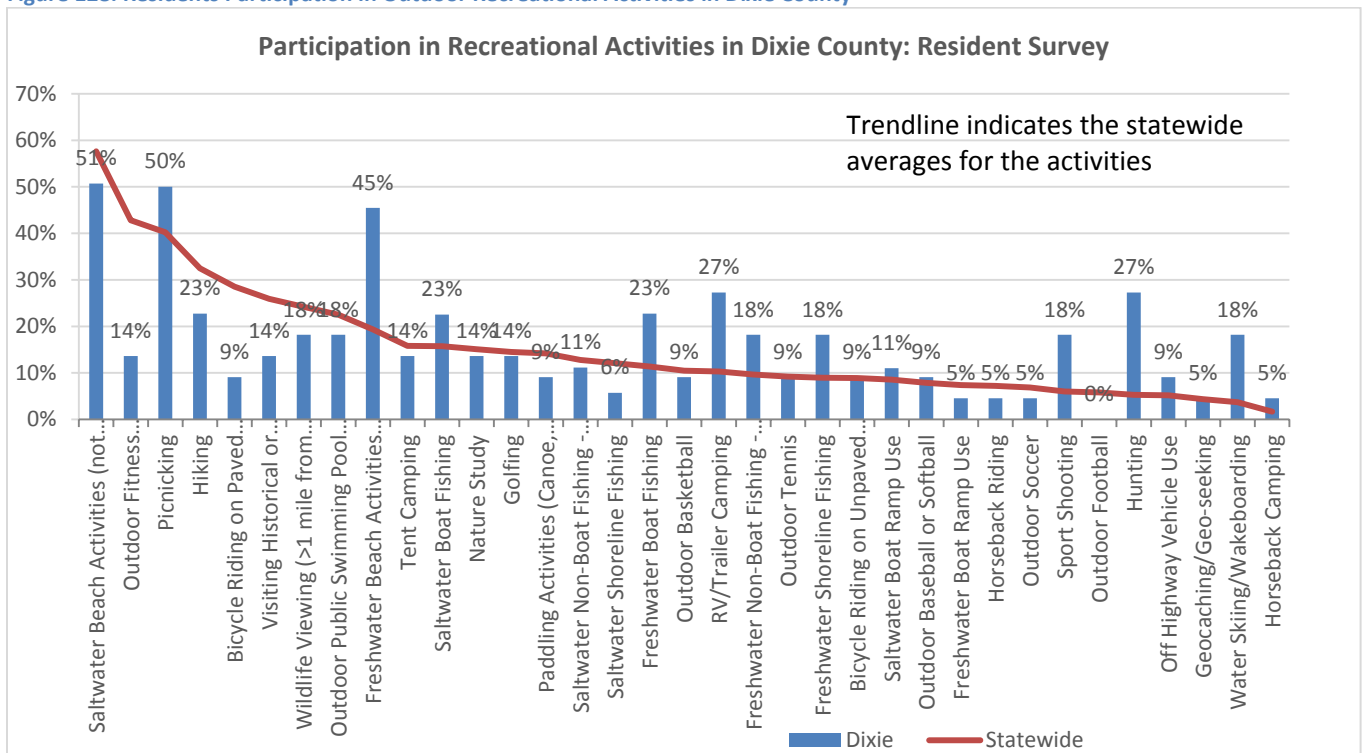


Figure 129. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Duval County

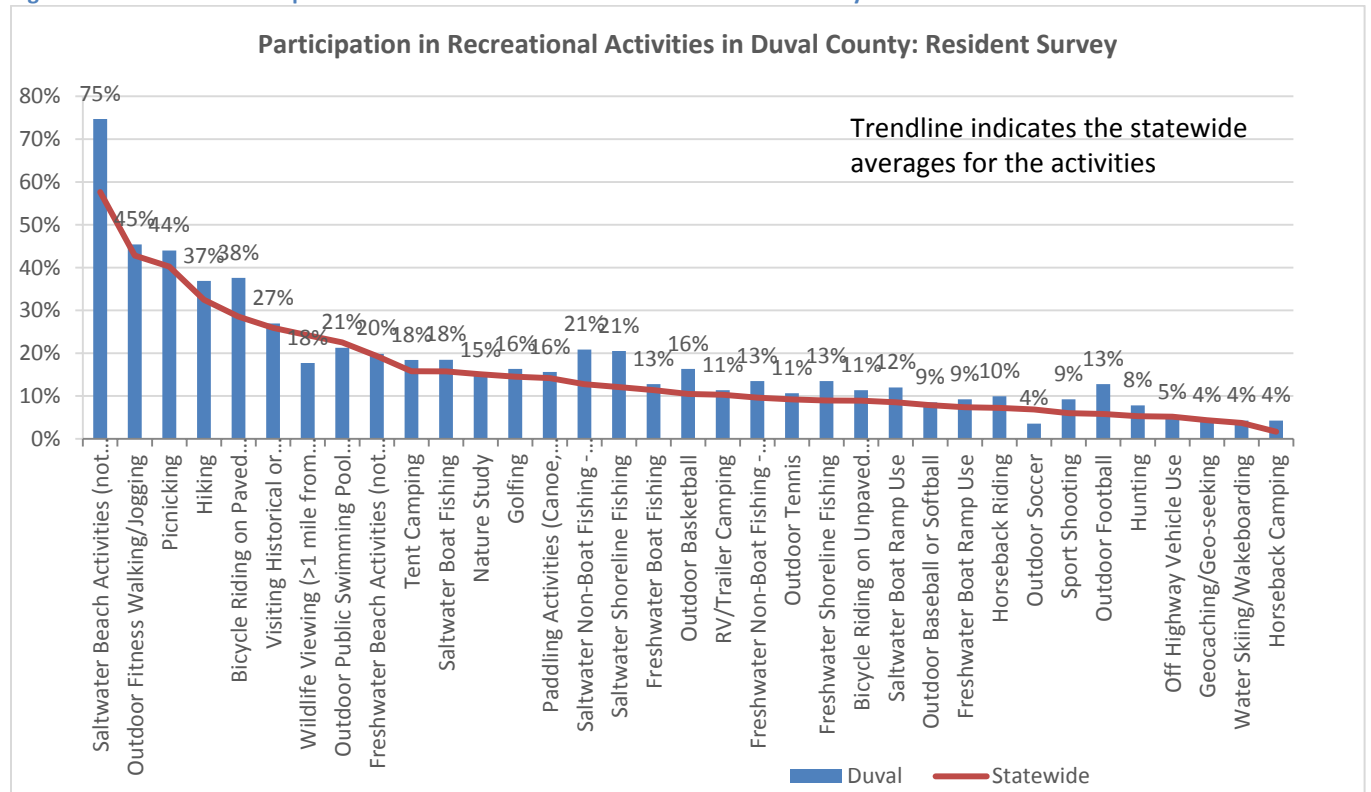


Figure 130. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Escambia County

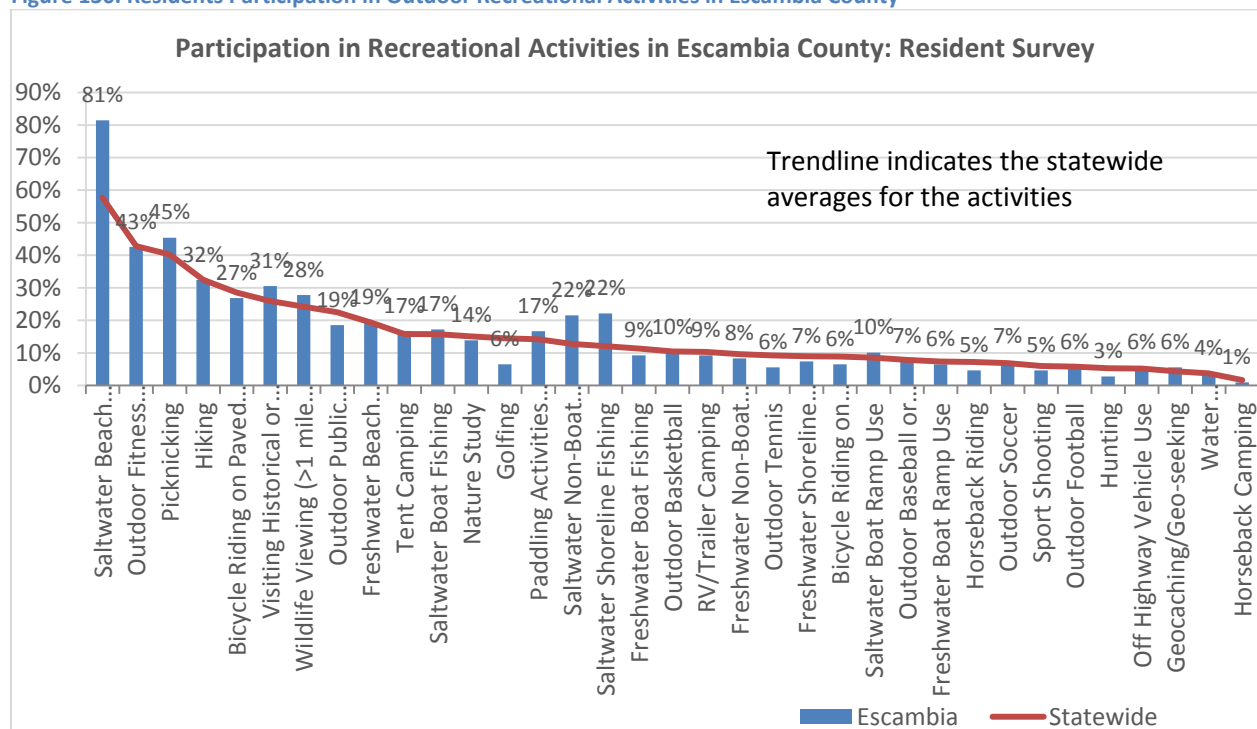


Figure 131. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Flagler County

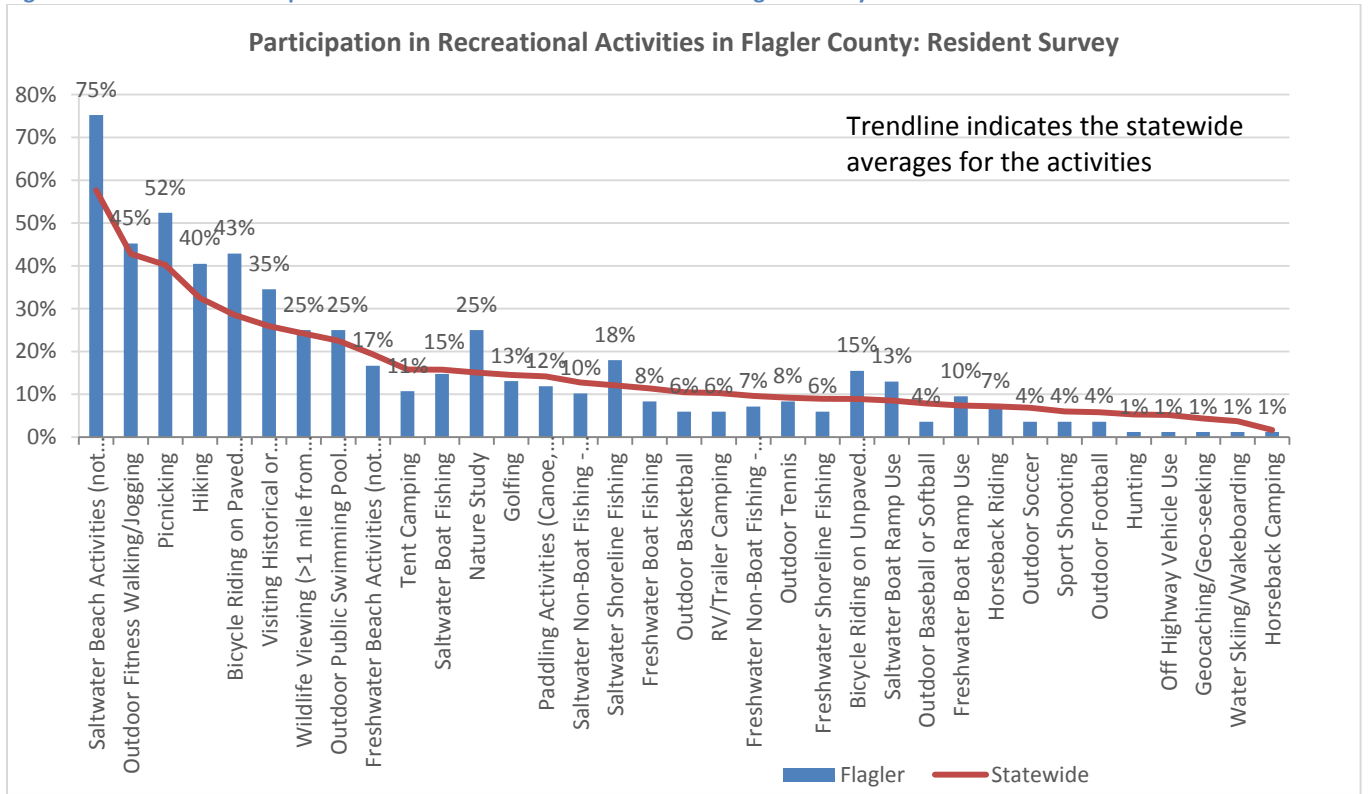


Figure 132. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Franklin County

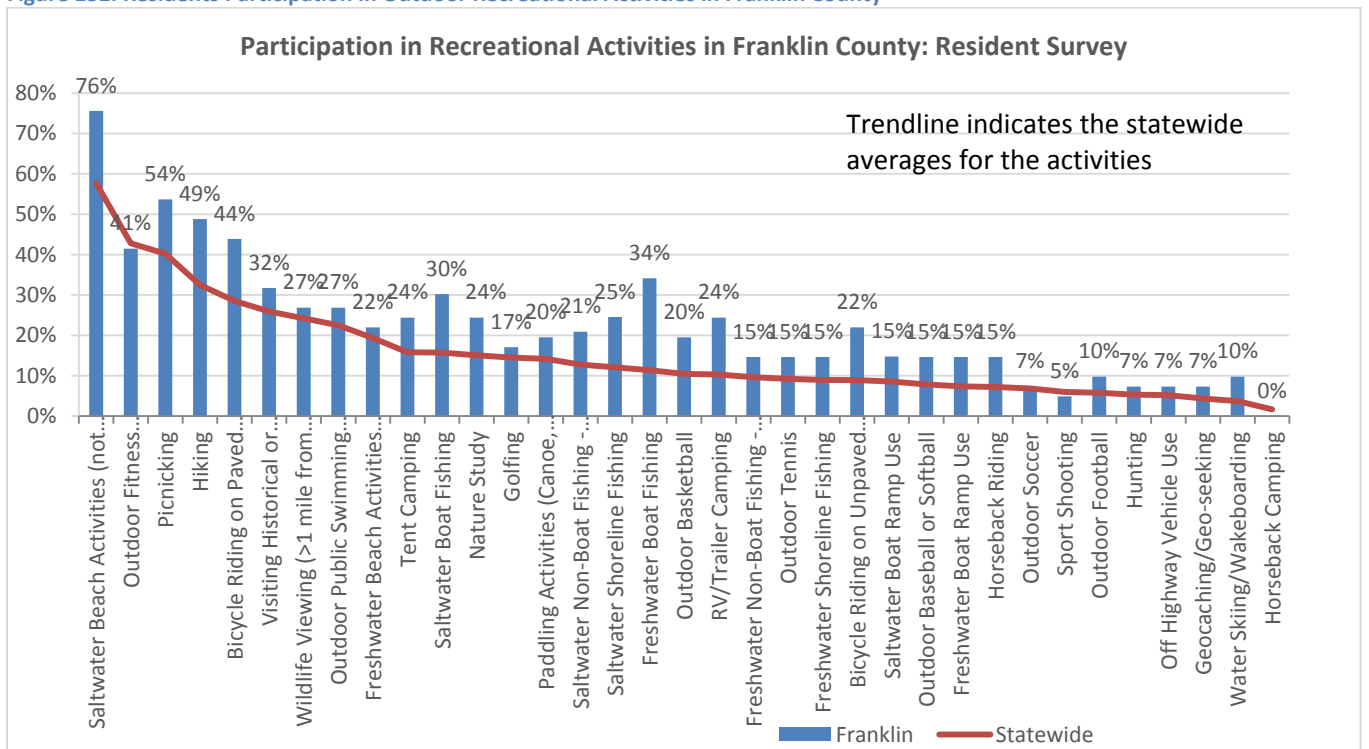


Figure 133. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Gadsden County

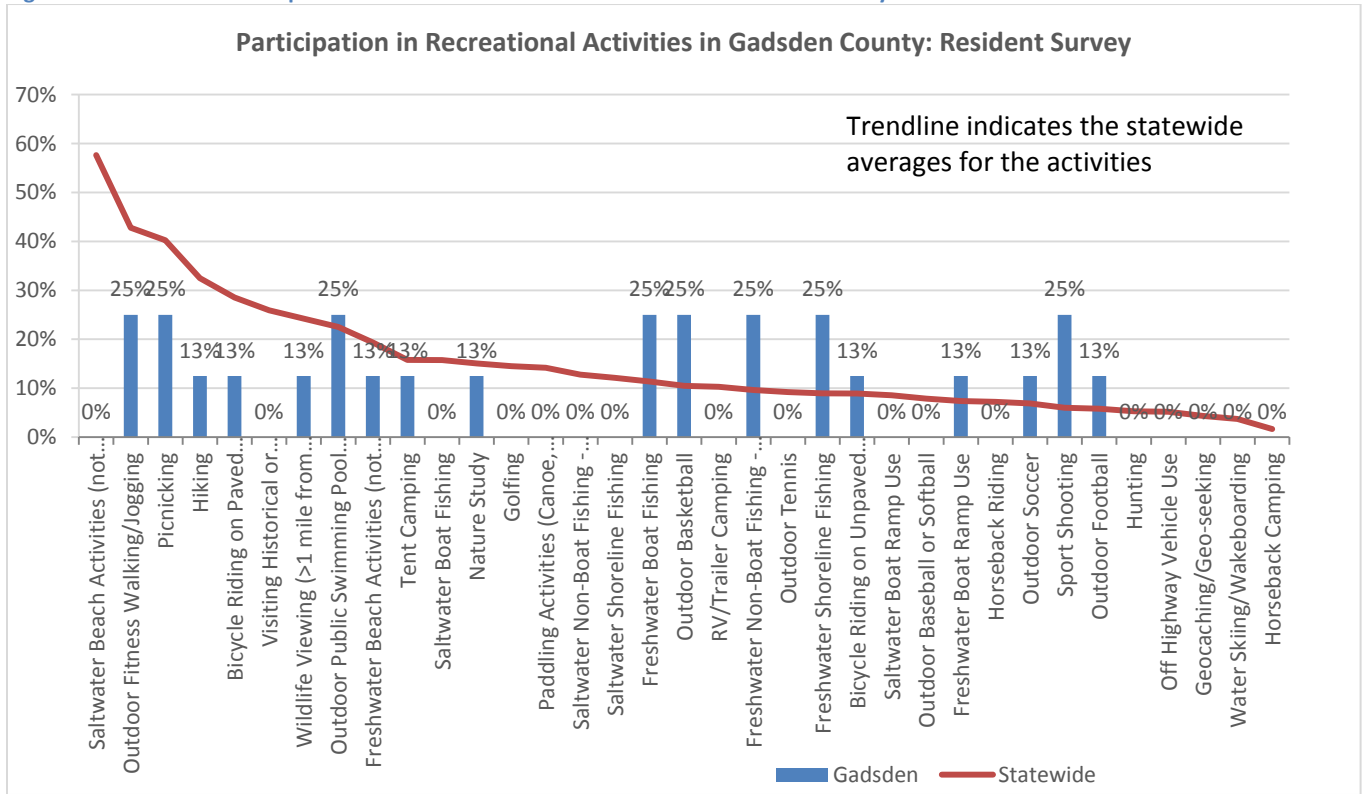


Figure 134. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Gilchrist County

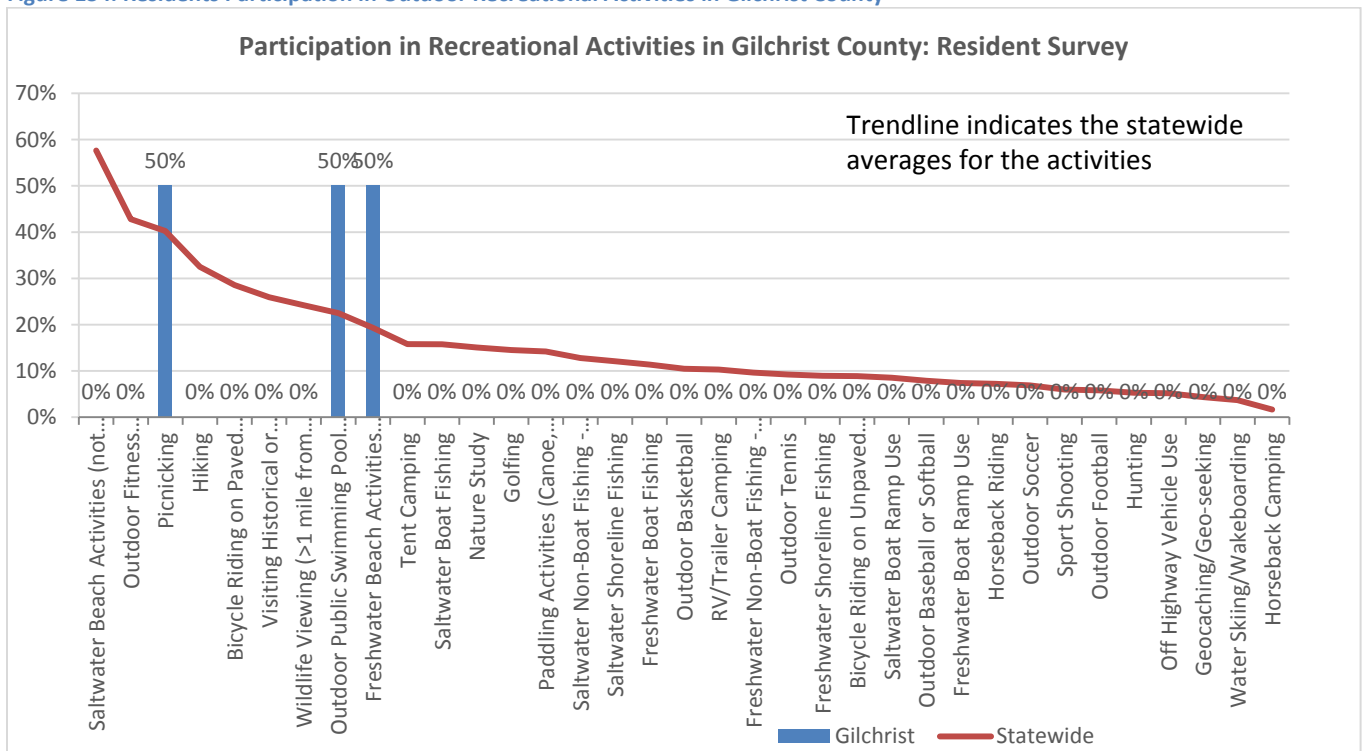


Figure 135. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Glades County

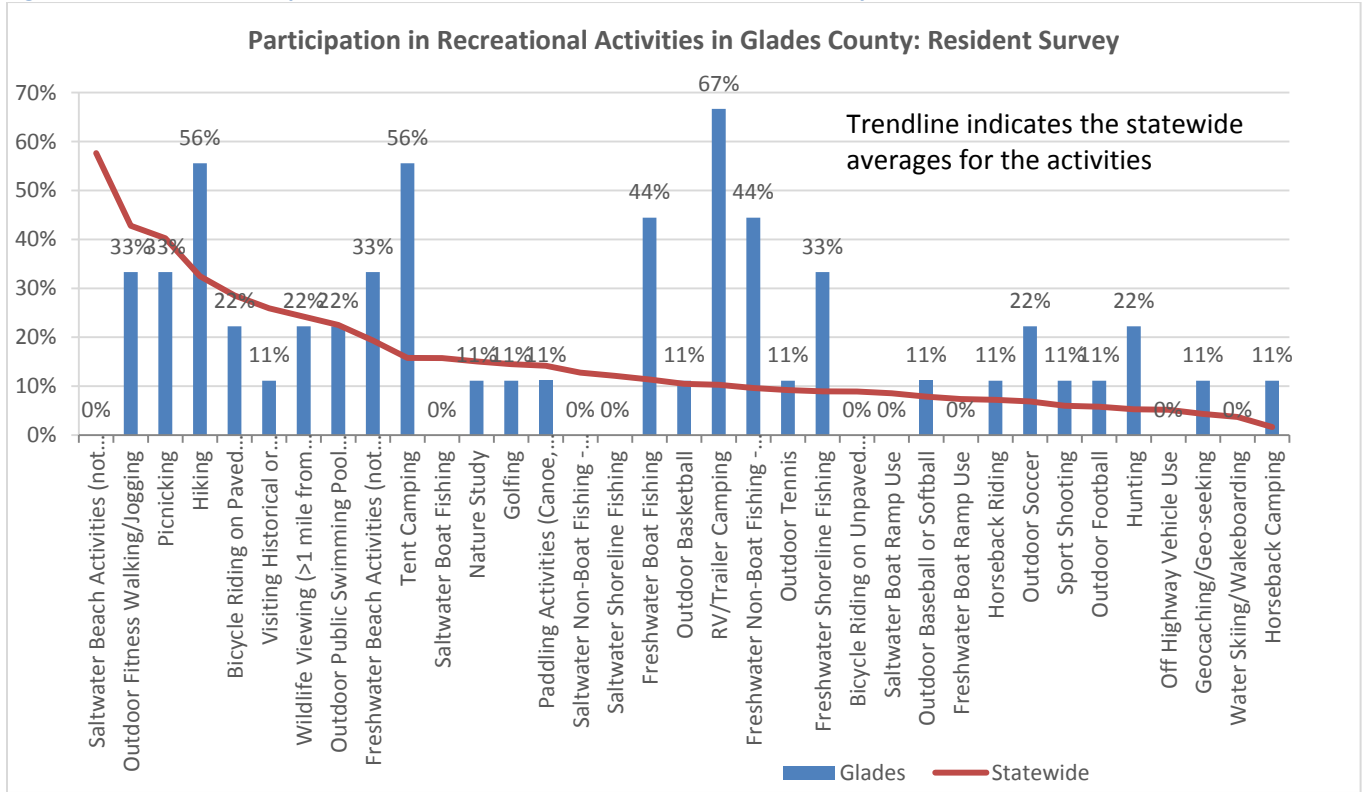


Figure 136. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Gulf County

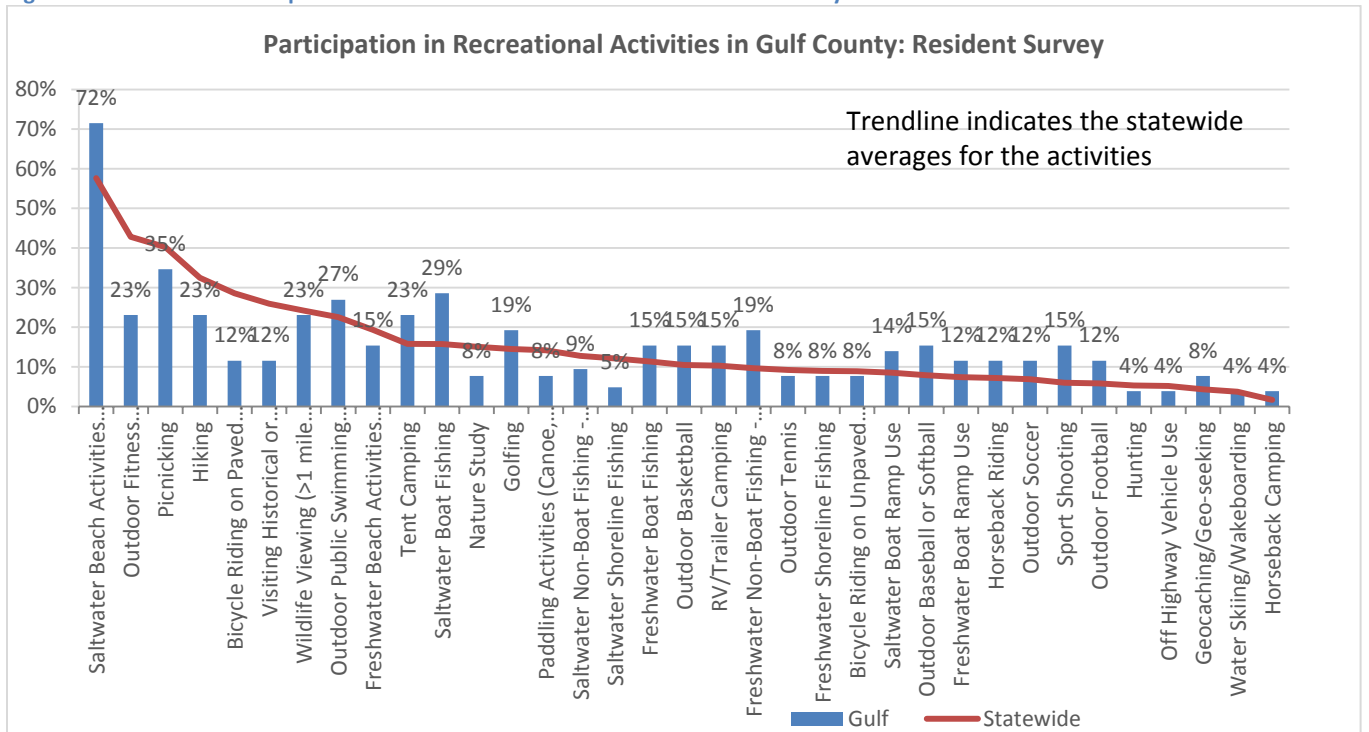


Figure 137. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Hamilton County

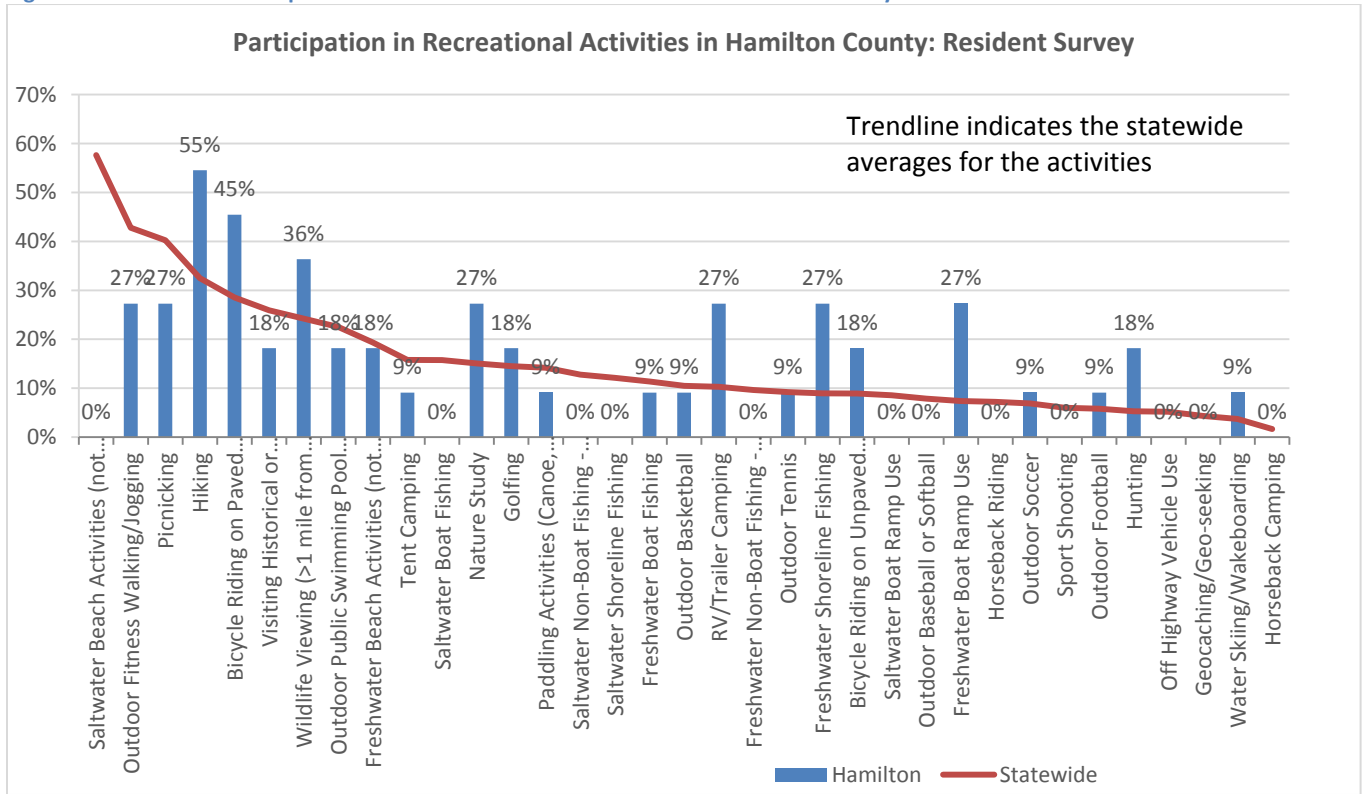


Figure 138. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Hardee County

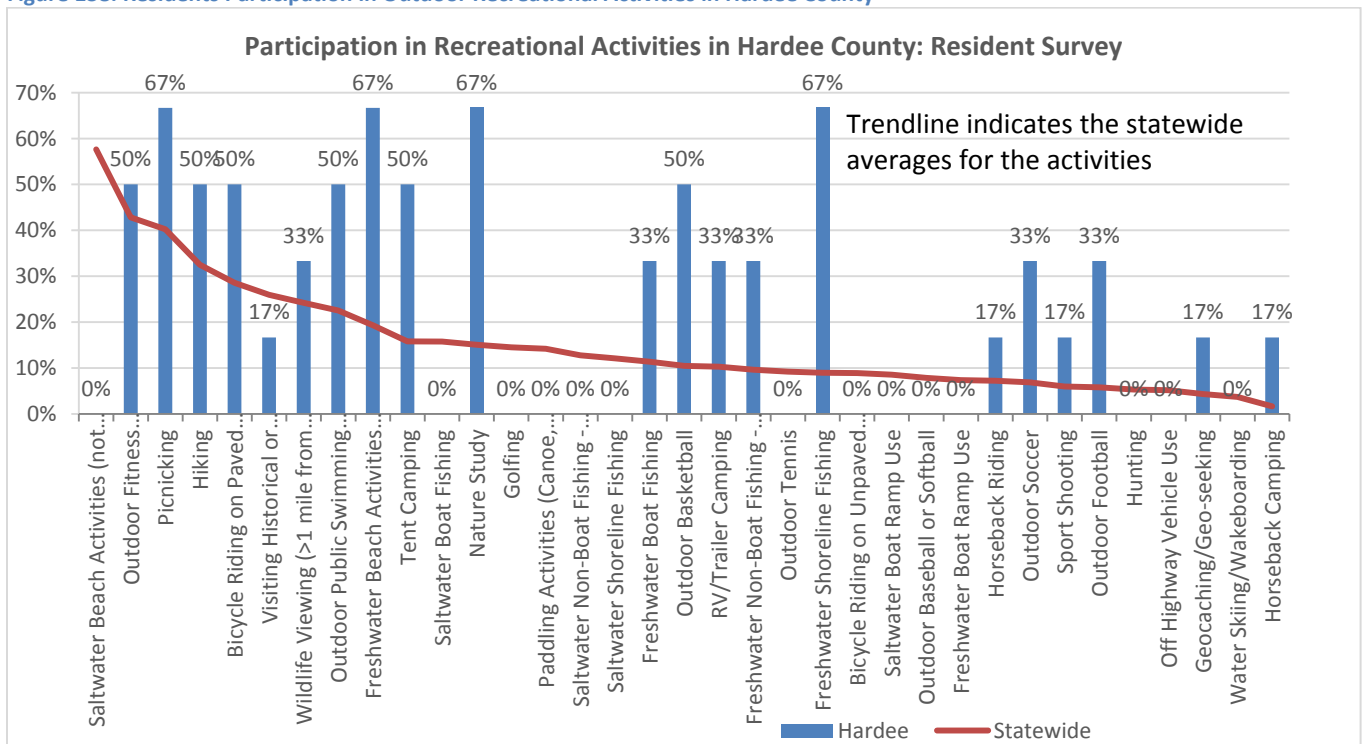


Figure 139. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Hendry County

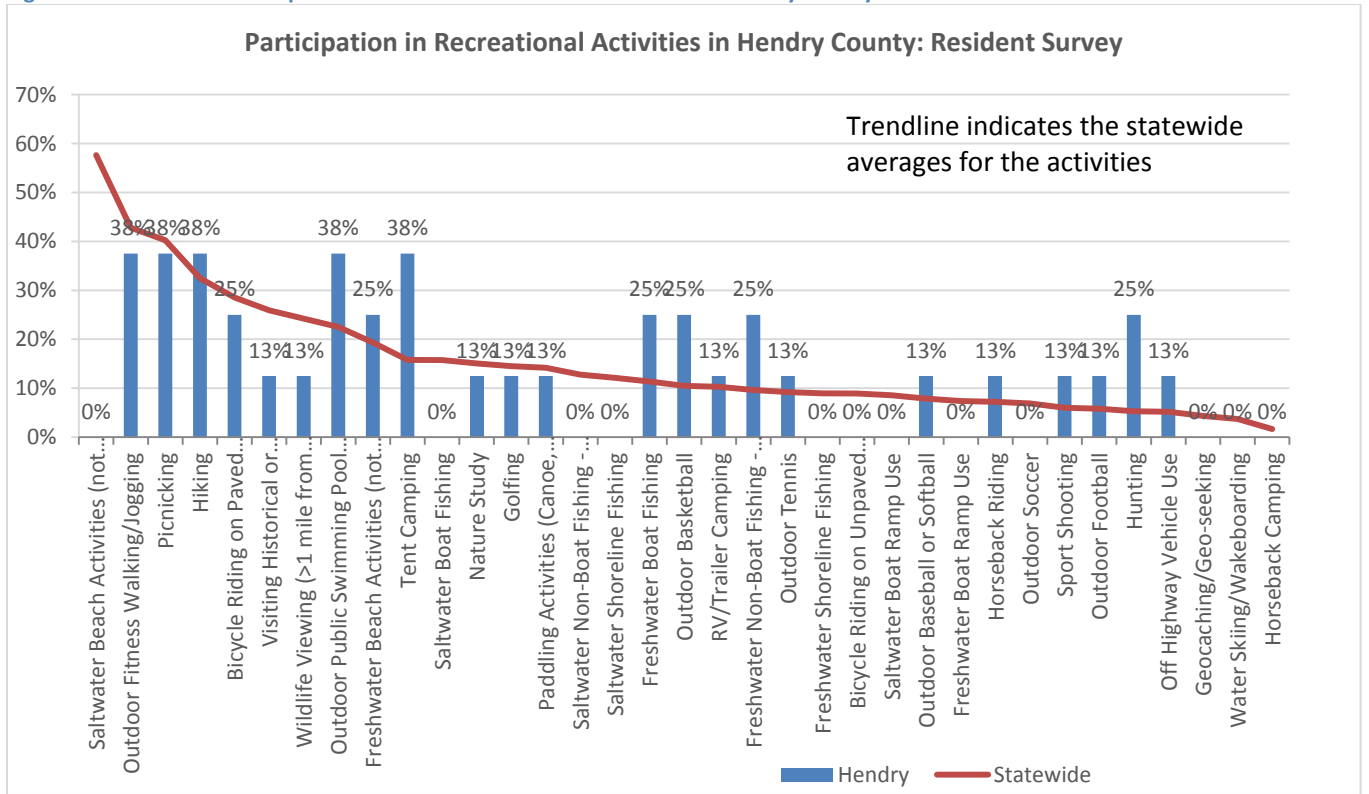


Figure 140. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Hernando County

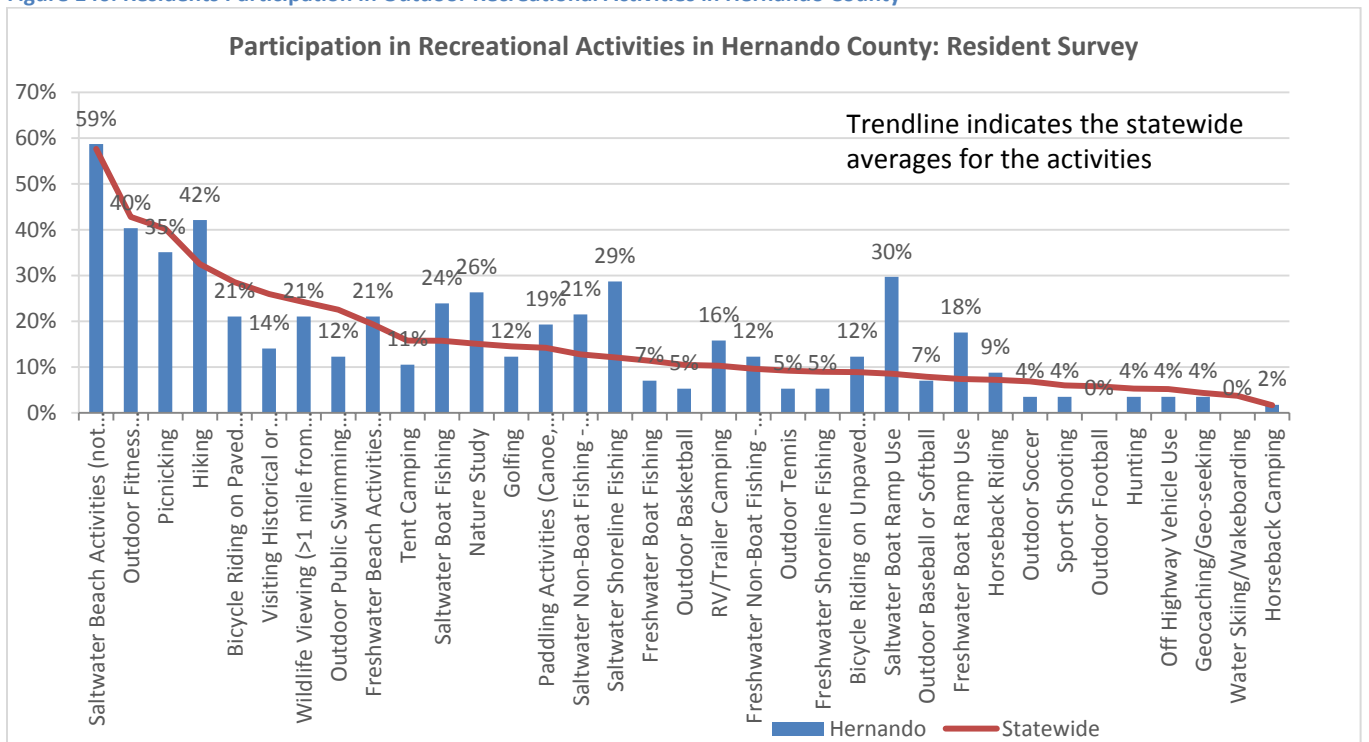


Figure 141. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Highlands County

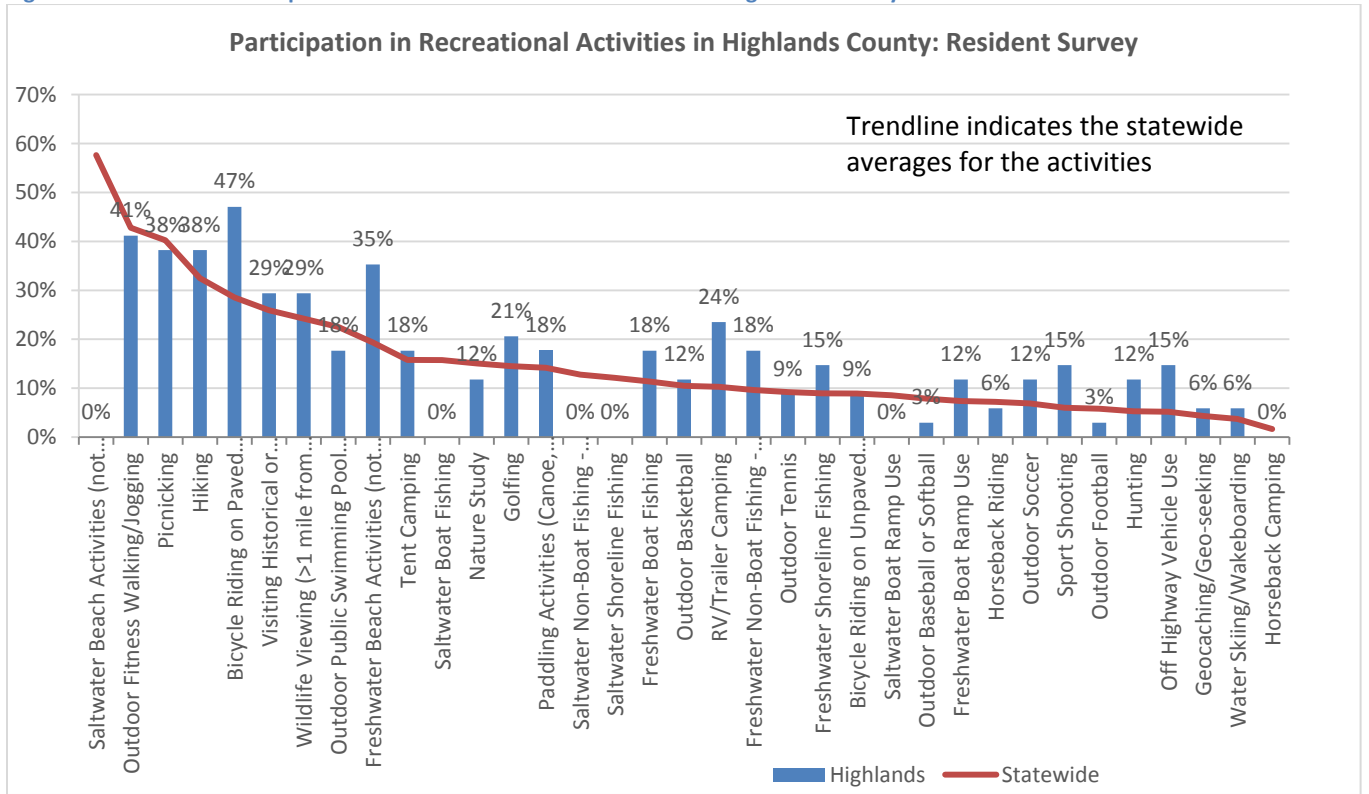


Figure 142. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Hillsborough County

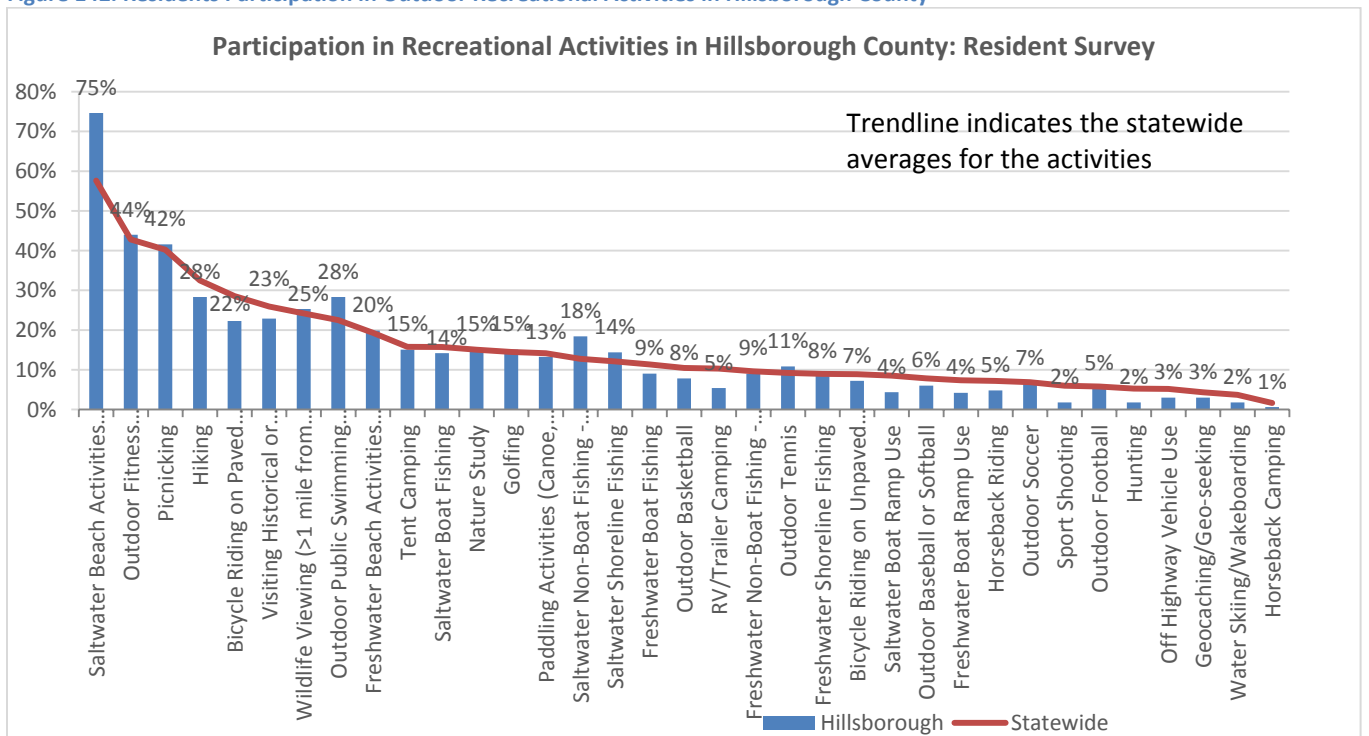


Figure 143. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Indian River County

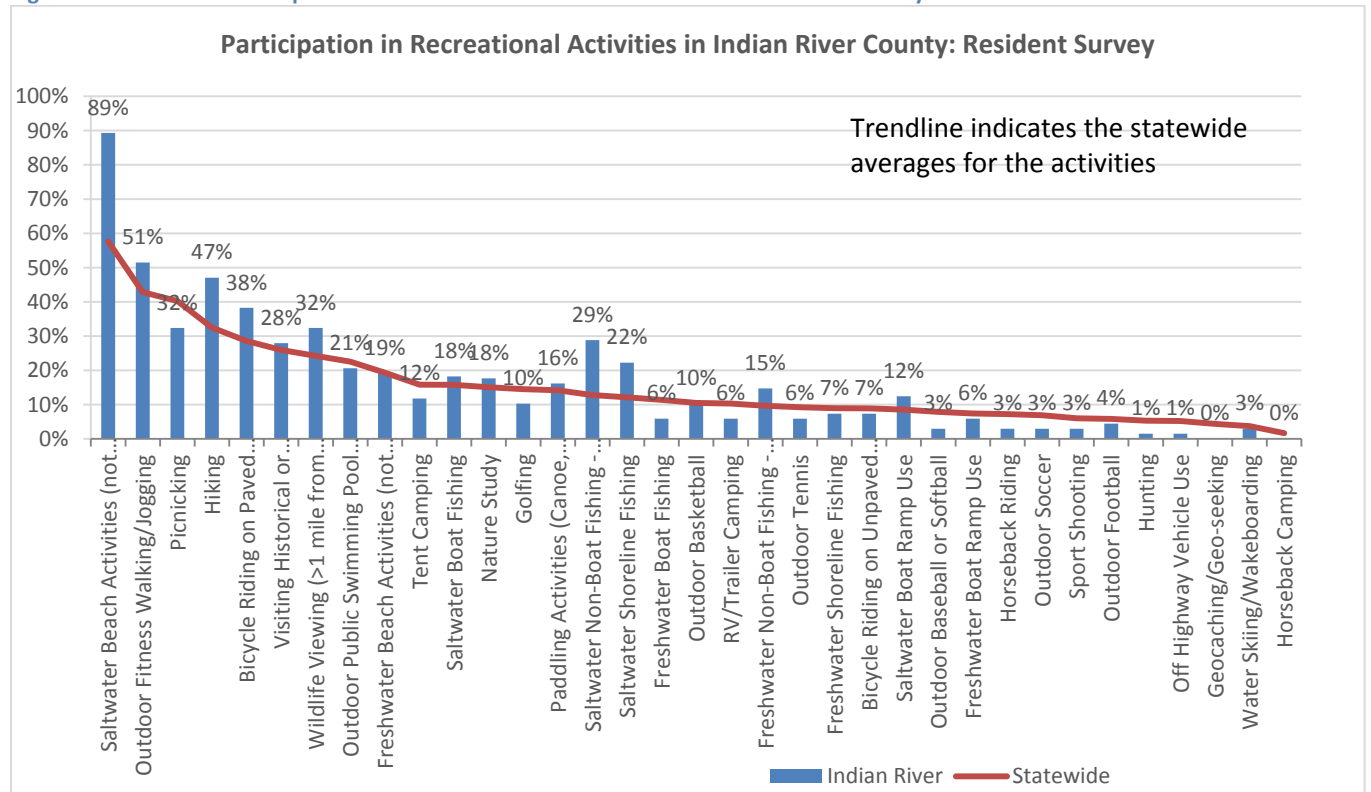


Figure 144. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Jackson County

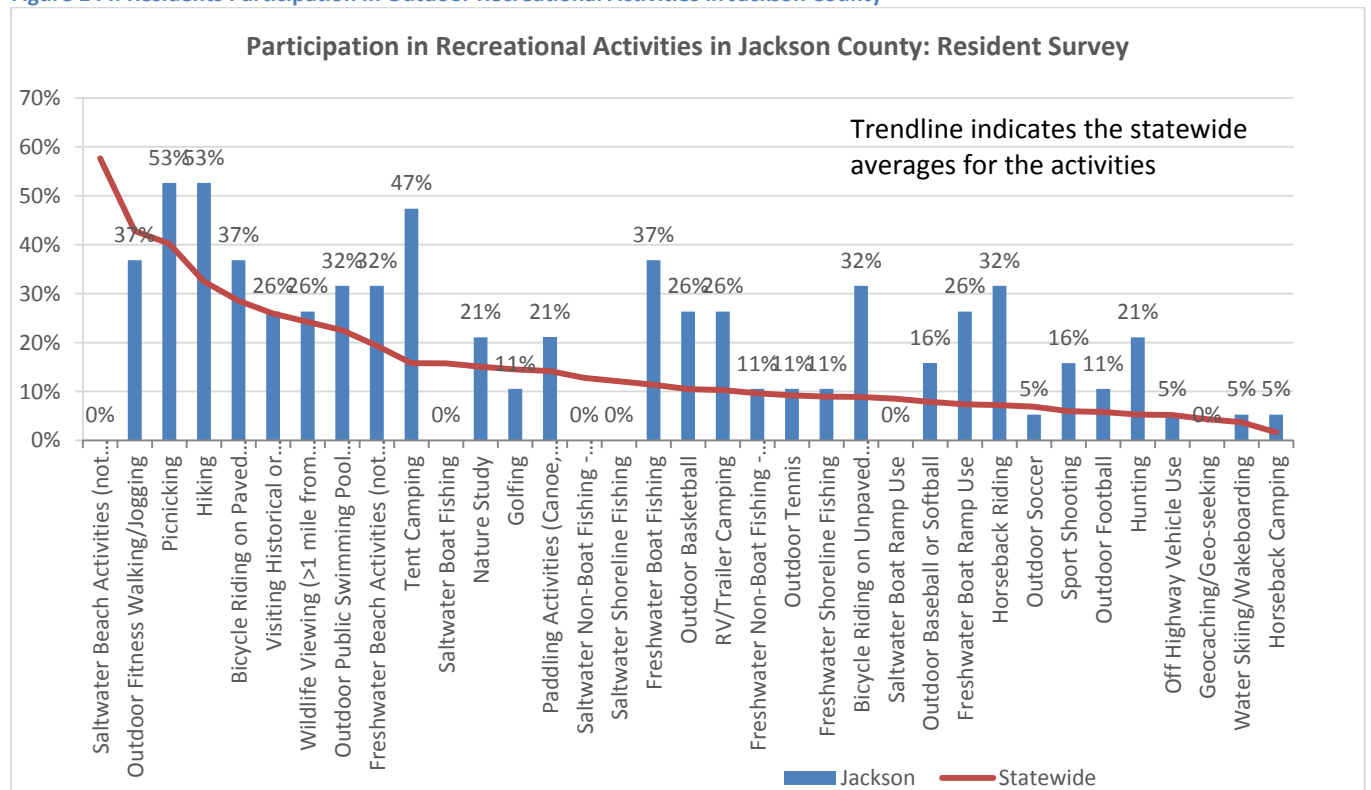


Figure 145. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Jefferson County

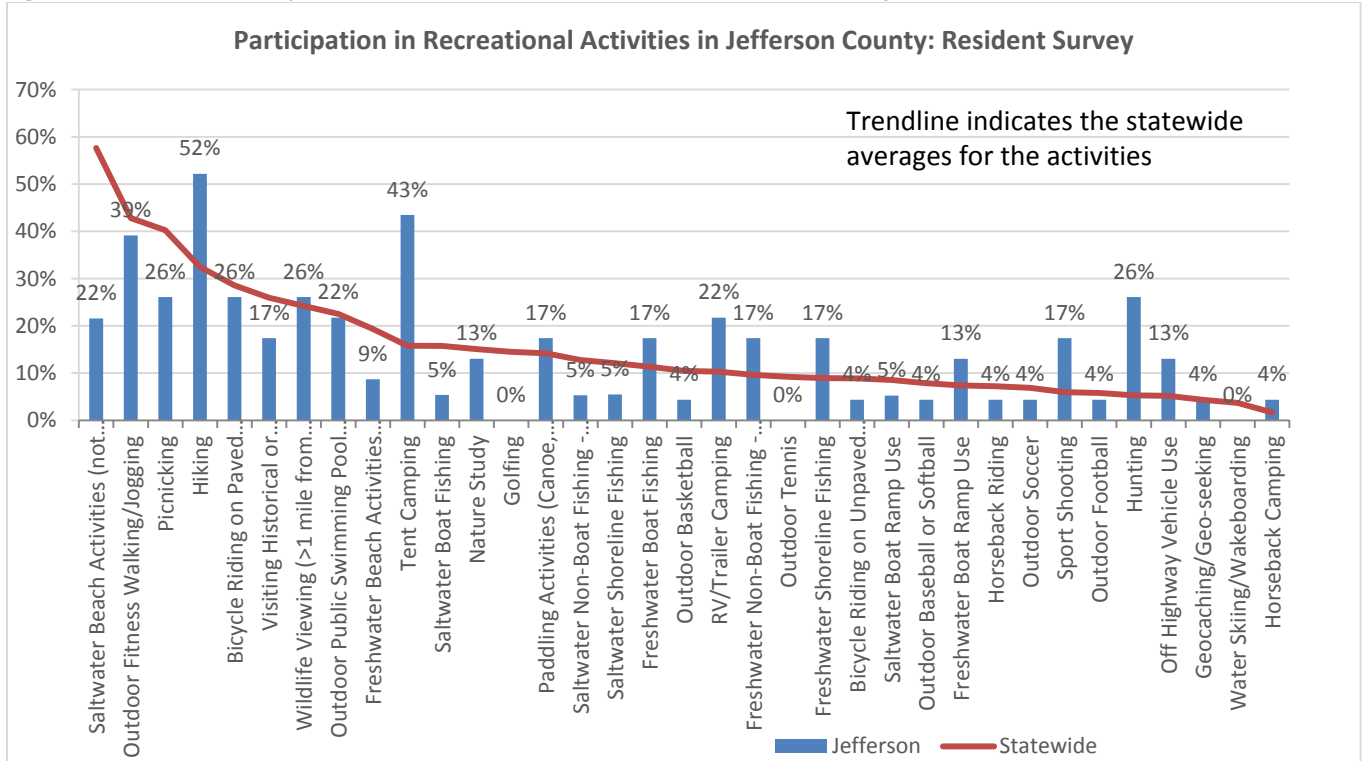


Figure 146. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Lafayette County

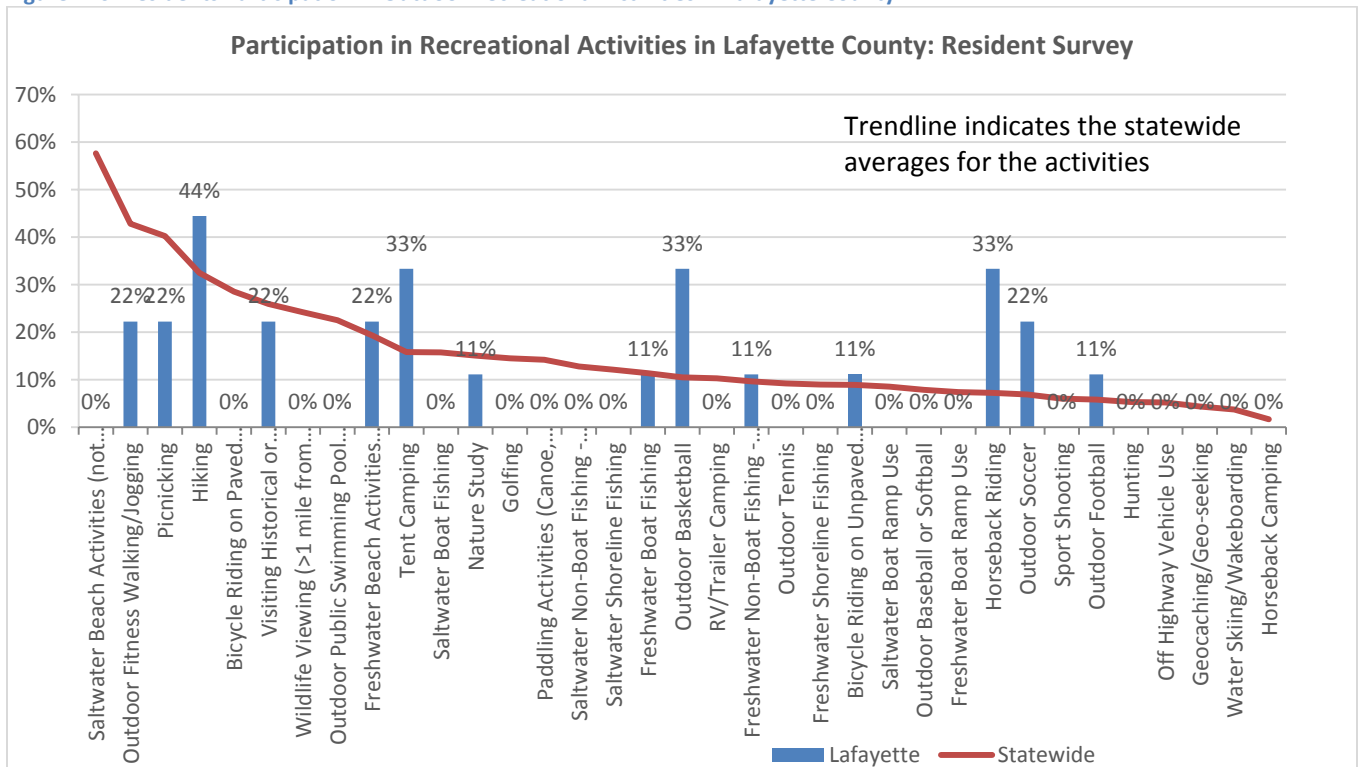


Figure 147. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Lake County

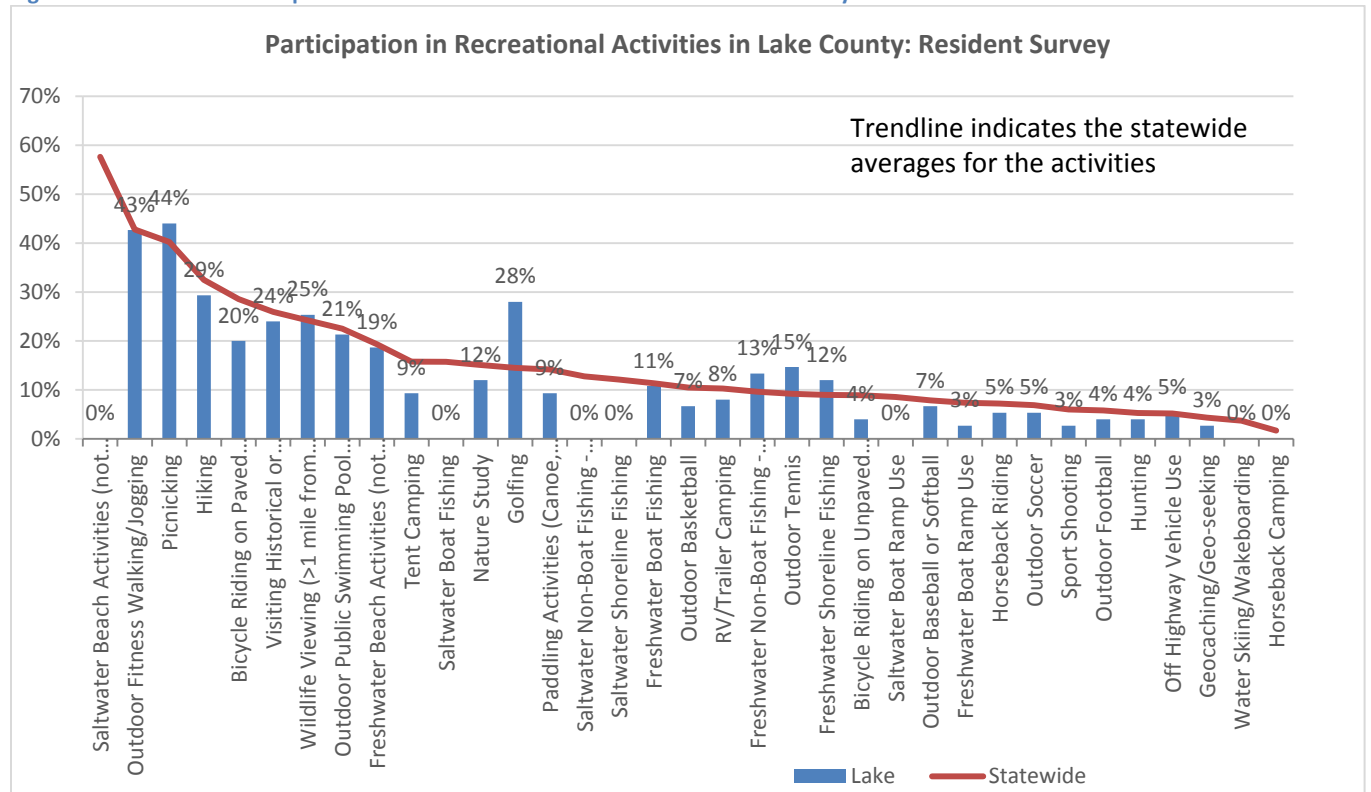


Figure 148. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Lee County

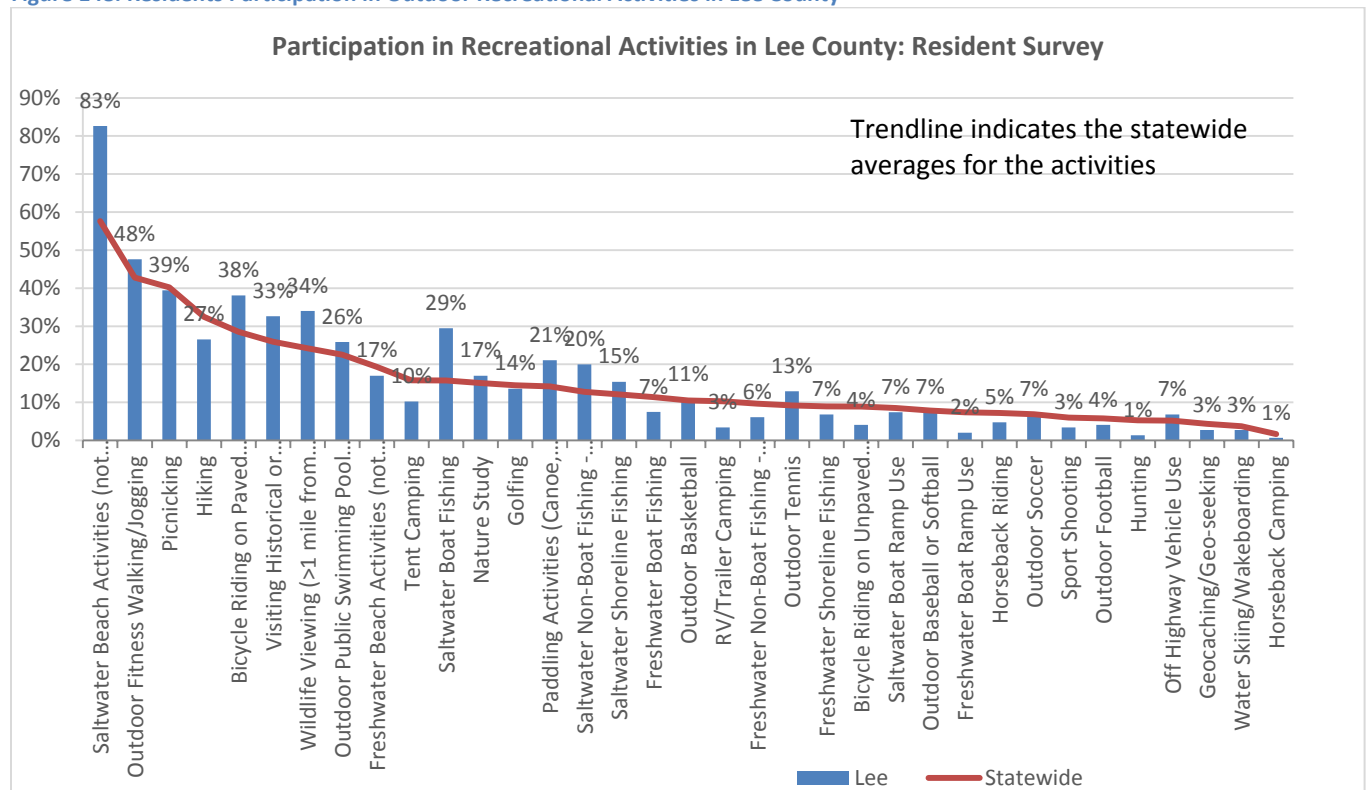


Figure 149. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Leon County

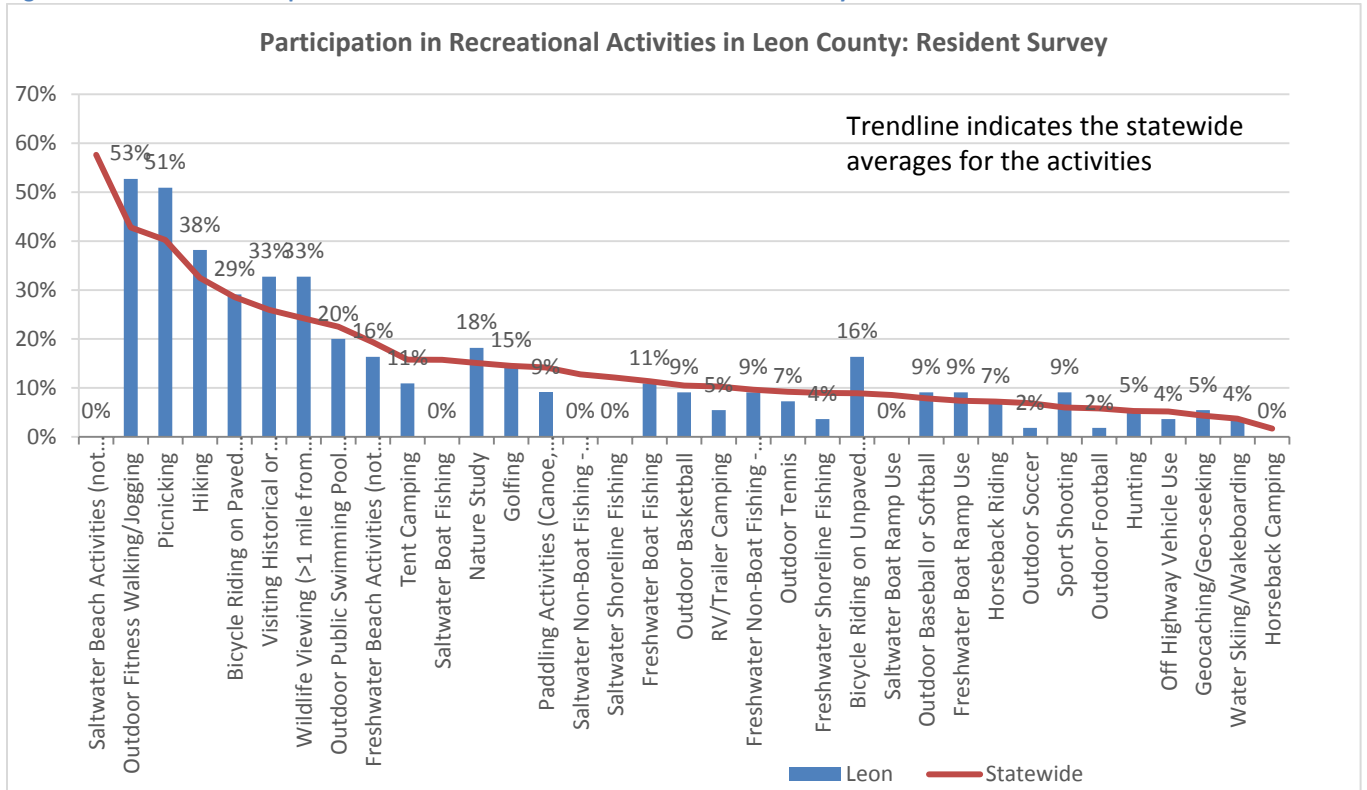


Figure 150. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Levy County

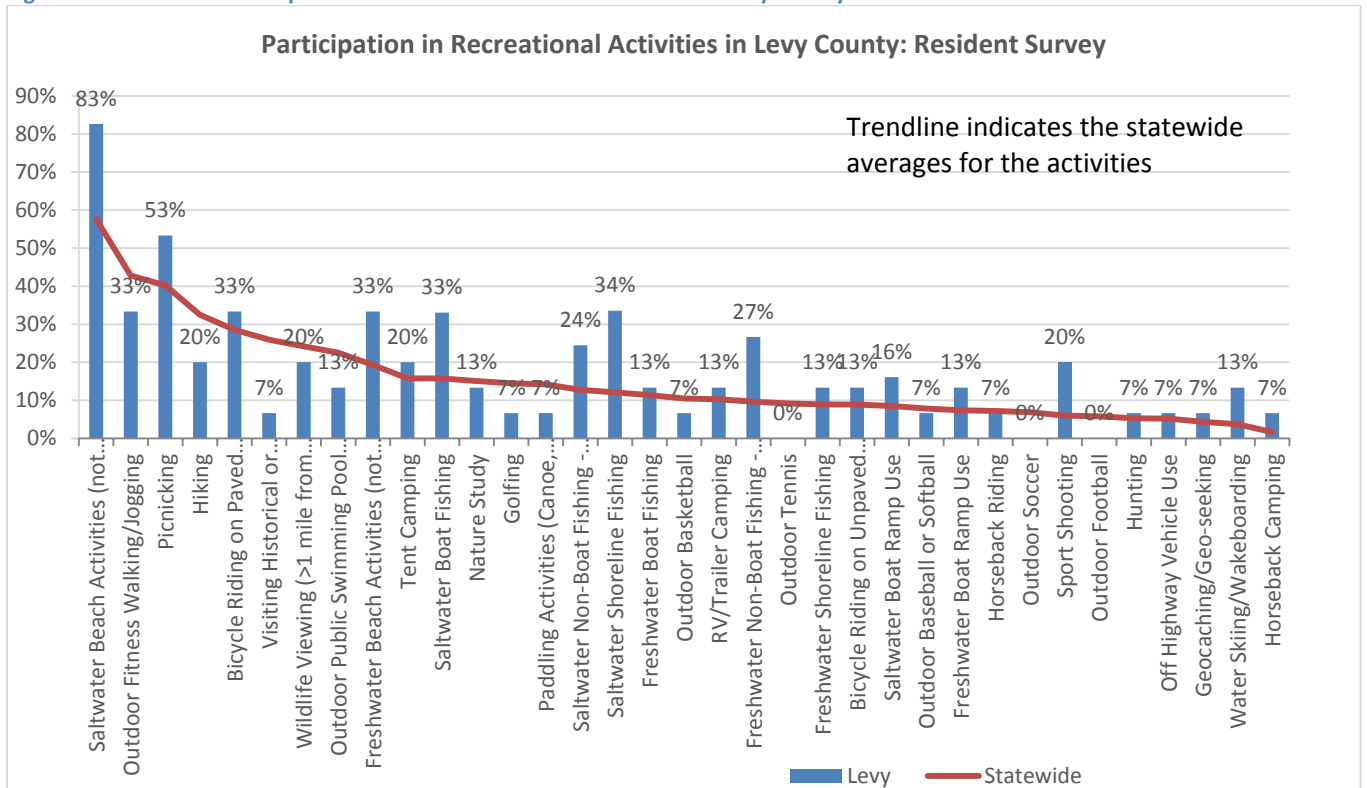


Figure 151. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Liberty County

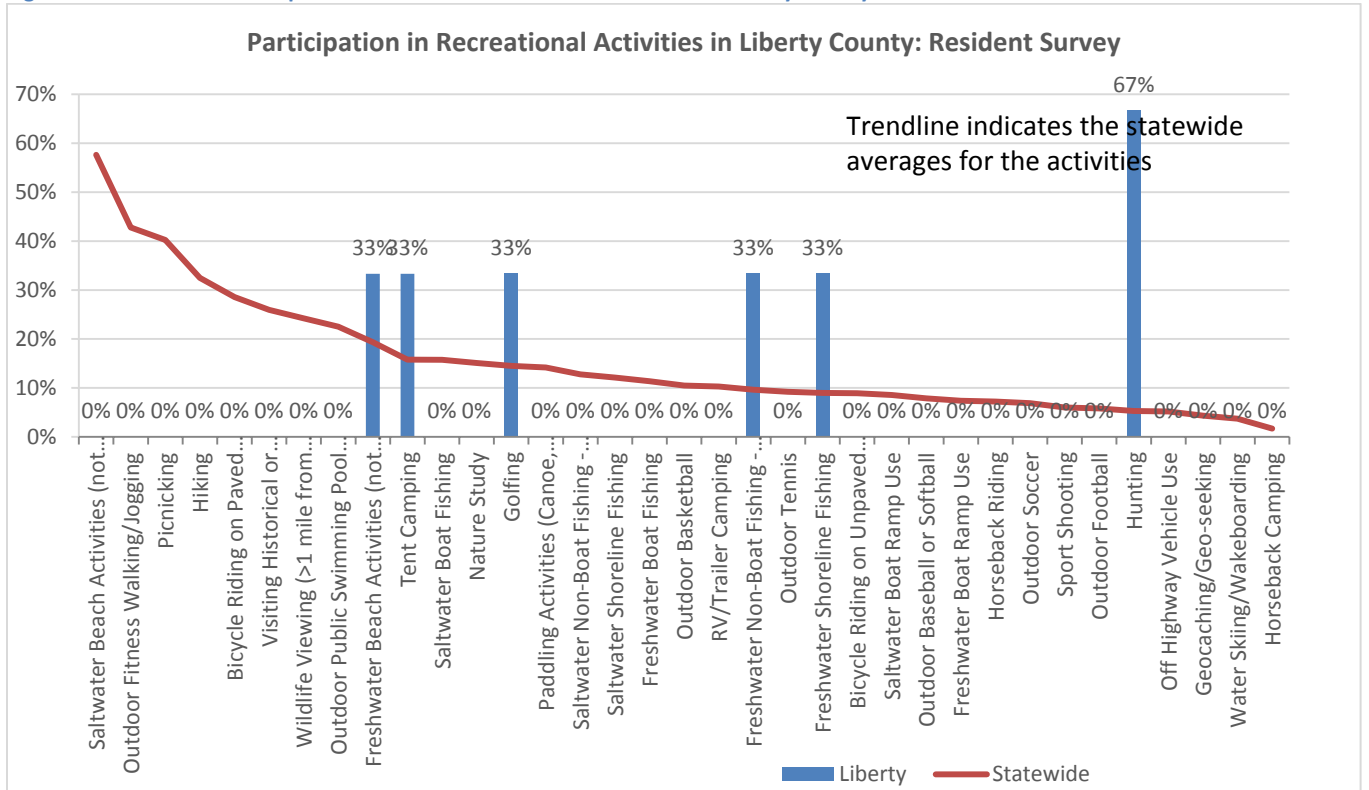


Figure 152. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Madison County

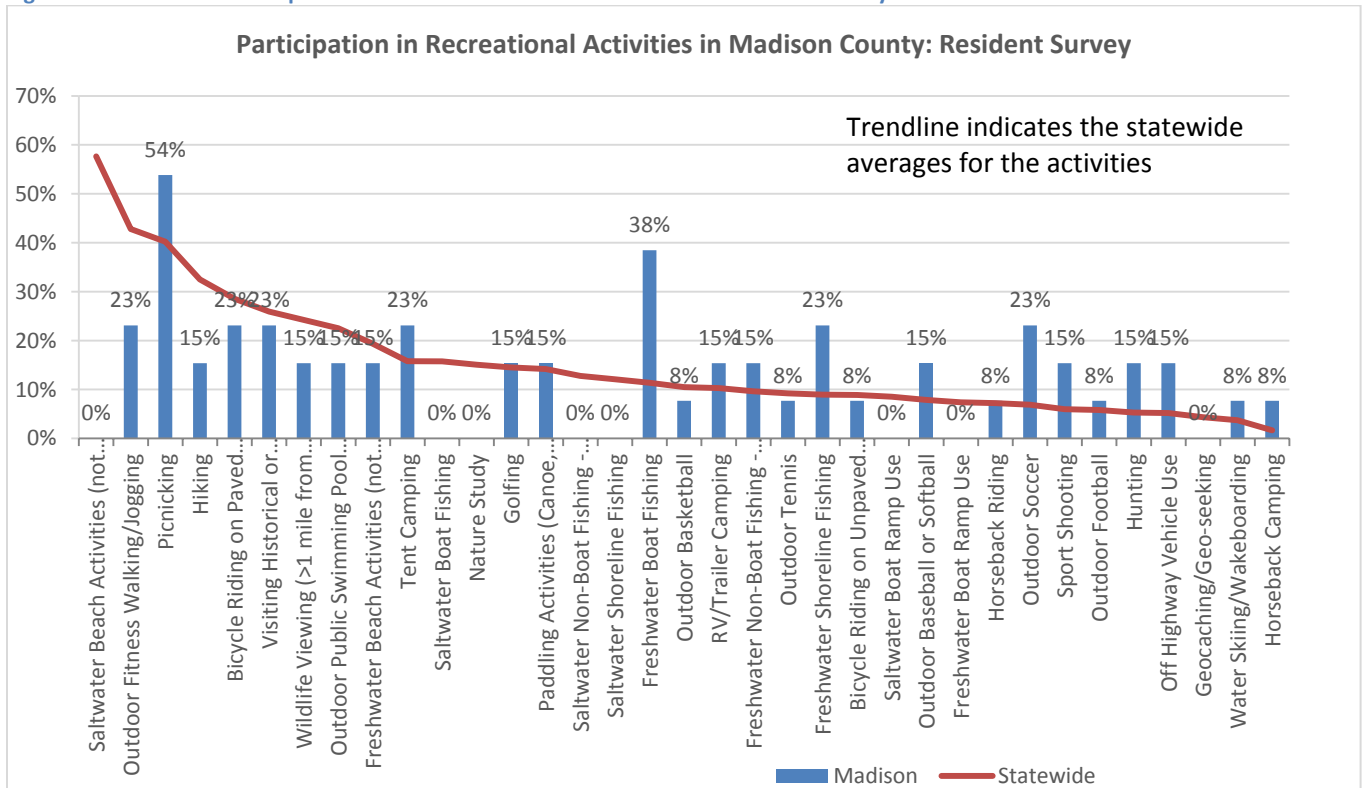


Figure 153. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Manatee County

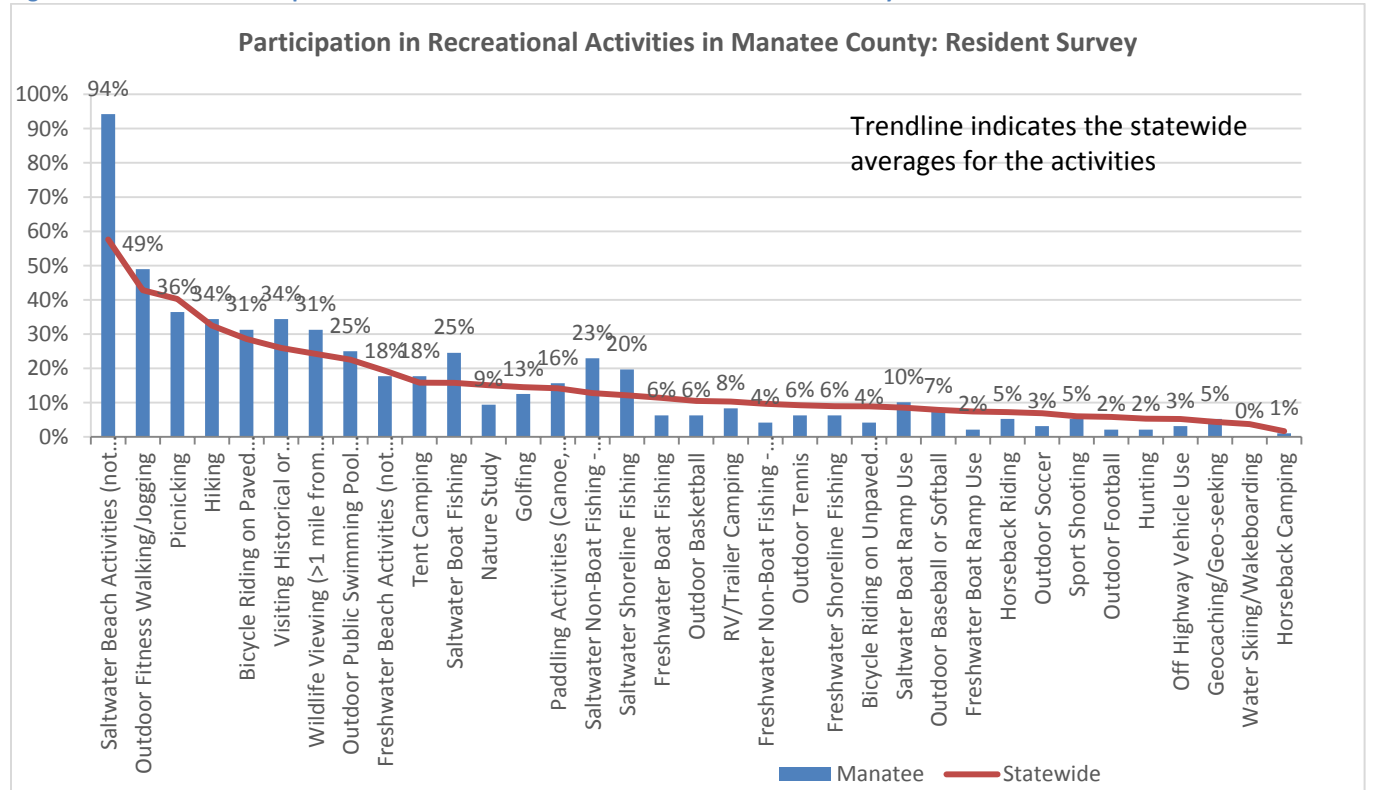


Figure 154. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Marion County

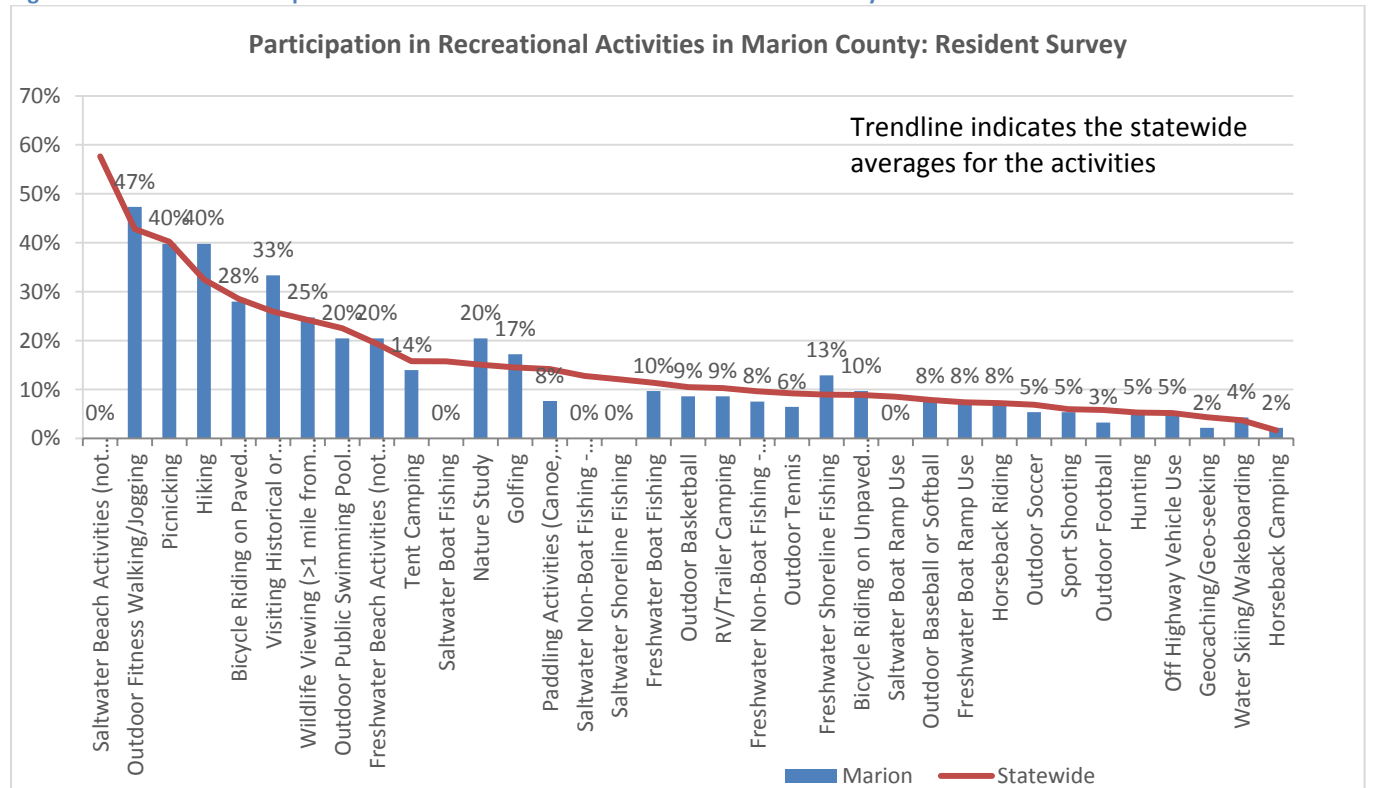


Figure 155. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Martin County

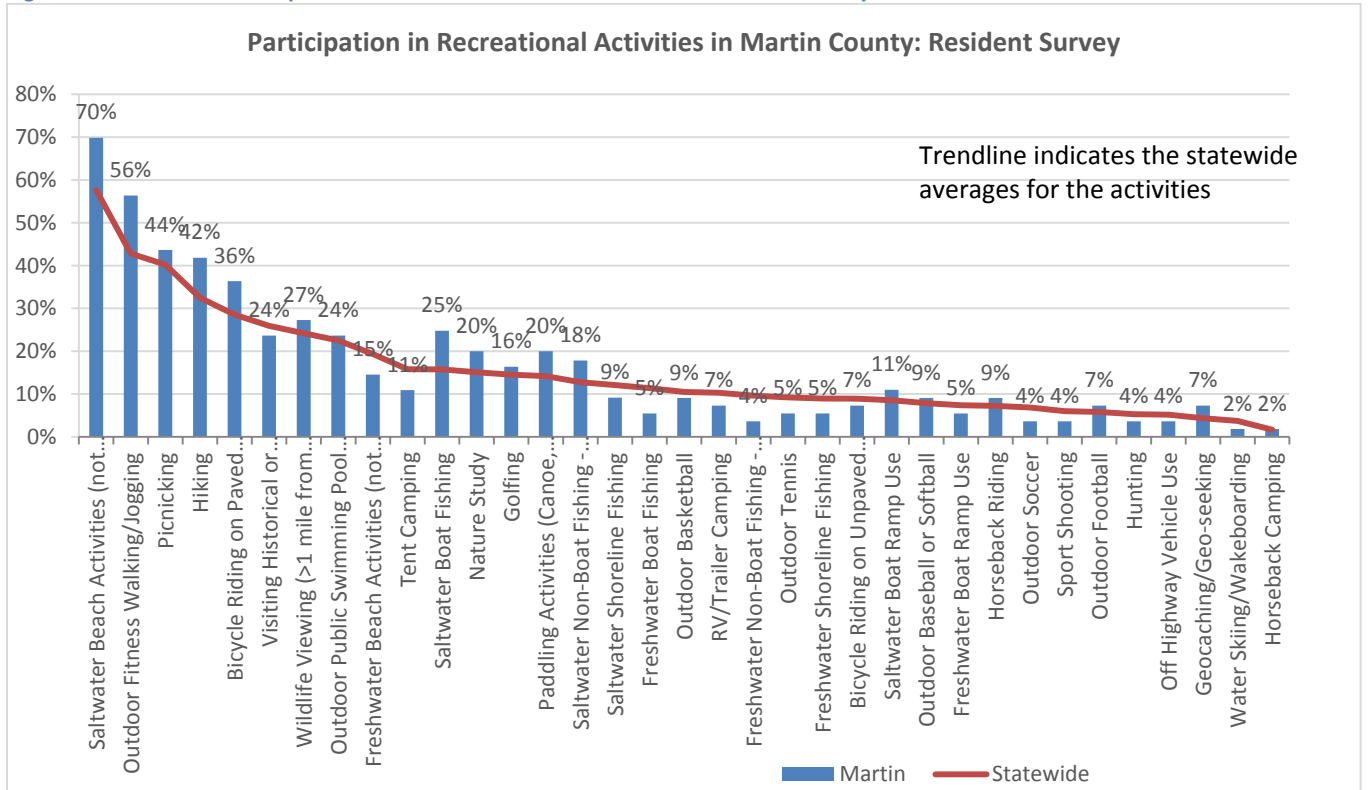


Figure 156. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Miami Dade County

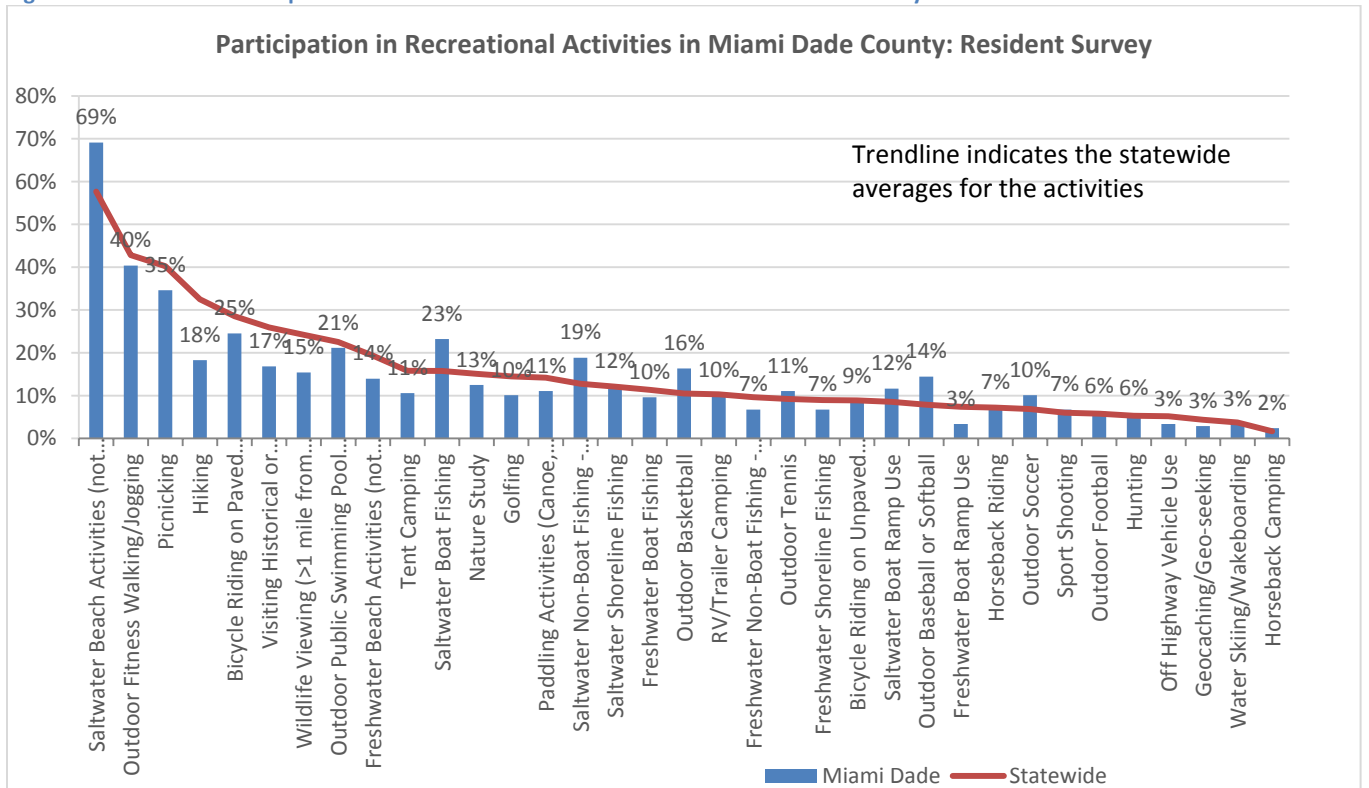


Figure 157. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Monroe County

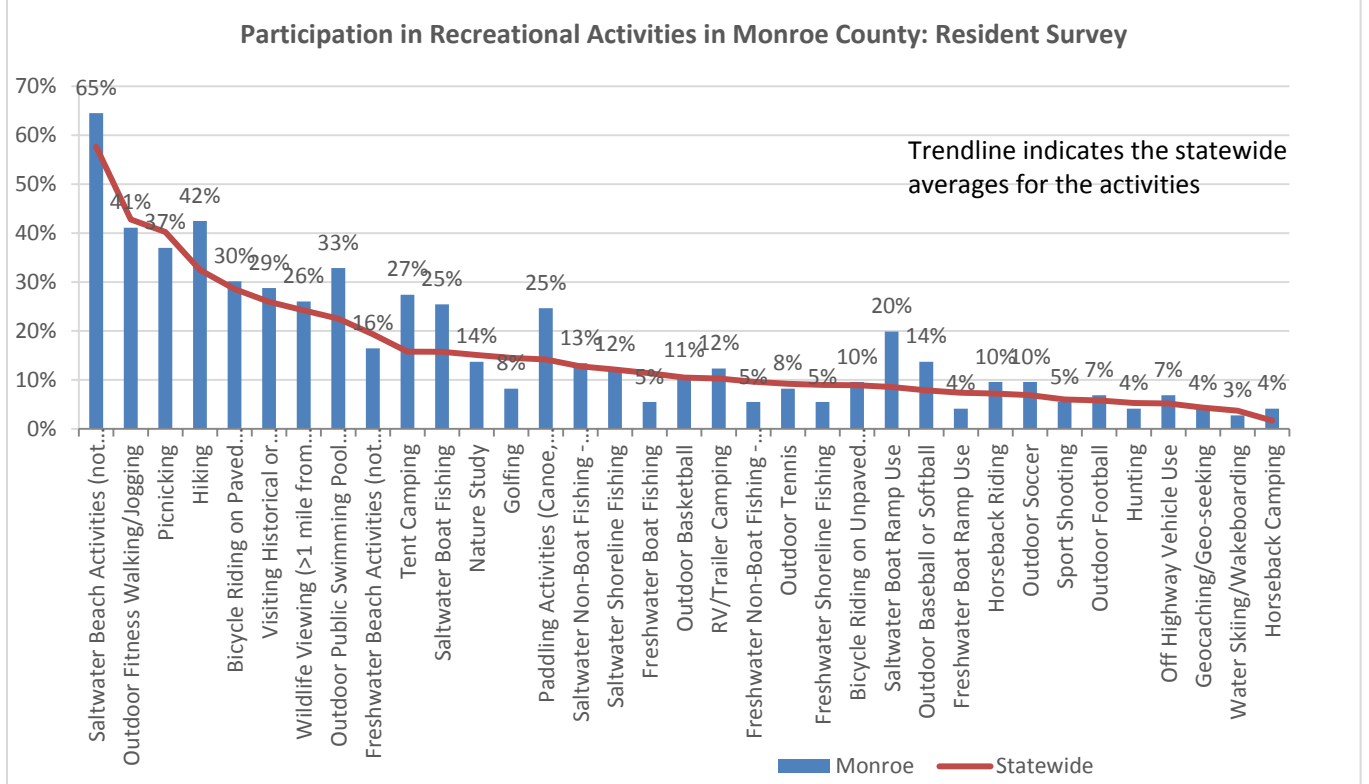


Figure 158. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Nassau County

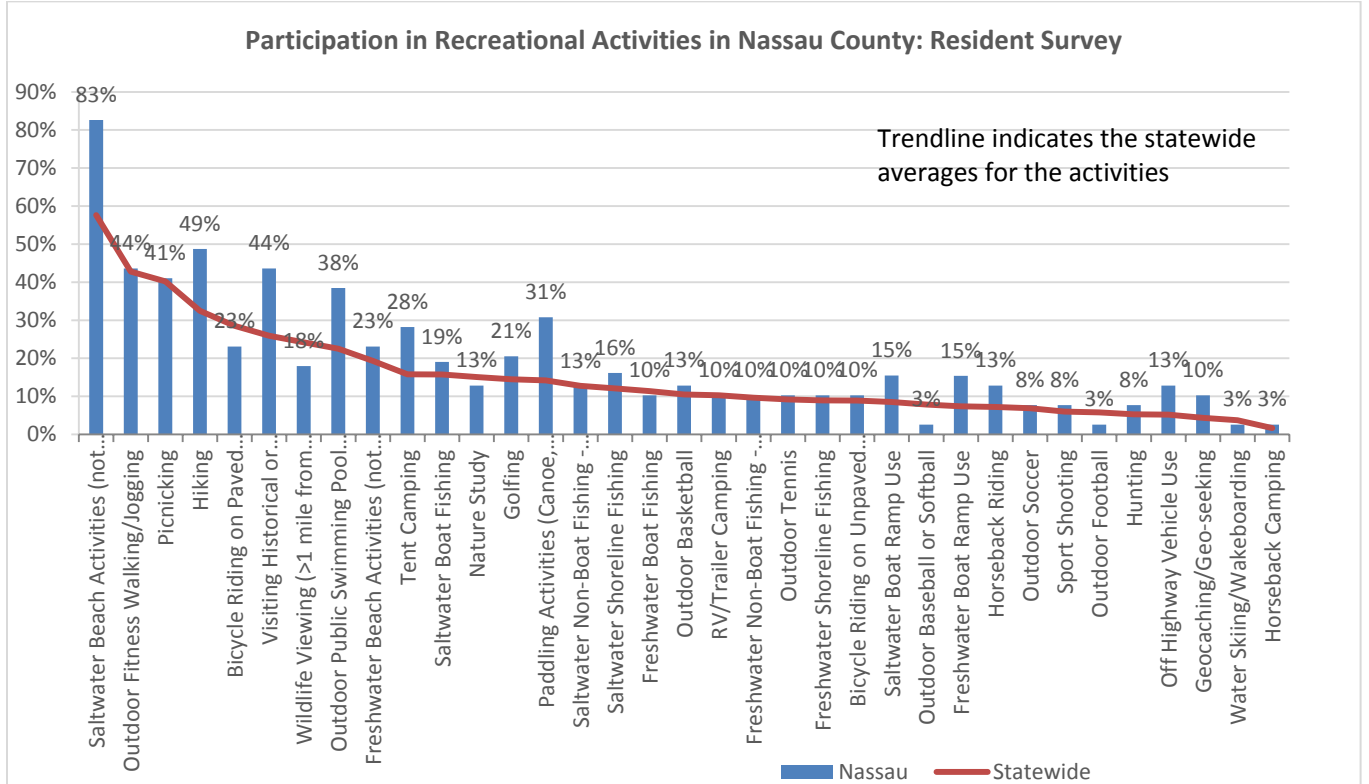


Figure 159. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Okaloosa County

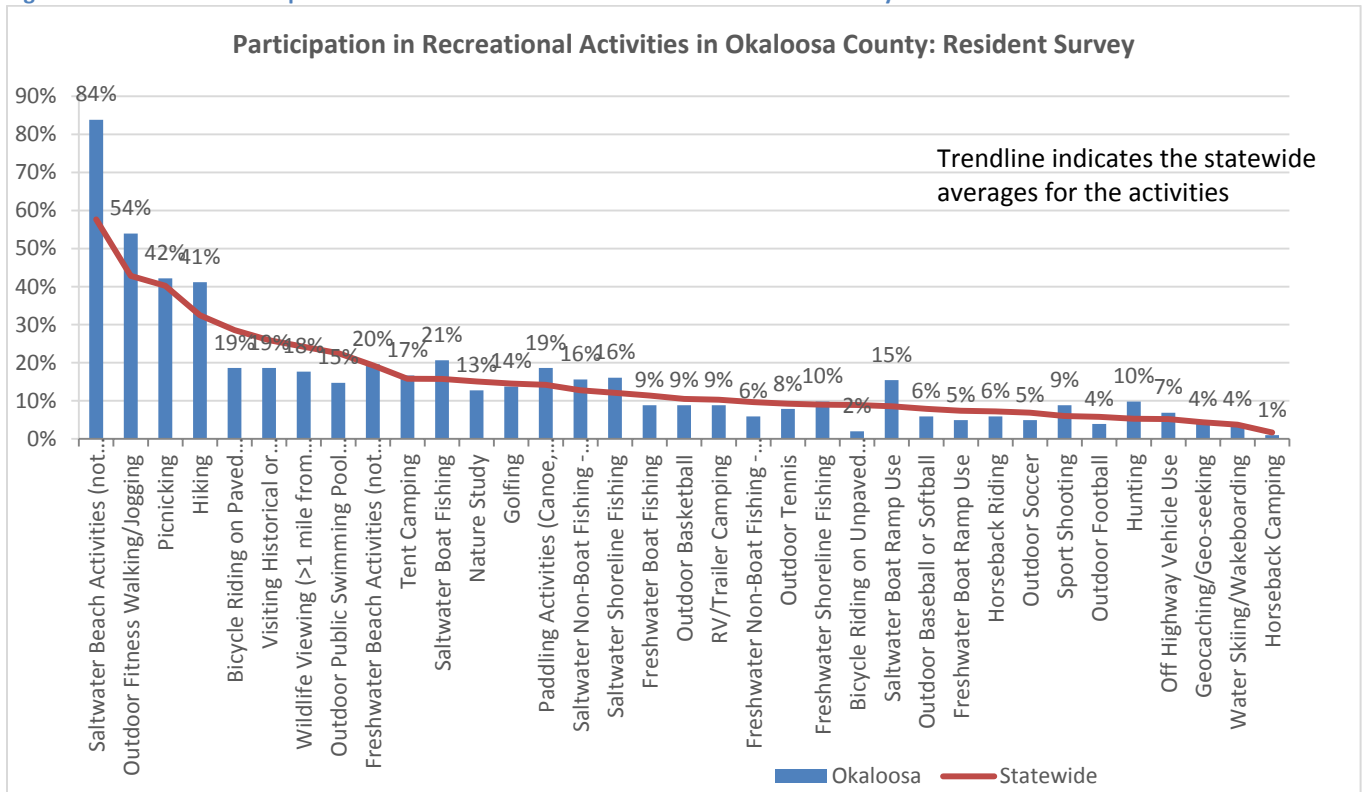


Figure 160. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Okeechobee County

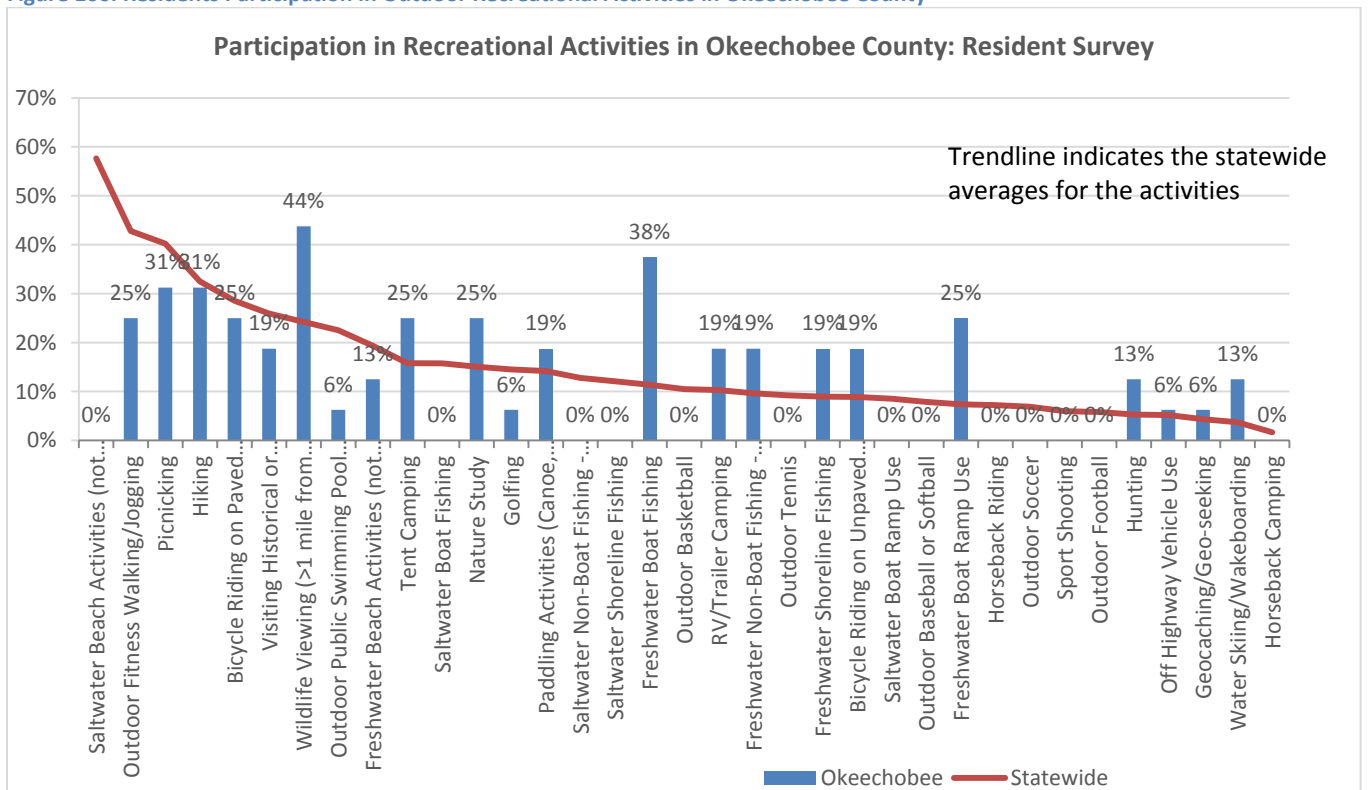


Figure 161. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Orange County

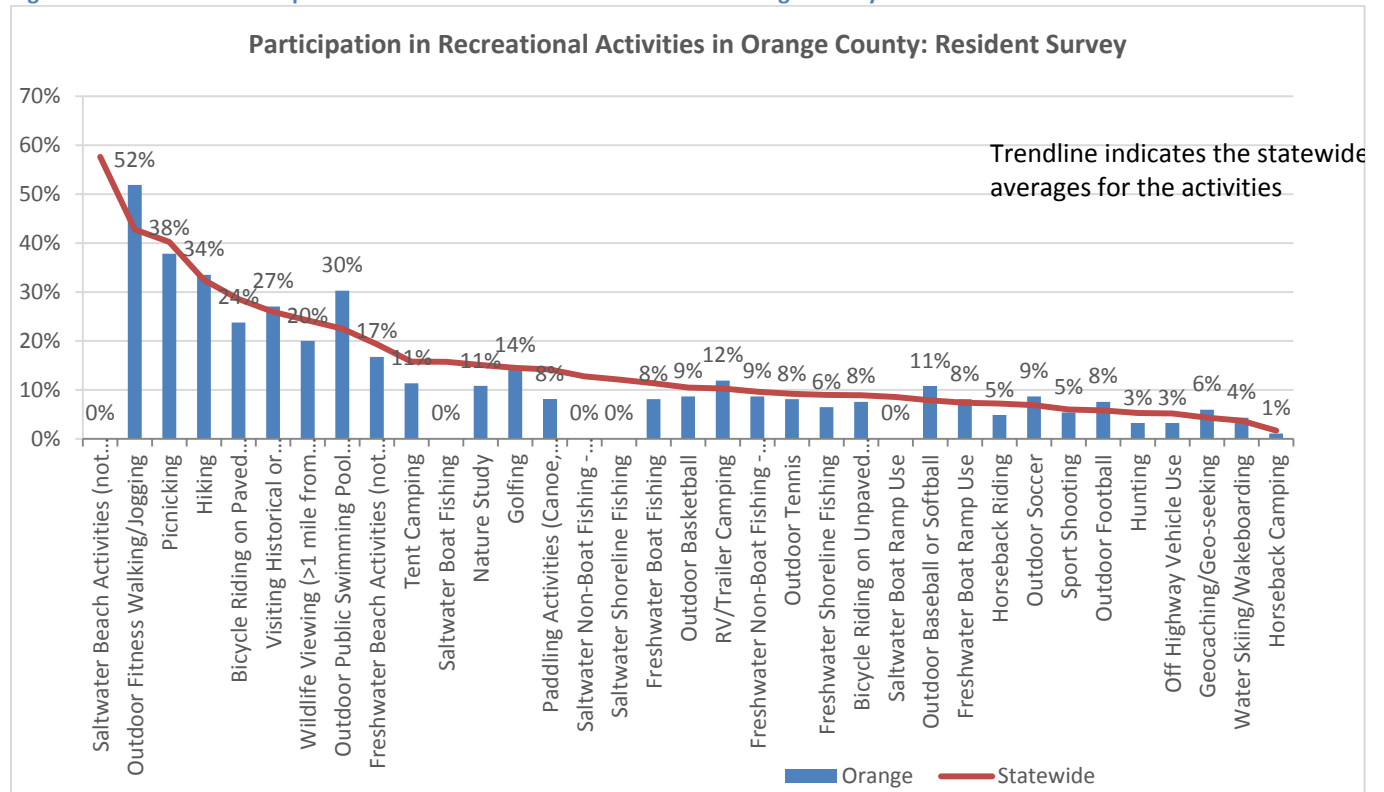


Figure 162. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Osceola County

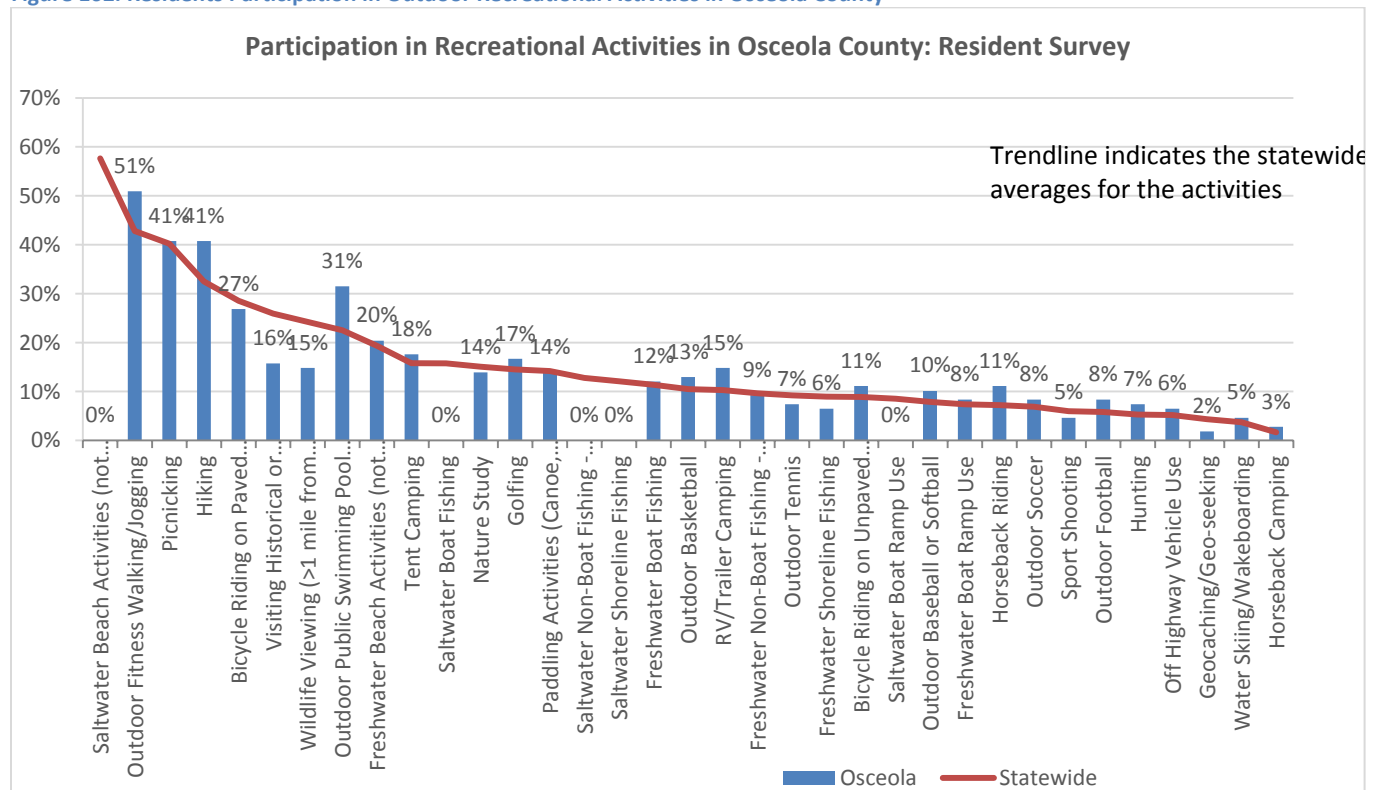


Figure 163. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Palm Beach County

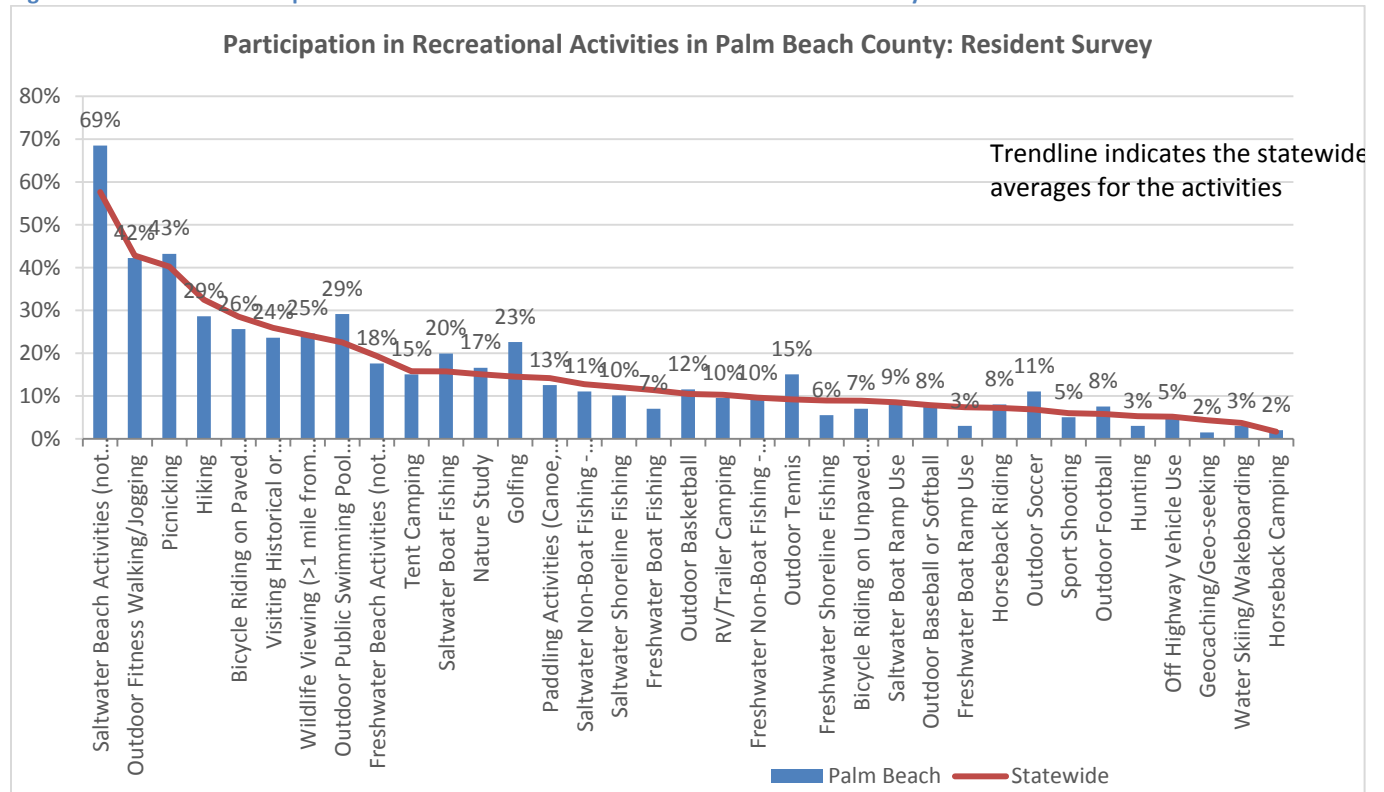


Figure 164. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Pasco County

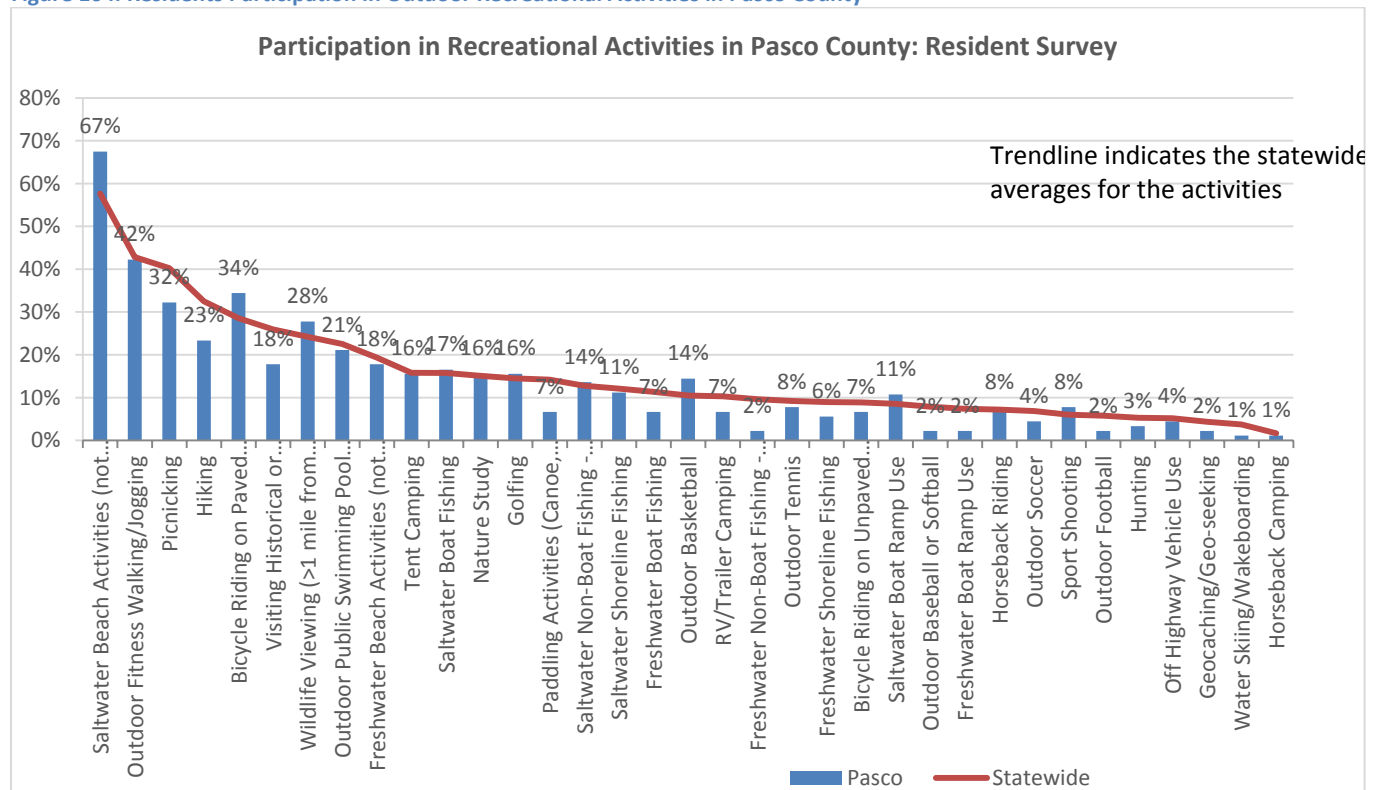


Figure 165. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Pinellas County

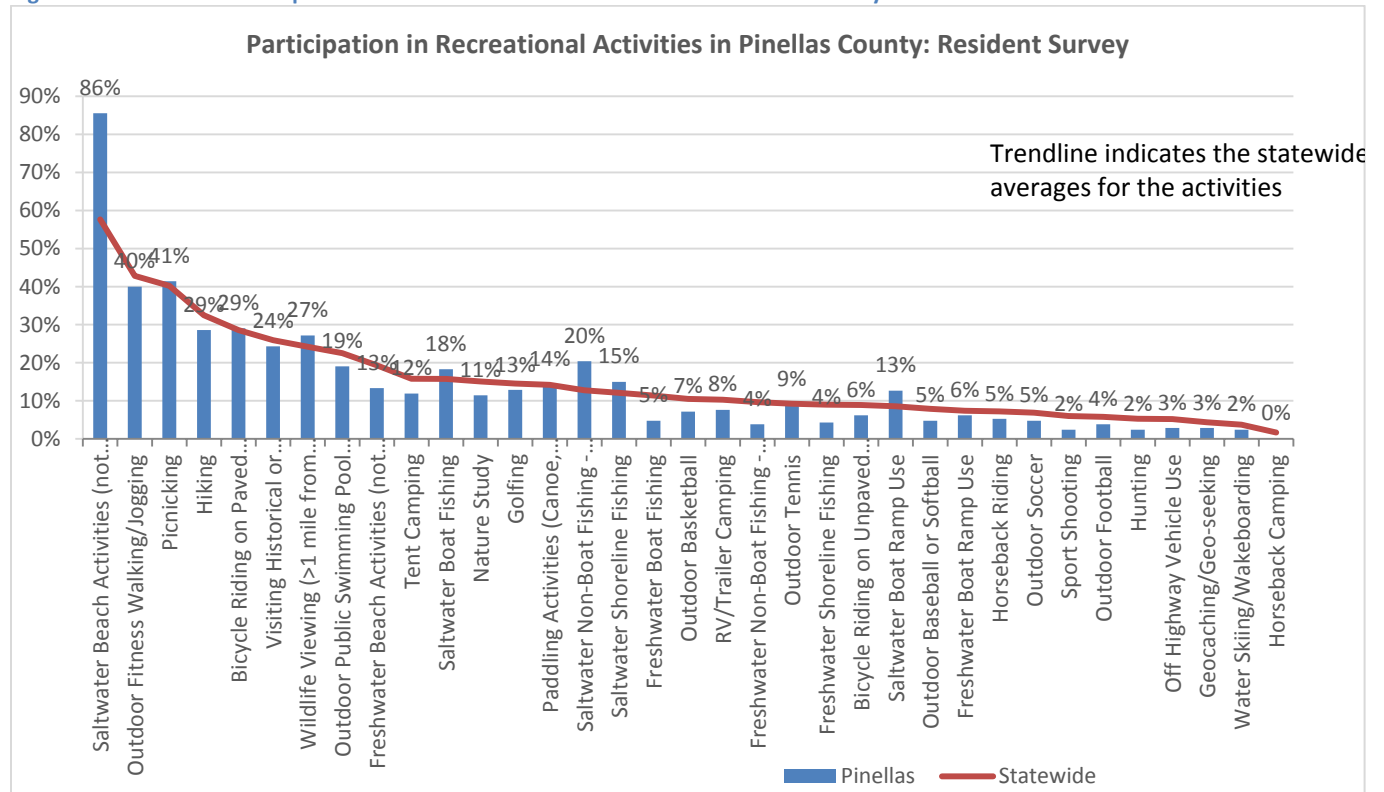


Figure 166. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Polk County

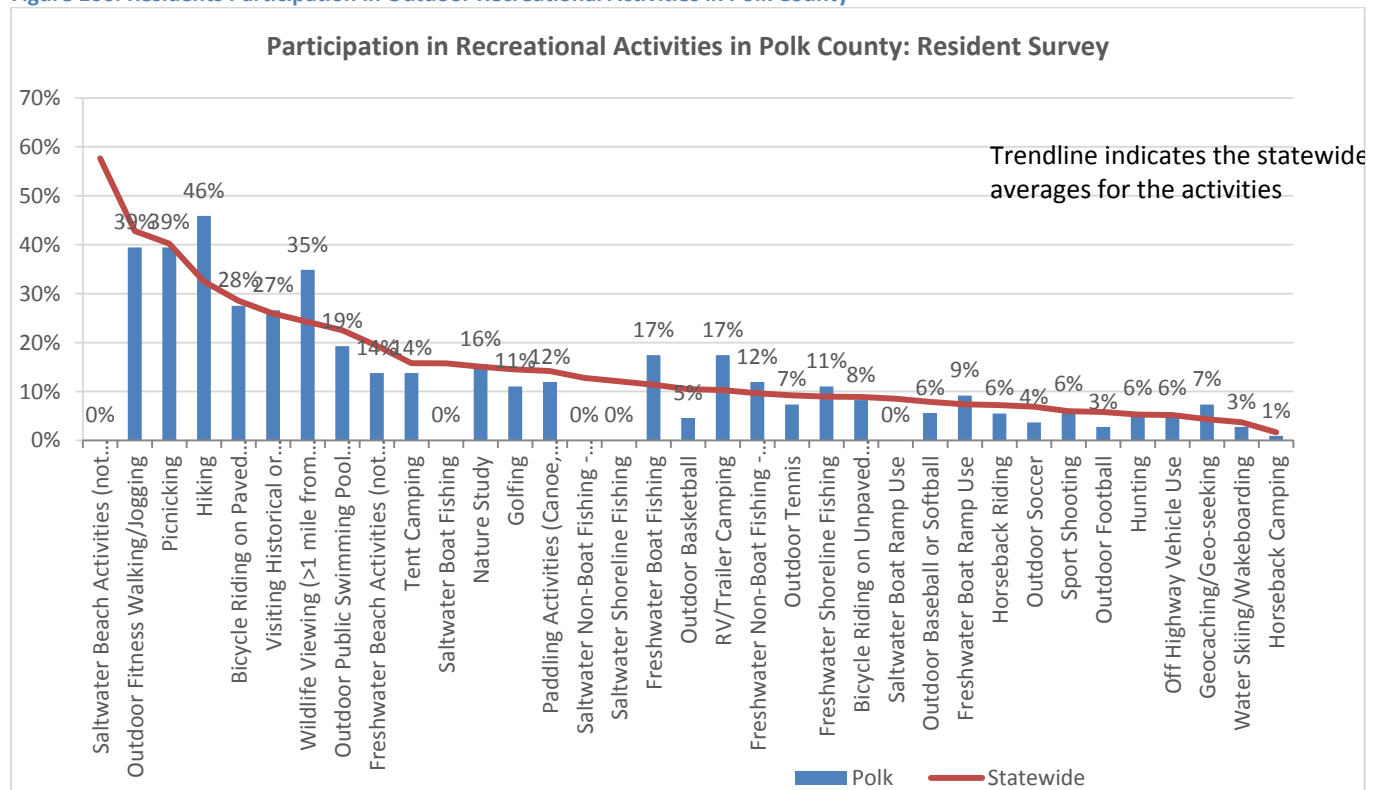


Figure 167. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Putnam County

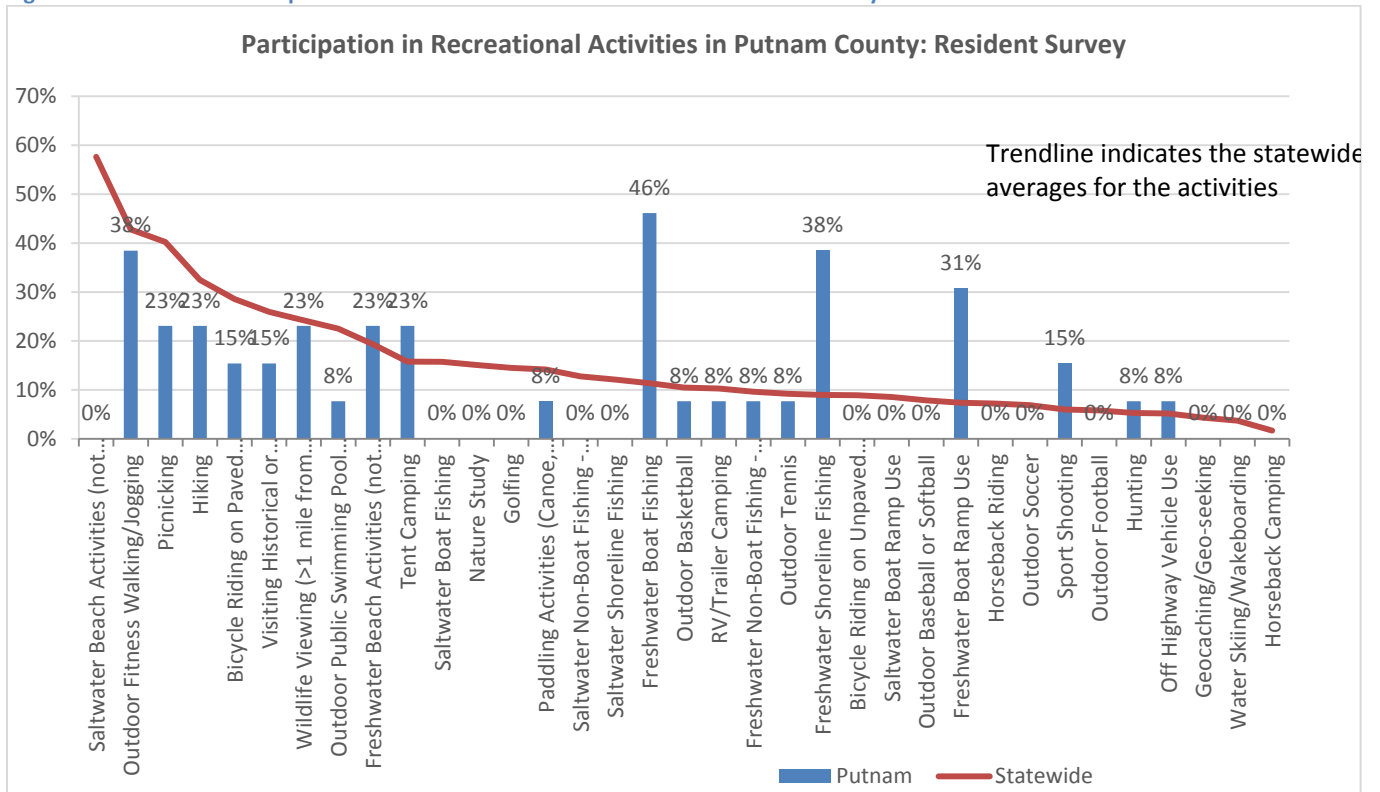


Figure 168. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Santa Rosa County

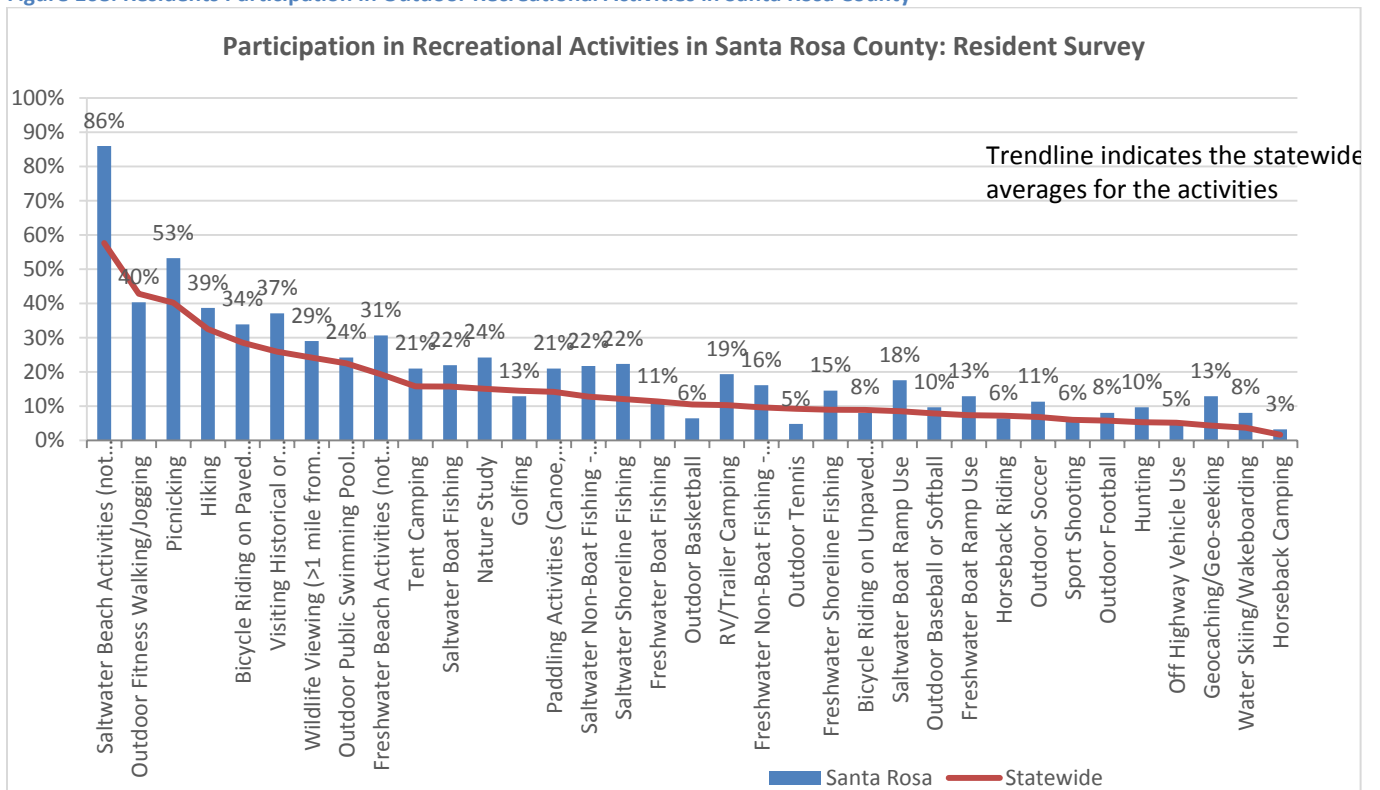


Figure 169. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Sarasota County

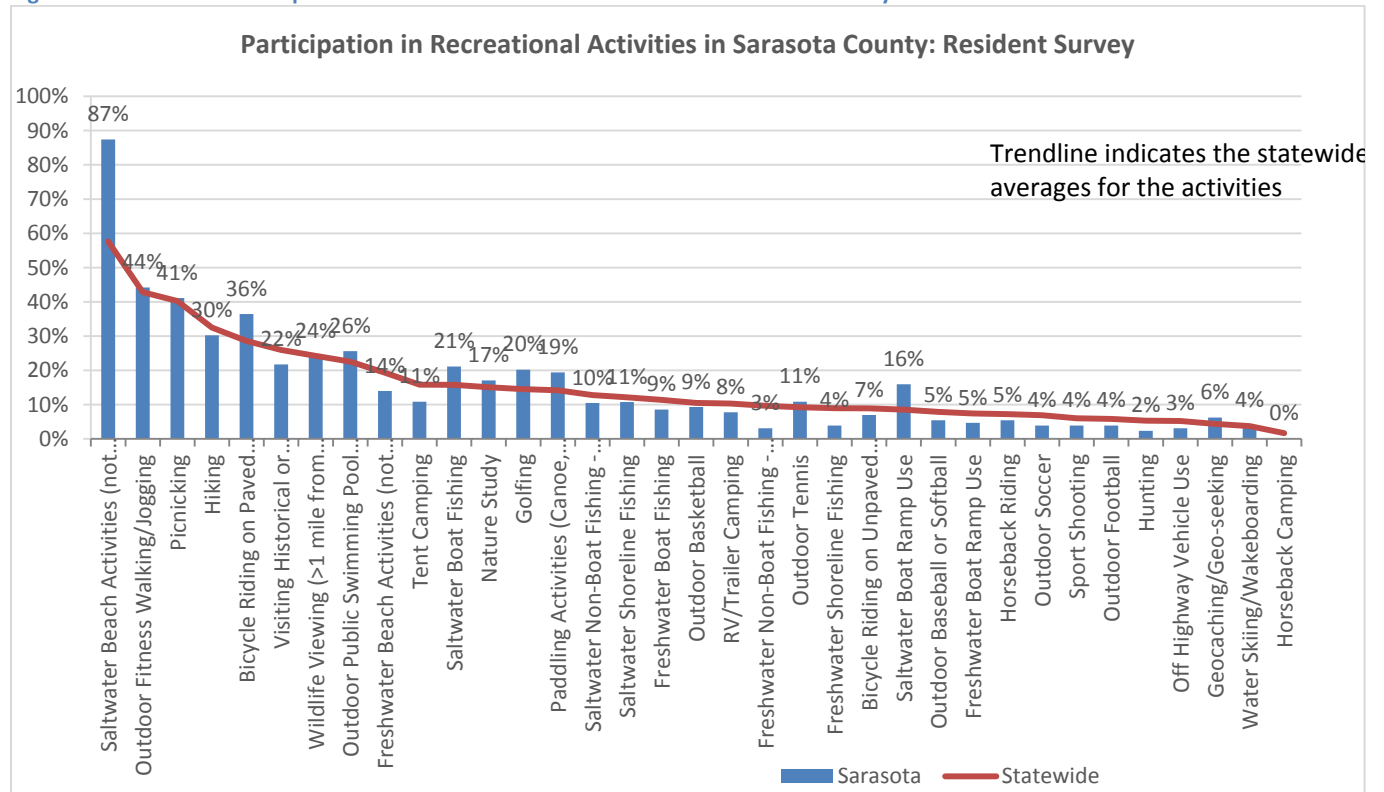


Figure 170. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Seminole County

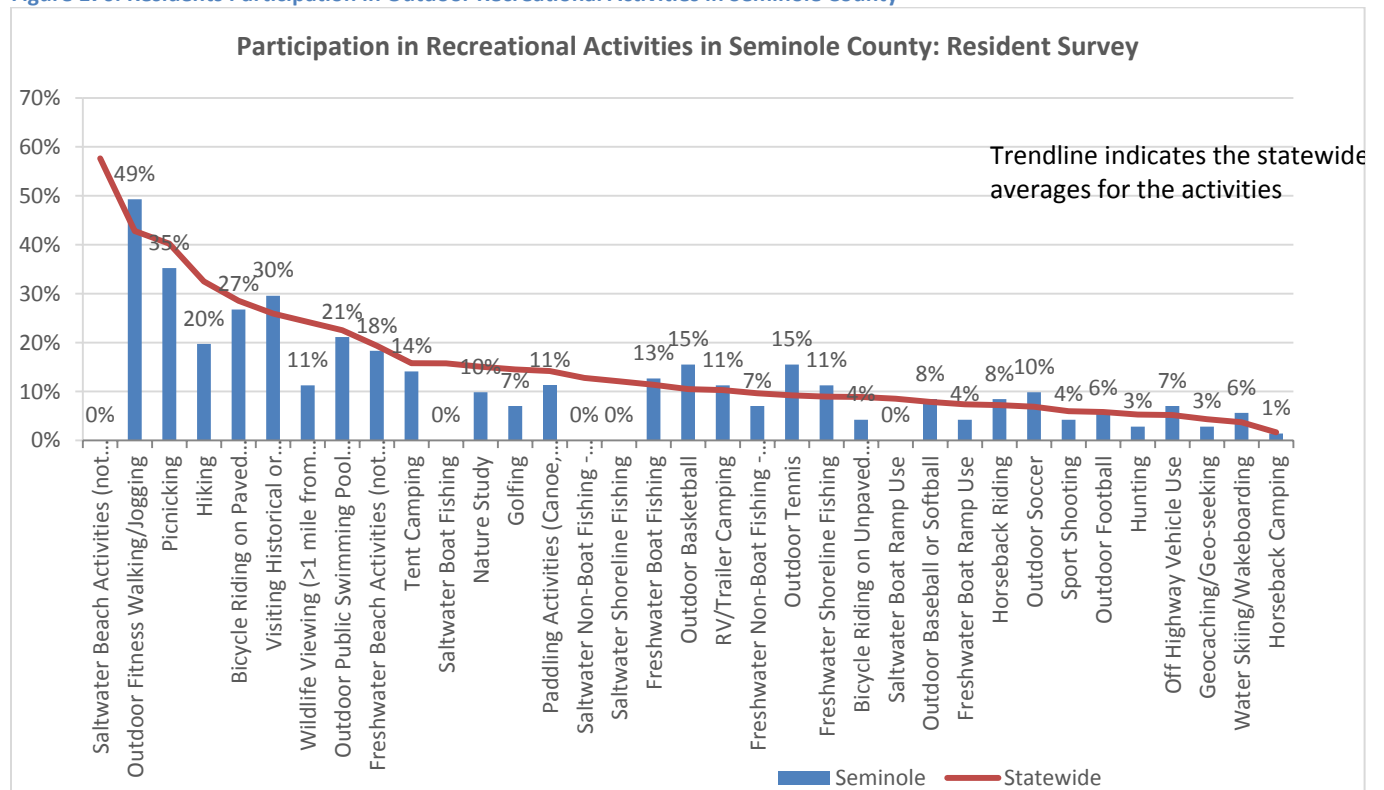


Figure 171. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in St. Johns County

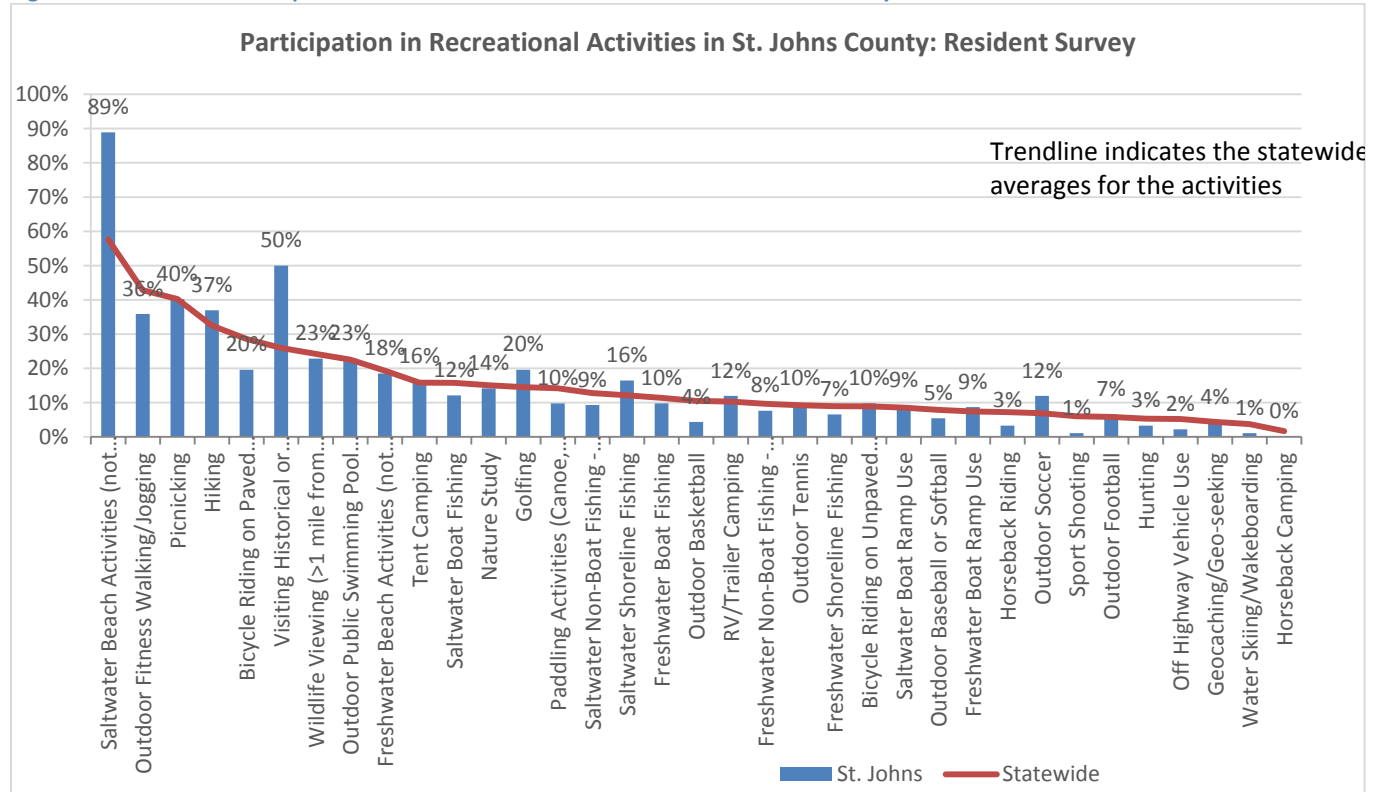


Figure 172. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in St. Lucie County

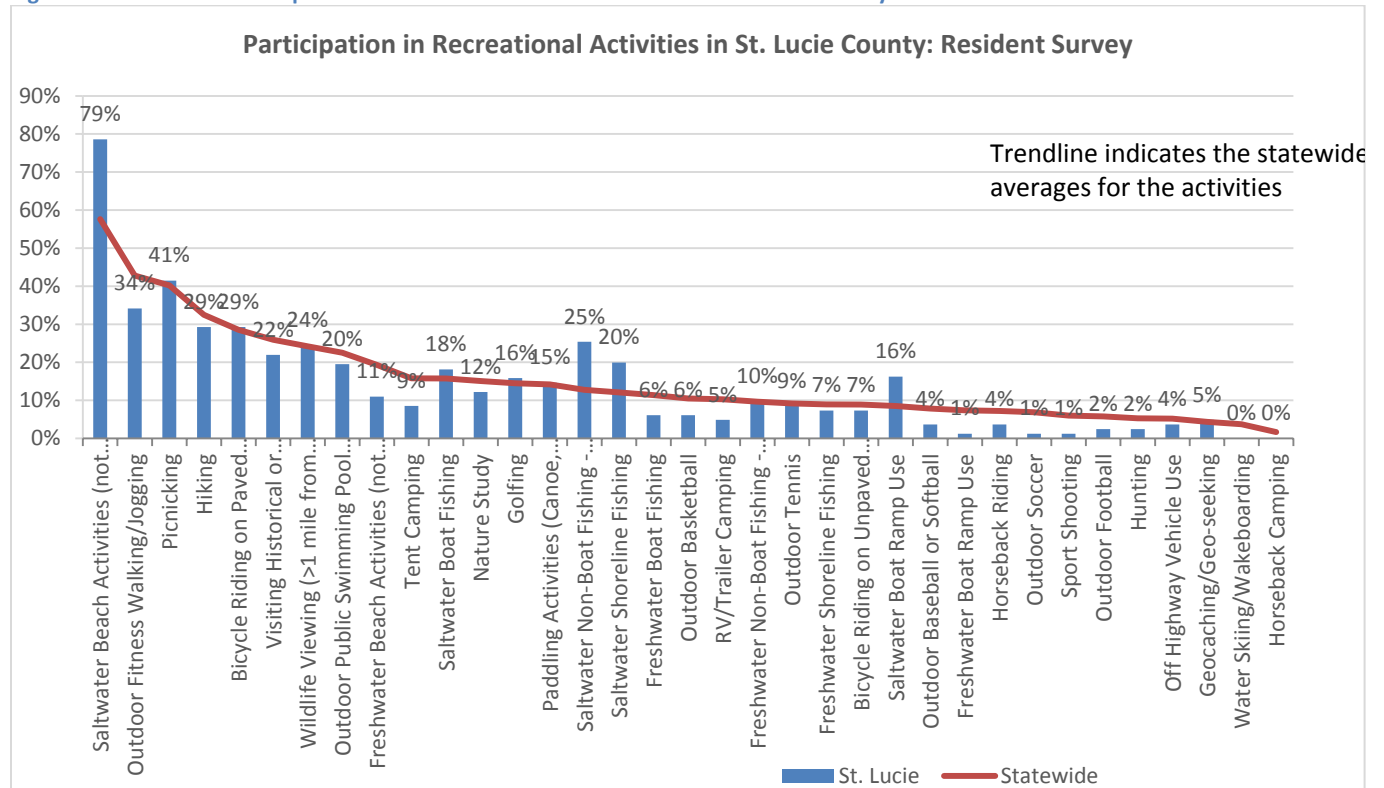


Figure 173. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Sumter County

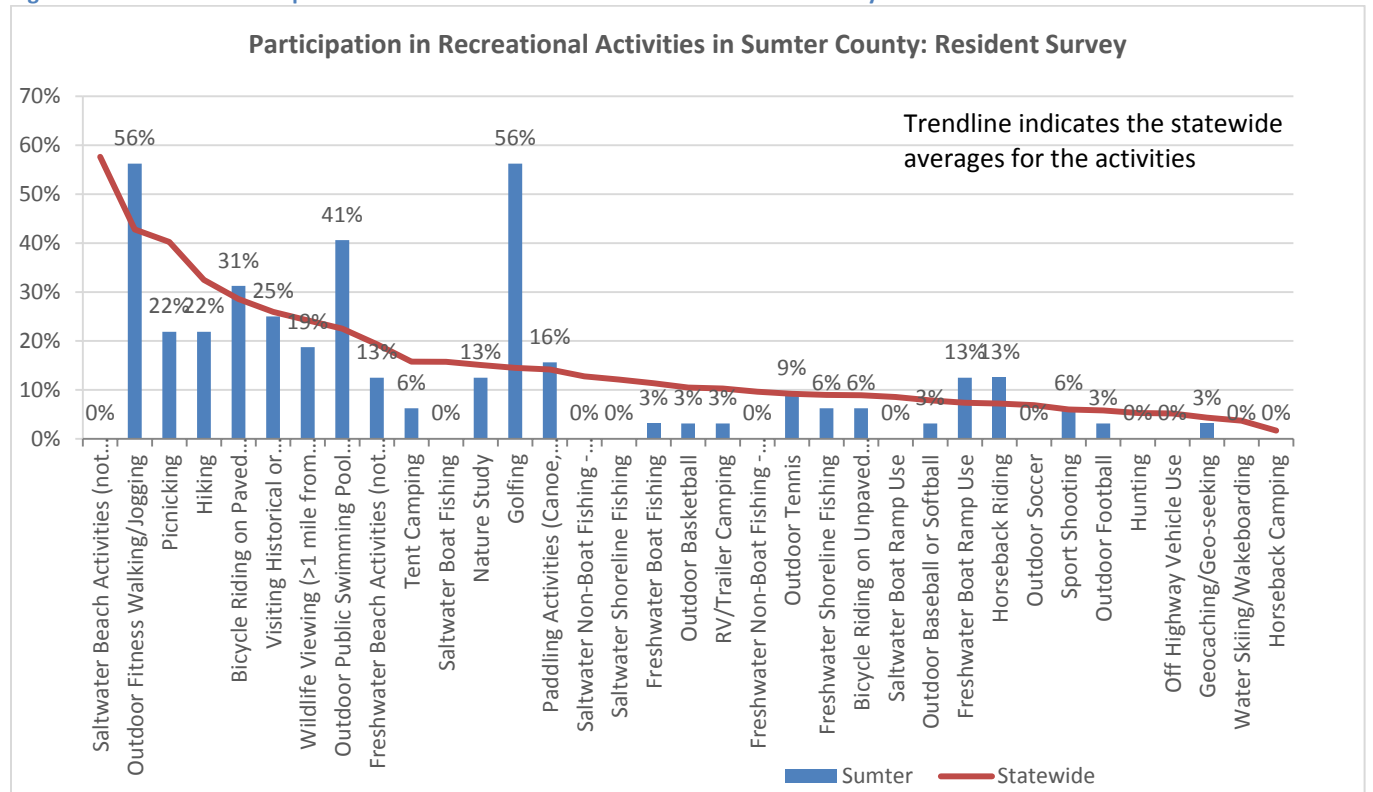


Figure 174. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Suwannee County

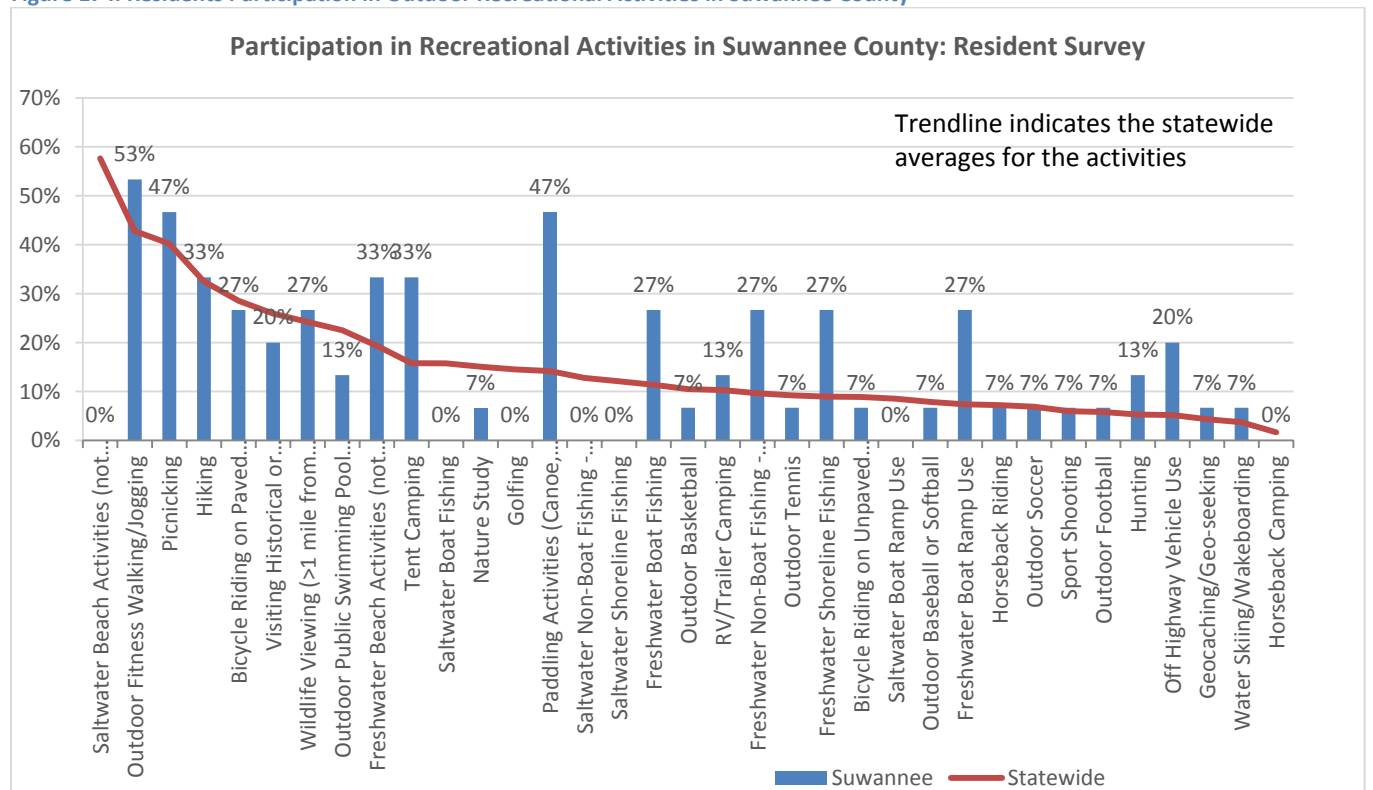


Figure 175. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Taylor County

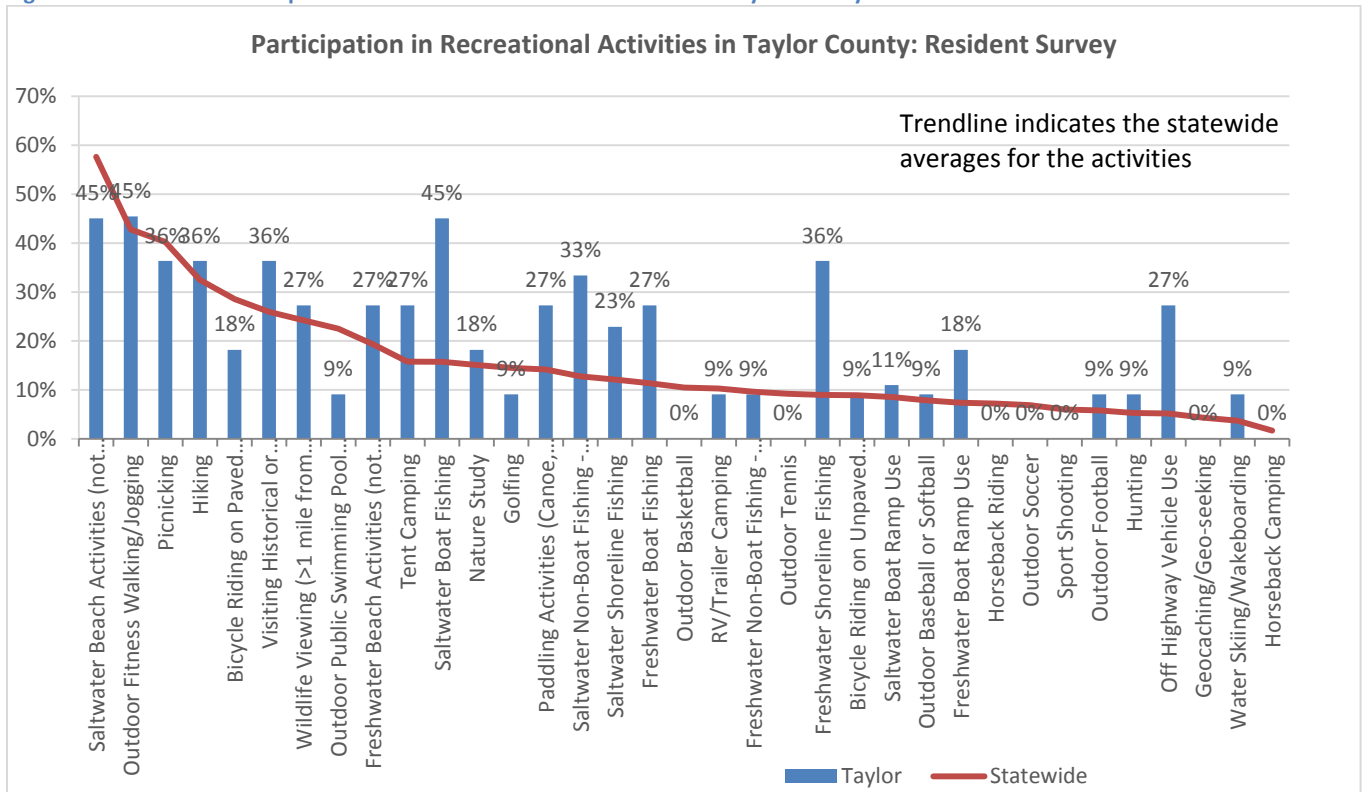


Figure 176. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Union County

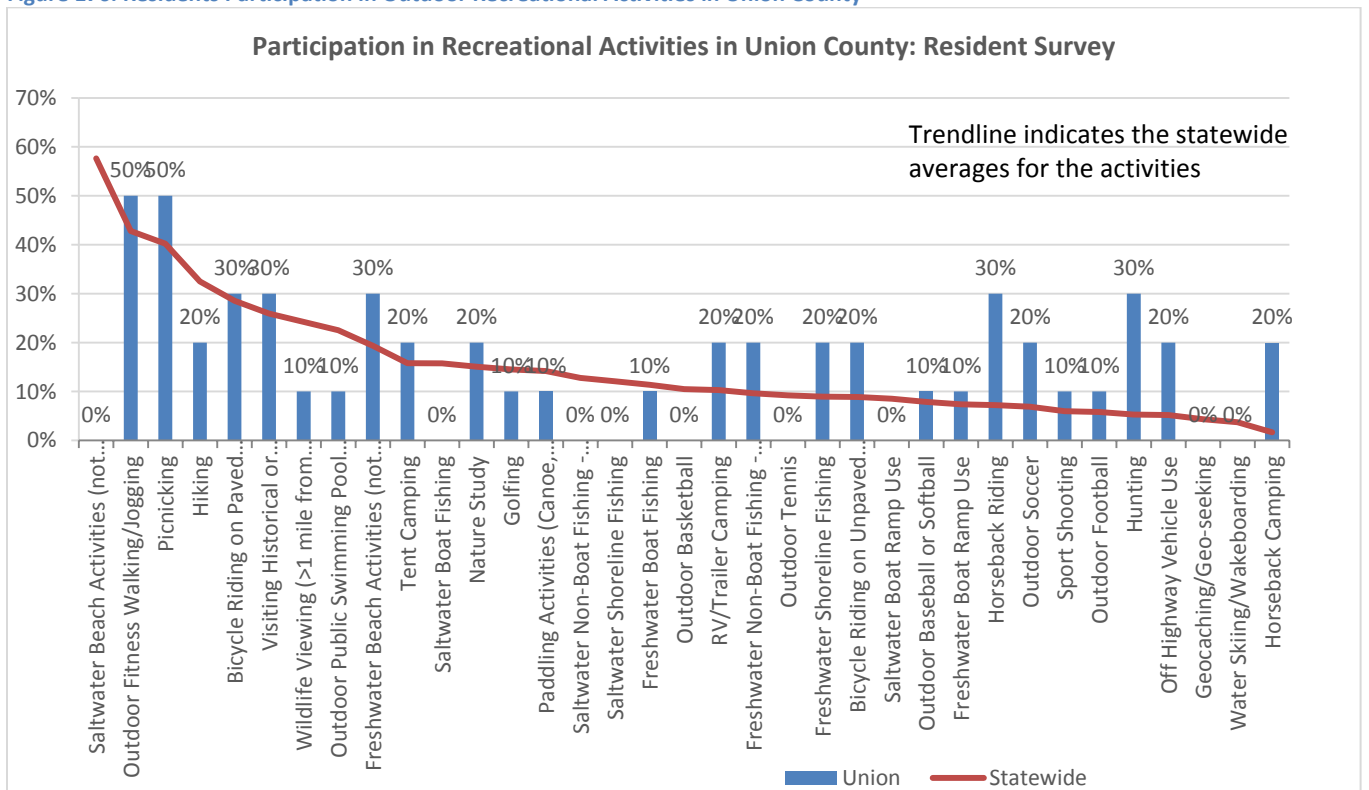


Figure 177. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Volusia County

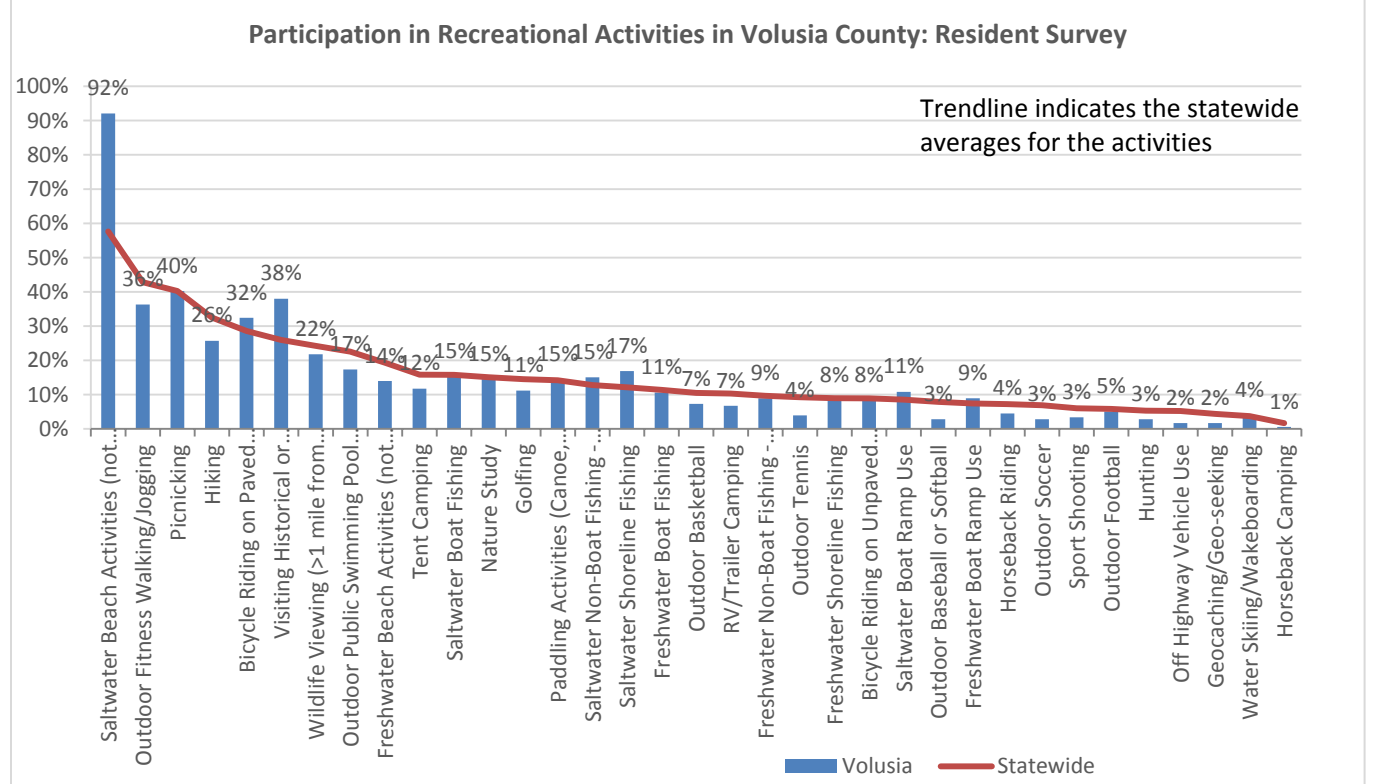


Figure 178. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Wakulla County

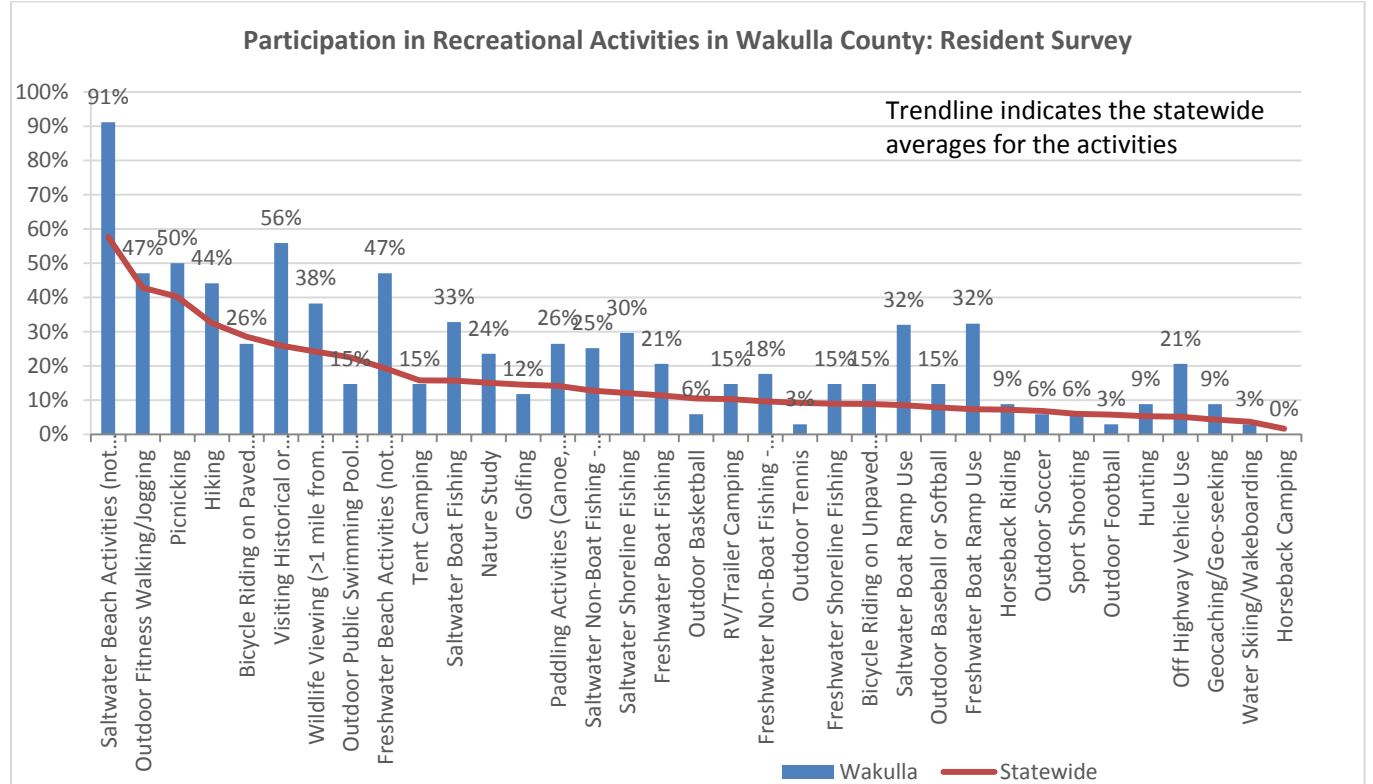


Figure 179. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Walton County

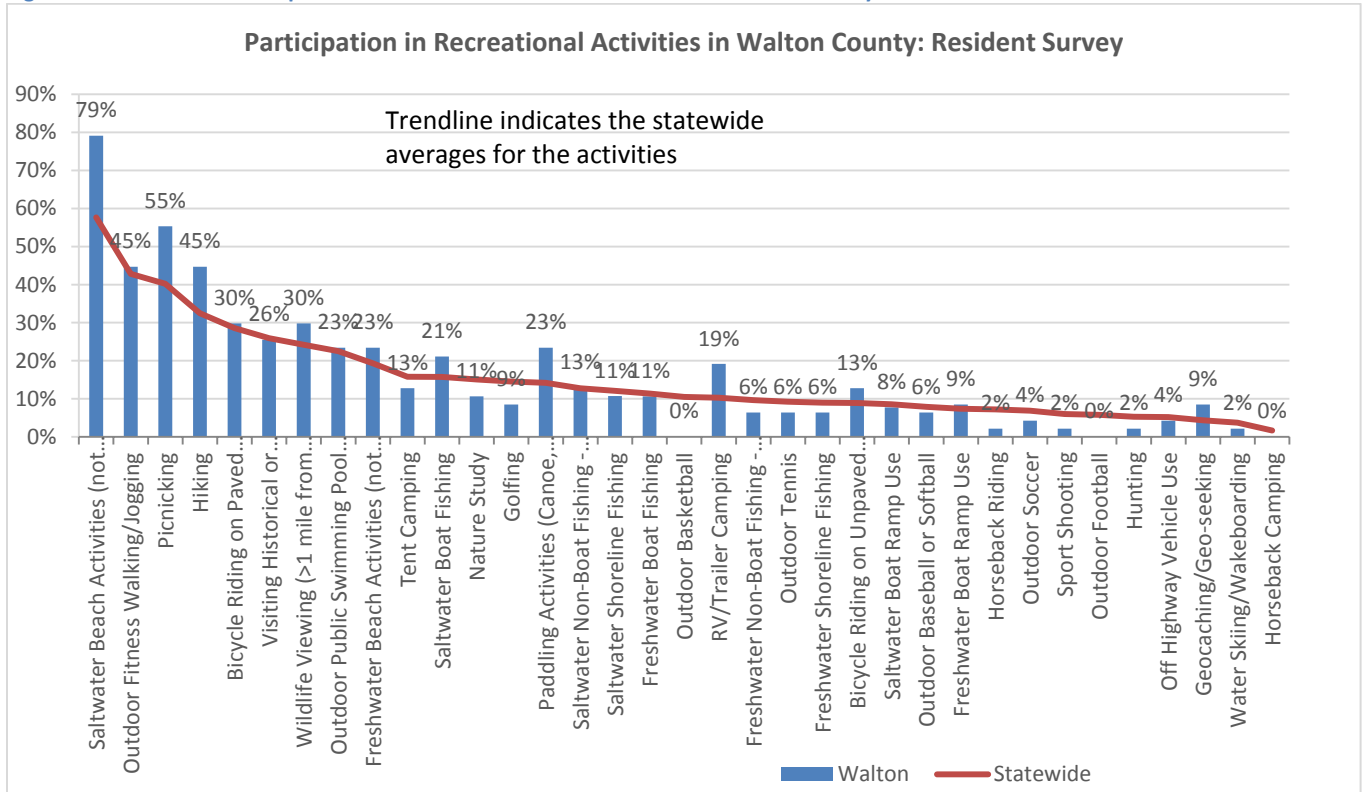
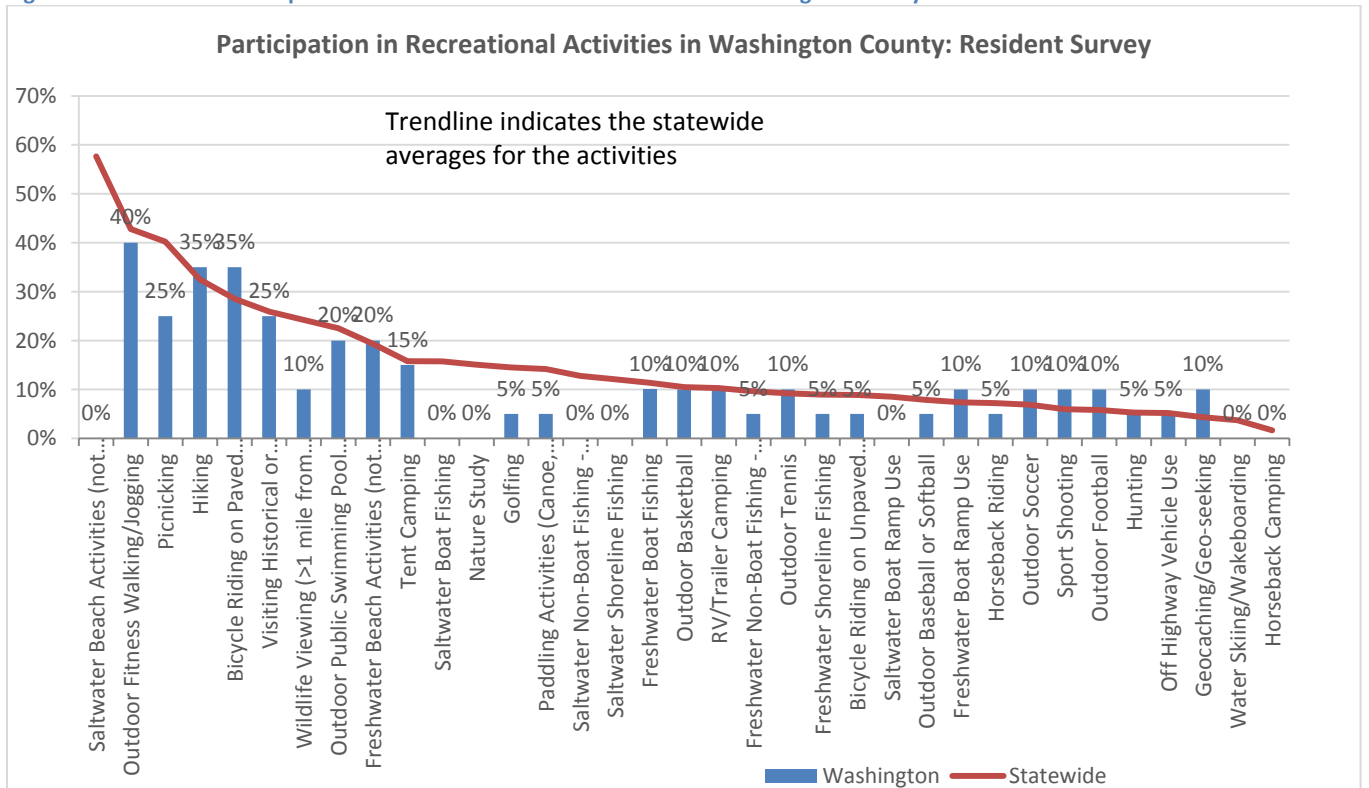


Figure 180. Residents Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Washington County

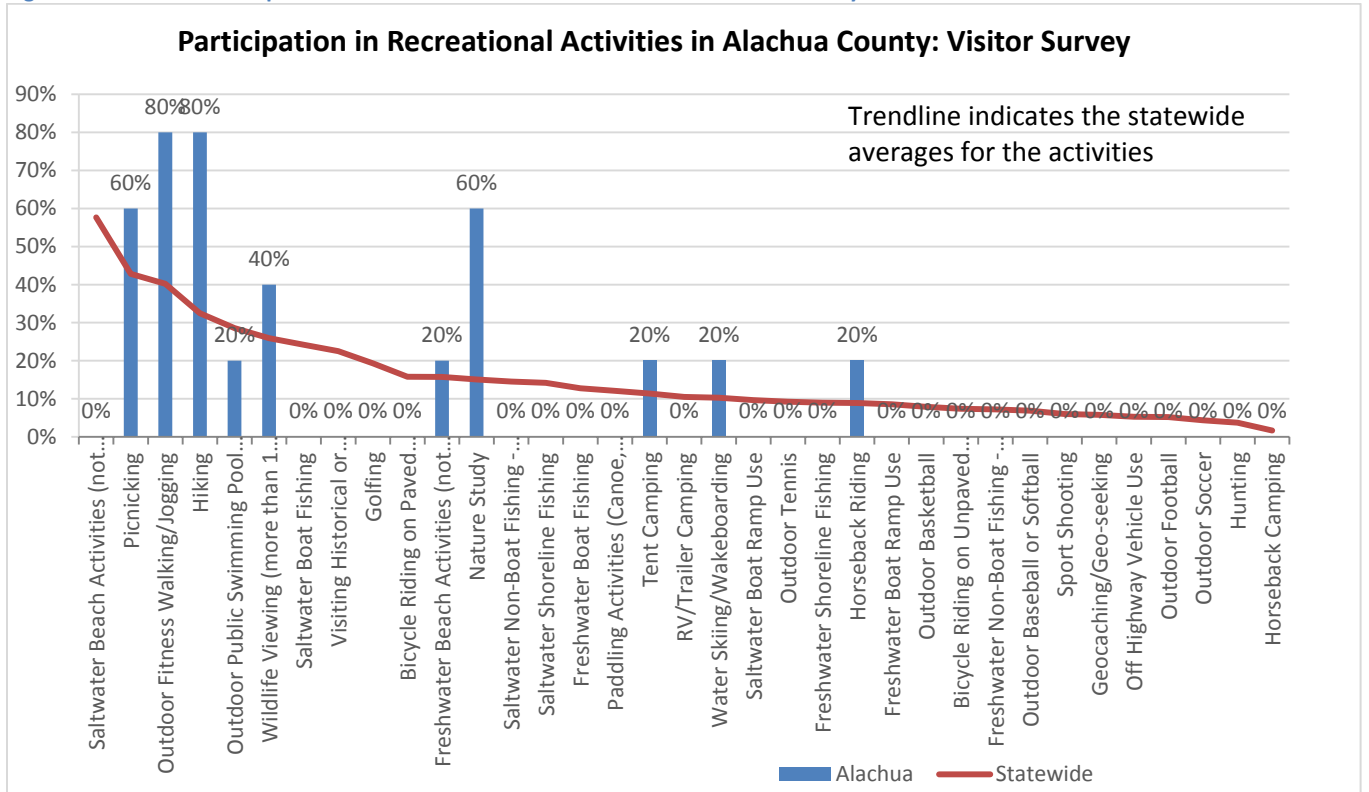


Figure 182. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Baker County

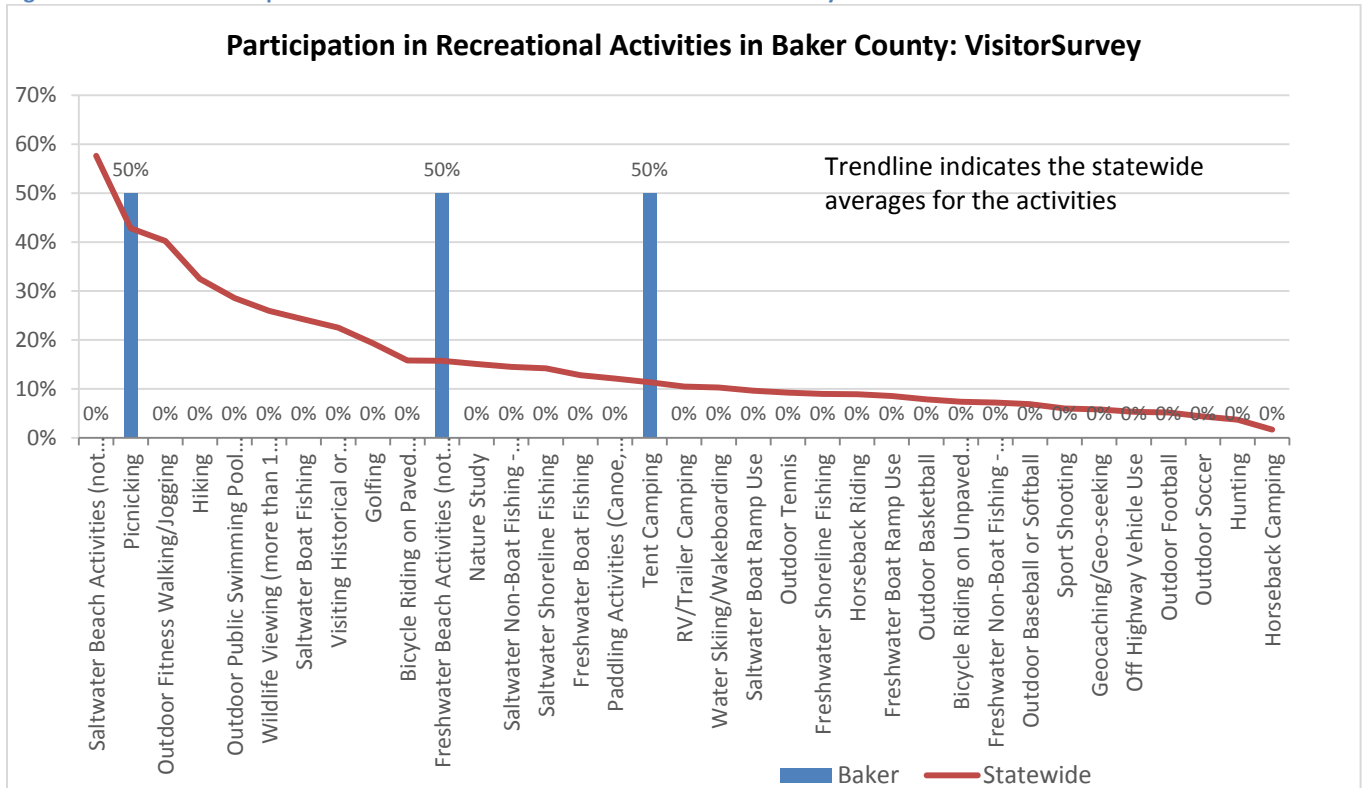


Figure 183. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Bay County

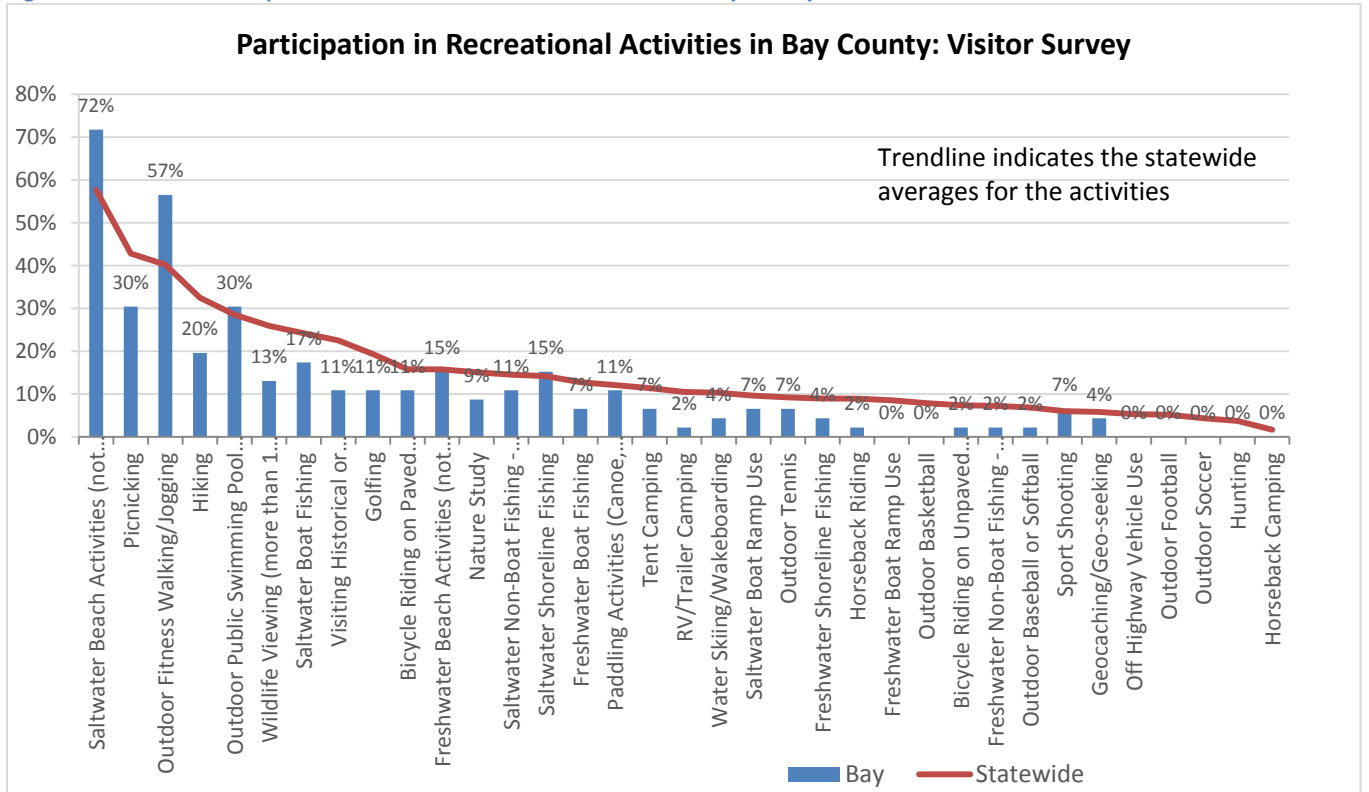


Figure 184. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Bradford County

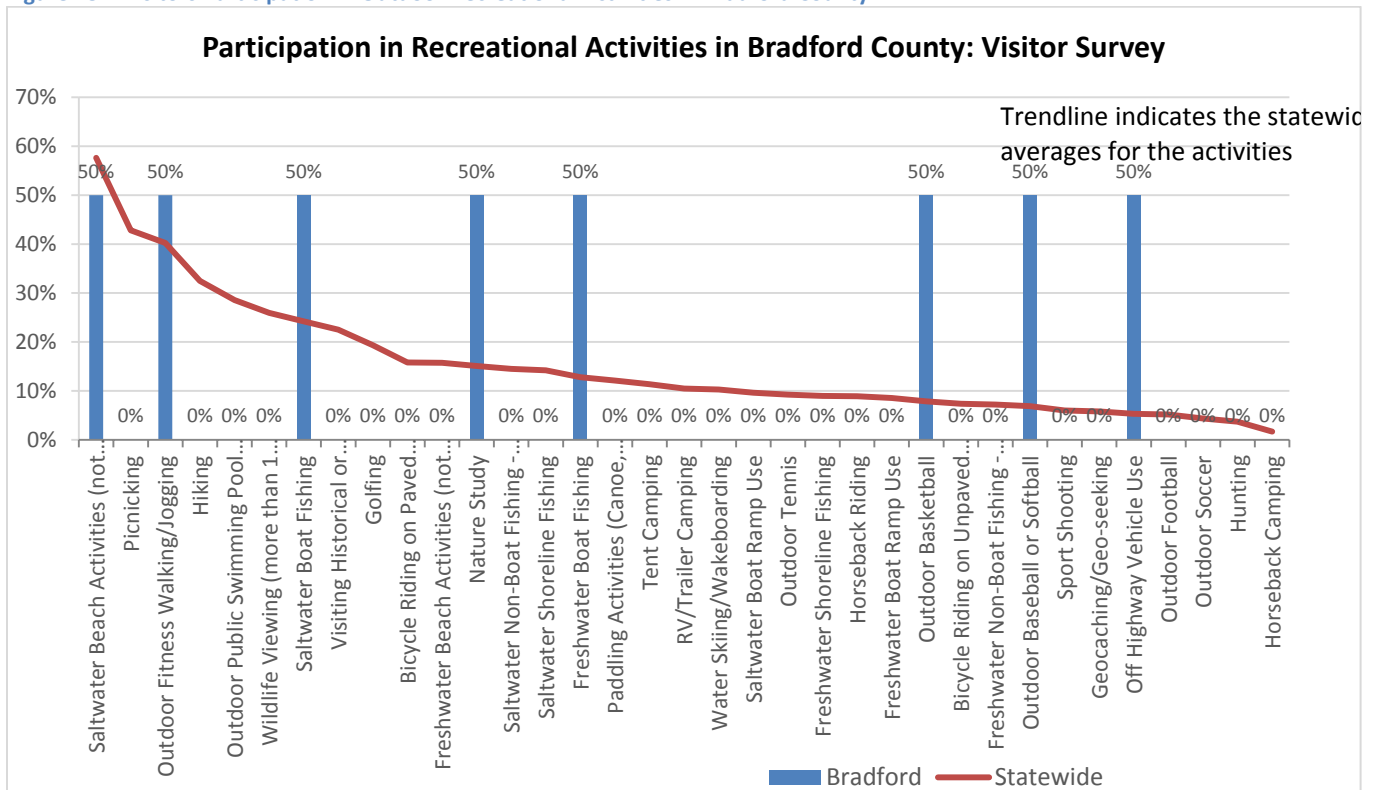


Figure 185. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Brevard County

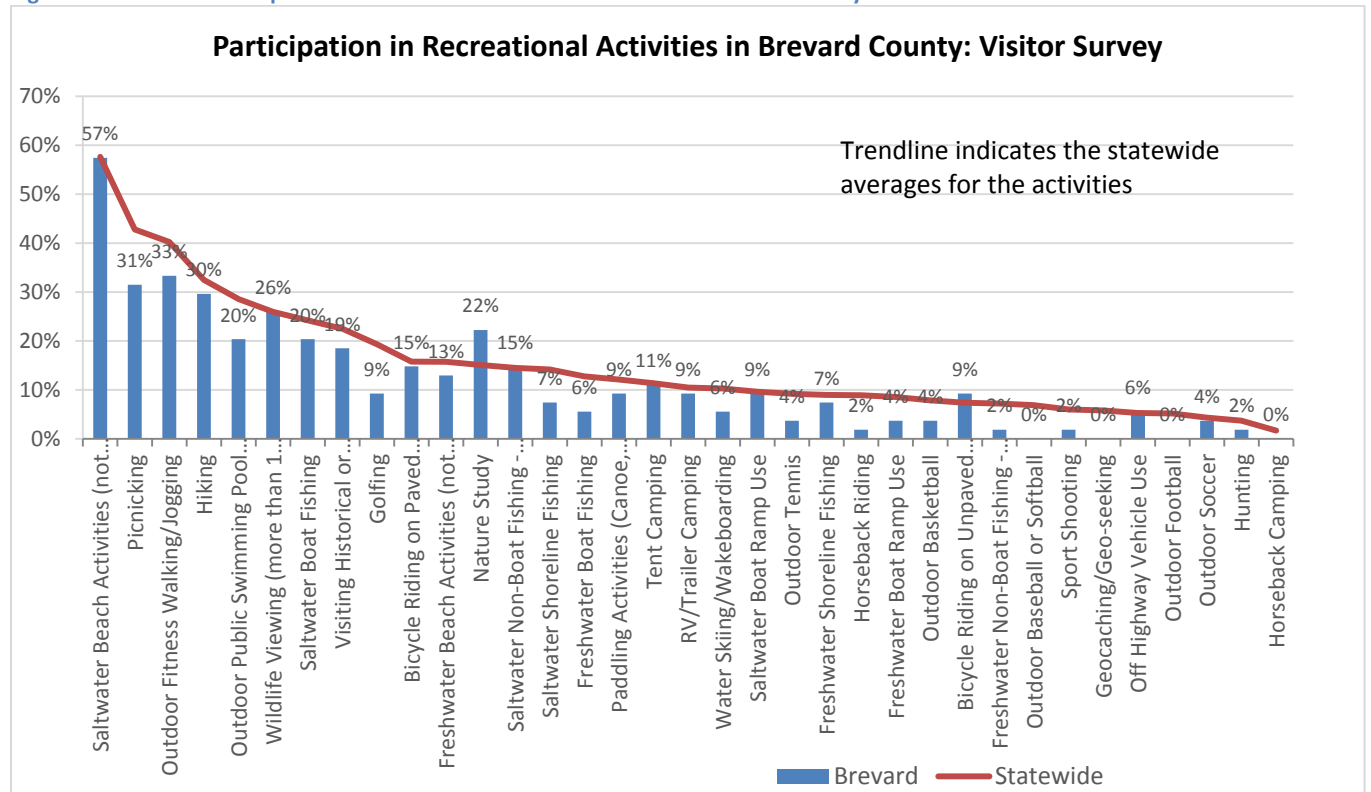


Figure 186. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Broward County

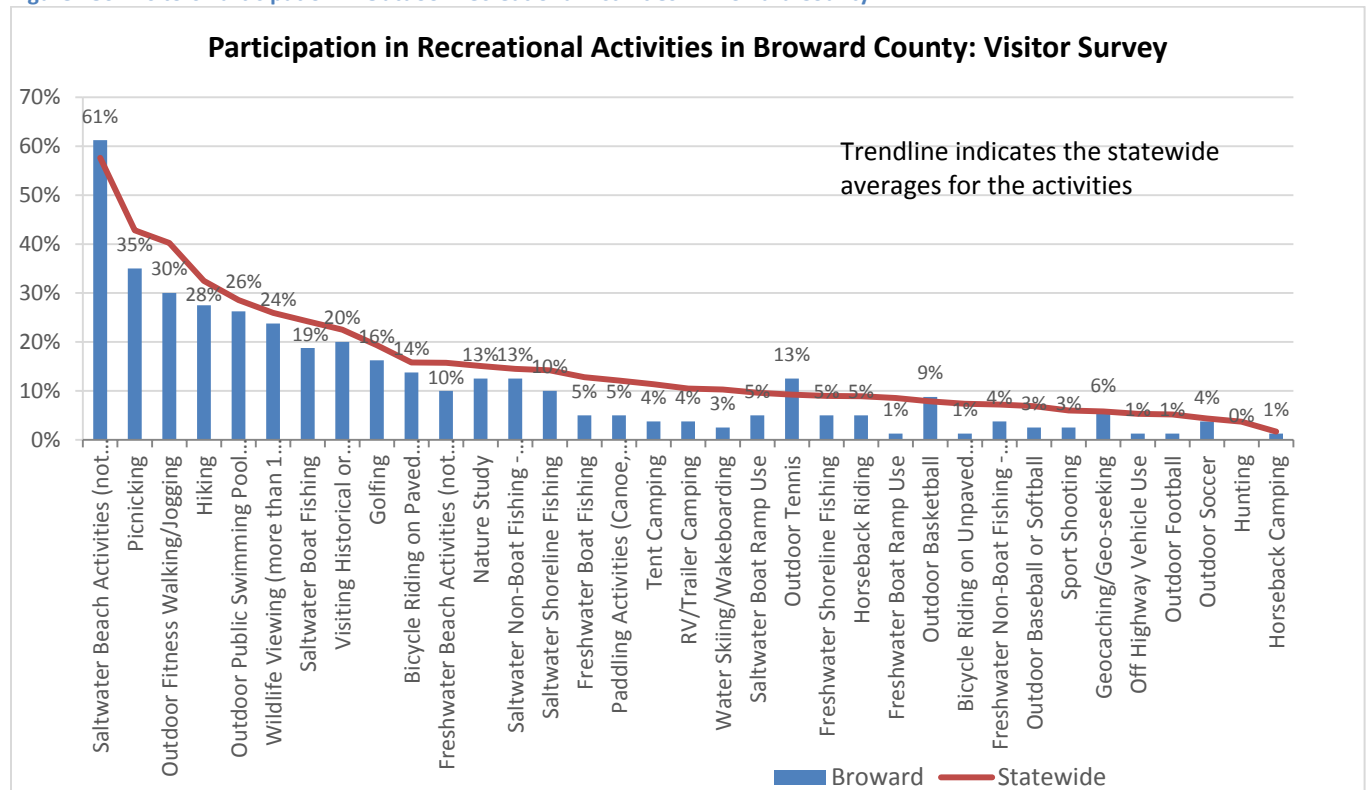


Figure 187. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Calhoun County

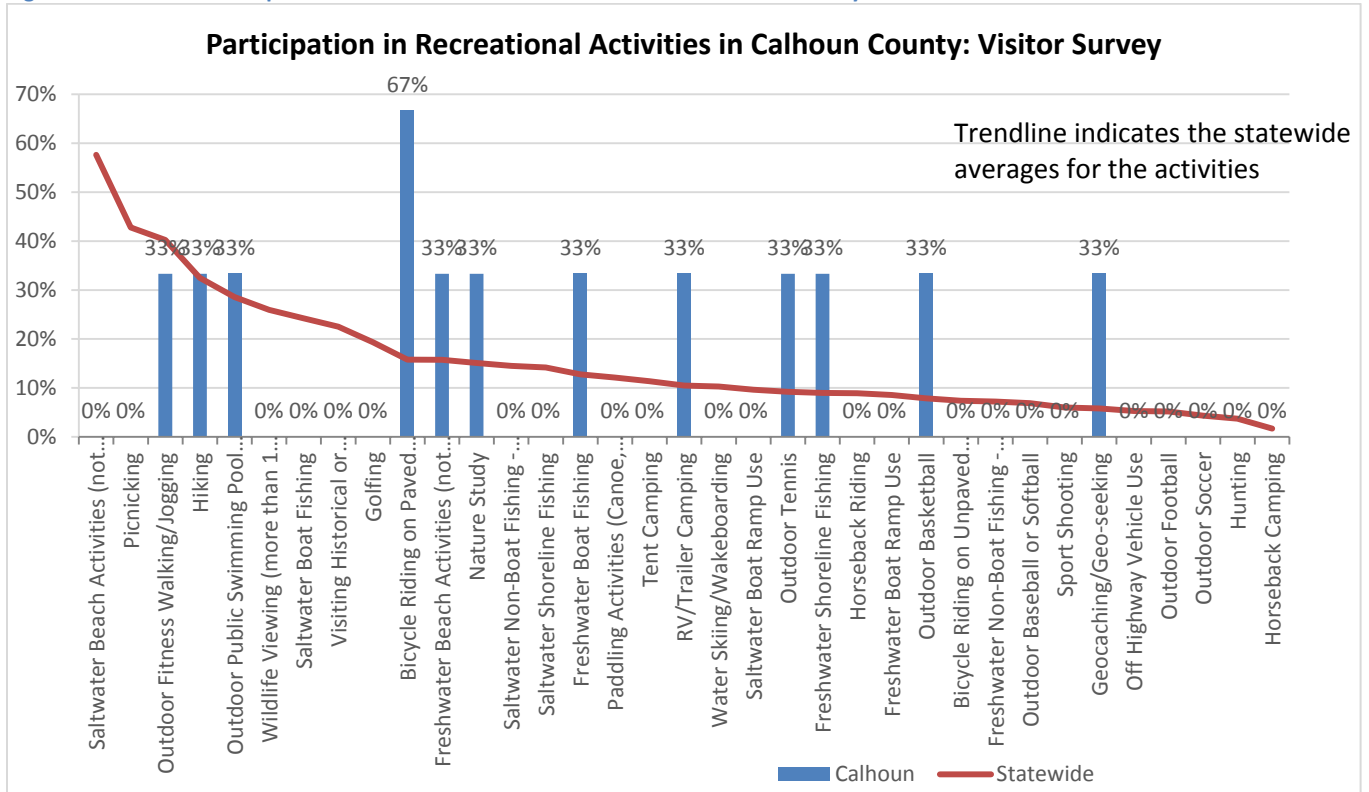


Figure 188. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Charlotte County

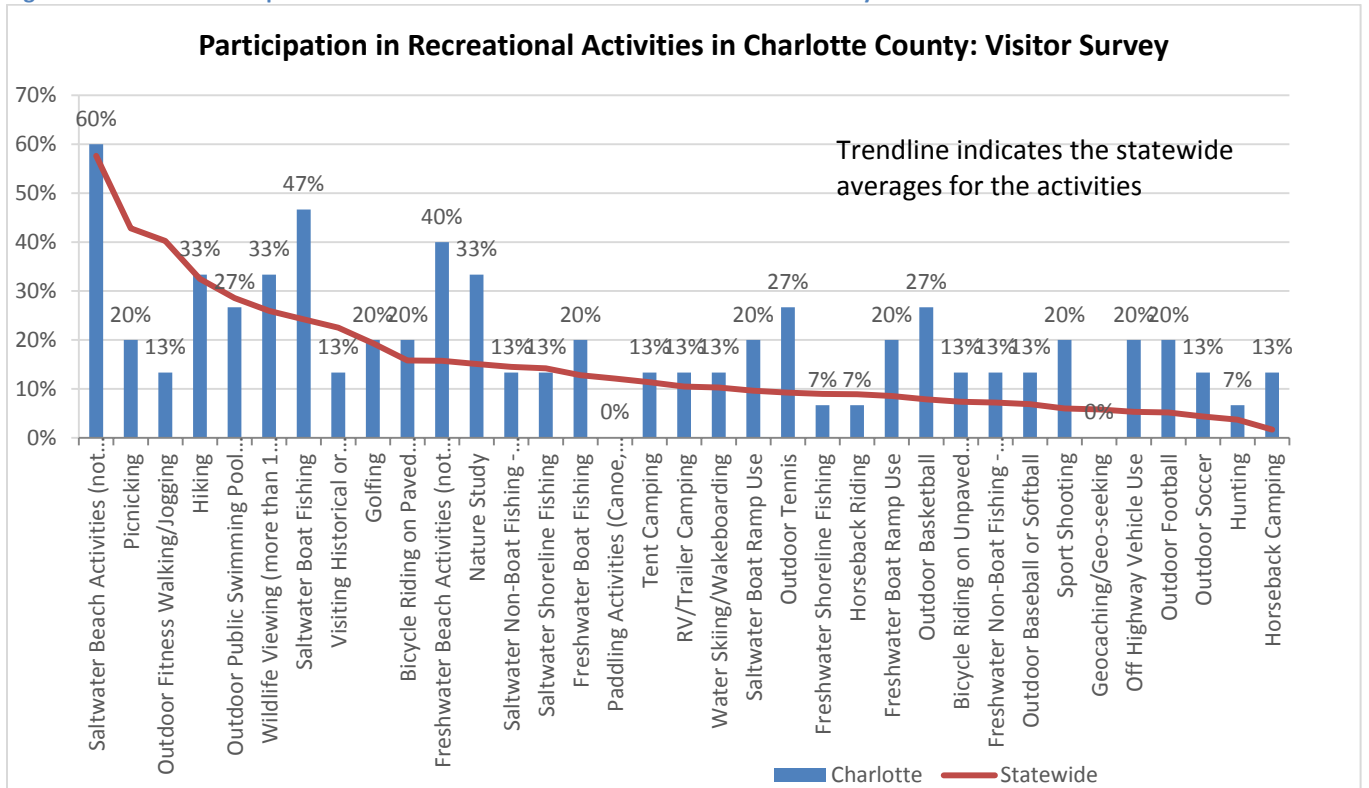


Figure 189. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Citrus County

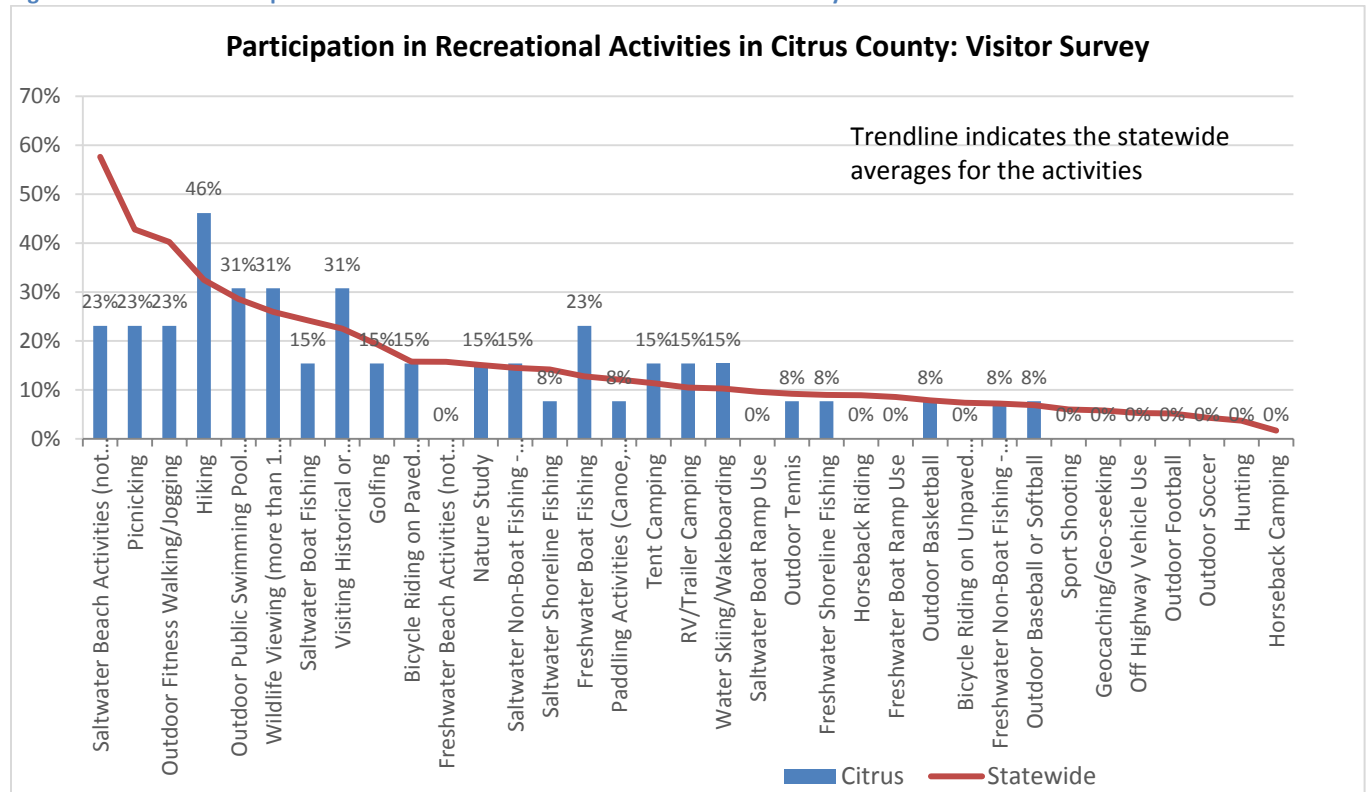


Figure 190. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Clay County

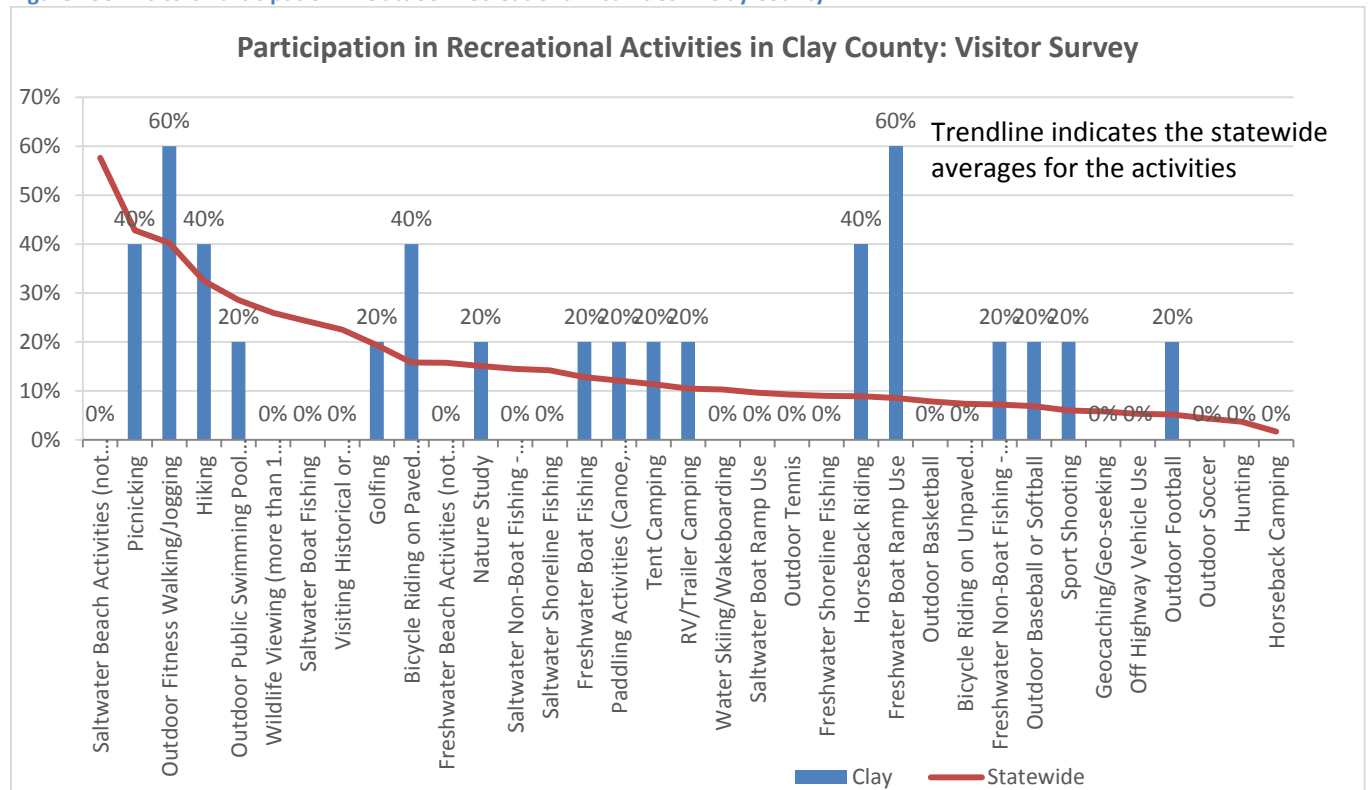


Figure 191. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Collier County

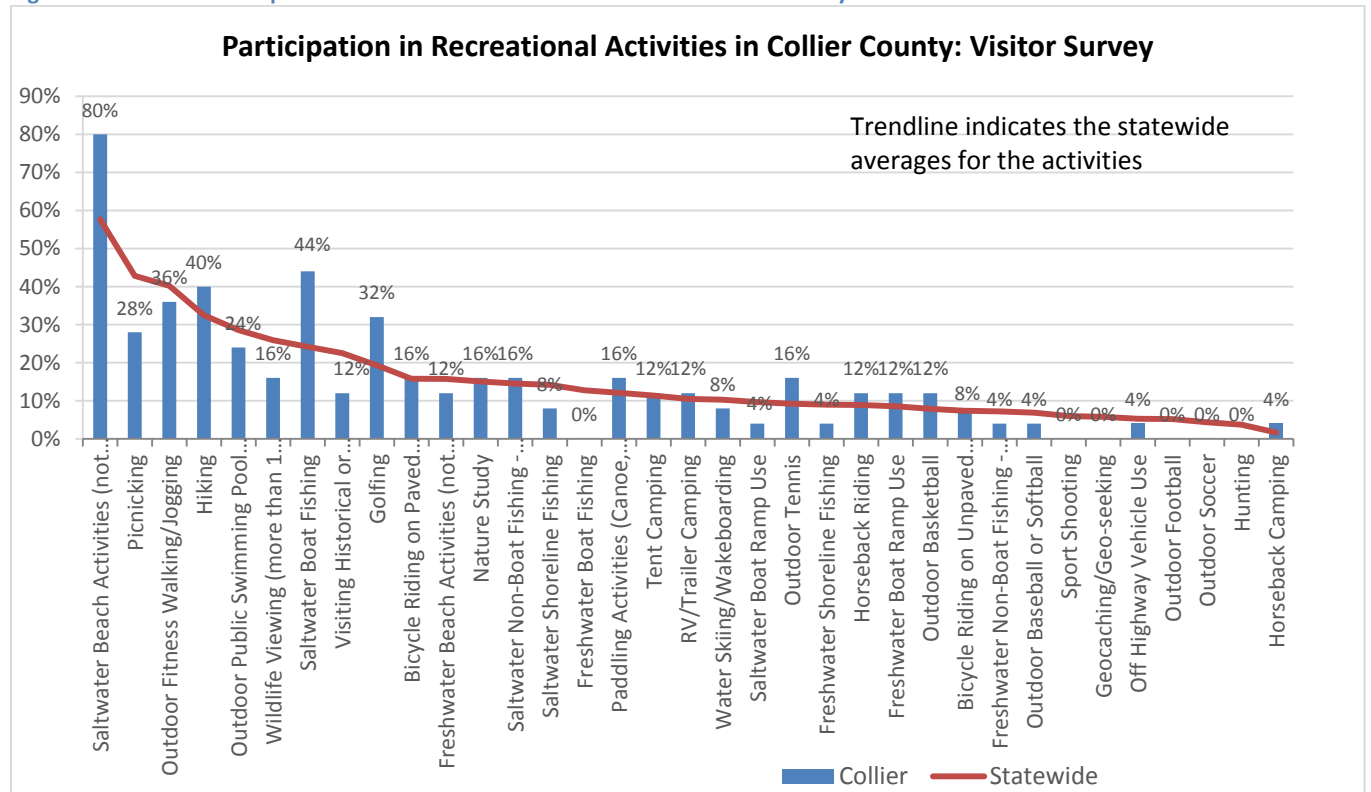


Figure 192. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Columbia County

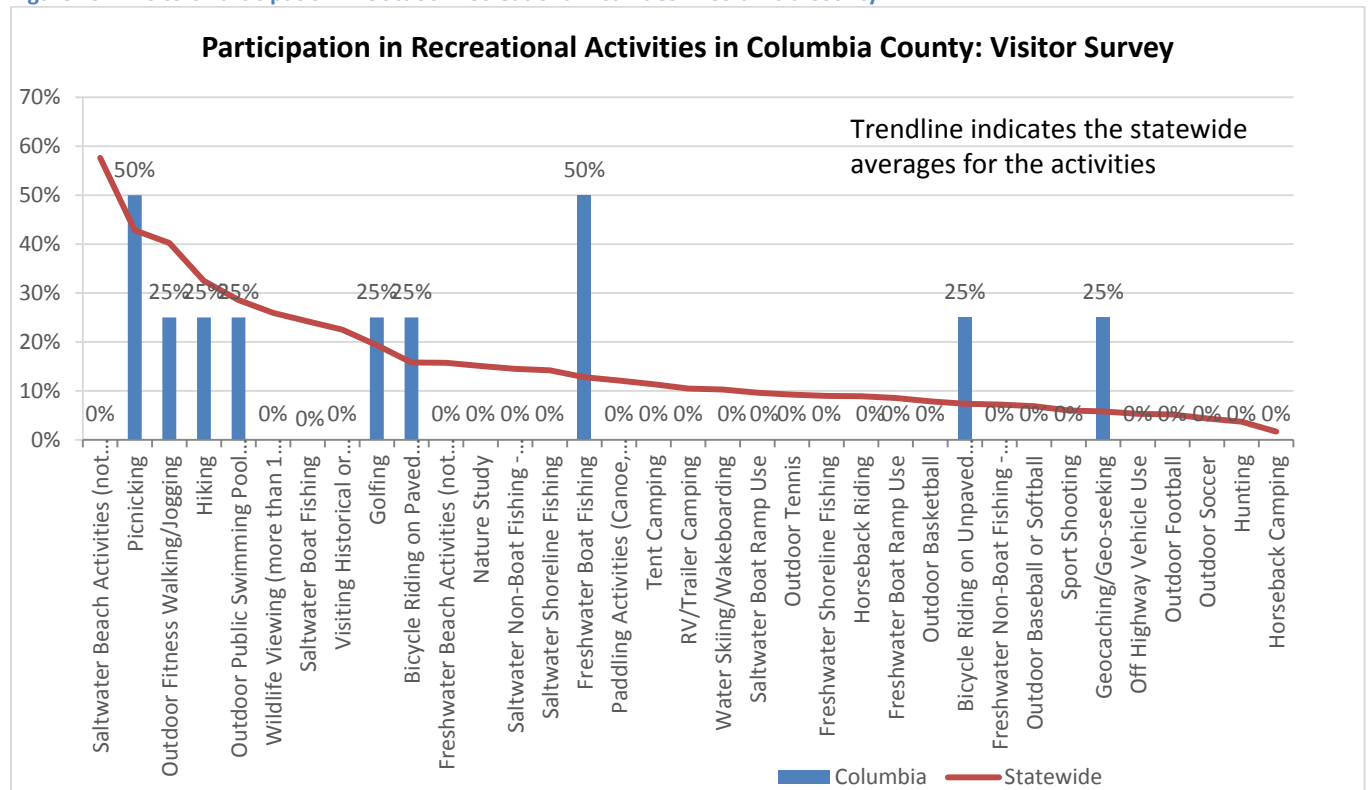


Figure 193. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in DeSoto County

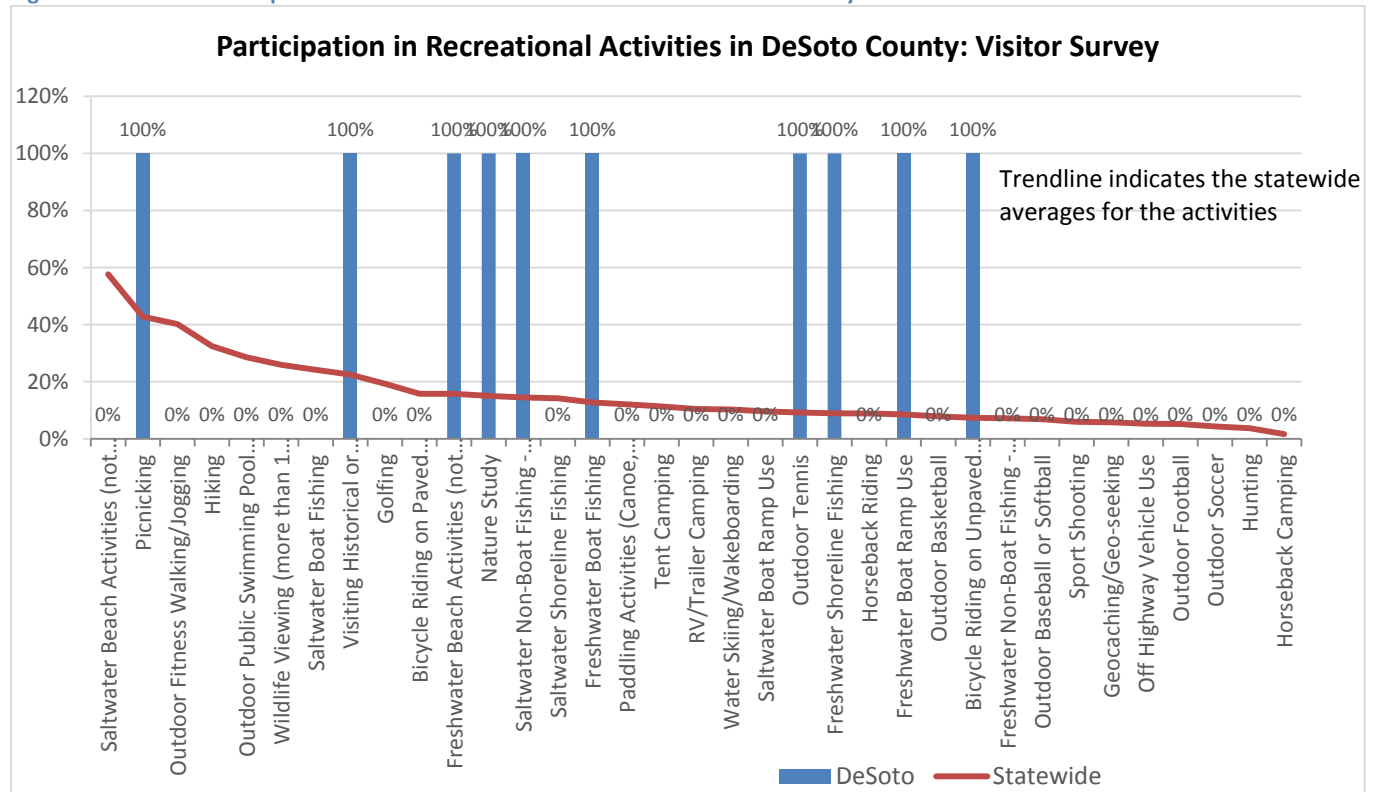


Figure 194. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Dixie County

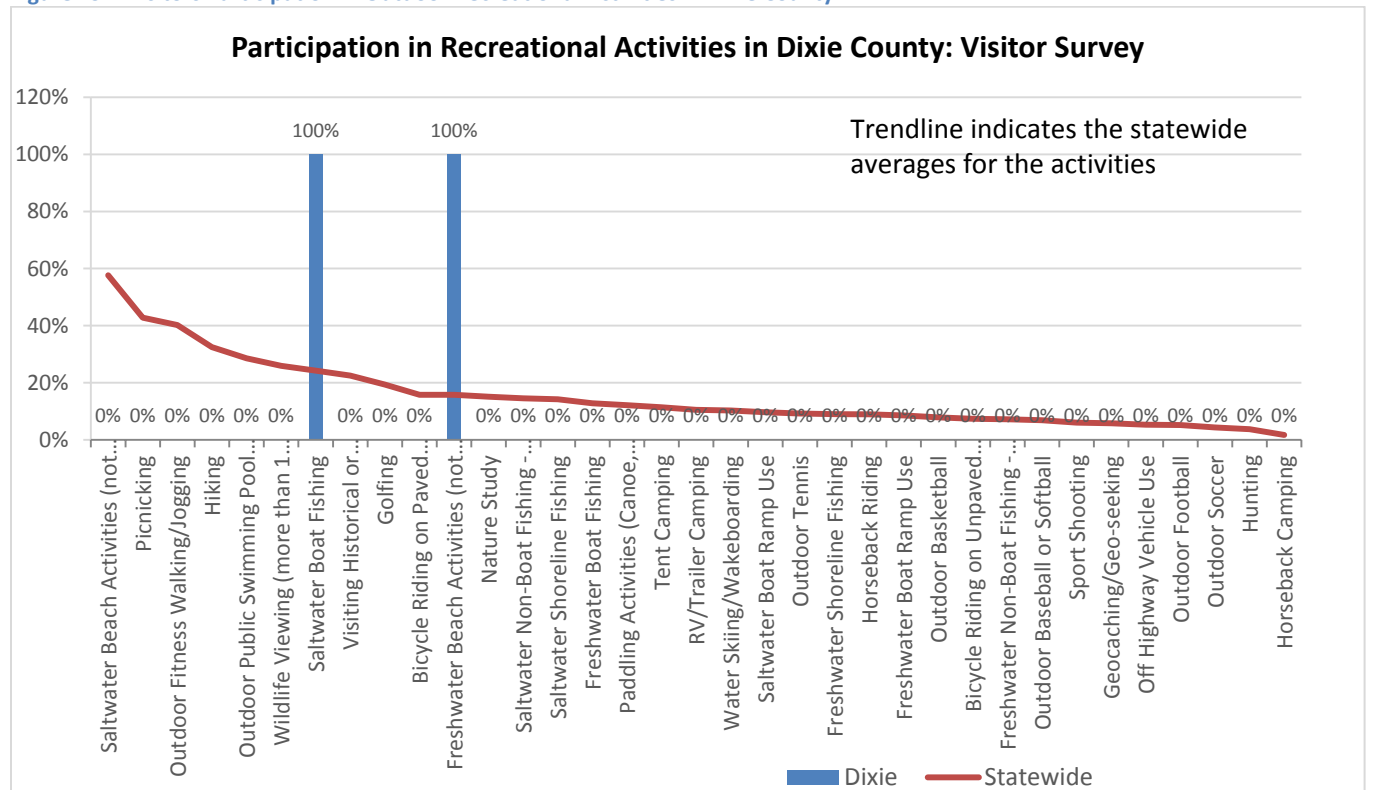


Figure 195. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Duval County

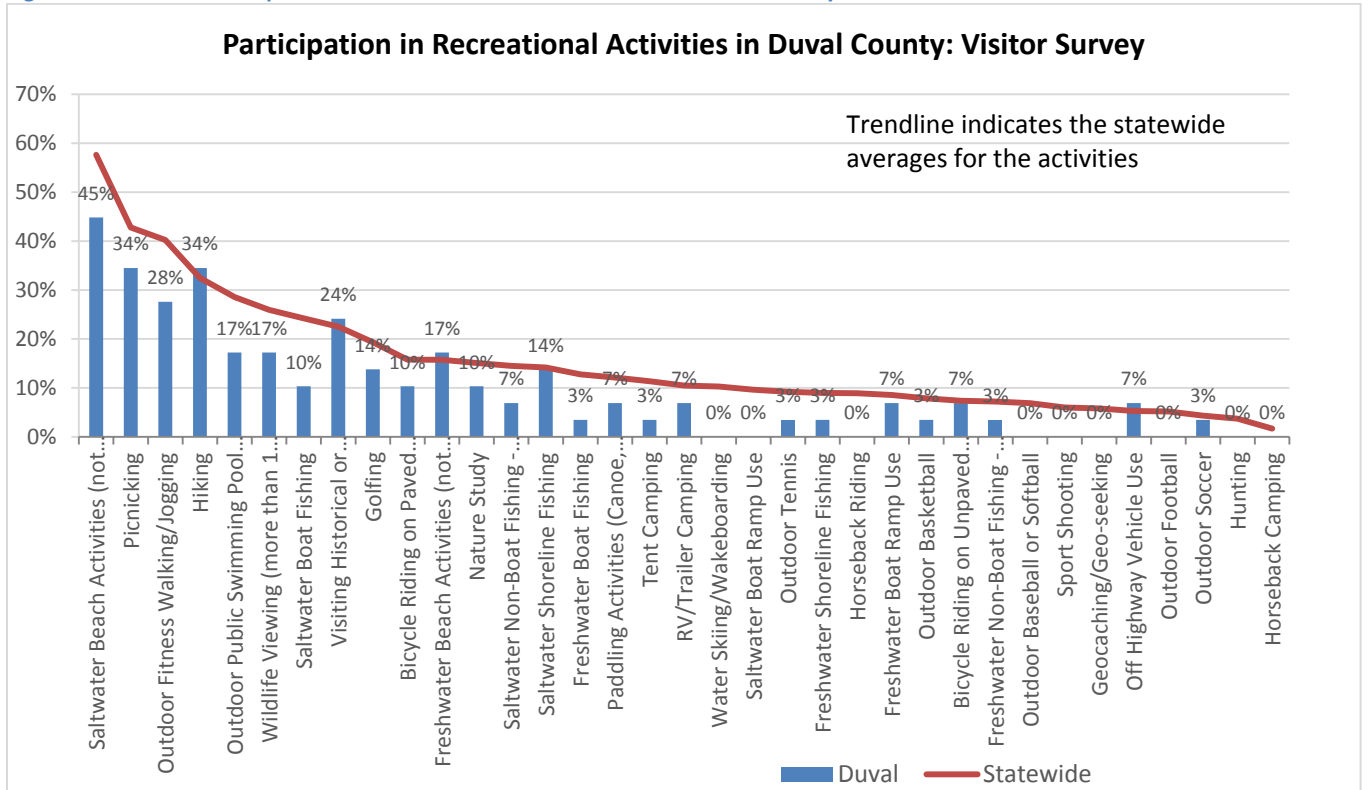


Figure 196. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Escambia County

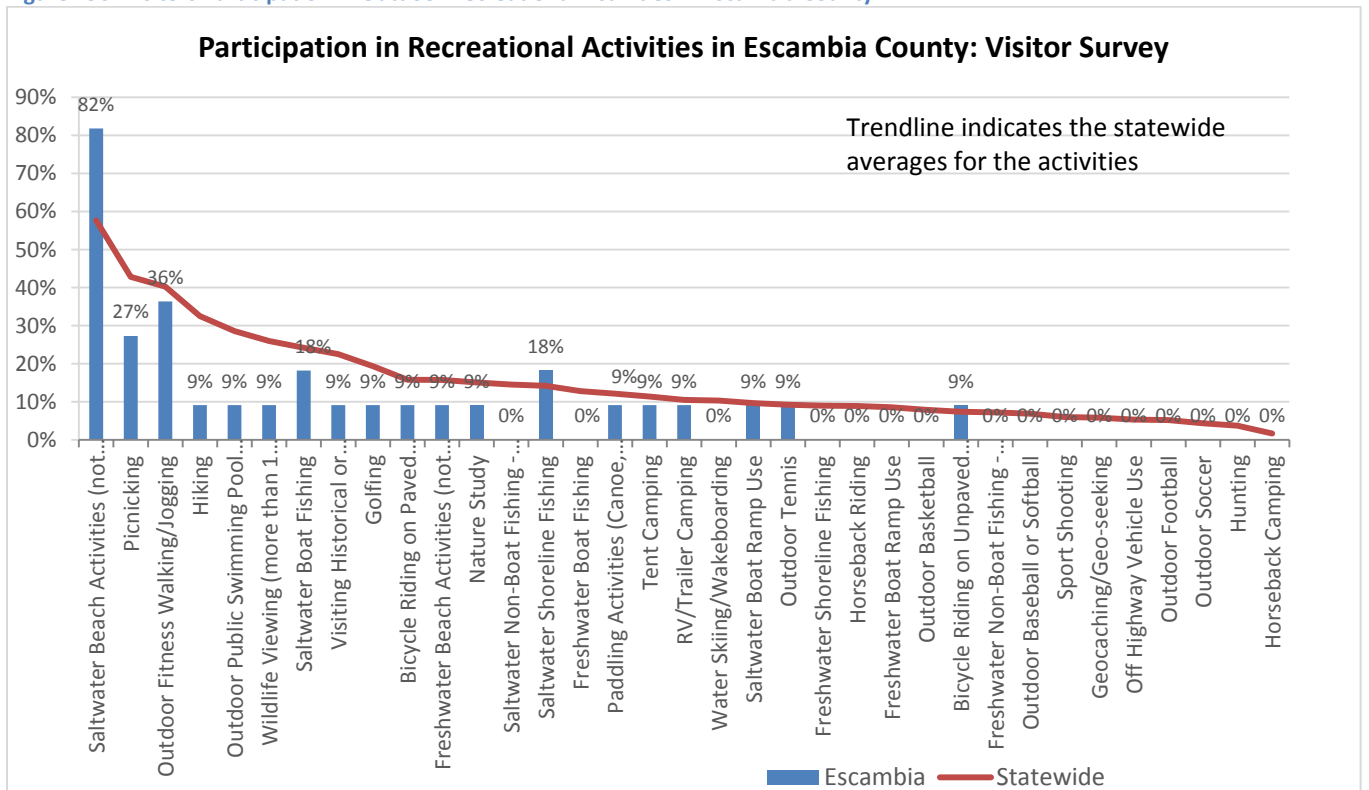


Figure 197. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Flagler County

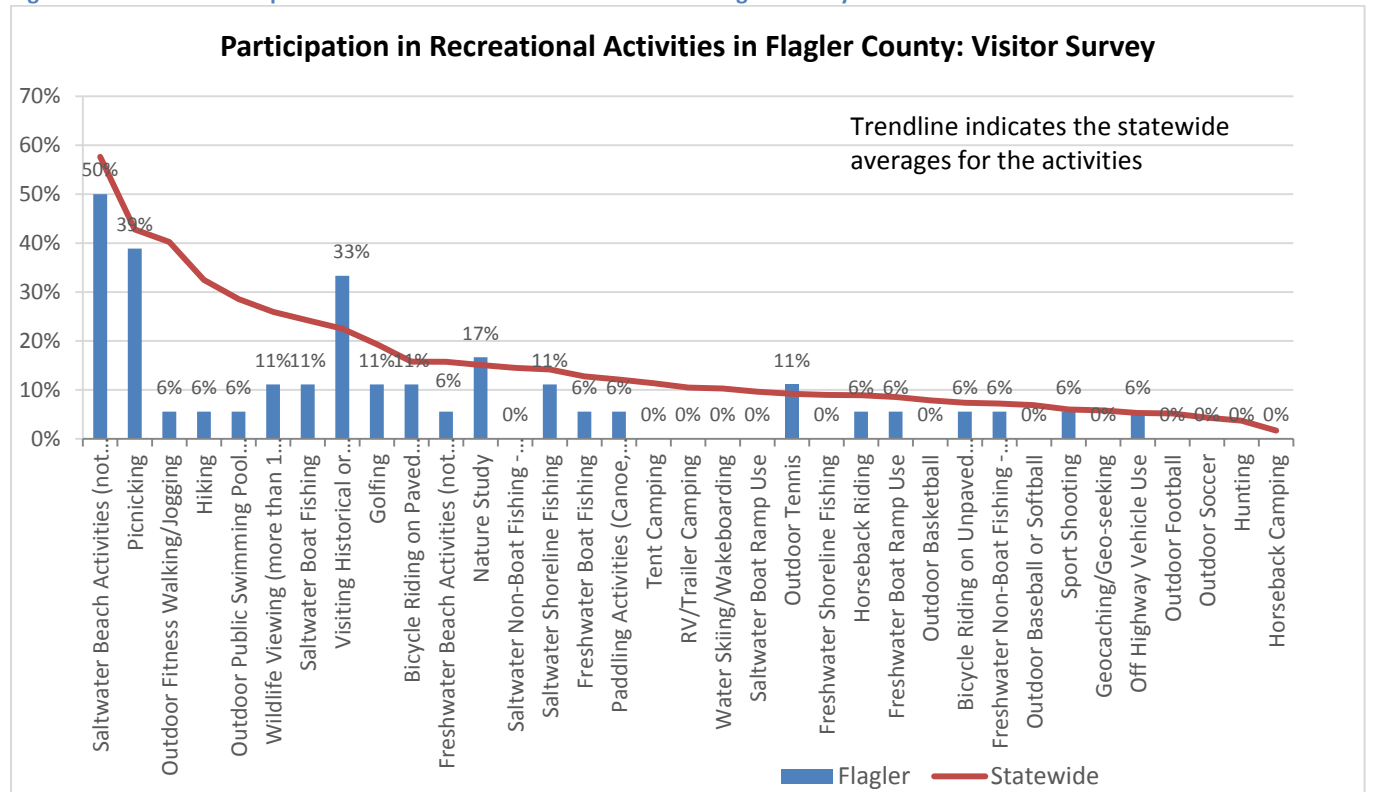


Figure 198. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Franklin County

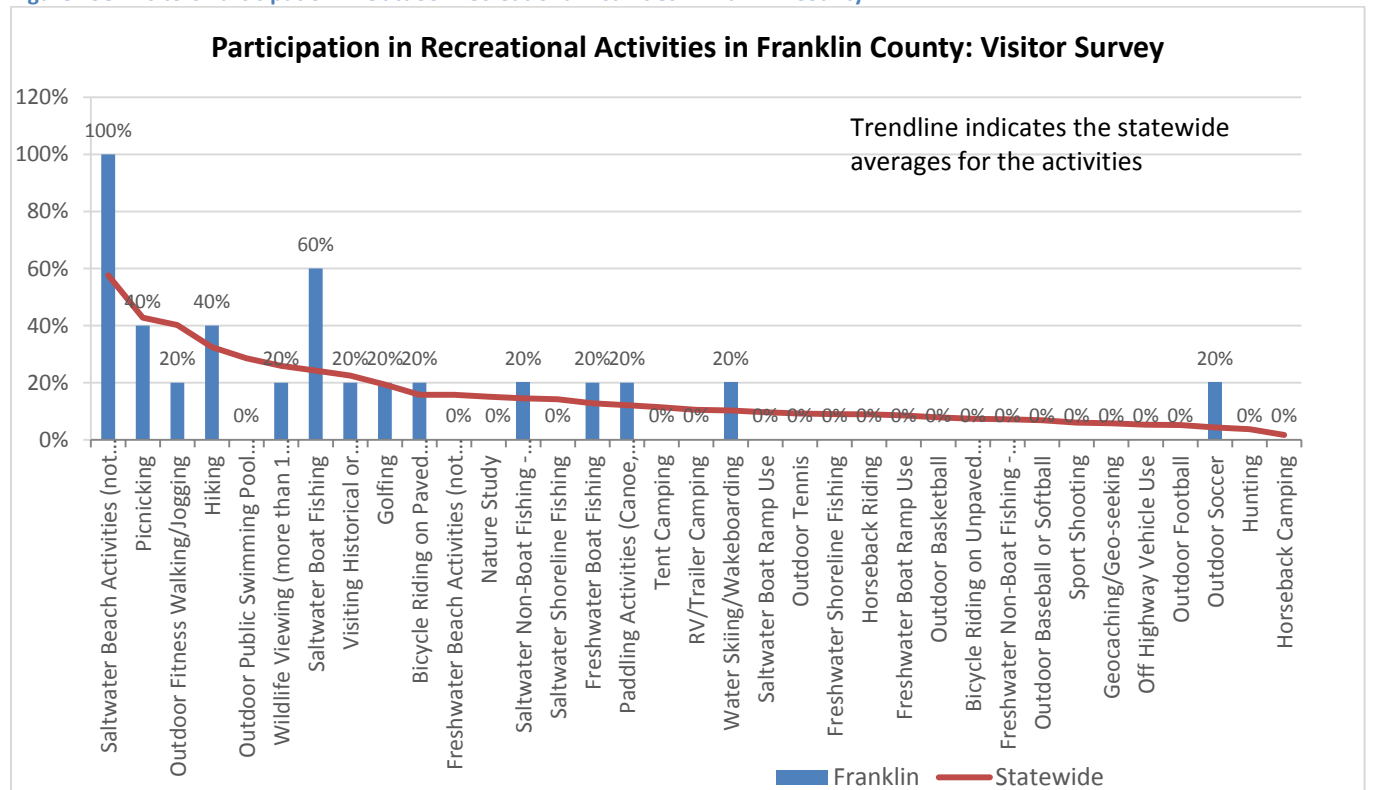


Figure 199. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Gadsden County

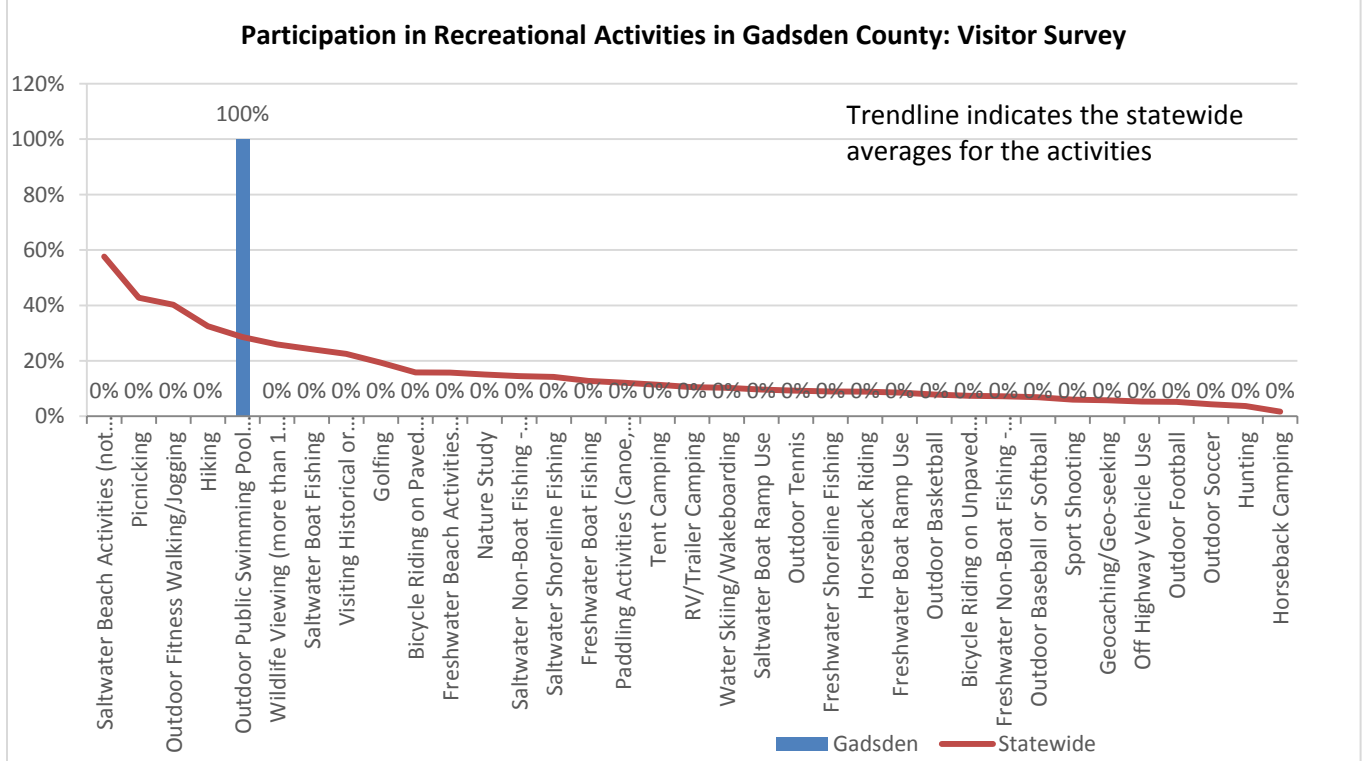


Figure 200. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Gilchrist County

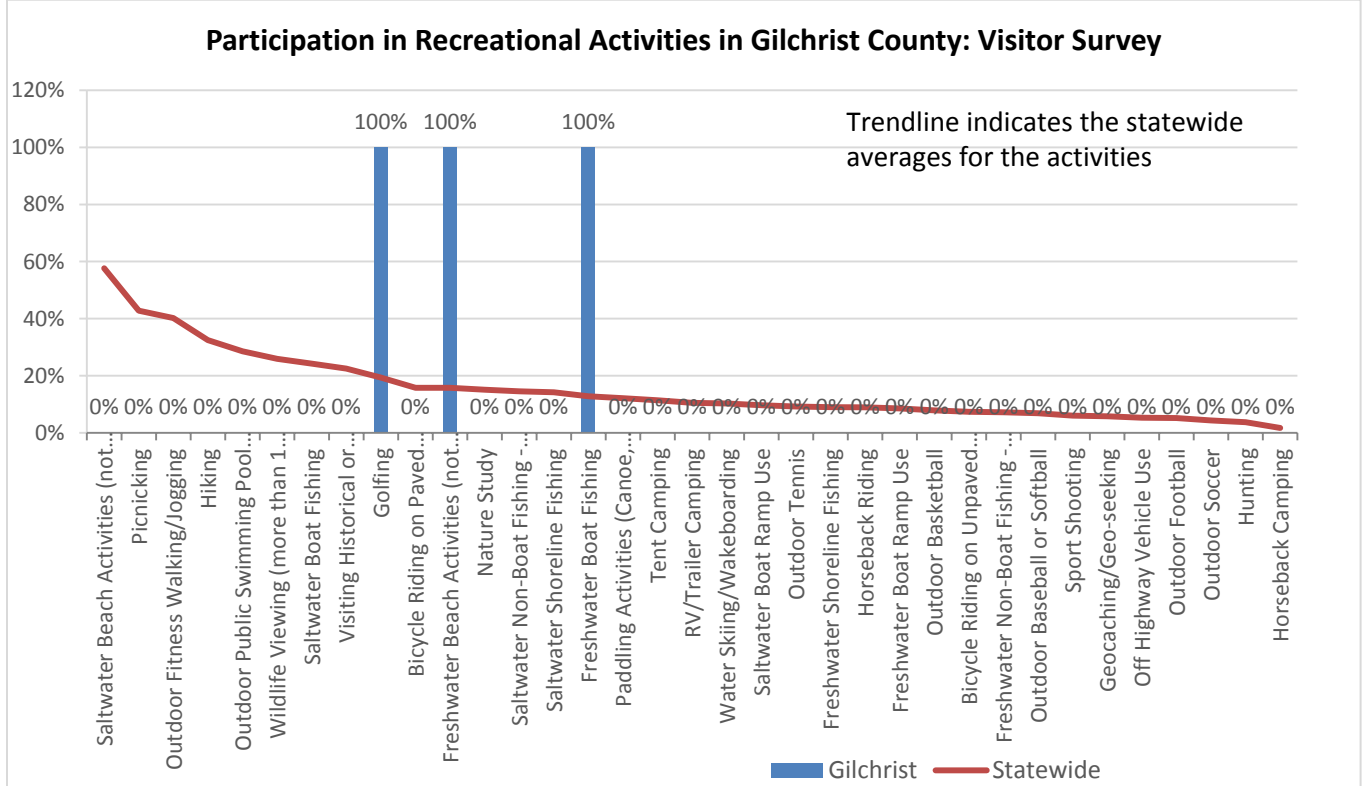


Figure 201. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Glades County

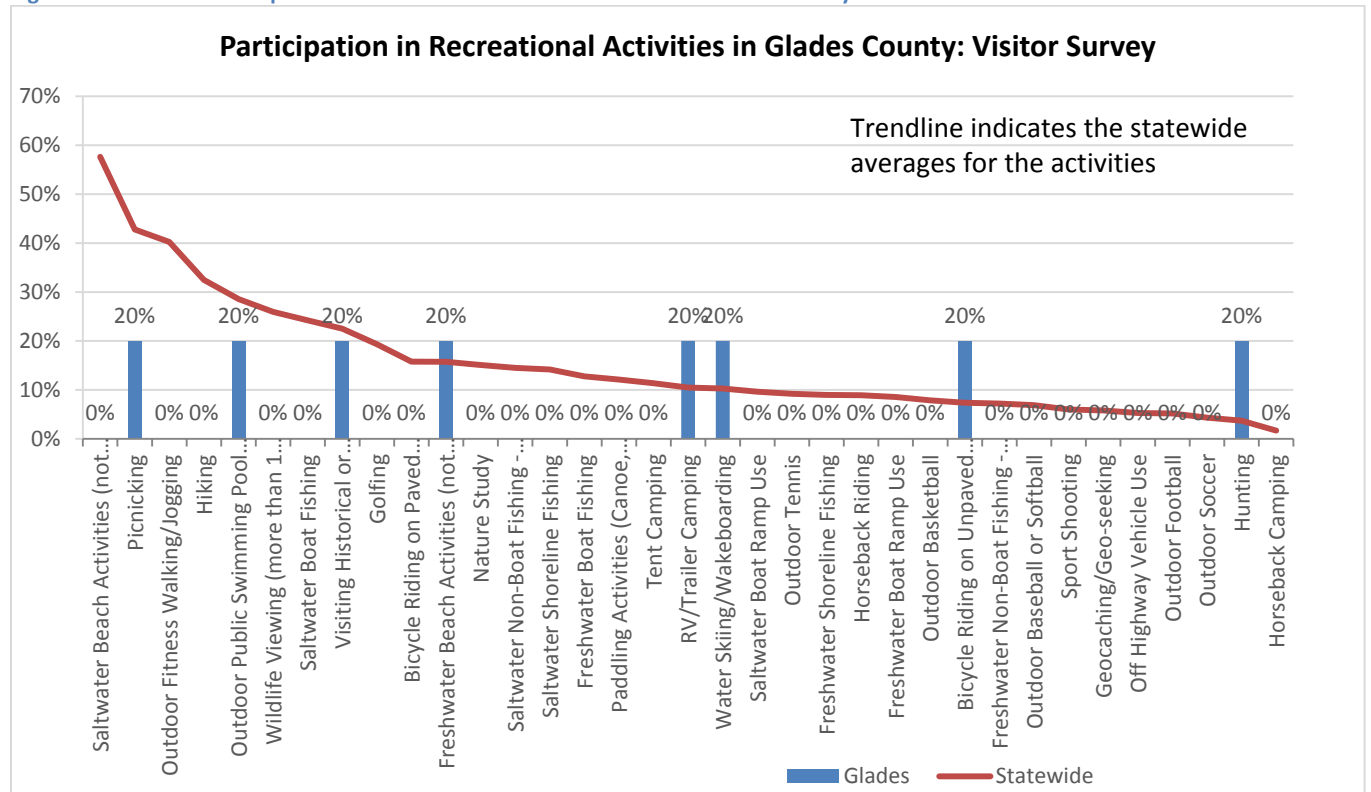


Figure 202. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Gulf County

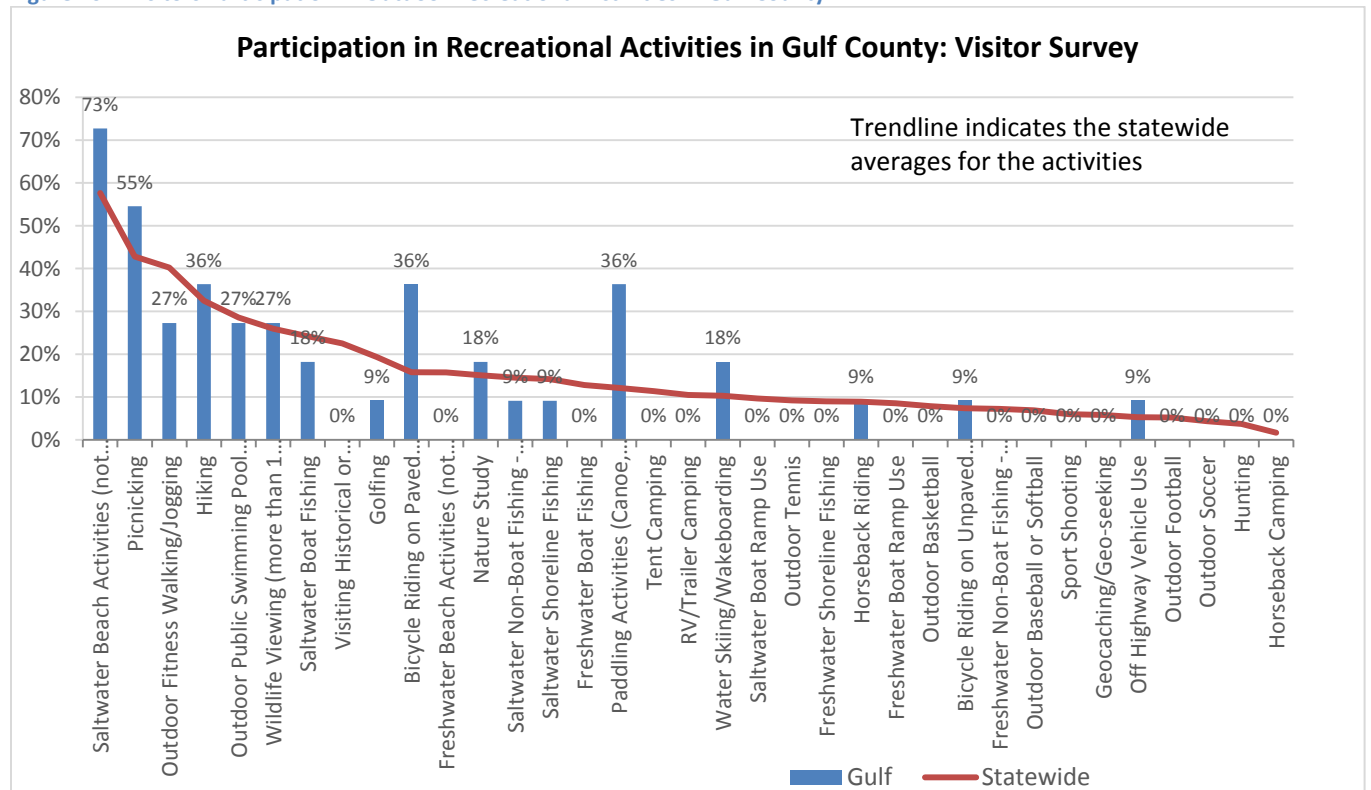


Figure 203. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Hamilton County

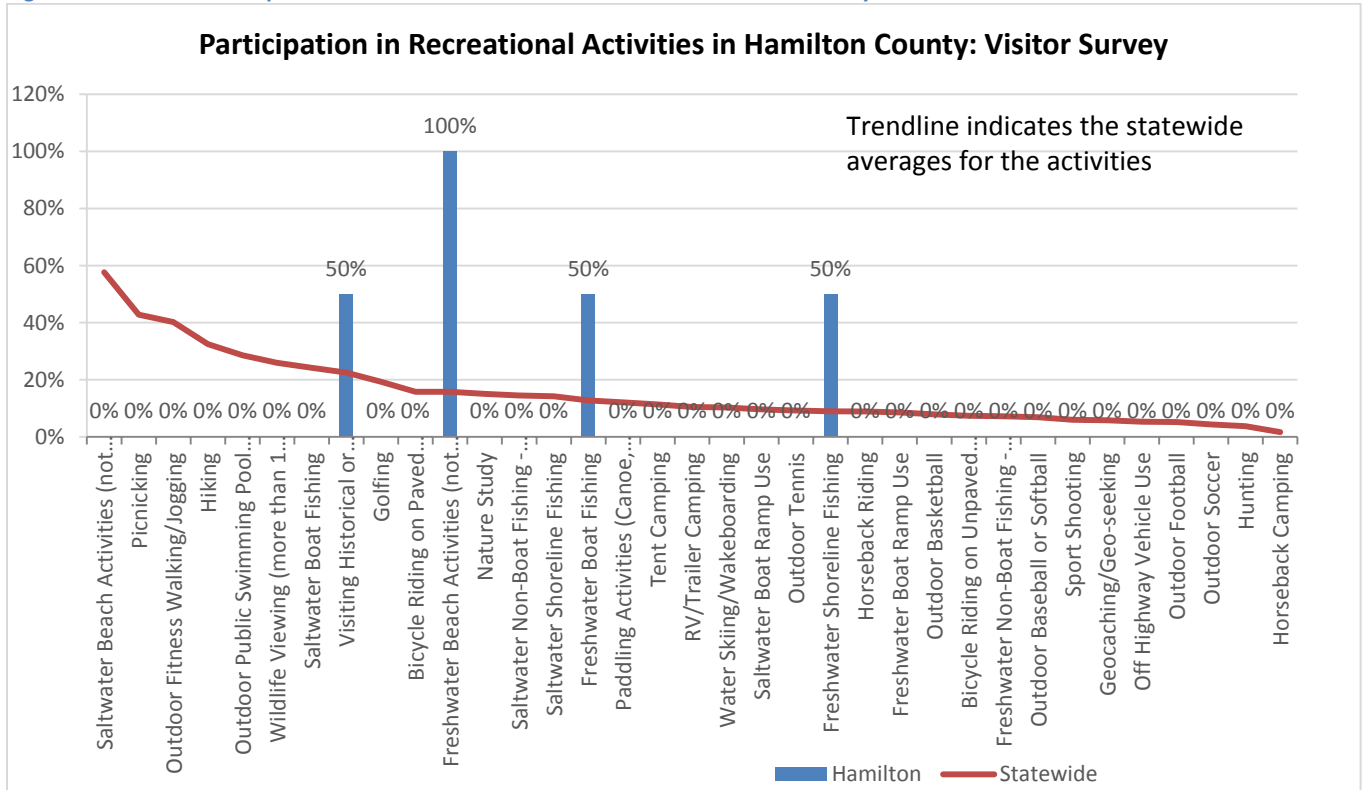


Figure 204. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Hardee County

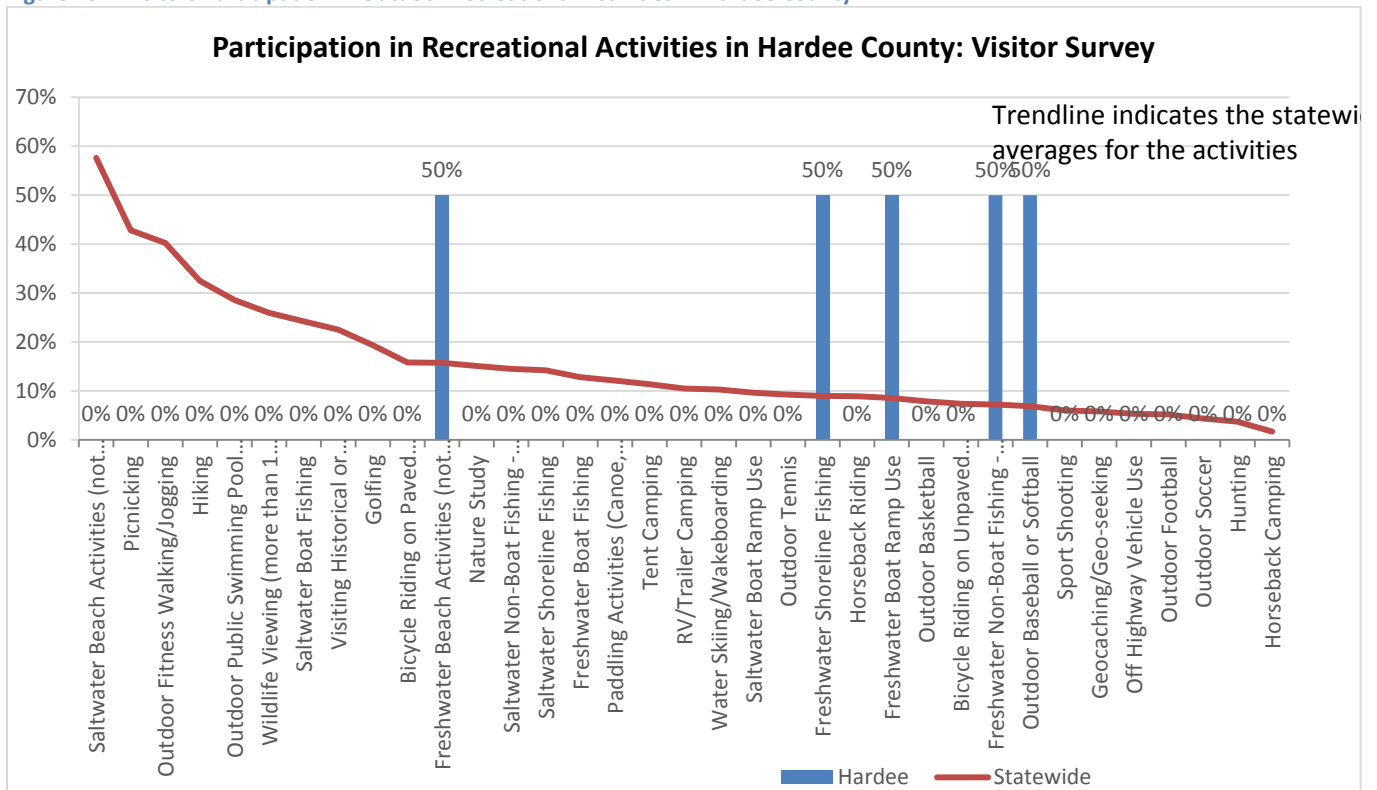


Figure 205. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Hendry County

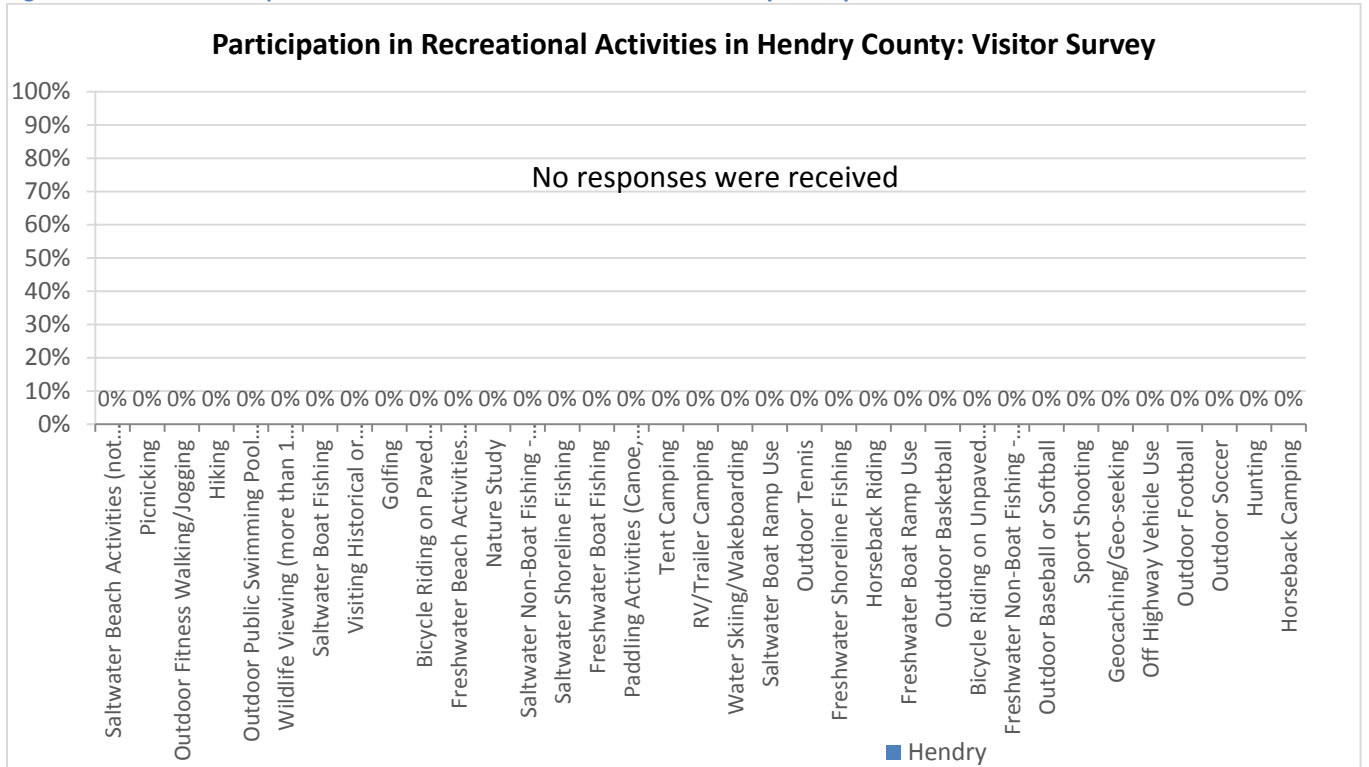


Figure 206. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Hernando County

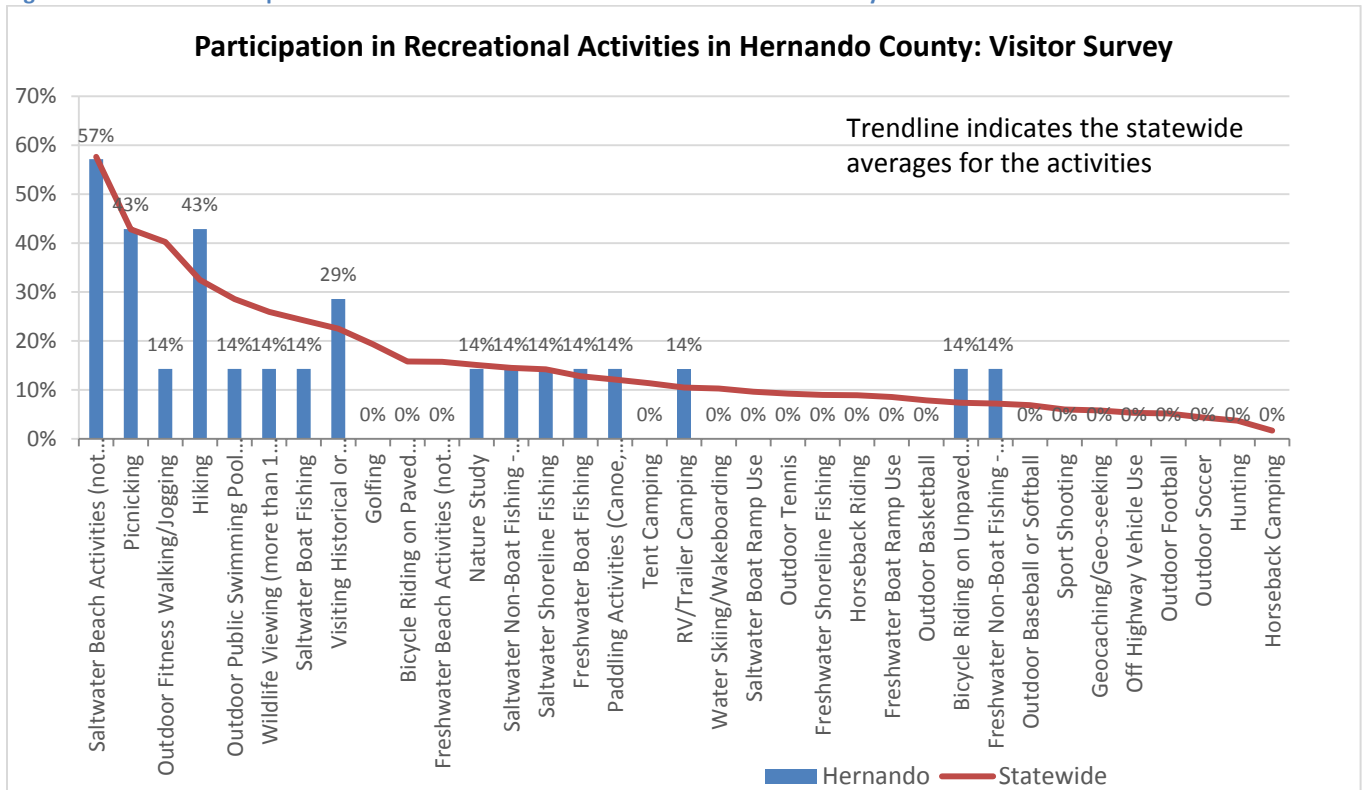


Figure 207. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Highlands County

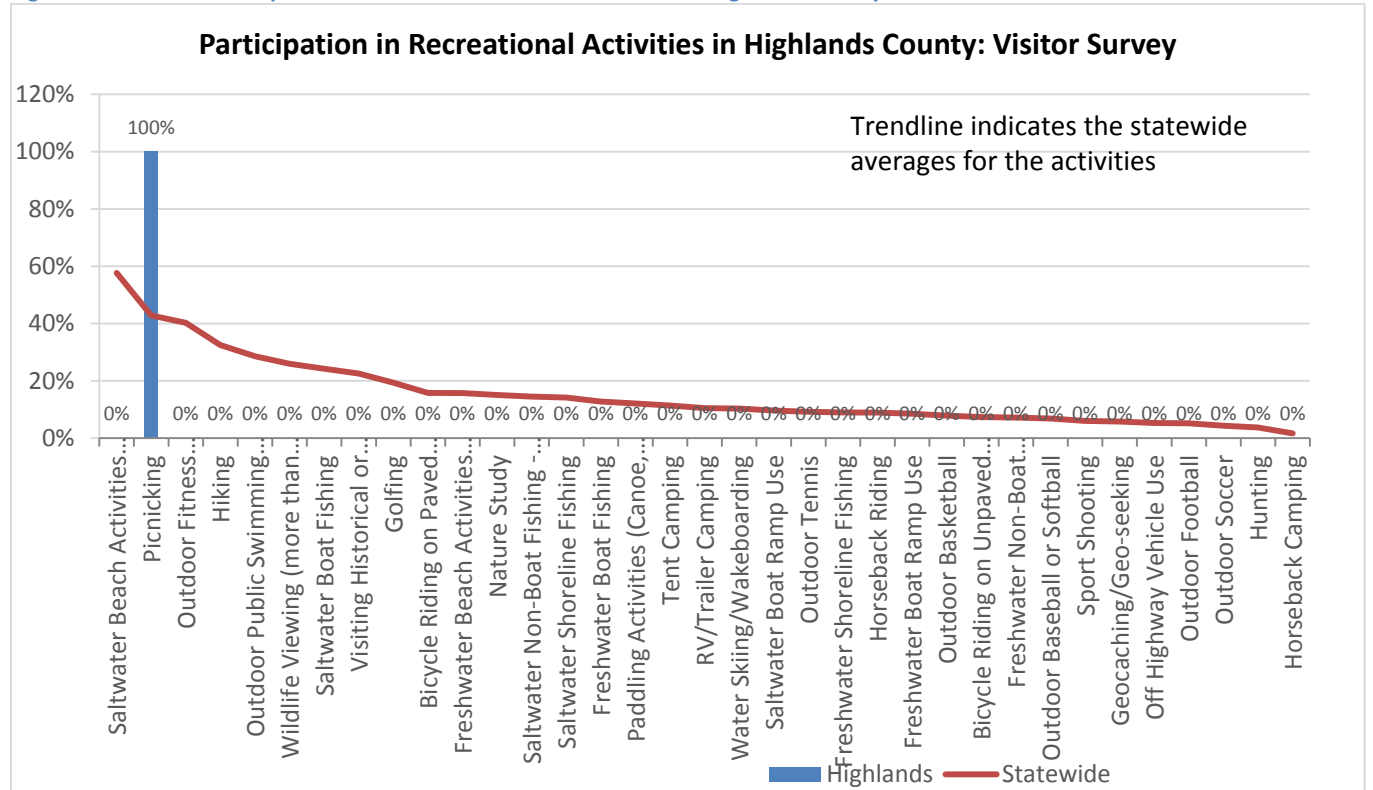


Figure 208. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Hillsborough County

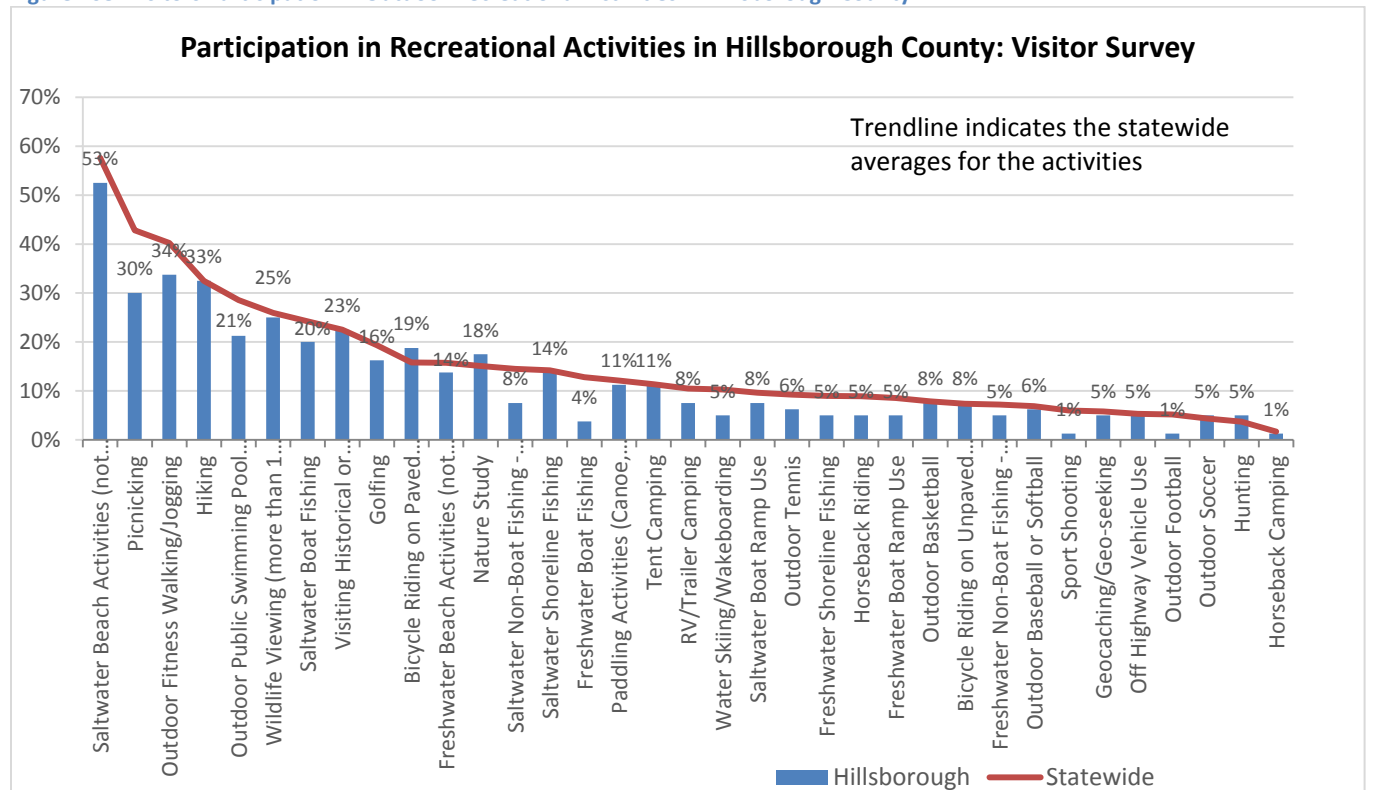


Figure 209. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Holmes County

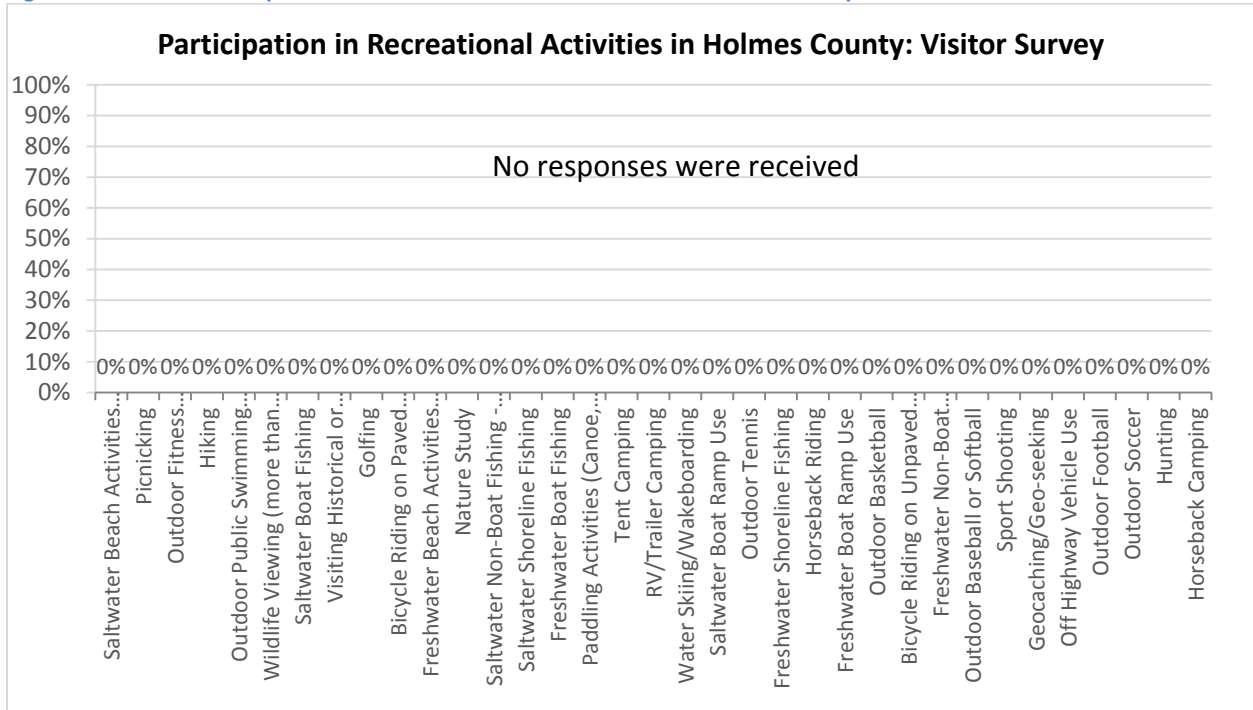


Figure 210. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Indian River County

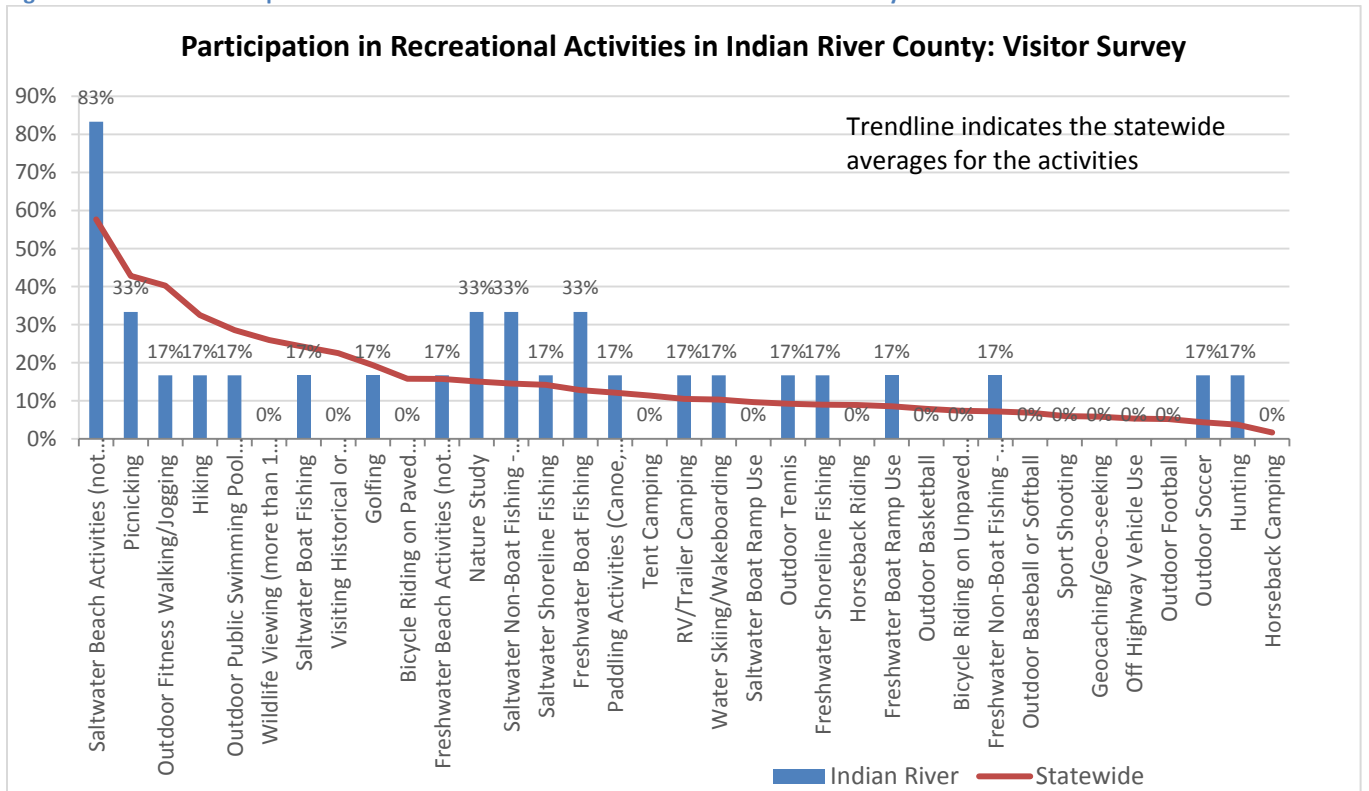


Figure 211. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Jackson County

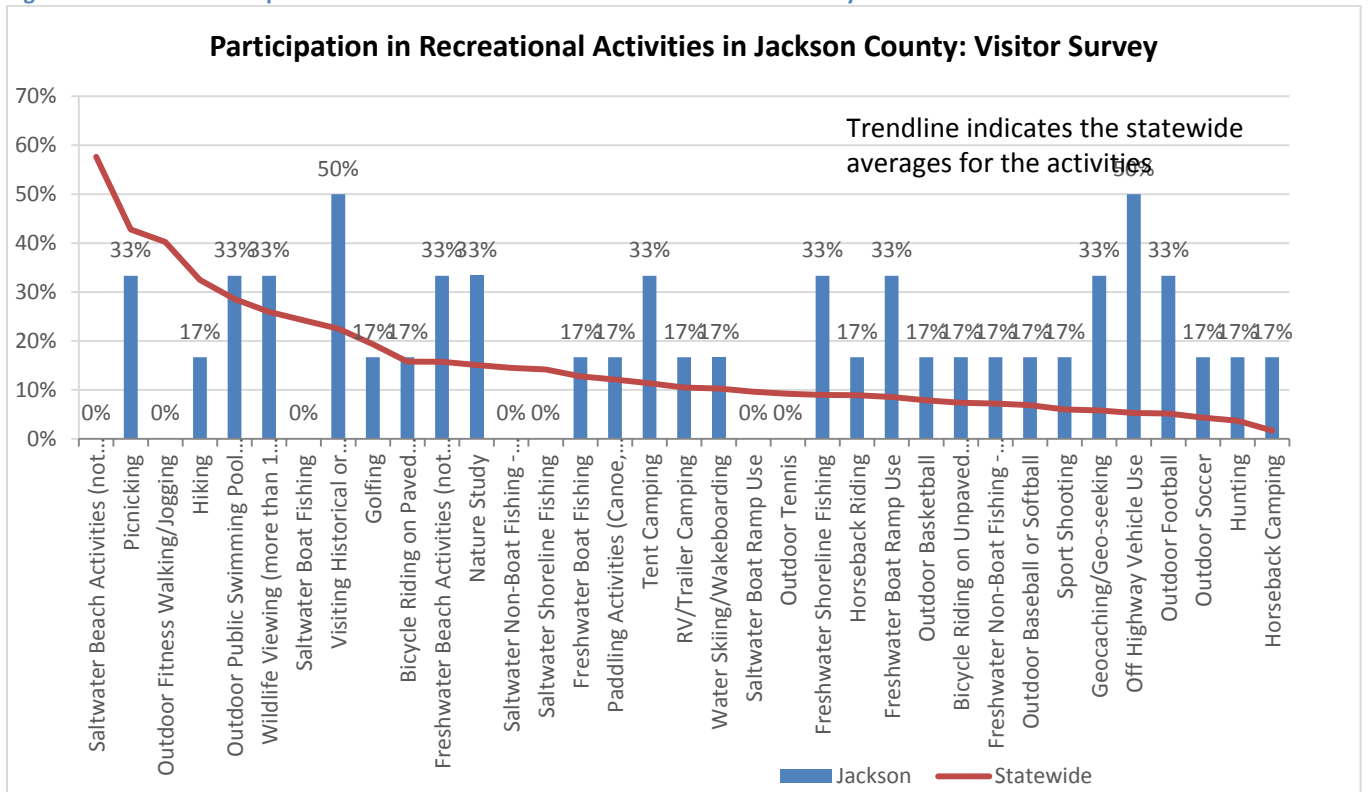


Figure 212. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Jefferson County

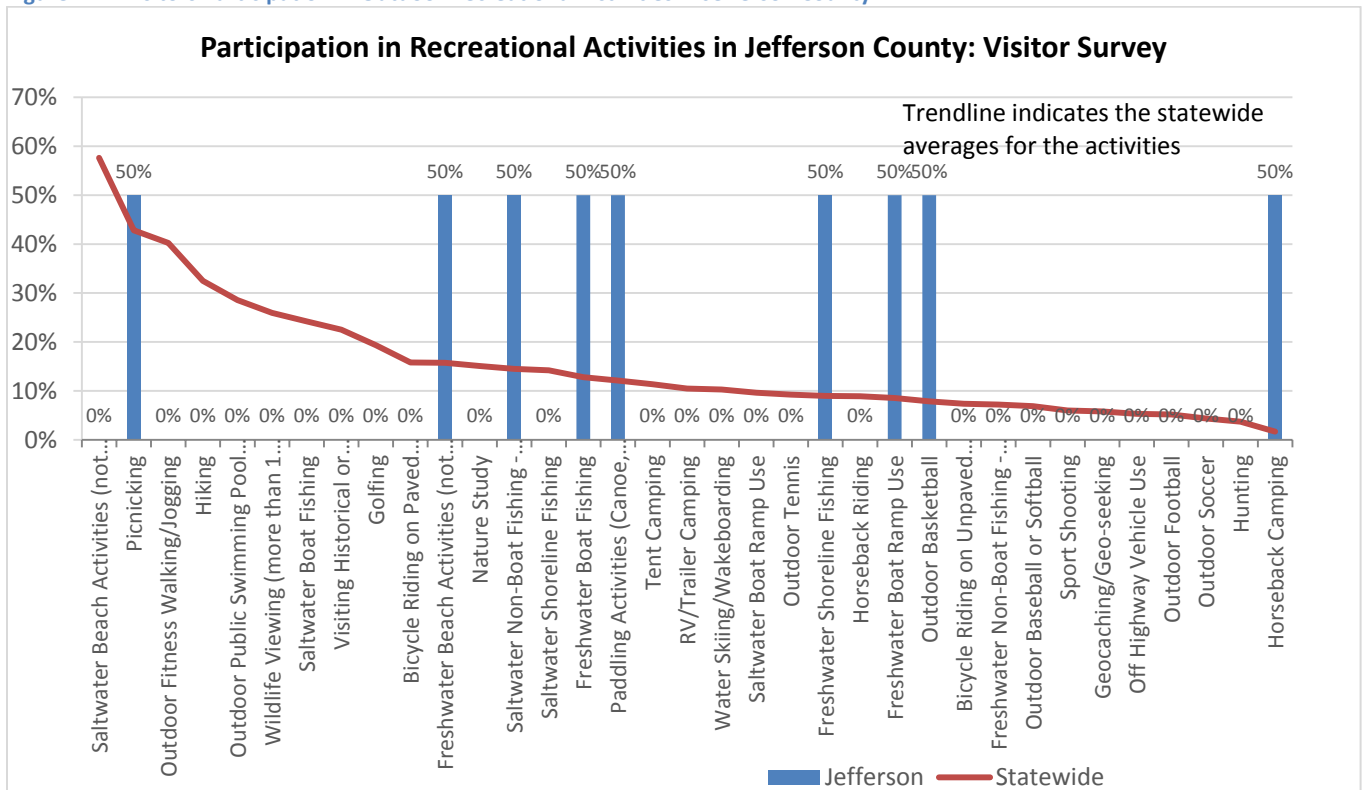


Figure 213. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Lafayette County

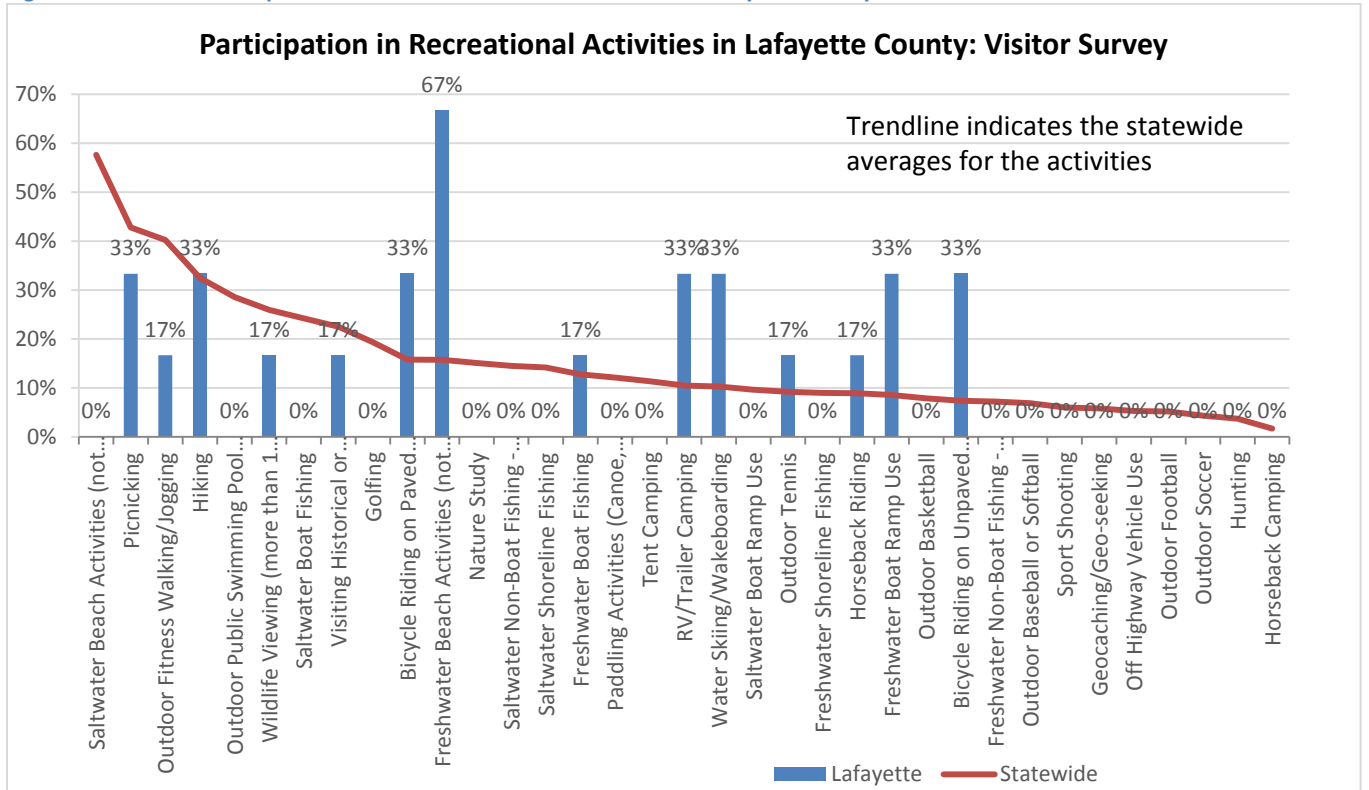


Figure 214. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Lake County

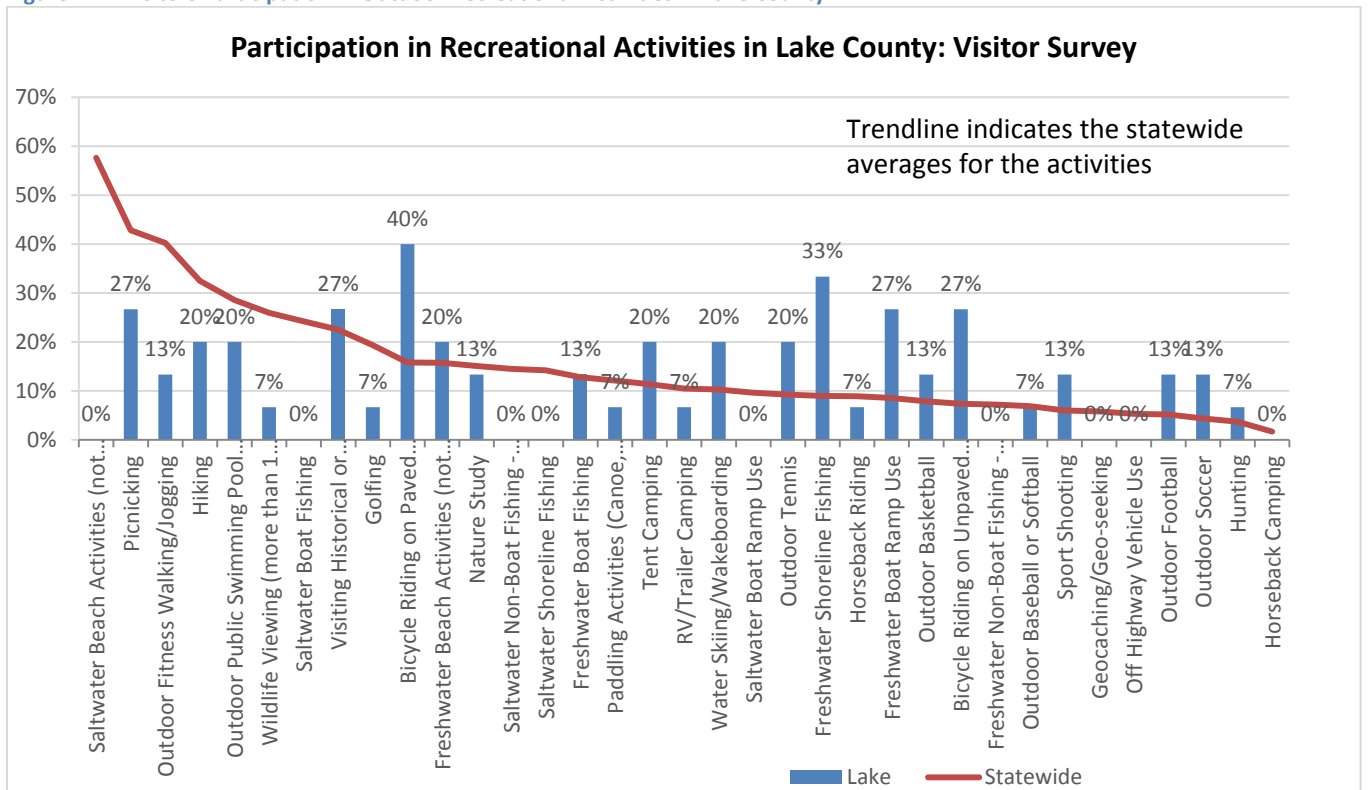


Figure 215. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Lee County

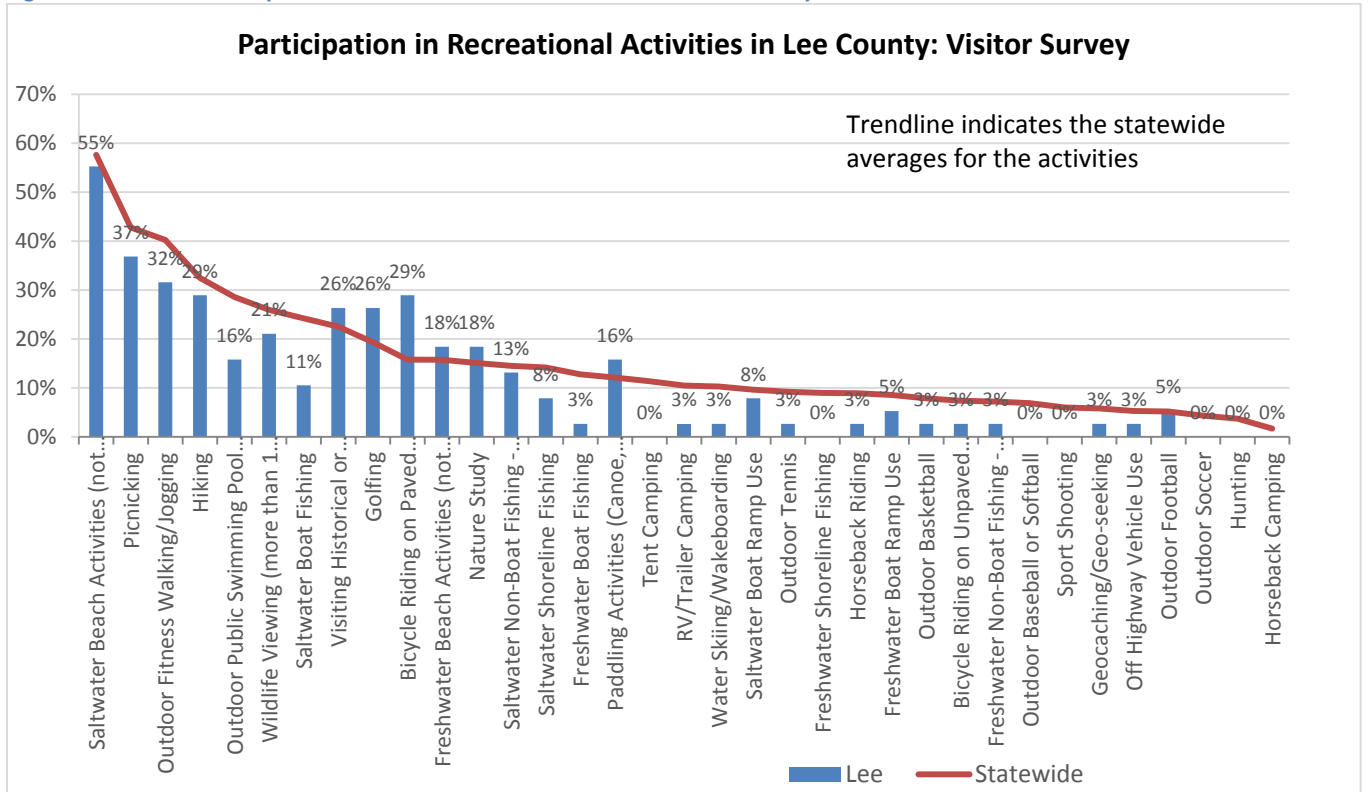


Figure 216. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Leon County

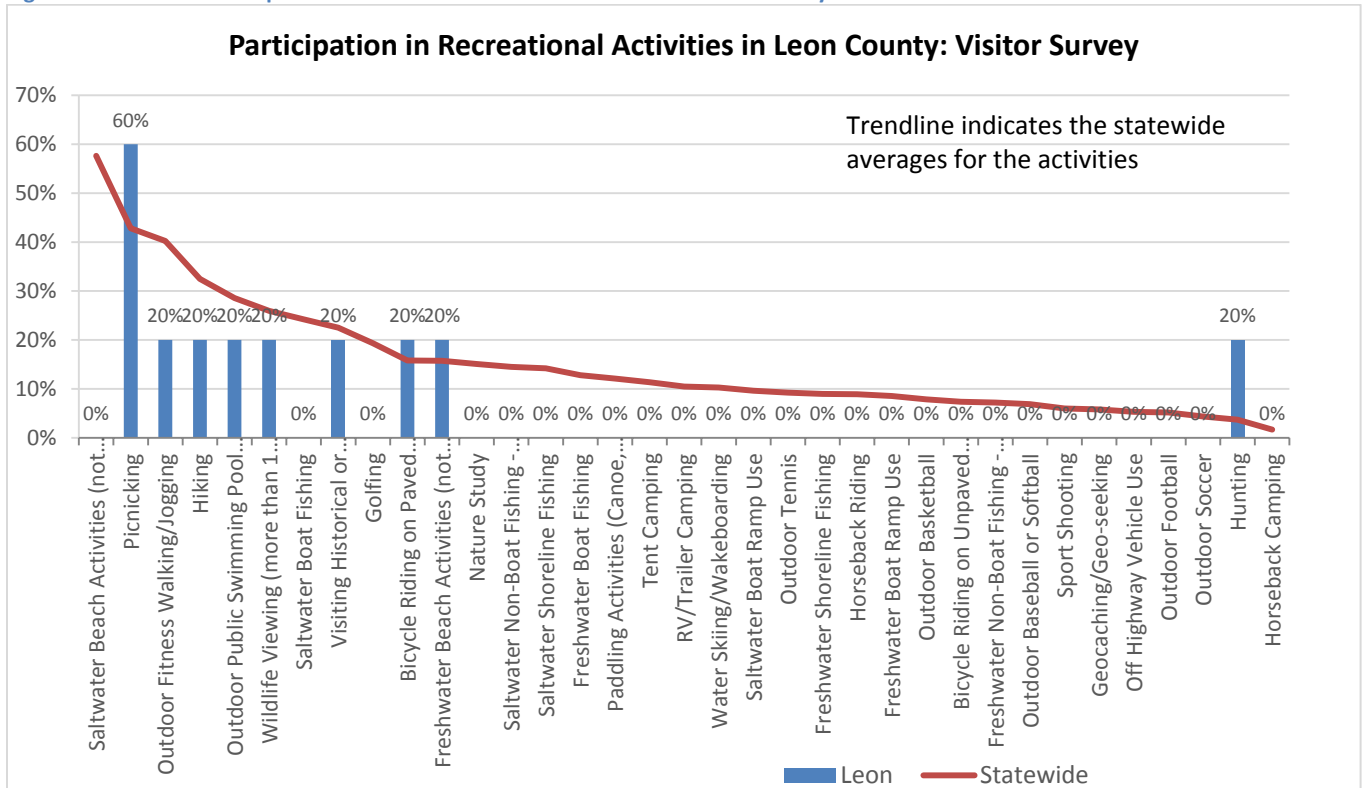


Figure 217. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Levy County

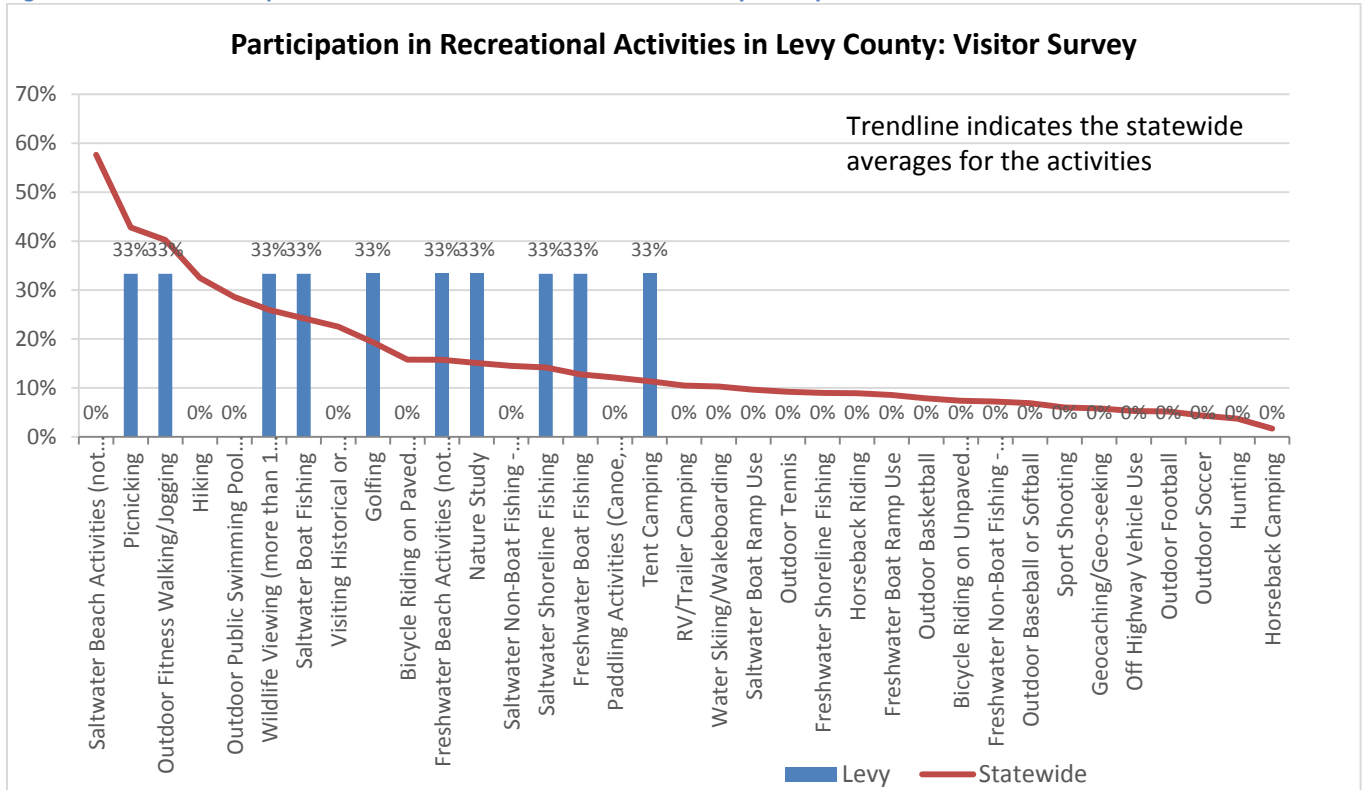


Figure 218. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Liberty County

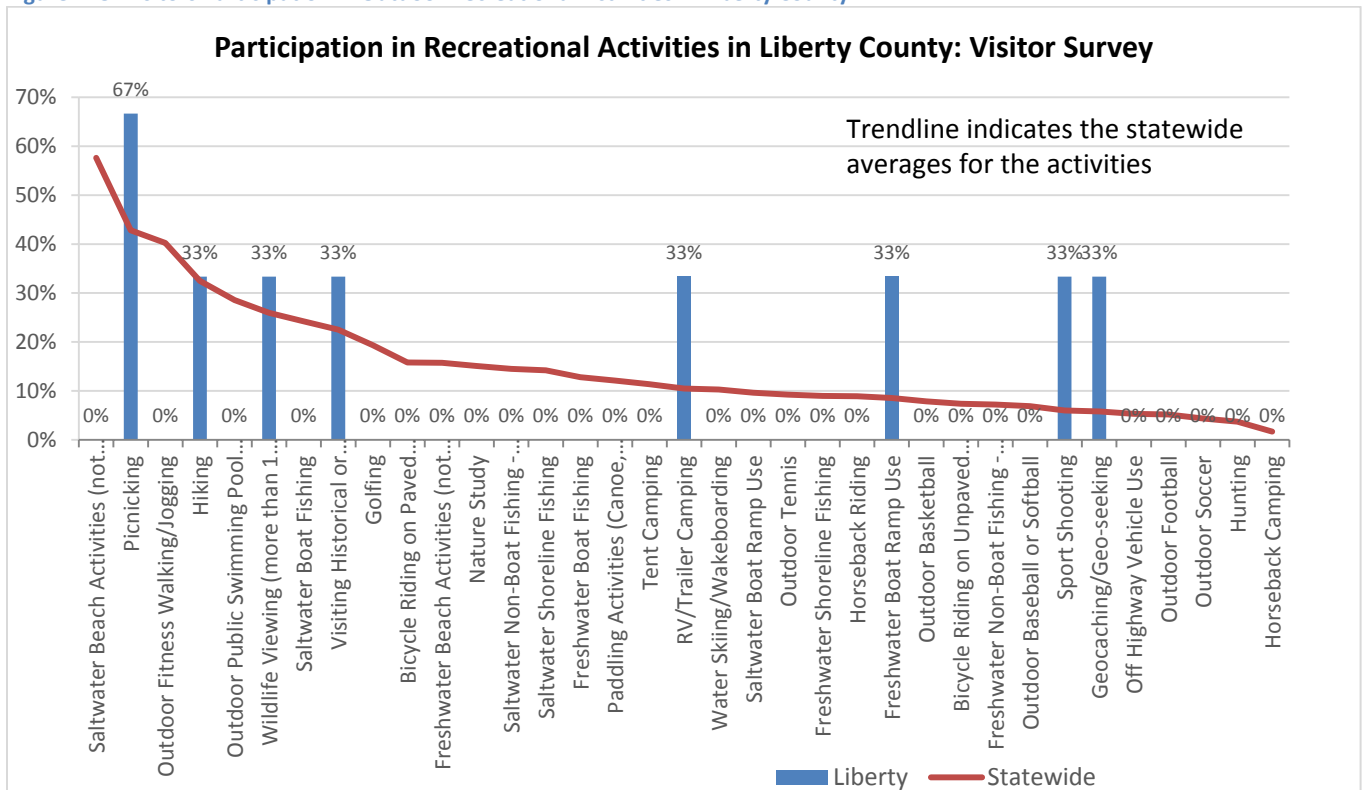


Figure 219. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Madison County

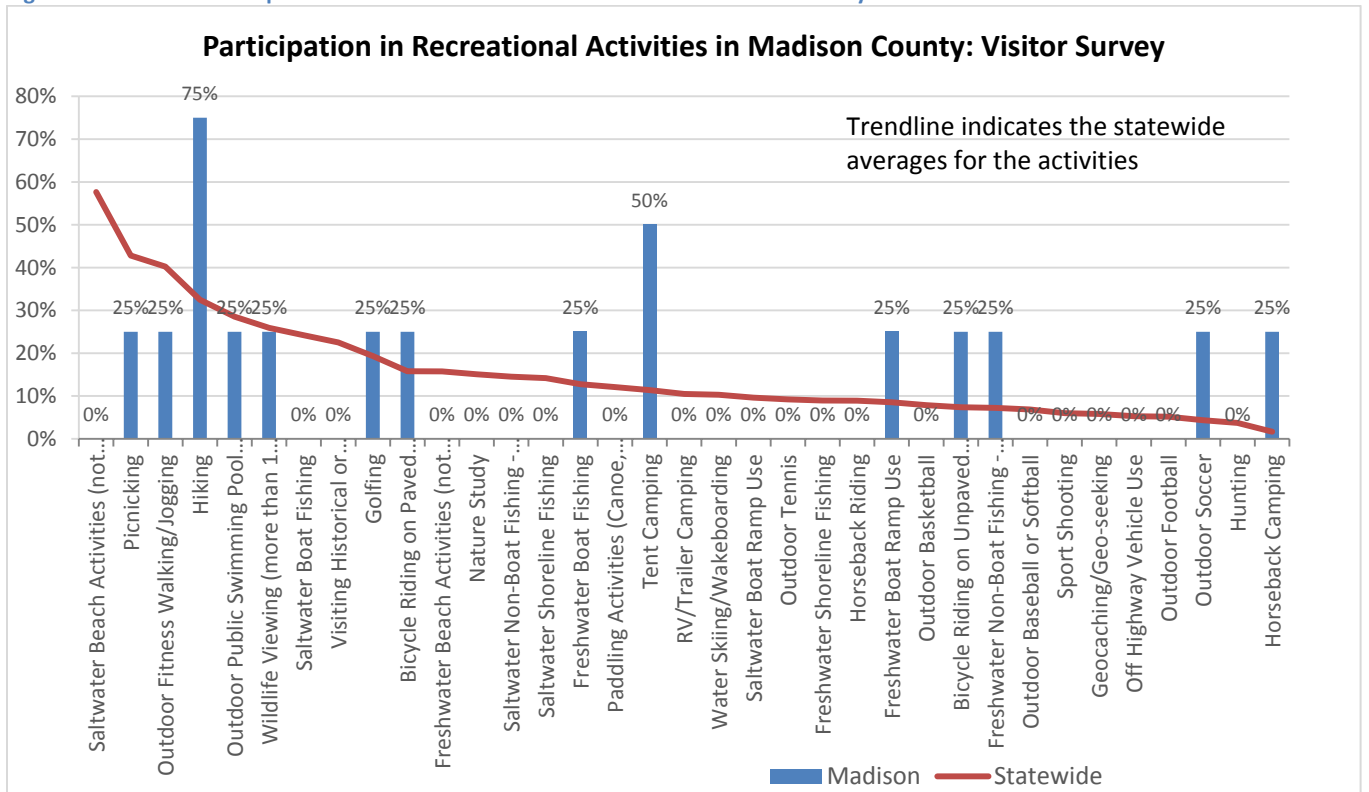


Figure 220. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Manatee County

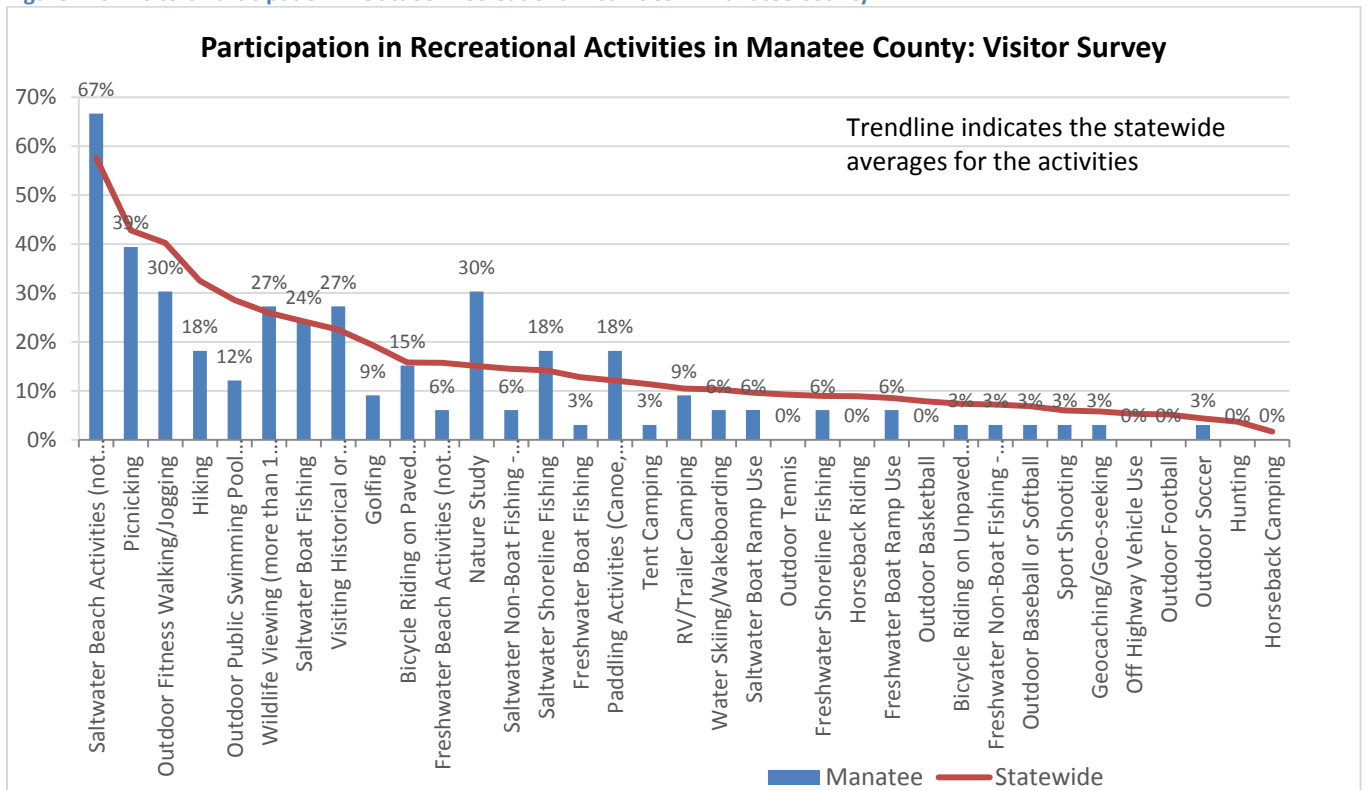


Figure 221. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Marion County

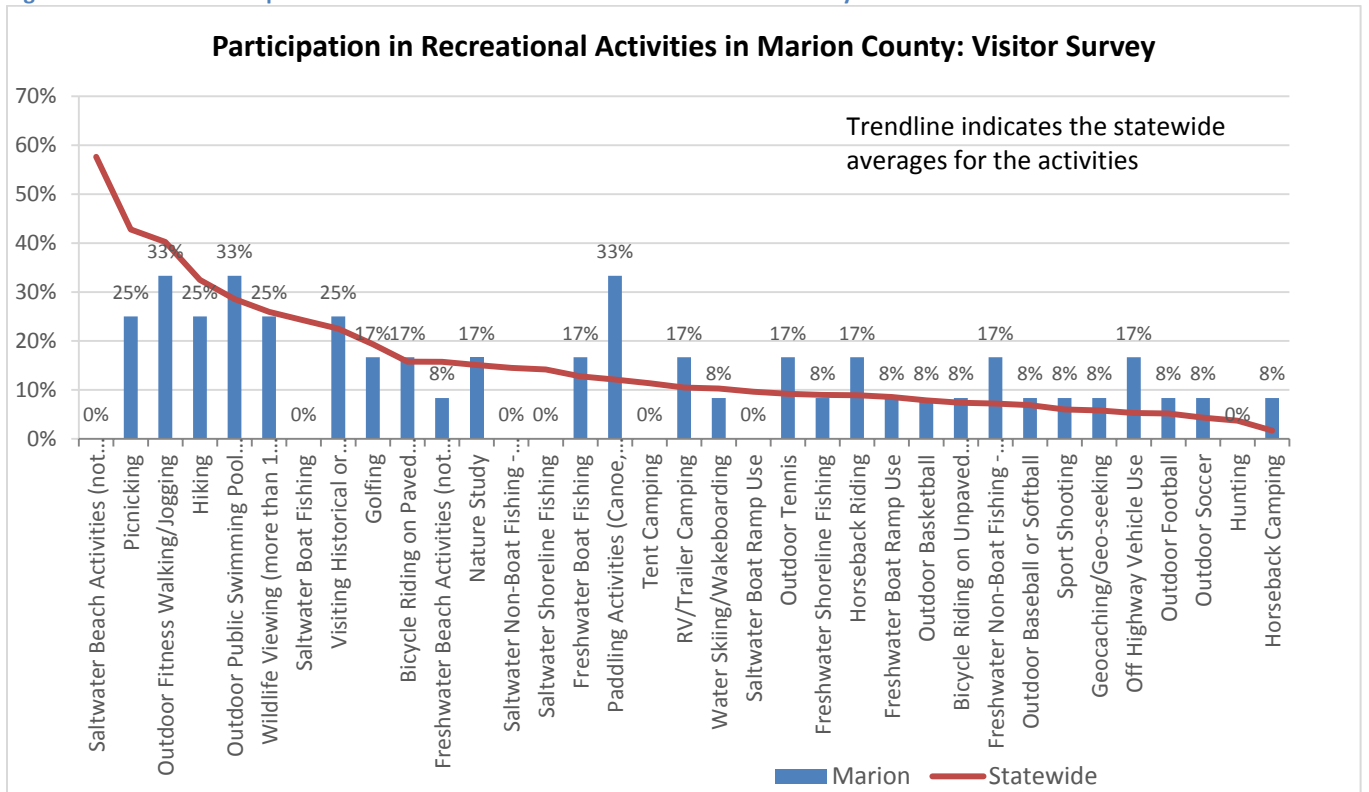


Figure 222. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Martin County

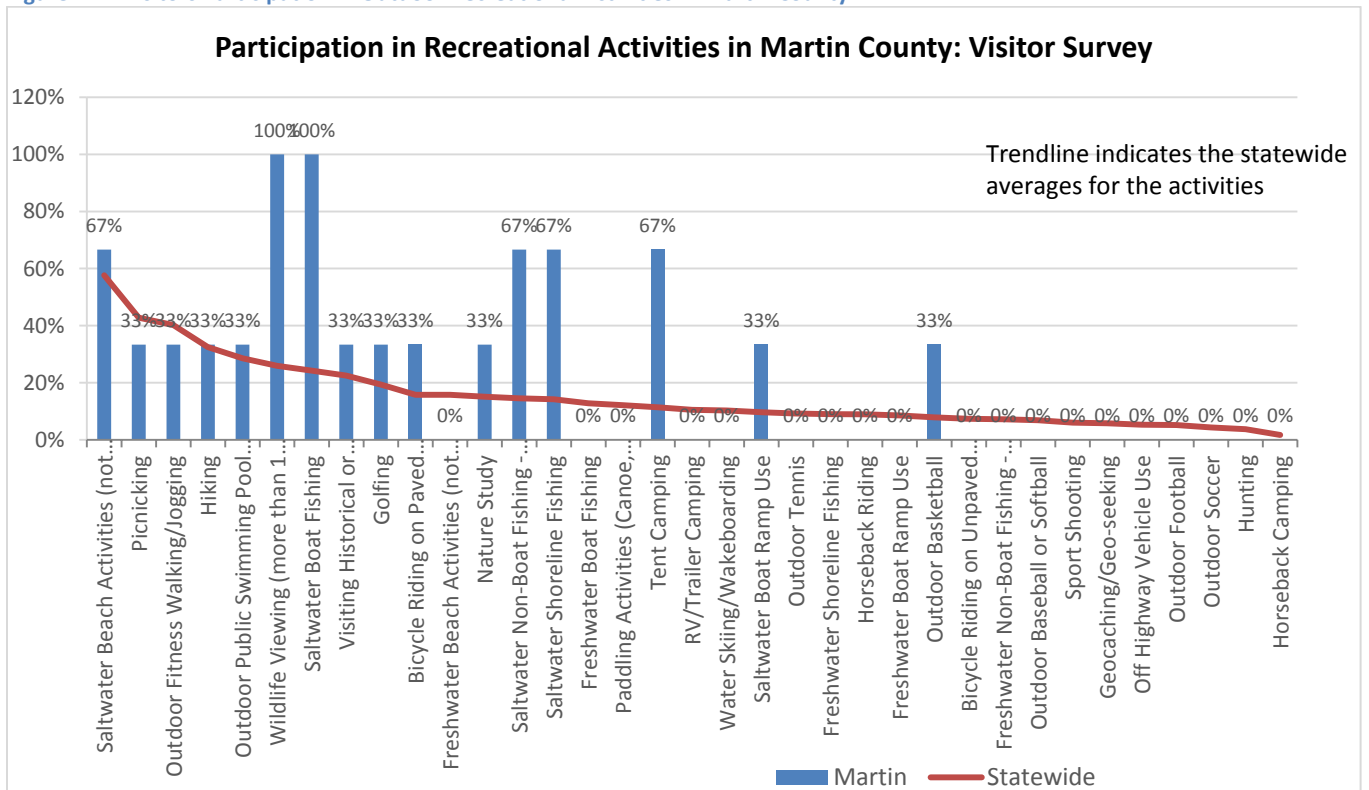


Figure 223. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Miami Dade County

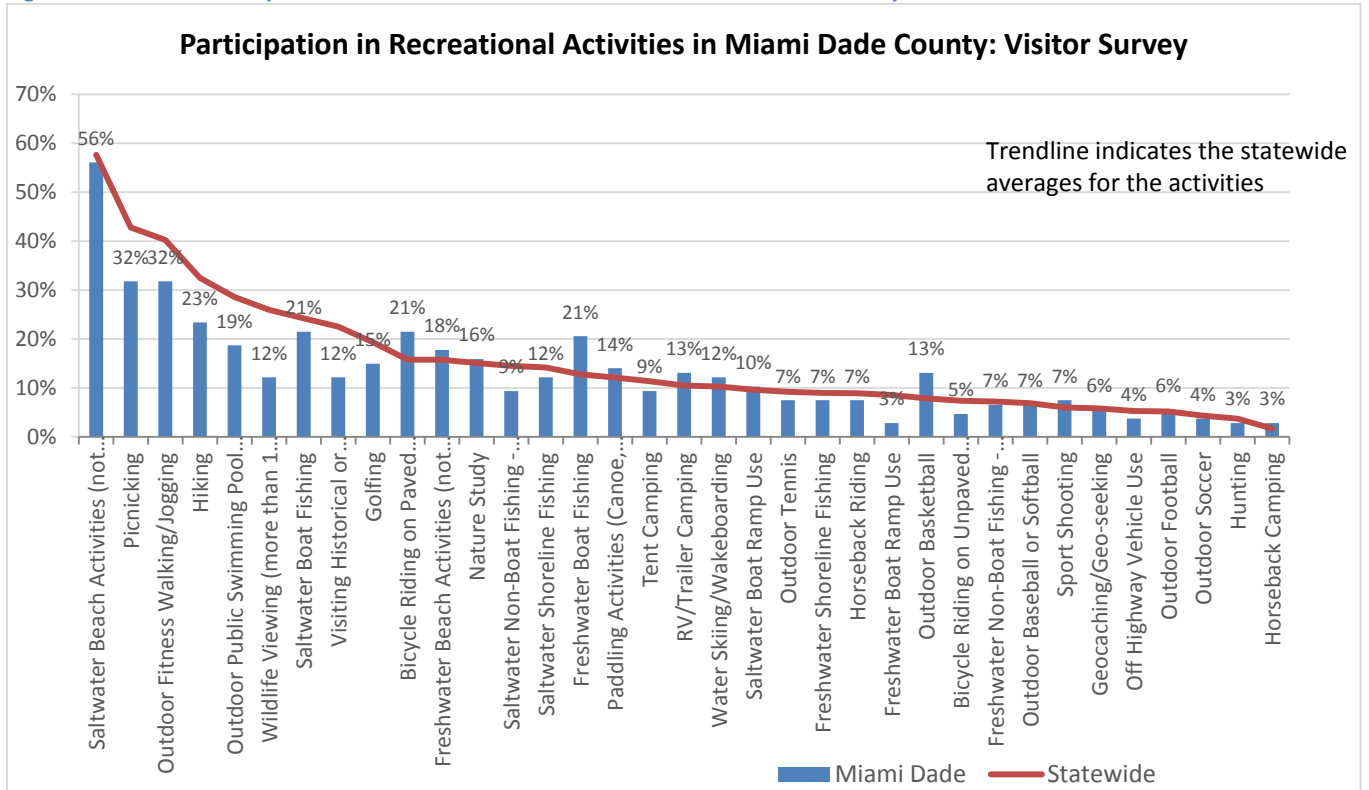


Figure 224. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Monroe County

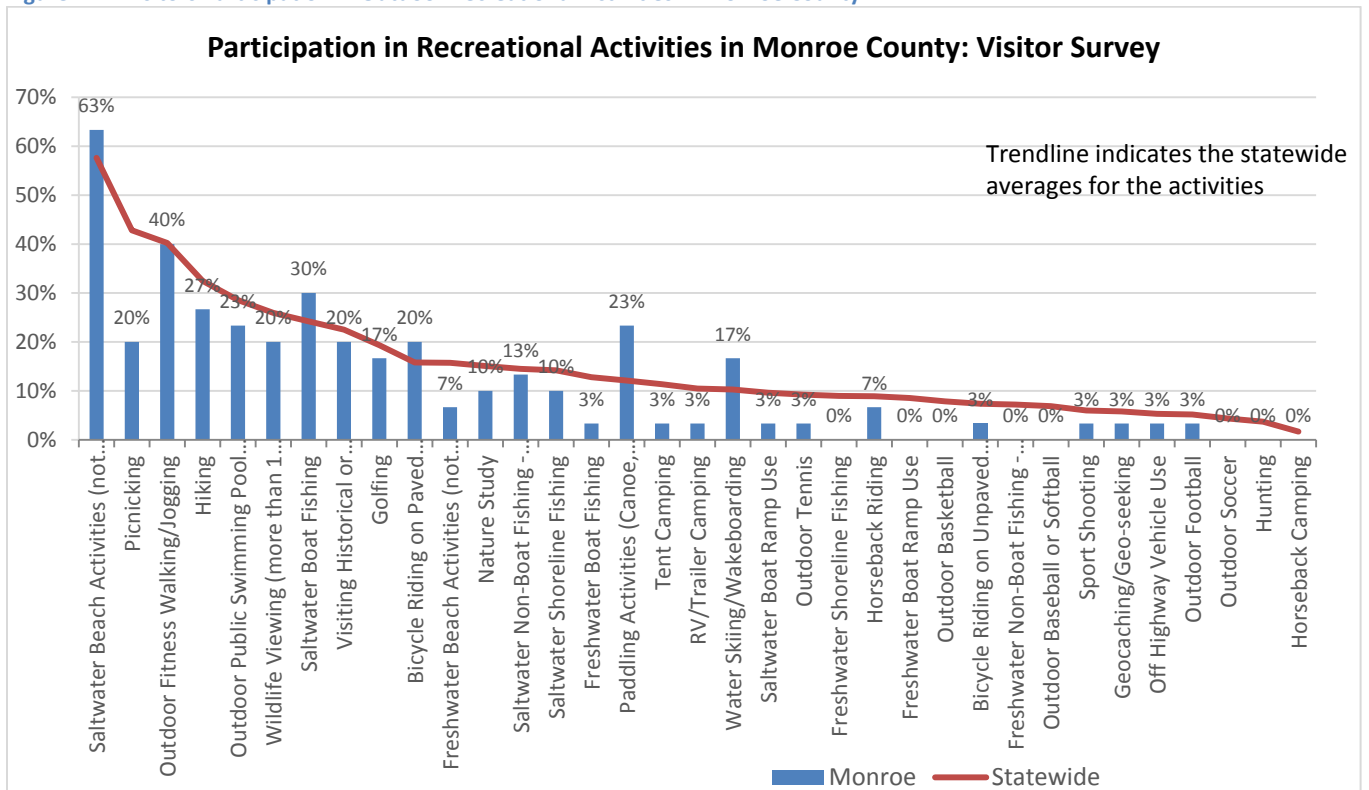


Figure 225. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Nassau County

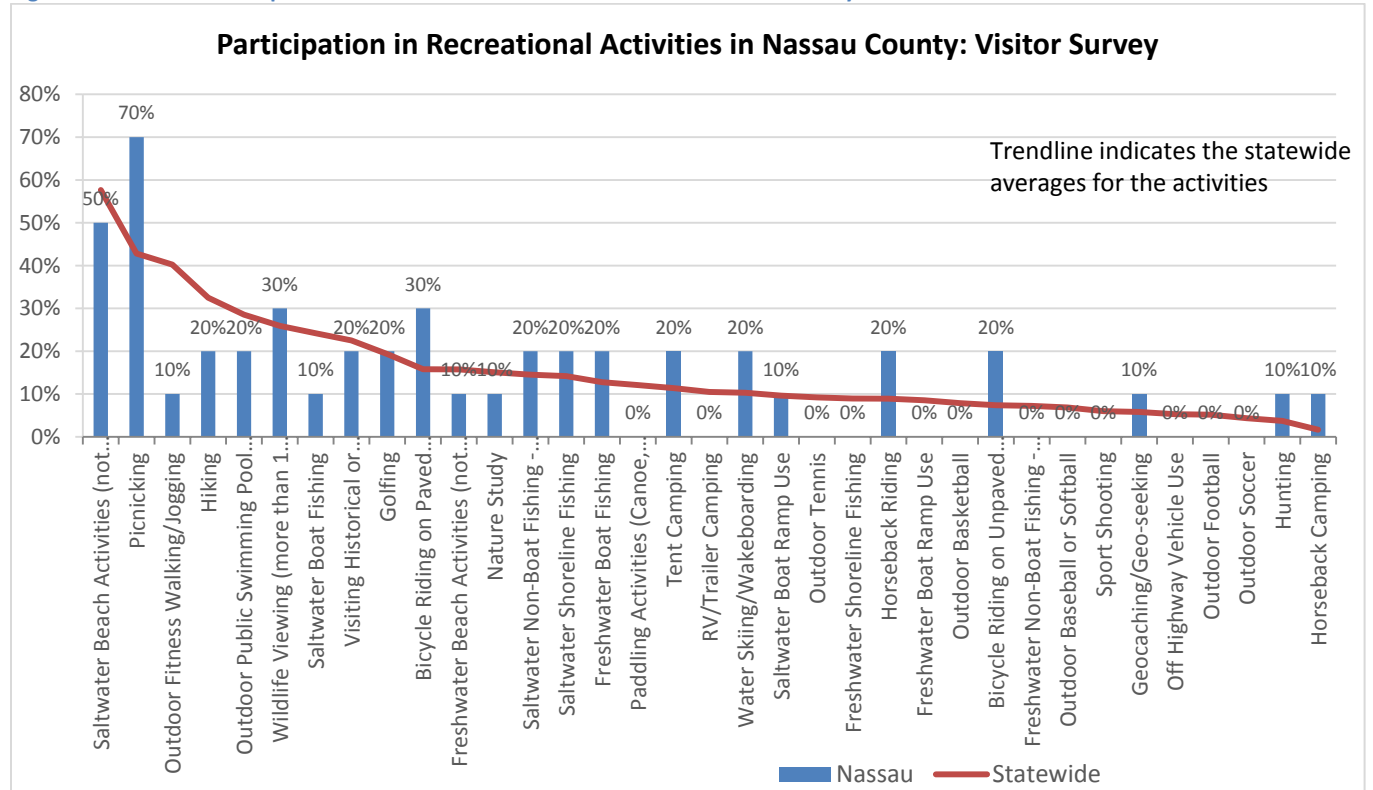


Figure 226. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Okaloosa County

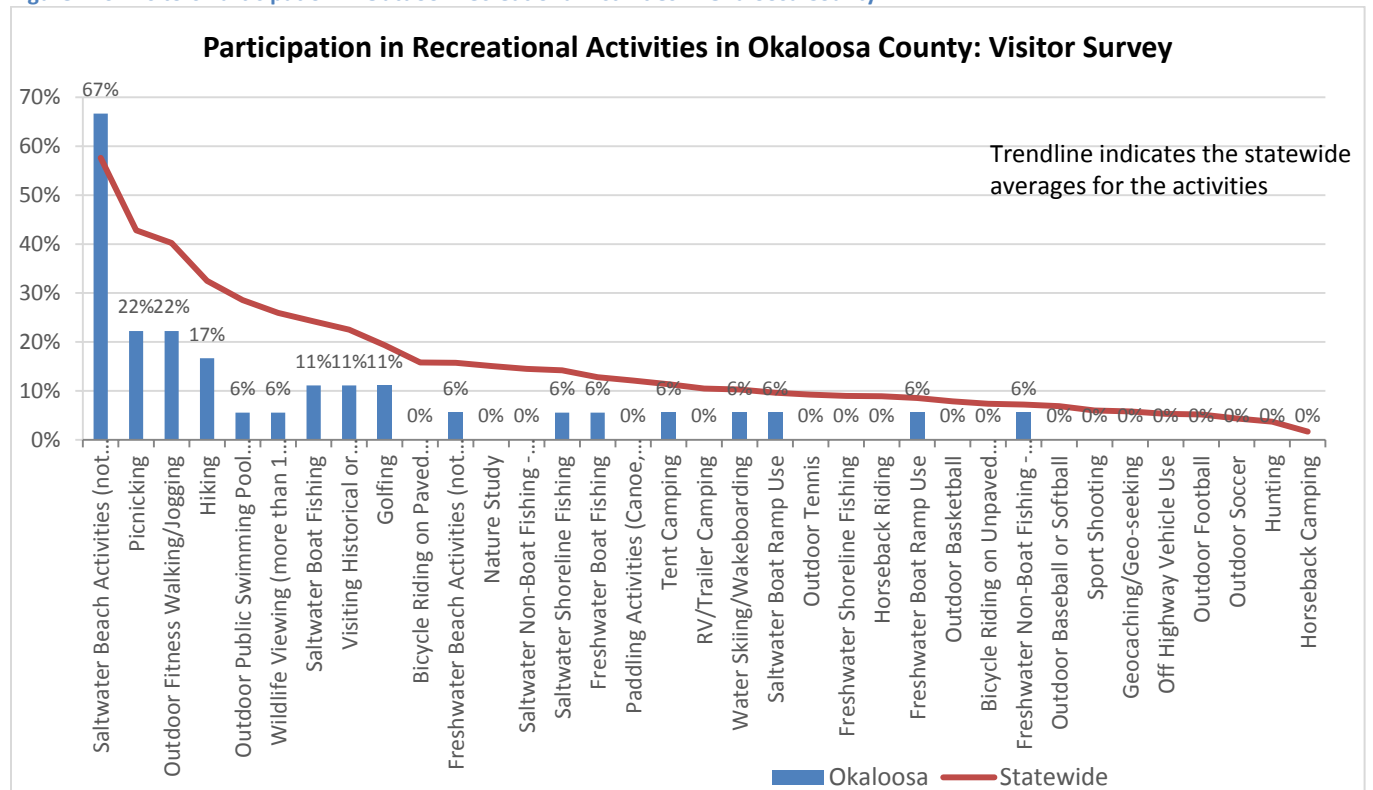


Figure 227. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Okeechobee County

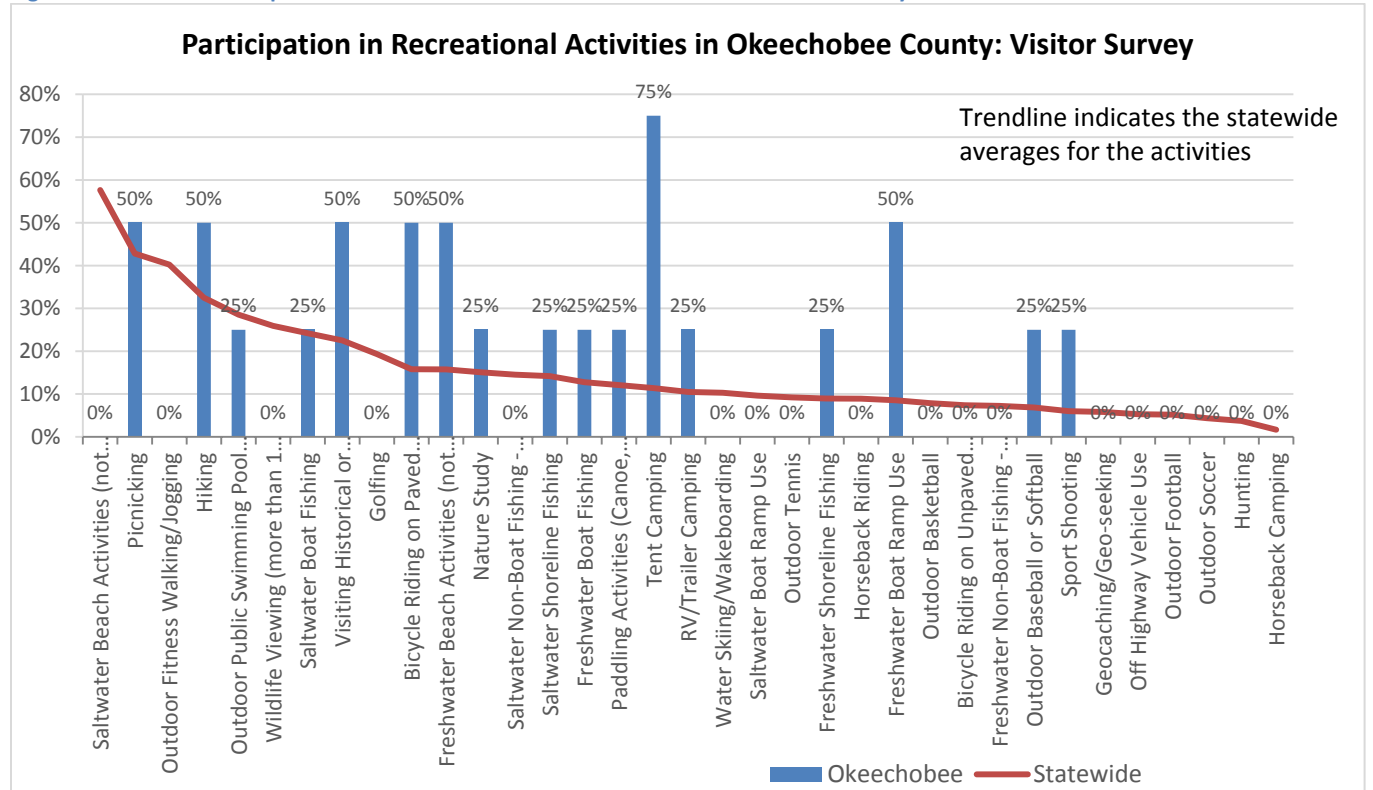


Figure 228. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Orange County

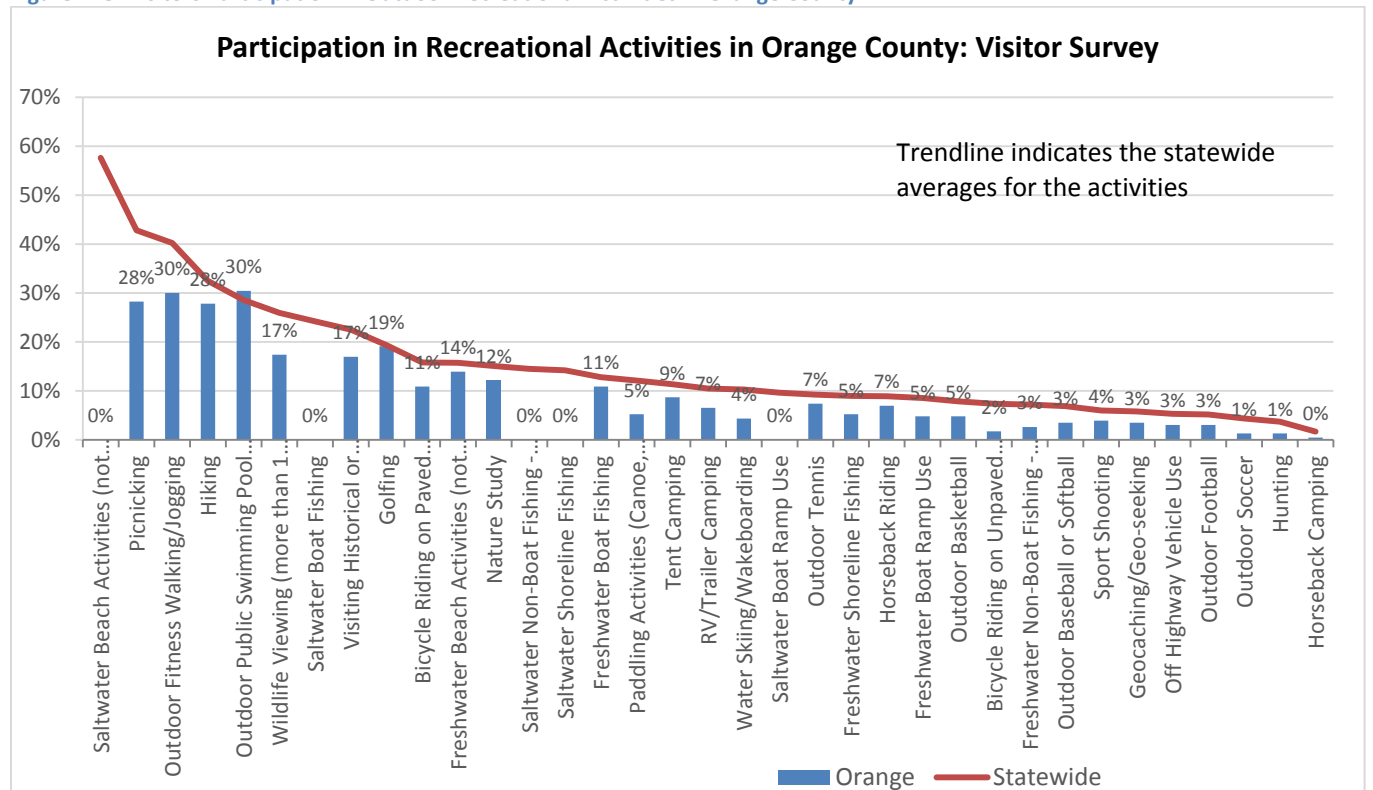


Figure 229. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Osceola County

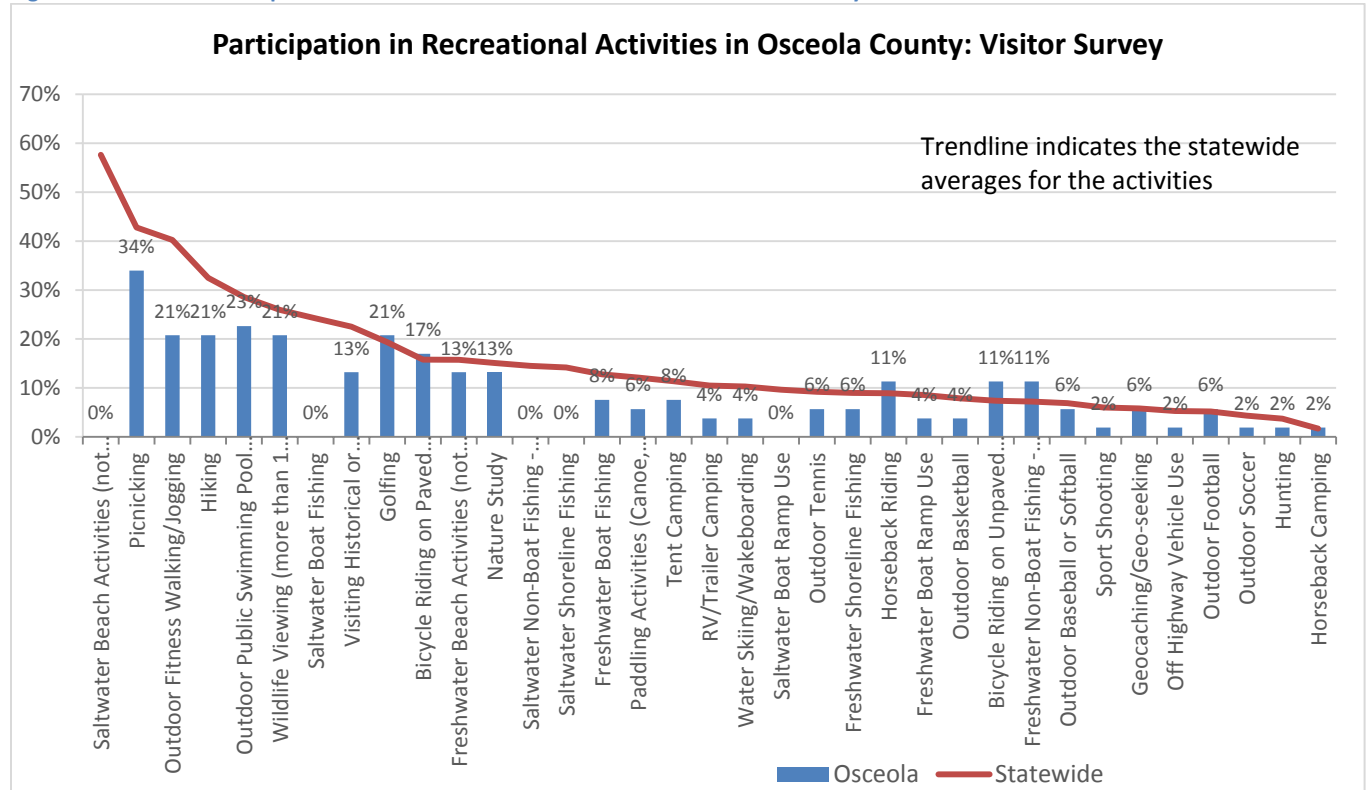


Figure 230. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Palm Beach County

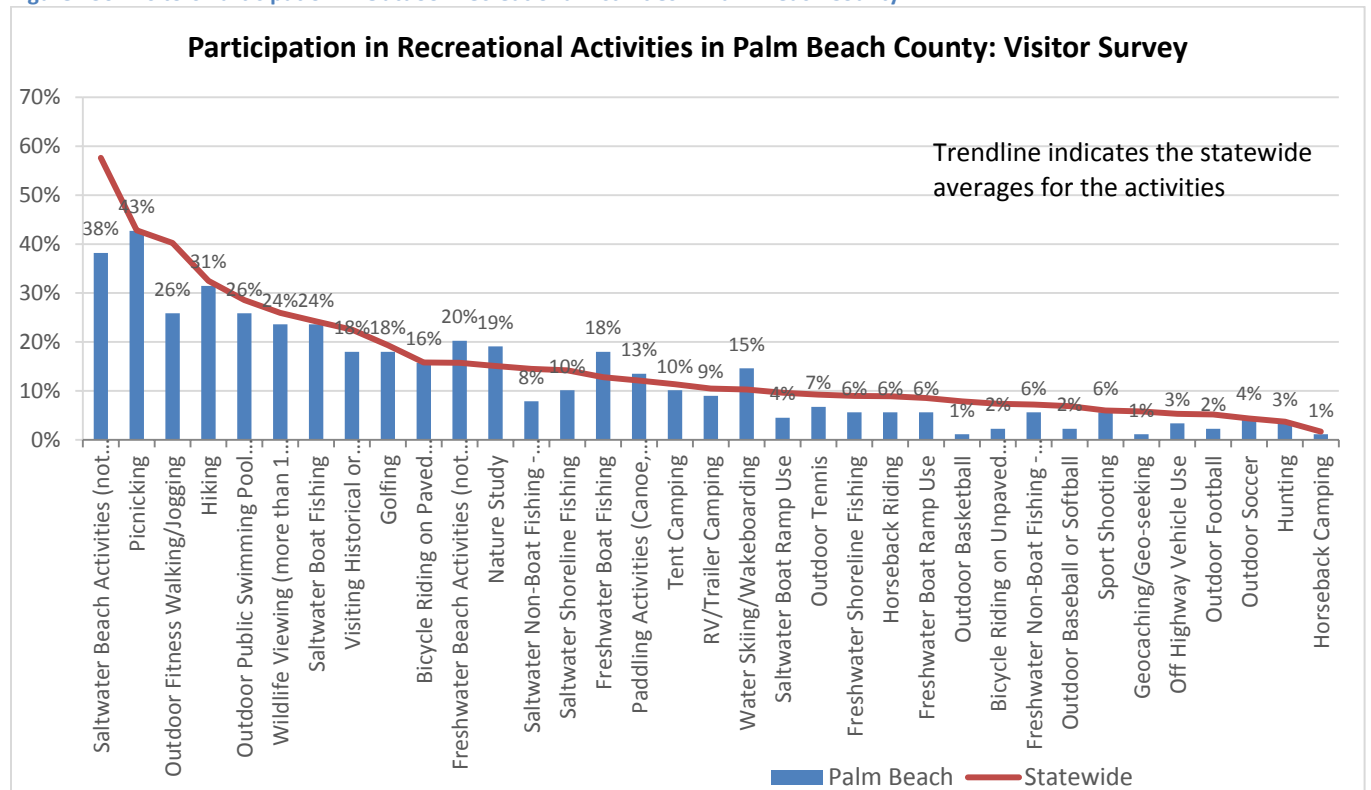


Figure 231. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Pasco County

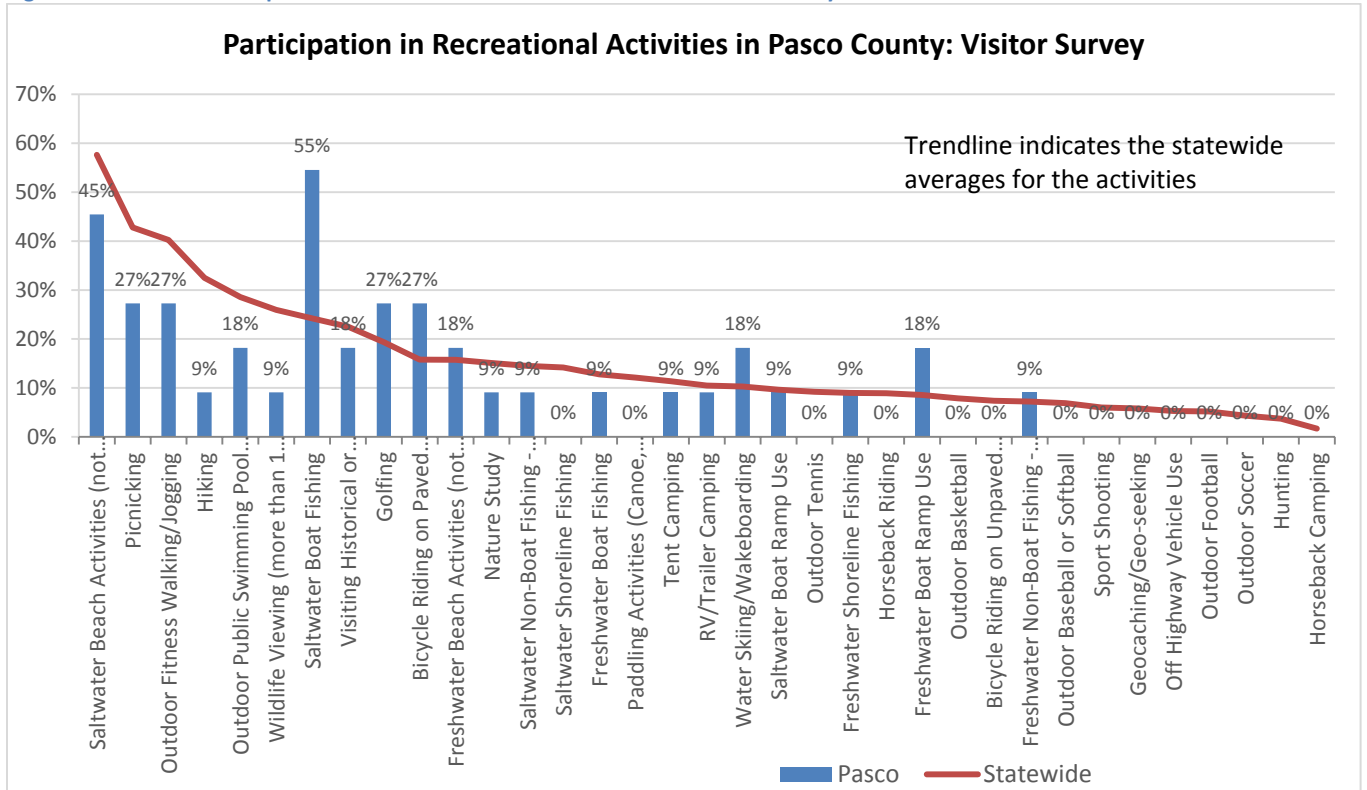


Figure 232. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Pinellas County

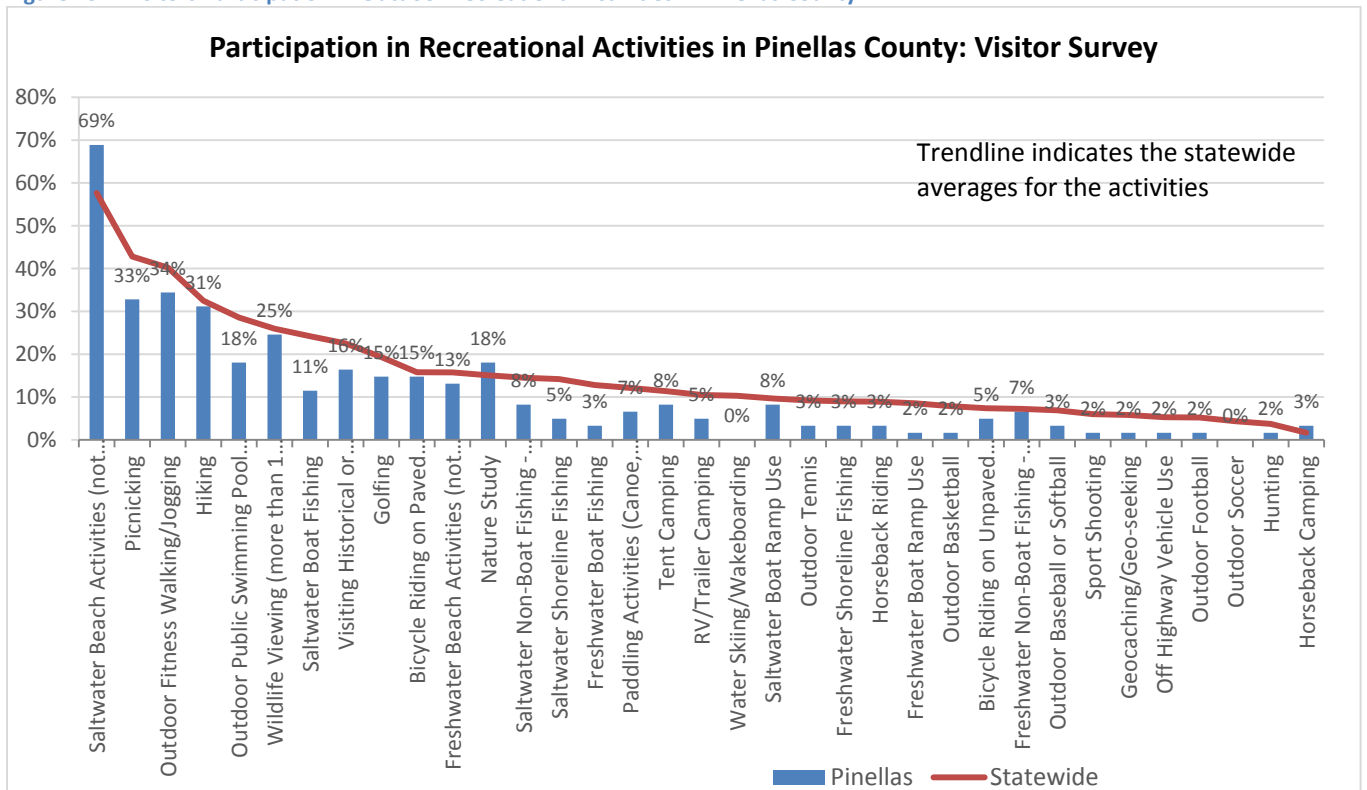


Figure 233. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Polk County

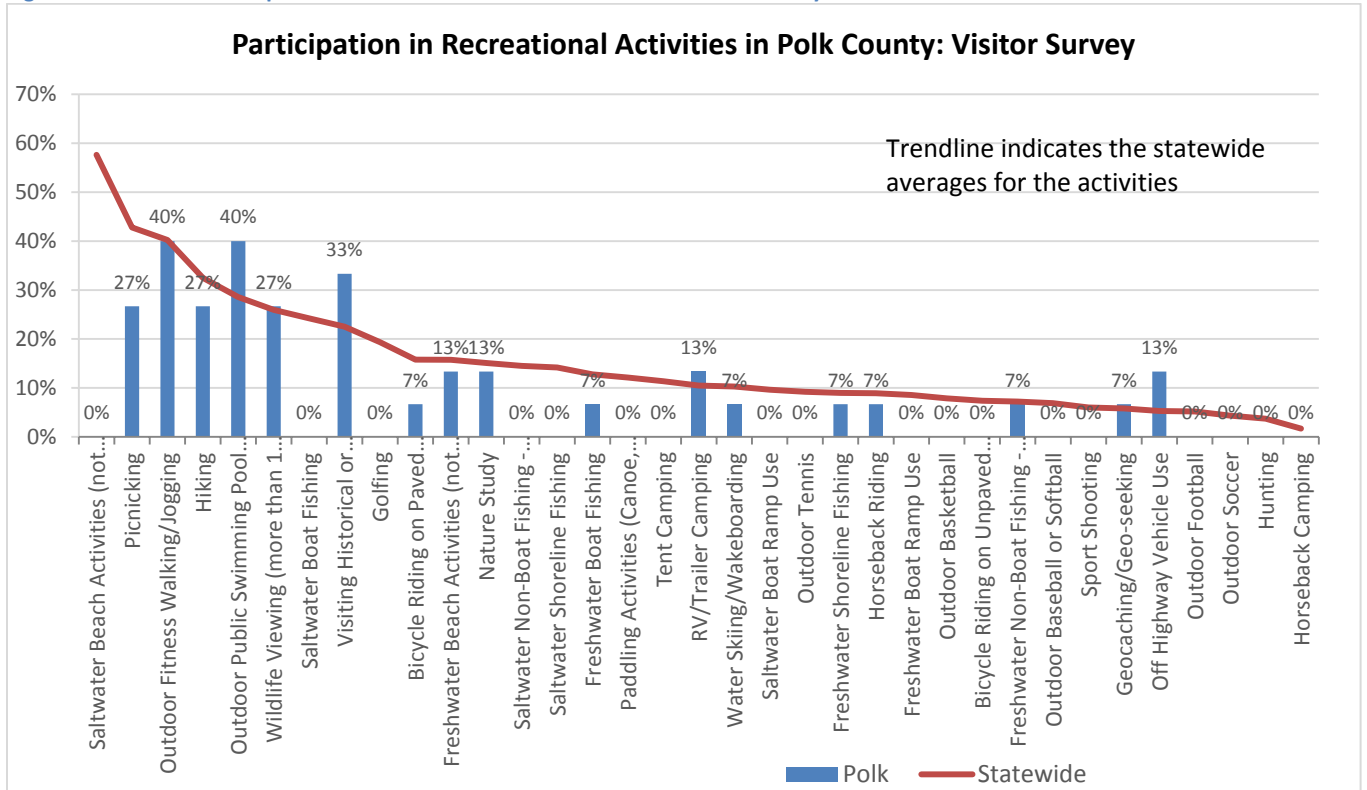


Figure 234. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Putnam County

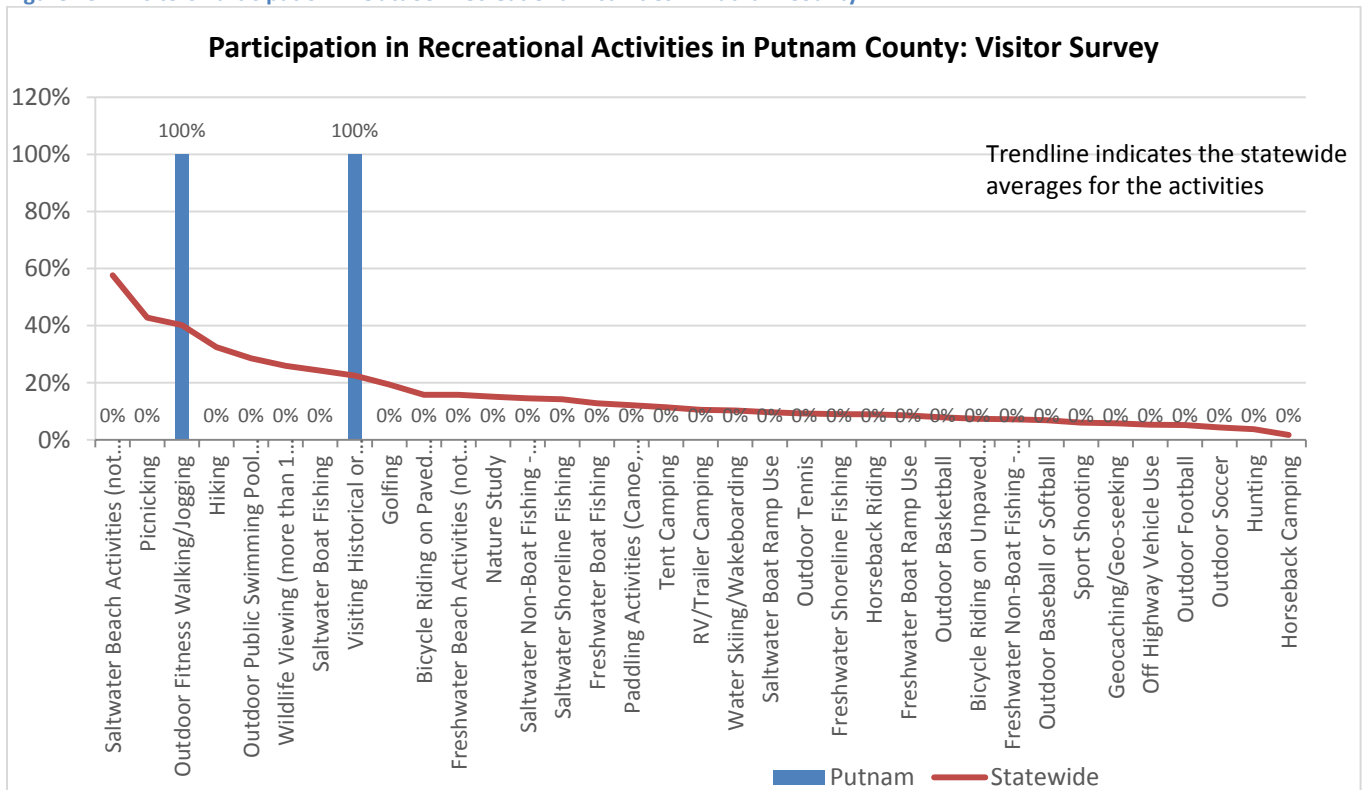


Figure 235. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Santa Rosa County

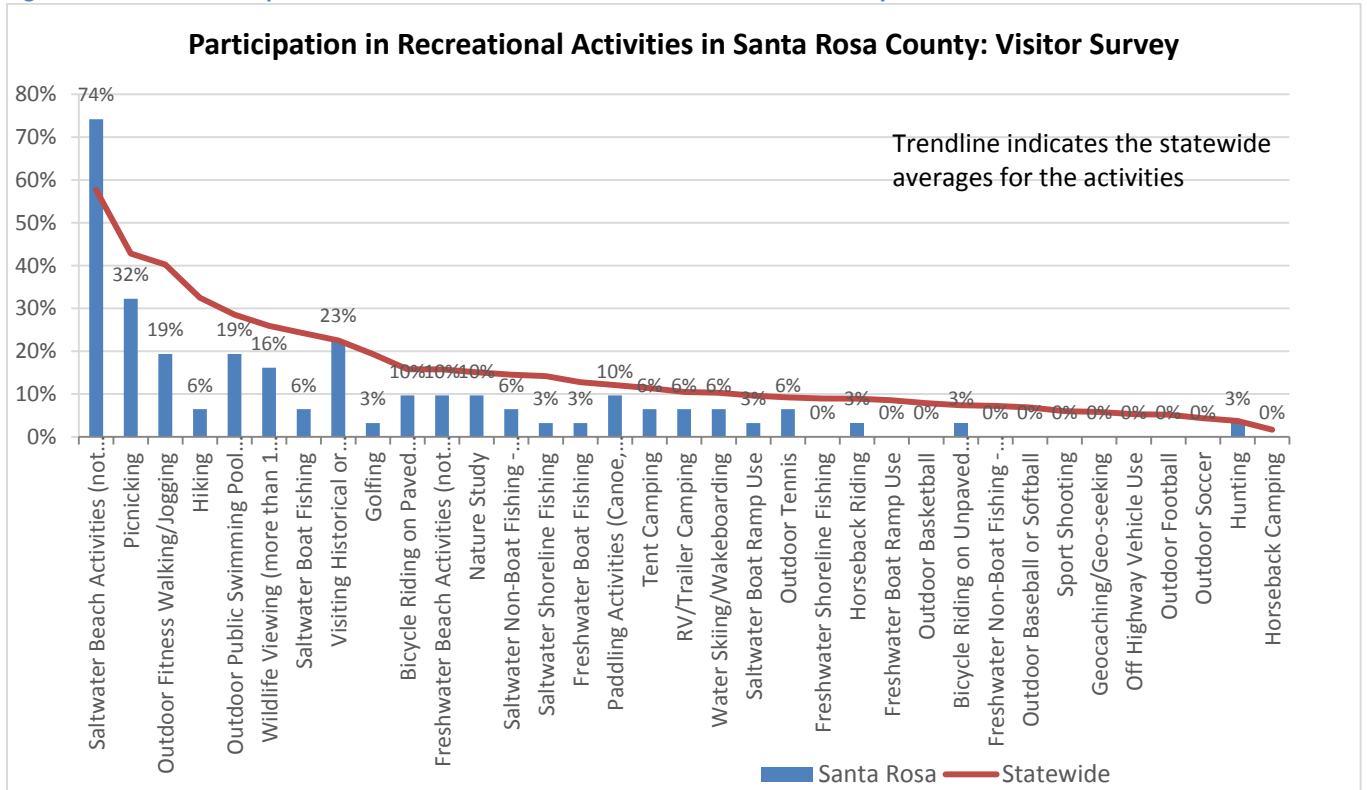


Figure 236. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Sarasota County

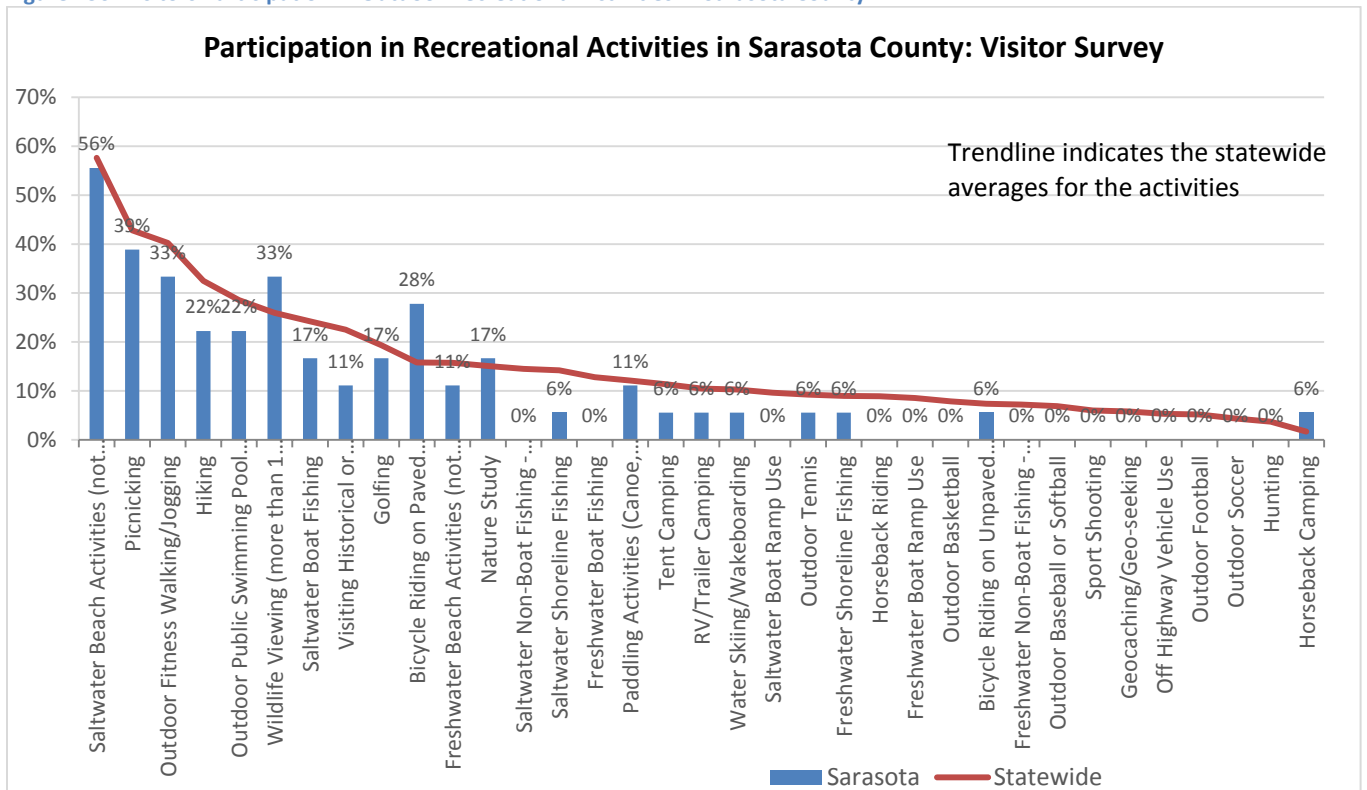


Figure 237. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Seminole County

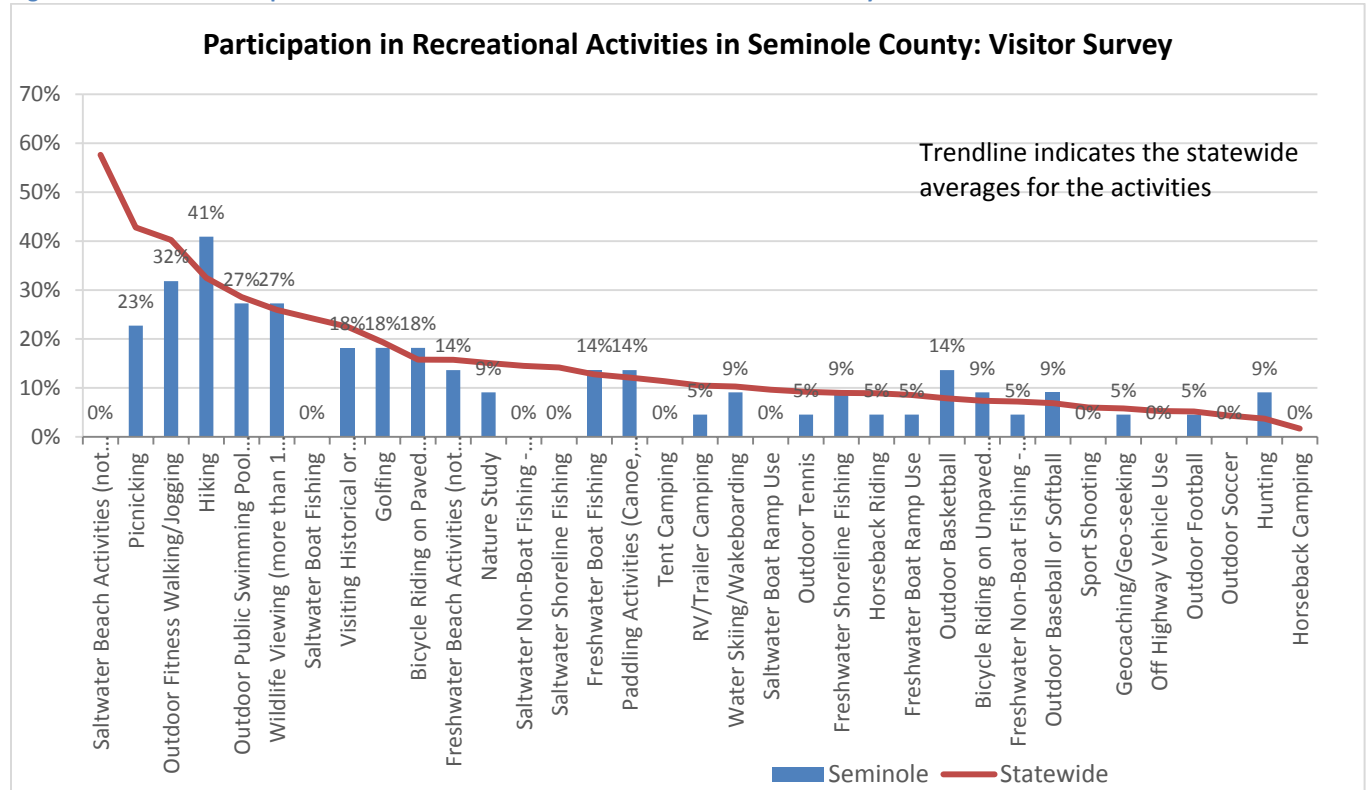


Figure 238. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in St. Johns County

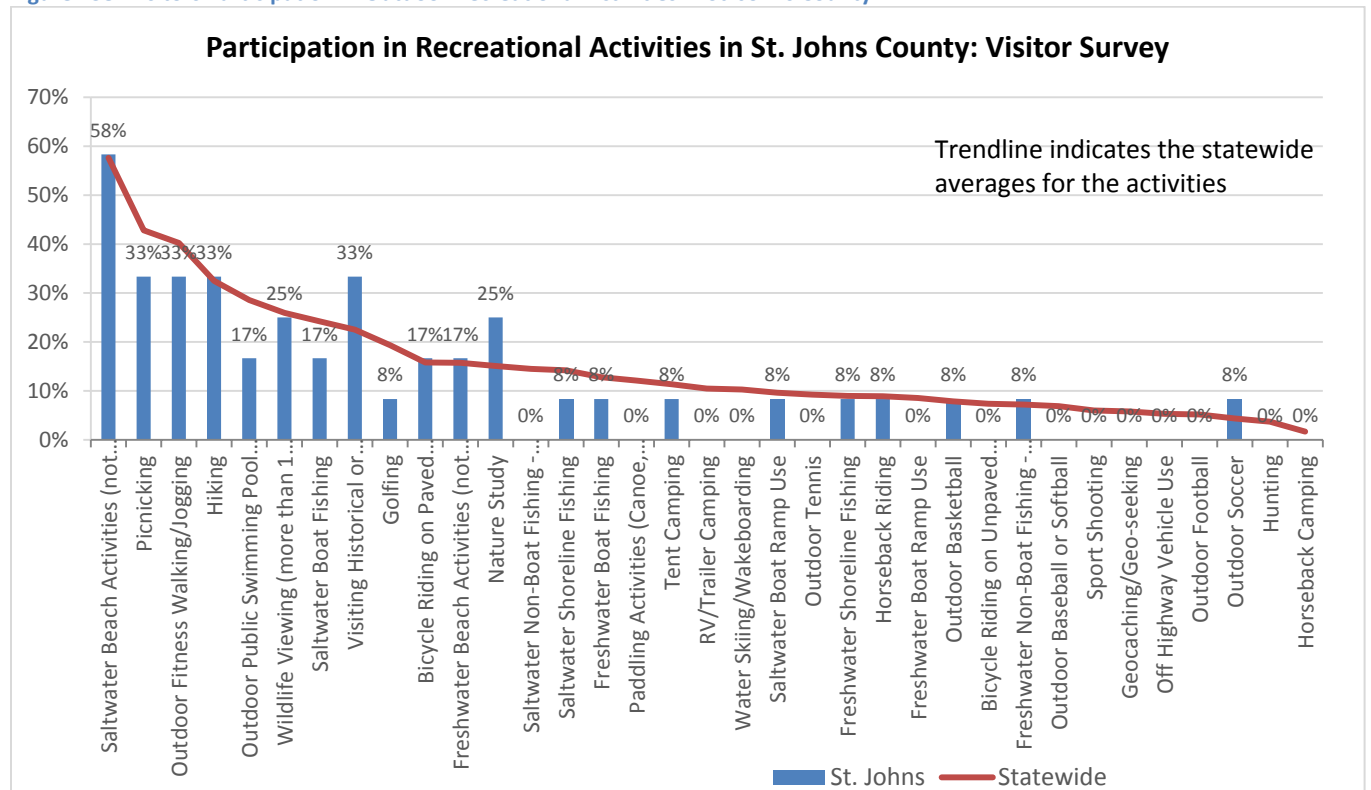


Figure 239. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in St. Lucie County

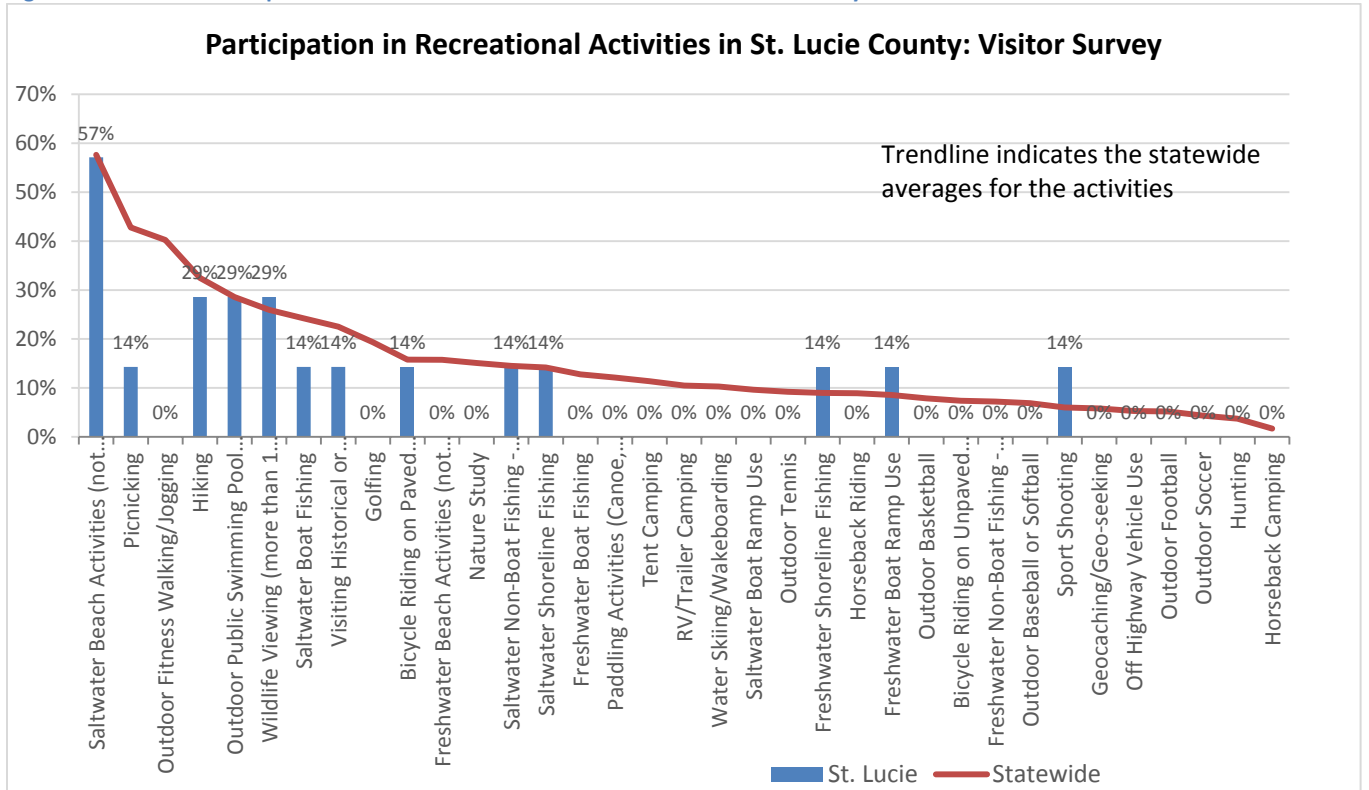


Figure 240. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Sumter County

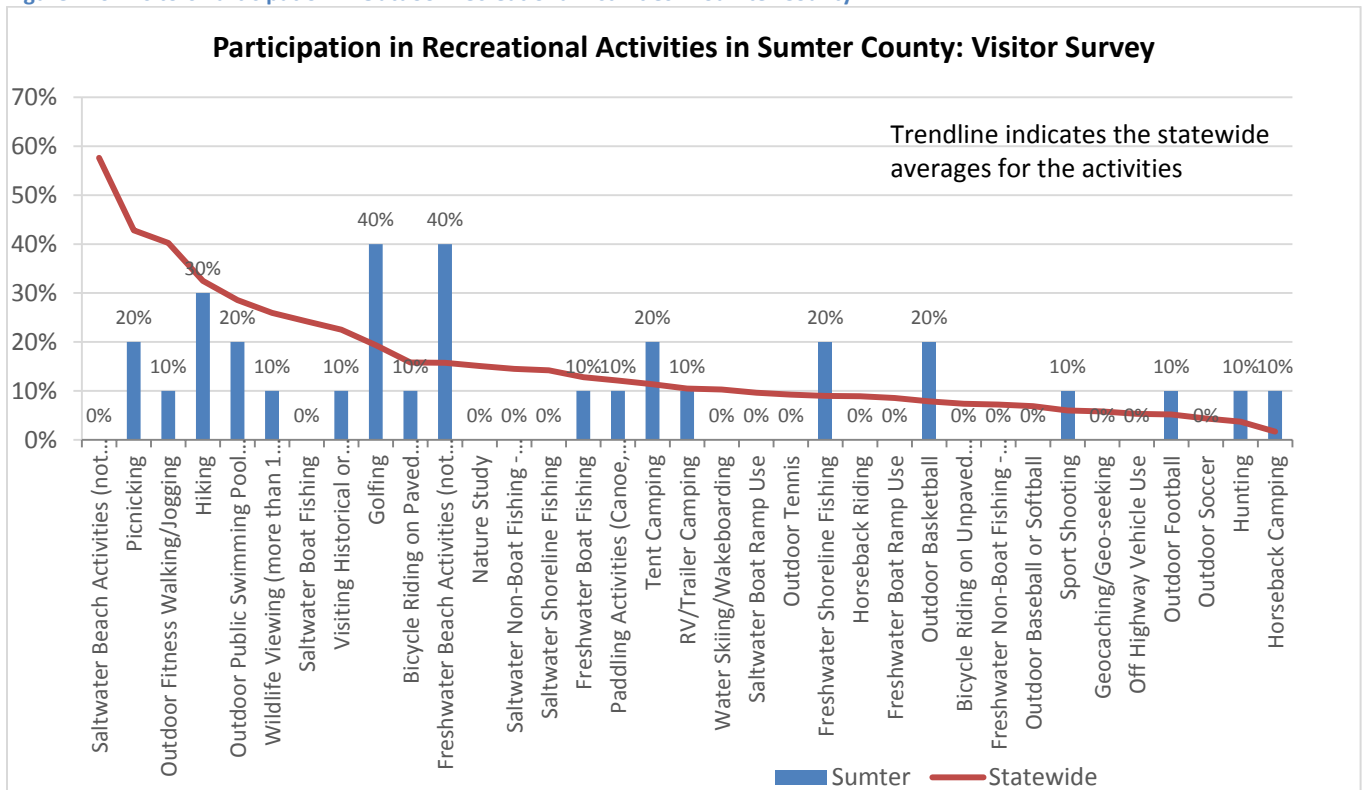


Figure 241. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Suwannee County

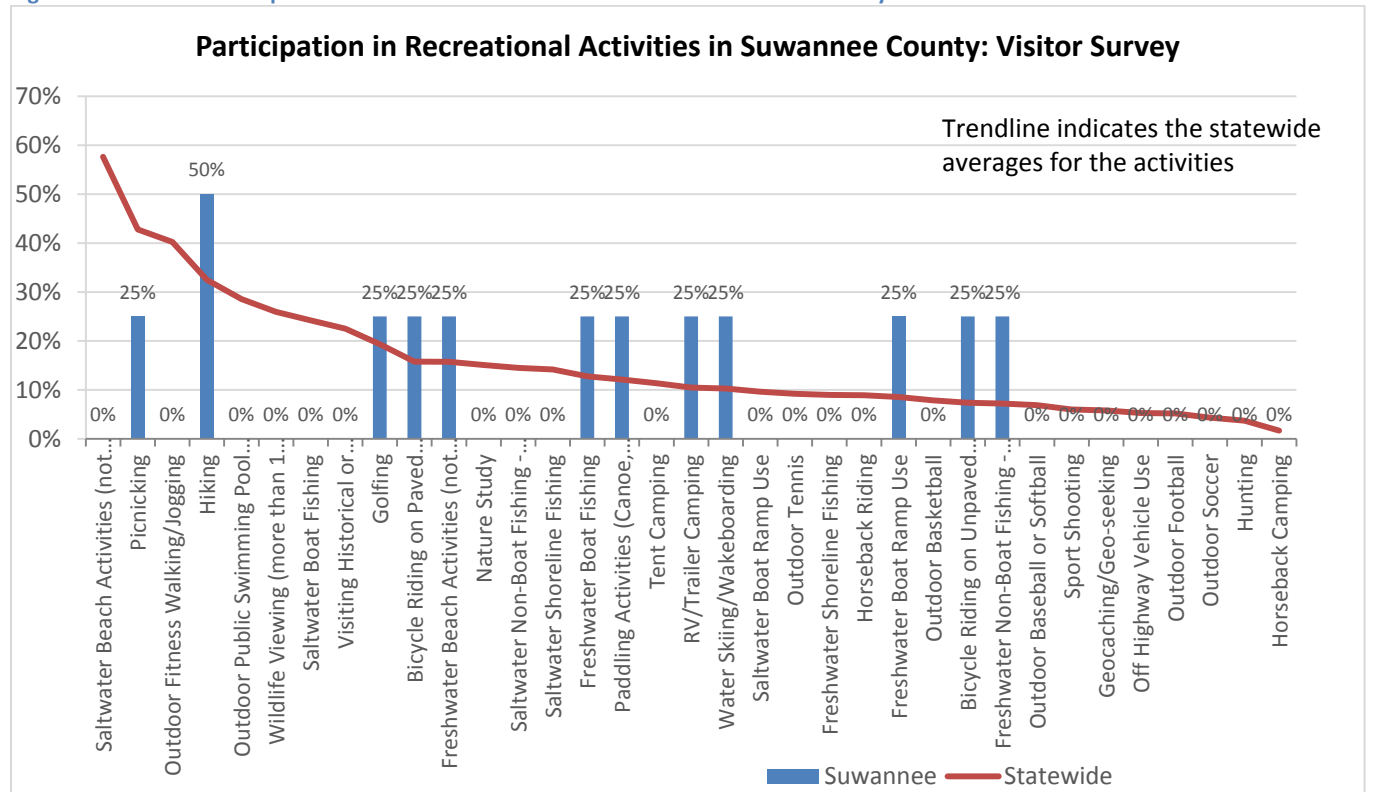


Figure 242. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Taylor County

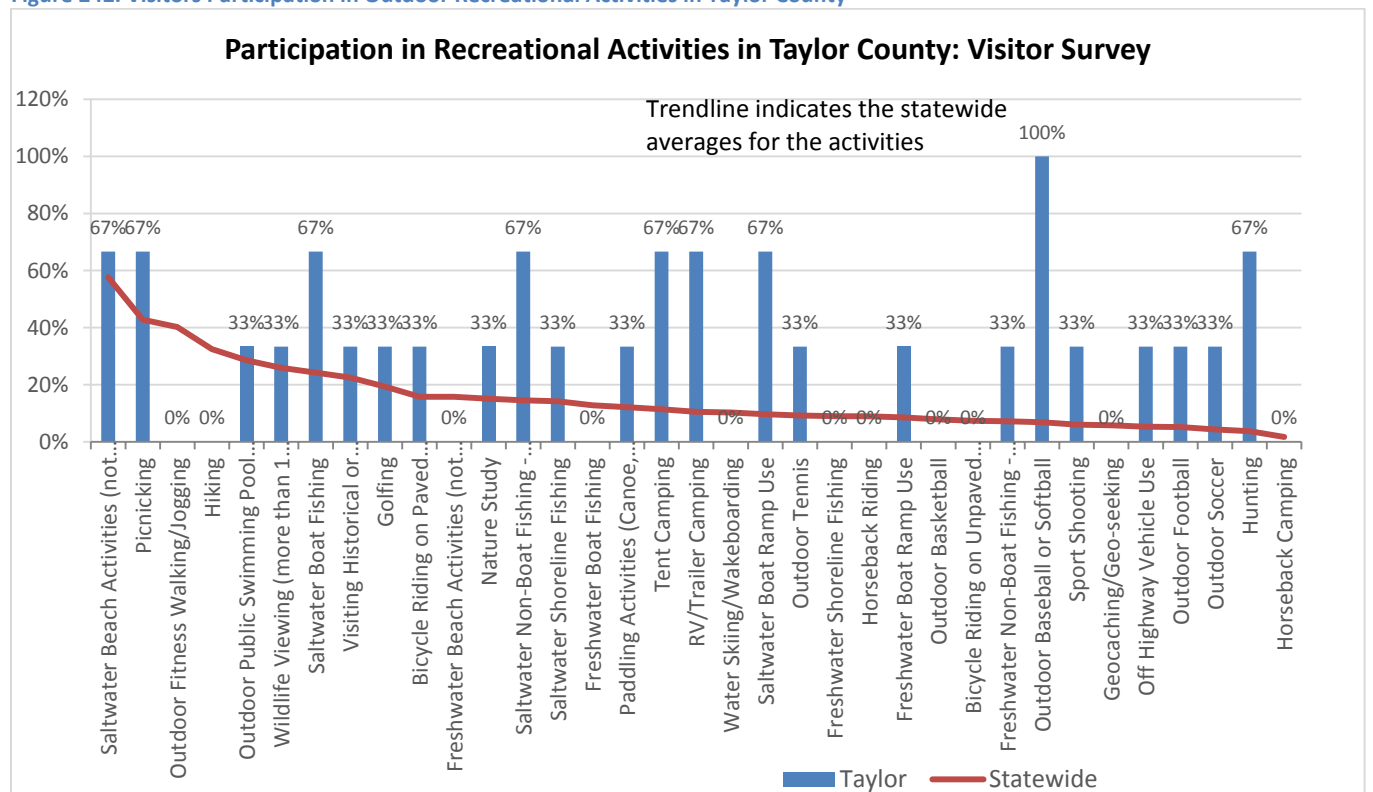


Figure 243. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Union County

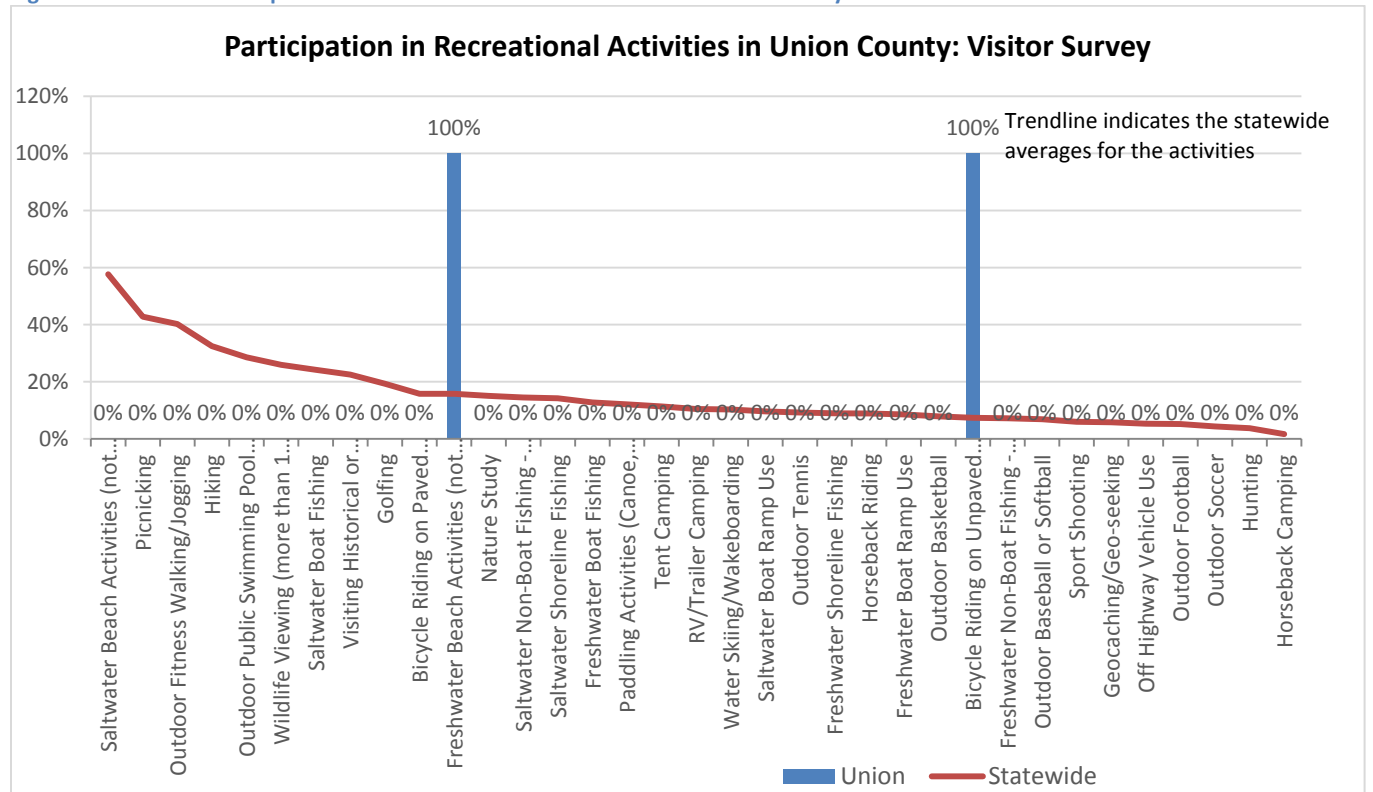


Figure 244. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Volusia County

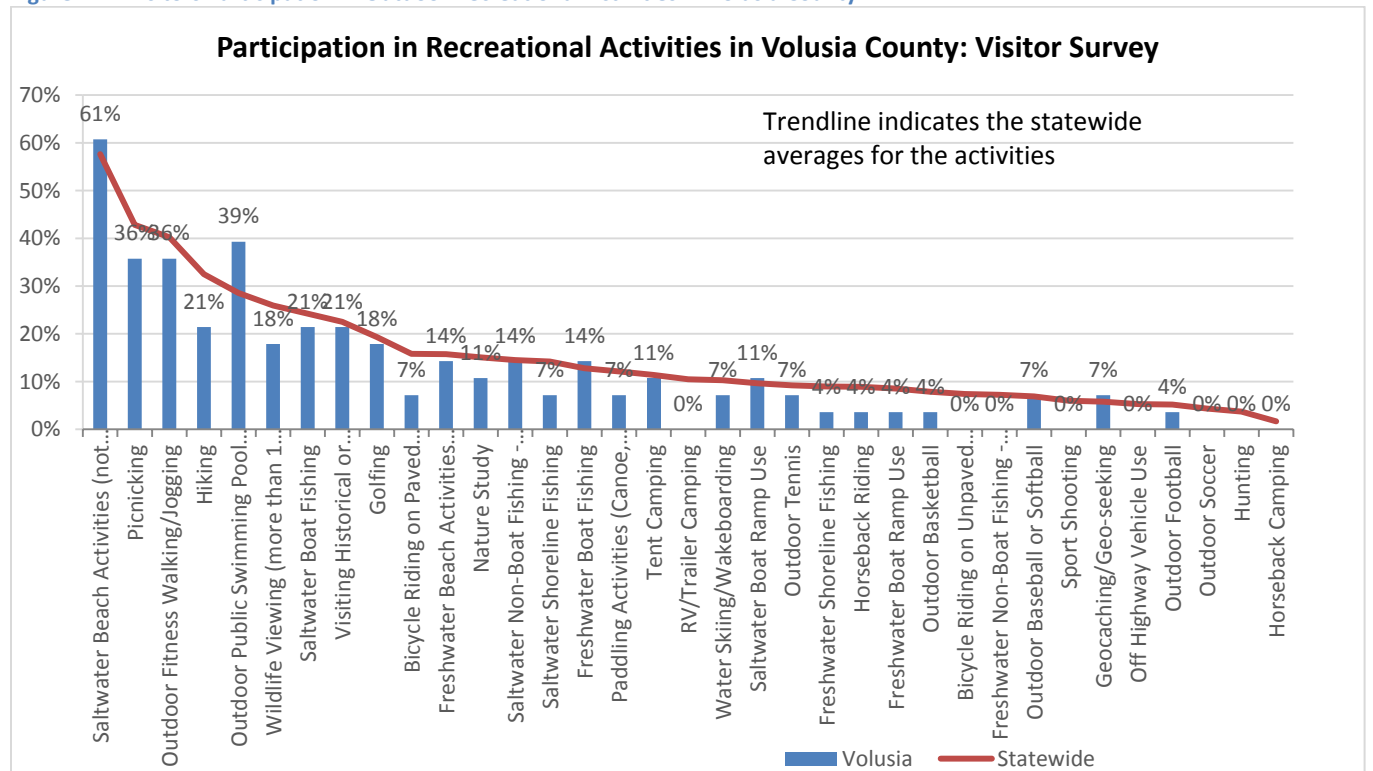


Figure 245. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Wakulla County

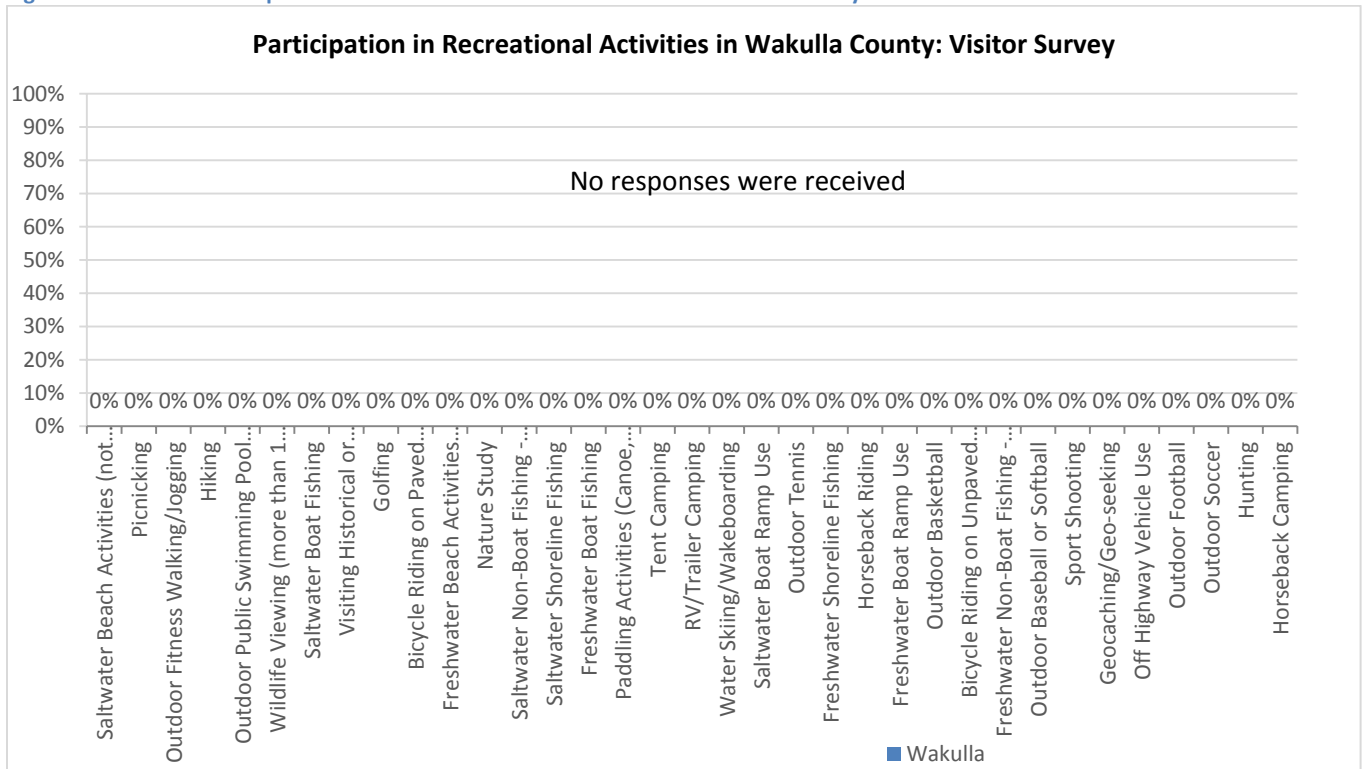


Figure 246. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Walton County

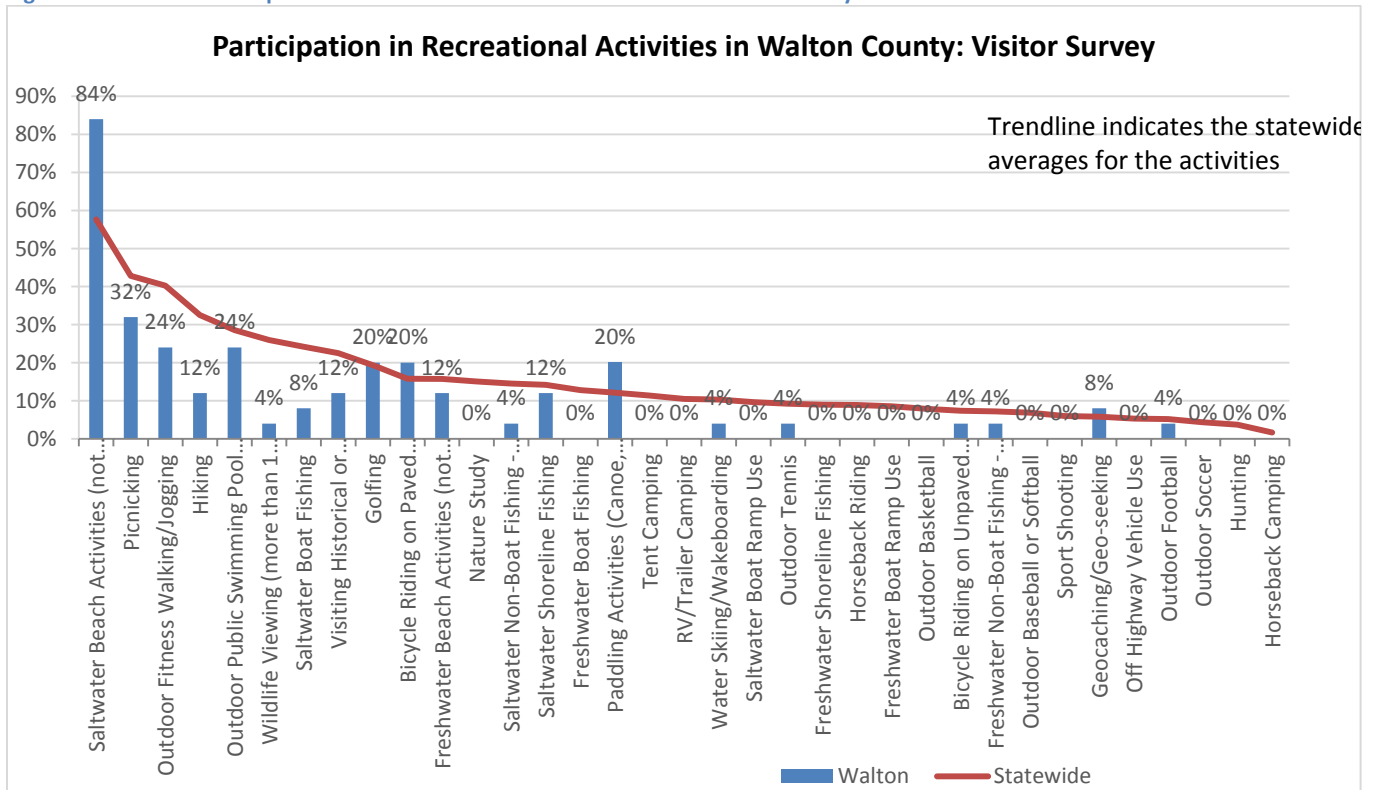


Figure 247. Visitors Participation in Outdoor Recreational Activities in Washington County
