



CLEAN VESSEL ACT (CVA) GRANT AGREEMENT

Once an agreement is reached, the grantee will sign first, followed by the DEP supervisor. The DEP supervisor's signature on the second page will establish the agreement's start date. The expiration date will be listed in the first page.

Only the agreed upon work, within the agreement period, will be eligible for reimbursement.

Grant work should start only after the agreement is fully executed.

QUARTERLY PUMPOUT GALLON REPORTING

For CVA equipment purchase or operations and maintenance funded agreements, the facility needs to submit a <u>quarterly pumpout report</u>.

- For equipment purchase agreements, the facility will be required to report for five years following the project completion date of the grant agreement.
- For operations and maintenance agreements, the facility will be required to report during the grant award period only.
