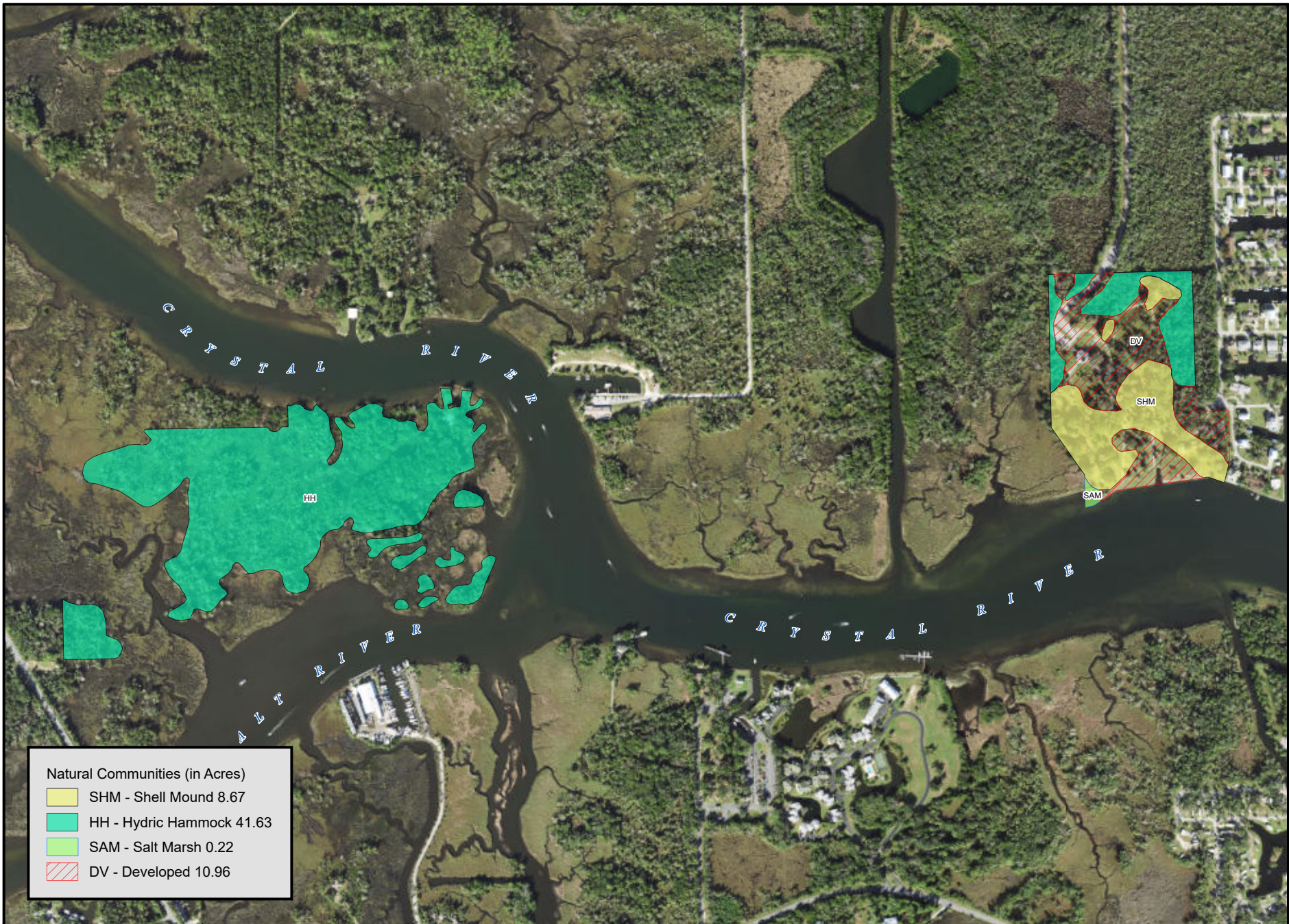

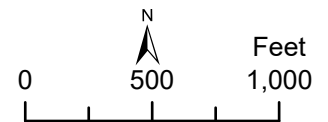

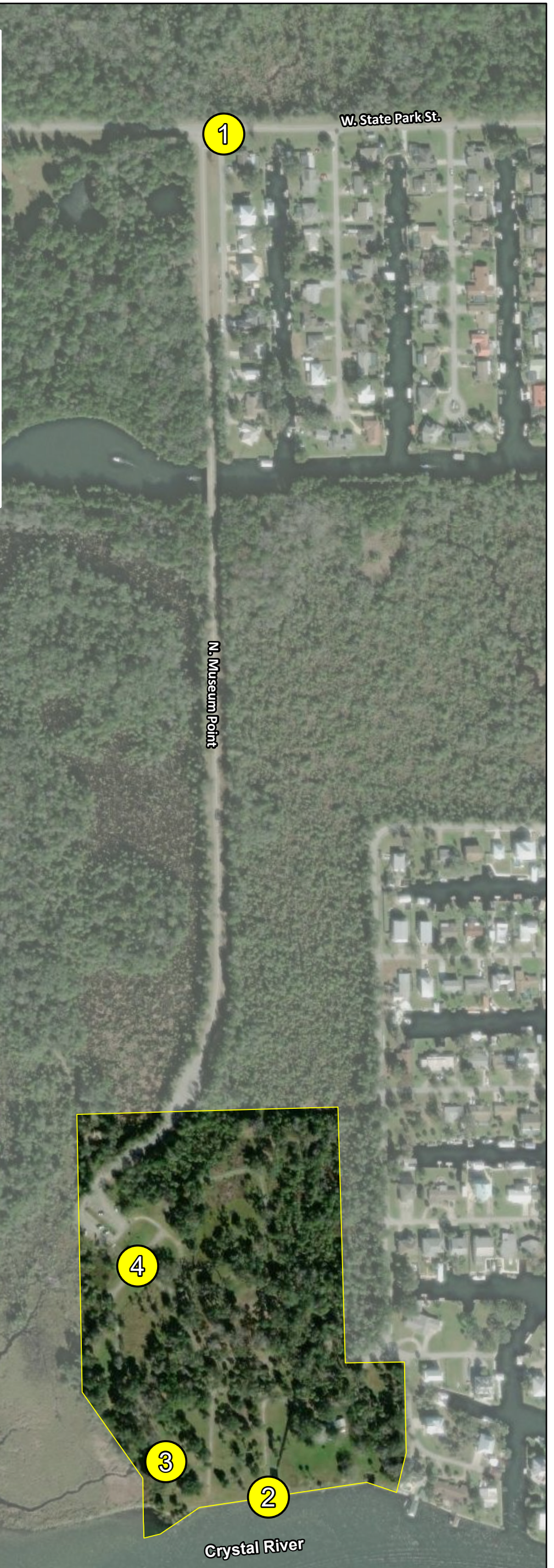
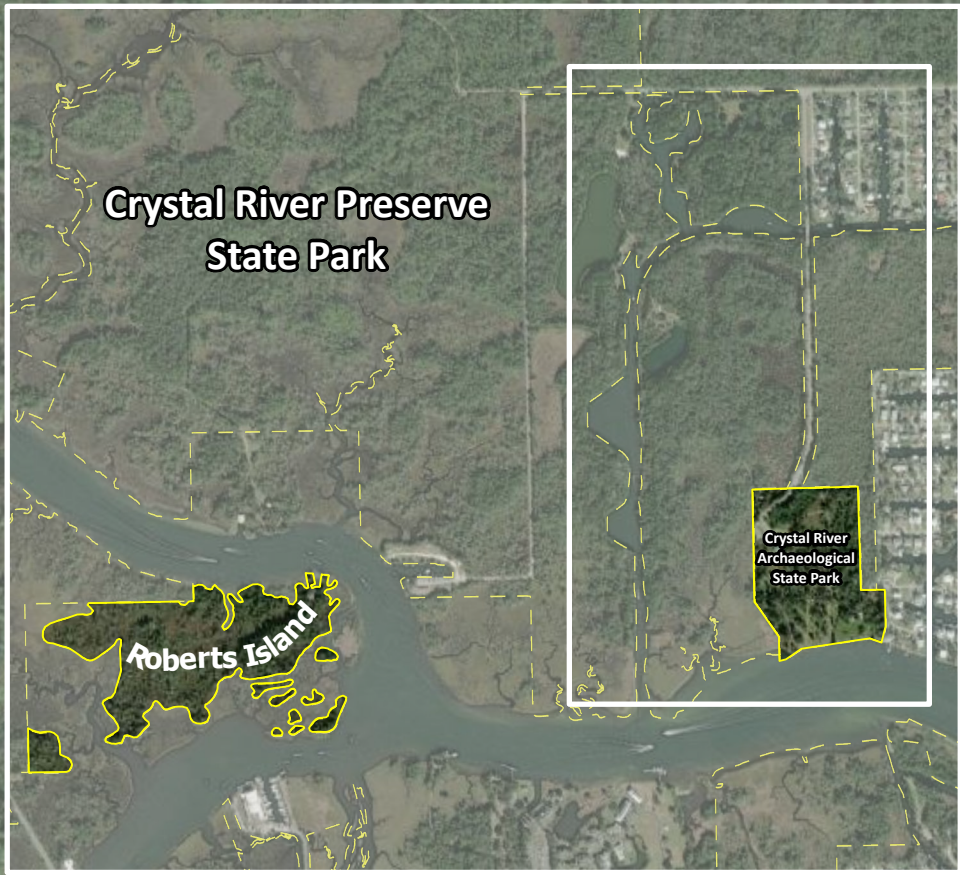

-  4 Update the Scope of Collections Statement.



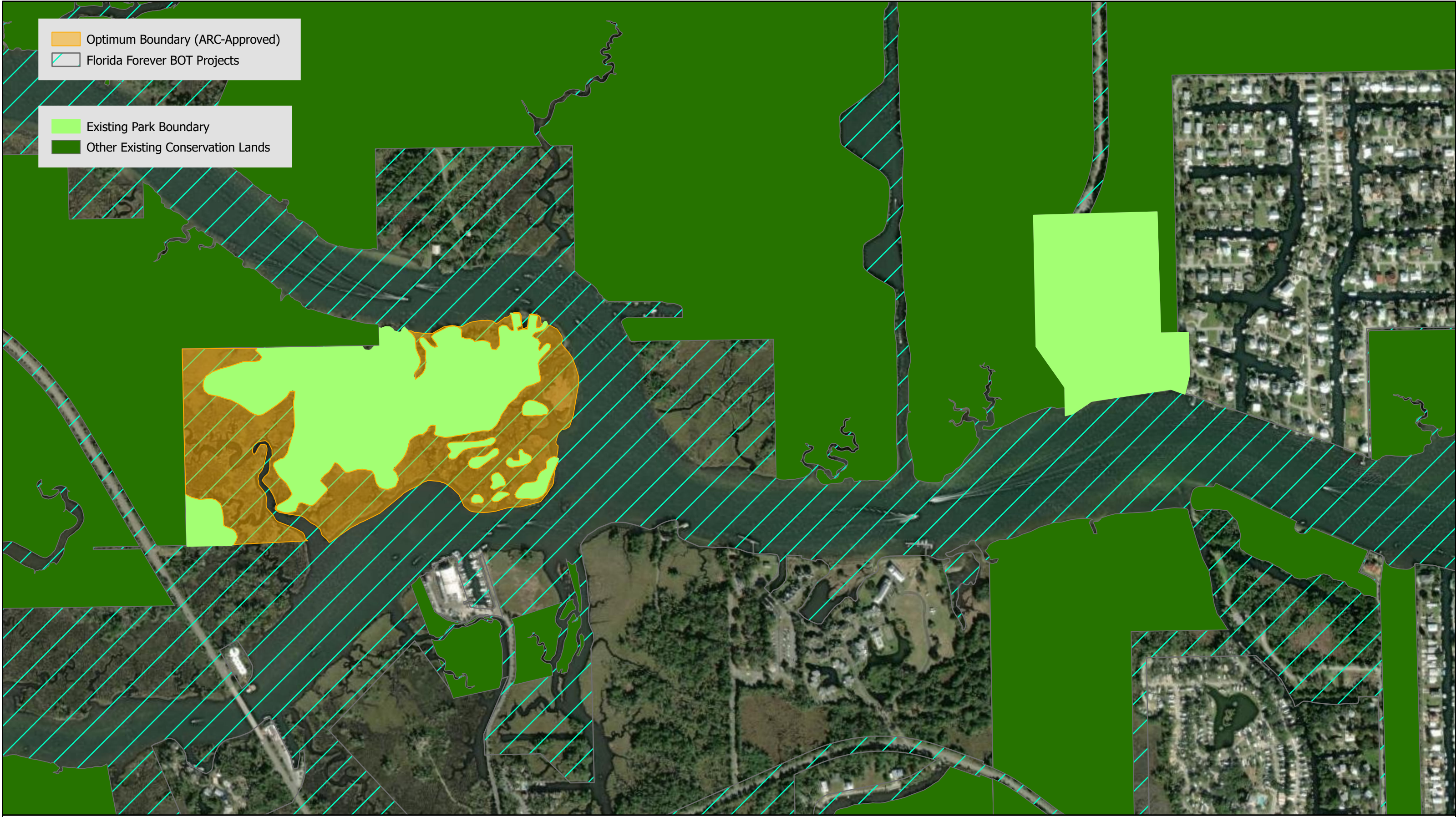
