

DEP's Daily Update on Mosaic – New Wales Sinkhole
Ongoing Oversight for October 2017

- **During the week of Oct. 30, 2017:** DEP and Mosaic collected monitoring well samples on three days, and DEP and ECT collected additional private drinking water well samples on two days.
- **During the week of Oct. 23, 2017:** DEP and Mosaic collected monitoring well samples on three days, and DEP and ECT collected additional private drinking water well samples on two days.
- **During the week of Oct. 16, 2017:** DEP and Mosaic collected monitoring well samples on three days. In accordance with their updated grouting plan implementation schedule and the ongoing requirements of the existing Consent Order, Mosaic completed construction of the extended work pad, which will expedite the remaining remedial grouting operations at the site.
- **During the week of Oct. 9, 2017:** DEP and Mosaic collected monitoring well samples on three days. In accordance with their updated grouting plan implementation schedule and the ongoing requirements of the existing Consent Order, Mosaic continued drilling and bulk grouting activity for remediation of the sinkhole. Earthwork is in progress to complete the last remaining area of the extended work pad.
- **During the week of Oct. 2, 2017:** DEP and Mosaic collected monitoring well samples on three days, and DEP and ECT collected additional private drinking water well samples. Results from these samples are forthcoming. In accordance with their updated grouting plan implementation schedule and the ongoing requirements of the existing Consent Order, Mosaic also confirmed that they had resumed drilling and grouting operations. They also continued work to complete the last pad expansion areas in order to expedite the remaining remedial grouting operations at the site.
