RCRA Waste 90 / 180 Day Accumulation Extension Request Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

When do I need to submit an extension request?

- Any time before accumulation Day 90; Large Quantity Generator (LQG)
- Any time before accumulation Day 180; Small Quantity Generator (SQG).

What does the request look like? Is there a form?

- There is no form currently for extension requests. Include a brief summary of why the request is needed and the required information for all waste.
- Use the subject line: (Facility name), (EPA ID): Accumulation Time Extension Request (Initial accumulation 90-day end date)

What needs to be included in the request?

- Description of the Waste Stream
- EPA Waste Codes
- Number of Containers
- Container Type/size (in gallons)
- Estimated Weight
- Accumulation End Date
- Extension End date

Who do I contact?

- Please contact your relevant <u>**DEP District Office**</u> to coordinate submission of your request in a timely manner.

How long is the extension good for?

- Each accumulation extension is for a 30-day period. If you are unable to ship the waste within that time you must submit another request before day 30.
- If multiple extension requests are required, please add: (extension number) after the accumulation end date

What do I do once the waste is shipped off?

- Send DEP an email stating the waste was removed and provide the initial shipment report. Once you have received the final signed copy, forward that to DEP with the Subject: (Facility name), (EPA ID): Accumulation Time Extension Request (Initial accumulation 90-day date), final manifest
