The following sites have been made eligible for petroleum cleanup EDI funding under a Consent Order (see attached) between Miami-Dade County and the Department of Environmental Protection, dated May 27, 1998

These sites were all part of a large site owned and operated by Eastern Airlines at Miami International Airport and where tracked under Facility ID # 138504453 while they were funded under the Eastern Airlines Settlement Agreement (EASA), which allowed for funding out of priority score order from October 1, 1998 through June 30, 2005. Now that The EASA has expired and these sites are funded under priority score order there is a need to separate these sites from the one facility ID used and track contamination remedial progress under the facility number listed above. These facility numbers do not have associated eligibility determination dates. Therefore, it is requested that the Consent Order dated of May 27, 1998, be used as the eligibility determination date
