The Local Trail Management Grant Examples of Eligible Projects

Projects include but are not limited to:

Equipment or contracted services

- 1. Mow grass along trail
- 2. Sweep trail of debris
- 3. Blow vegetative debris from trail
- 4. Prune vegetation along trail
- 5. Remove Trees or limbs fallen, or as risk of falling on or near trail
- 6. Trash or debris collection along trail;
- 7. Clean stormwater facilities such as culverts, catch basins to keep swales clear of debris
- 8. Manage Invasive plants
- 9. Control Drainage
- 10. Replant native vegetation along trails, mainly trees and shrubs, to improve native habitat and prevent erosion

Safety

- 1. Maintain wayfinding, informational kiosks and permanent signs
- 2. Install or replace damaged access control devices
- 3. Inspect bridges to ensure structural integrity
- 4. Install lighting to improve visibility
- 5. Trim vegetation to ensure sight distance
- 6. Remove hazardous tree limbs and other obstructions
- 7. Install fencing

Trail Repair

- a. Repair trail or boardwalk surface
- b. Seal, fill, or patch cracks in asphalt or concrete trail
- c. Cut and remove tree and shrub roots
- d. Repair trail to remove standing water
- e. Repair pothole/depression

Operations and access

- 1. Maintain/install concrete pads
- 2. Purchase and install benches
- 3. Purchase and install bike racks
- 4. Purchase waste receptacles
- 5. Purchase and install picnic tables
- 6. Purchase and install water fountain/waterbottle refill station
