ITEM 2: Announcements

The Chair of the FCT Governing Board will ask for any announcements to be made by Board members. The OMC Manager for Land and Recreation Grants Section will announce meeting instructions and instructions for public comment.

Guiding Principles for The Meeting

Meeting Parameters –To ensure that the Ranking and Selection meeting is conducted in a manner that is fair to all applicants, the following parameters have been set for all presentations:

Review of FF24 Applications – Applications will be reviewed in project number order for eligible projects, then by withdrawn projects. Review is subject to changes in sequence at the discretion of the Governing Board.

Trust Staff Presentations – Staff will introduce the project name, project number and applicant agency. We will present recommended scores for each project application and mention whether the applicant submitted objections to the preliminary project score.

Applicant Objections to Point Score – Applicants who have raised objections have the option of presenting those objections to the Board at this meeting. Each applicant has up to five (5) minutes to address any unresolved issues or objections to Staff recommended scores. (Trust Staff will notify the presenter and the Chair with time warnings). It is important to note that not all applicants who raised objections intend to present those to the Board. Applicants may disagree with our decision on their objection; however, they may elect not to pursue Board action.

Governing Board discussion – The Board may ask additional questions of applicants and Staff.

Scoring Consideration – The Board will vote to either uphold Staff recommendations or to accept applicant objection information for the awarding of additional points.

Applicant Project Excellence Presentation – Each applicant is limited to a maximum of five (5) minutes to present their project to the Board. (Trust Staff will give presenters and Chair time warnings). Applicant comments should only address requests for the awarding of additional Project Excellence points.

Governing Board Discussion – The Board may ask additional questions of applicants and Trust Staff.

Scoring Consideration – The Board will make the final applicant score determination, including the awarding of project excellence points, if any. The Board will clearly state the basis for the awarding of project excellence points.

Calculation of Scores – Applicant scores will be calculated, and the preliminary ranking will be created in descending point order. In the event of a tie score, Rule 62-818.008(2)(d) establishes a four-step tie breaking procedure. FCT will apply each of these steps, in order, until the tie is broken.

- Score received in the Community Planning Section.
- Score received in the Outdoor Recreation Section.
- Score received in the General Standards Section.
- The order in which the applications were received.

Selection for Funding – The Board will make a preliminary determination of which applications will be funded for the FF24 Grant Cycle.

Final Priority List – The final priority list as approved by the board at this meeting will be published on the FCT website following the meeting.

Public Comment – the Board will receive public comment and adjourn as all business has been concluded.
