

Program Overview and Purpose

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), pursuant to Section 375.075, F.S., is authorized to establish the Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program (FRDAP) to provide grants to qualified local governmental entities to acquire or develop land for public outdoor recreation purposes.



Eligible Applicants

- Counties
- Municipalities
- An independent special district of the State of Florida with legal responsibility for providing outdoor recreational sites and facilities for use and benefit of the general public.





Ineligible Projects

- Application scored below minimum points (minimum point score 53)
- No Site Control of the project boundary
- Board of Trustees State Owned Leased Property
- Project Site is not a Viable Recreation Area
- Support facilities more than 50% of the total project cost
- A project site would not be considered practical if it has documented and unresolved environmental violations
- Duplicate Projects or Overlapping Projects





Application Cycle Dates

- **October 1-15, 2019**
- Applications can now be submitted through the Department's Grantee Portal (Portal) at <https://myeco.force.com/grants>.
- **The Portal until will not go "live" until October 1st**
- The Portal will not accept any applications submitted after 11:59 p.m. on October 15, 2019. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- **Post marked by the deadline for applicant's who cannot submit through the Portal.**



Site Control





No Deficiencies

- Chapter 62D-5, Florida Administrative Code does not provide for a deficiency period.
- Each eligible application shall be evaluated on the basis of the information provided in accordance with the program rule.





How FRDAP Grants are Awarded

- Each application is reviewed to determine eligibility.
- FRDAP staff evaluates each eligible application according to Florida Administrative Code and the Legislative mandate to assign a final score and rank.

50,000 or less	100%	0%
50,001 to 150,000	75%	25%
150,001 to 200,000	50%	50%







Conceptual Site Plan








