The following information applies only to the FY 2026-27 Stan Mayfield Working Waterfronts Capital Outlay (SMWWCO) Grant Program funding cycle.

Application Period

- ✓ Application Webinar: Thursday, July 30, 2026, at 8:00 a.m. (EDT)
- ✓ Application Opens: Monday, August 3, 2026, at 8:00 a.m. (EDT)
- ✓ Application Deadline: Monday, August 17, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. (EDT)

Applications must be submitted electronically through the FDEP Grant Portal.
Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.

Available Funding

A total of **\$2,525,359.91** is available for the FY 2026-27 Stan Mayfield Working Waterfronts Capital Outlay (SMWWCO) Grant Program funding cycle.

Applicants may request a maximum of **\$125,000.00** per application.

The SMWWCO Grant Program is a **reimbursement-based grant program**.

- ✓ Grantees are responsible for paying eligible project costs upfront and submitting reimbursement requests with all required supporting documentation for reimbursement.

Award Notification

Applicants will be notified by email regarding the status of their application following completion of the evaluation process. Funding recommendations are contingent upon final approval and execution of grant agreements.

Payment Processing Notice

To support the State of Florida's financial system transition, payment processing will be temporarily unavailable from **October 1, 2026, through February 1, 2027**.

- ✓ Additional guidance regarding reimbursement submission timelines will be provided to all awarded grantees following grant execution.
