

Division of State Lands Land and Recreation Grants

The Land and Recreation Grants Section fosters partnerships that enhance and sustain Florida's natural and cultural resources to provide increased outdoor recreational opportunities for the state's residents and visitors.





- Local governments must provide a 25% match; no match is required for nonprofit environmental organizations and small local governments.
- Refer to the current application for maximum grant amounts.



Stan Mayfield Working Waterfronts Program awards grant funding for the acquisition of lands used directly for the restoration and preservation of working waterfronts.

- Small local governments with a population of 10,000 or less, small counties with a population of 75,000 or less and nonprofit organizations qualify for a 100-percent grant award. No match required.
- A local match is required of all other applicants.
- Refer to the current application for maximum grant amounts.

Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program

Provides state funds to acquire or develop lands for public outdoor recreation. Eligible applicants include local governments and other authorized entities with the legal responsibility to provide public outdoor recreation.

- Projects of \$50,000 or less qualify for a 100-percent grant award. A local match is required for grant requests greater than \$50,000.
- Maximum grant award is \$200,000.

The Land and Recreation Grants Section fosters partnerships that enhance and sustain Florida's natural and cultural resources to provide increased outdoor recreational opportunities for the state's residents and visitors.















A nationally competitive grant opportunity that provides federal funding to projects that provide new or significantly improved existing recreation opportunities to low-income communities located in park deserts.

- All grant awards must be matched at a 50:50 ratio.
- Funding is contingent upon approval by the National Park Service.
- Refer to the current application for maximum grant amounts.



Supplies federal grant assistance for the development and maintenance of recreational trails, trailheads and trailside facilities for both motorized and nonmotorized uses. Eligible applicants include local governments, state and federal agencies, Indian tribal governments and nonprofit organizations that have an agreement with a governmental agency to develop public lands.

- All grant awards must be matched at a 50:50, 60:40 or 80:20 ratio.
- Funding is contingent upon approval by the Federal Highway Administration.
- Refer to the current application for maximum grant amounts.



Land and Water Conservation Fund

Awards federal funds to acquire or develop lands for public outdoor recreation. Eligible applicants include state and local governmental entities with the legal responsibility for providing public outdoor recreational sites and facilities.

- Grant awards must be matched at a 50:50 ratio.
- Funding is contingent upon approval by the National Park Service.
- Refer to the current application for maximum grant amounts.
