REQUEST FOR INFORMAL DETERMINATION OF WETLAND AND OTHER SURFACE WATERS

An Informal Wetland and Other Surface Waters Determination is provided as a public service; we will make every effort to complete it in a target of 8 weeks upon receipt of all required information. Please contact Central District at 407-897-4100 or by email at DEP CD@FloridaDEP.gov if you have any questions before requesting an Informal Wetland and Other Surface Waters Determination. Incomplete information will further delay the process. There is a \$100 fee for the first acre reviewed, with an additional \$50 fee for each additional acre, up to a maximum fee of \$500. Pursuant to Florida Statute 373.109, an informal determination is not an application for a permit and is not subject to the permit review timeframes established in chapter 120, nor does it constitute final agency action.
