


Populating Unique Values When Filtering


1. Click Filter on the right-hand menu




- 2. If you want to work with the layer shown, select the field you want to filter on
- 3. Otherwise, select the layer from the drop-down menu




4. Click Add new




- 5. Select the field you want to filter on
- 6. Pick from a drop-down menu of operators
- 7. Choose the value you're interested in
- 8. You can apply multiple filters on the same layer by using the Add new button



- 9. Fill out the next condition by repeating steps 5 through 7
- 10. You have 2 choices under "Show features where", "All the following are true" is the equivalent of an AND statement, "Any of the following are true" is the equivalent of an OR statement



- 11. If you want to add layers open an attribute table, click Layers in the left-hand menu
- 12. Click the ellipsis beside the layer of interest and click Show table to open the attribute table
- 13. Click Add if you want to add layers



14. After clicking Add, you can use the search bar or scroll through available layers. In the top drop-down box, you also have the option to search through the Living Atlas or ArcGIS Online
