Purpose

The purpose of this meeting is to receive public input on proposed improvements and facilities at John D. MacArthur Beach State Park.

Background

John D. MacArthur Beach State Park is a 436.39-acre property located in Palm Beach County, in North Palm Beach, Florida. The park is managed by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Recreation and Parks (DRP).

Improvements

The following developments/improvements are proposed for the updated John D. MacArthur Beach State Park management plan:

- Repairs and improvements to Munyon Island
- Re-deck the Lagoon Boardwalk
- Renovate restrooms near the Atlantic Beach Access
- Replace shop building
- Stabilize dune crossovers with crushed shell
- Connect park to the central sewer system in the area
- Add improvements to the South Paddling Launch
- Construct new volunteer sites near the SatinLeaf Picnic Area
