




What is Map Direct?

- Map Direct is a web-based application that allows you to research whether FDEP has information regarding a property and/or other properties nearby a specific location.
- Map Direct can be used to access certain information regarding a specific location by providing links to information that is stored in Oculus.








Accessing Map Direct – Main Screen






Searching for an Address


 Search for a specific location using an address, the County, a parcel ID, coordinates.

Hint when you are searching for a parcel ID, always add the "Cadastral Property Appraiser Parcels" layer.






Adding Layers





Adding Layers

- Layers are not preloaded to your search; you must select at least one.
- You can scroll down in the Layers window to view all of the available layers.
- You can also search for layers by program (ex: ERP, Waste, Portable Water).
- To add a layer, click "Add Layer to Map".
- You can add and remove as many layers as needed for your search.











Drop a Marker

 The Drop Marker feature will allow you to search the surrounding area based on the physical address you are using for your search.



 Click on the Drop Marker icon, then click "What's Nearby the Marker".







Drop a Marker – Search Results

- Based on where your marker is placed on the map, a new tab will open with your search results.
- The search results will generate into a report with information based on your search radius.






 If you click back to the Map Direct map tab, you will see your search area around the marker.
