Navigating

The map will load an image of the whole state. Use your scroll wheel to zoom in on your area of interest. Or you can select a county from the pop-up list at the lower right corner





Zoom to Address

Zoom to an address by typing it in the Search box in the upper right corner. The computer will provide suggestions below as you complete your query. You can sometimes zoom to a project location by entering the DEP Project Number here as well.





Background Imagery

Change the background to an aerial photo or other selections by clicking the double arrow button at the bottom left corner and clicking on your selection.





Imagery Slider

- Click on the Imagery Slider button in the bottom left corner to choose the year of aerial photo background.
- Be aware that not all locations have photos for all years. In this example there is only partial coverage of the state in that year.
- Aerials may take a minute to load because of the data size.





Adding Layers

- Click on the arrow in the upper left corner to access the More Data button.
- There are over 4500 data layers that you can add.
- Enter a search term and use the filters to find those layers you want.







Data Layers

- Some data layers become visible only when you zoom in.
- If your map is too busy, you can easily turn off the layers by clicking on the layer icon in the list to the left.
- Those with the ! symbol are not visible right now.





Identification of Data

- Markers of different shapes and colors represent points from the various data layers.
- Click on a marker to show information, including the Department Site Number on the right.
- Click on the Documents link to access documents in the Oculus database.
- Print the results or put them in a table format.





Other Search Features

Expand the toolbar at the bottom center of the map and click the I-Ball tool to allow you to select an area of interest.





Results Table

Map Direct identifies all layer items within your polygon. The results can be exported to a table if desired.



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Bookmarks

There are a couple of ways to Bookmark your work in Map Direct. The bookmark in the bottom center toolbar lets you easily zoom back to a specific location. Name and add the bookmark. Go to the same tool to choose it when you again open up Map Direct on the same computer.





More Bookmarks

- Alternatively, Select the Share Map button on the top center tool bar to Bookmark the Map. This saves map layers as well as location but is only accessible on that computer.
- Choose Save Map to share the map location and layers that with any computer. To access, open Map Direct, choose the Load Map button and select the saved file.







Measurement Tool



Use the Measurement Tool in the bottom center toolbar to measure distance or area.











The Pencil tool at the bottom center toolbar lets you create markers, polygons, and labels of various types and colors to create a site map with identified features.





Area of Interest

Click on a site of interest and then choose Drop Marker from the menu at the right to place a blue marker at that location. Then click on the What's Nearby button.





What's Nearby

- What's Nearby allows you to create a report of all features in a selected area. Specify the buffer, and choose the Report features.
- Choose the Standard Report, or a specific report from a drop down list.
- Customize the report by adding or deleting data layers to be searched.
