

Motor Fuel Supplier Outreach

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is providing you with this outreach guidance because of your current listing with the Florida Department of Revenue as a petroleum carrier in the State of Florida.

As a licensed petroleum carrier, your company has responsibilities in accordance with Chapter 376, Florida Statutes (FS) if it provides motor fuel (such as for vehicles or standby generators) in liquid form, at standard temperature and pressure, to the following types of storage tanks:

- Stationary aboveground tank with a capacity of greater than 550 gallons, or
- Underground tank with a capacity of greater than 110 gallons

Specifically, 376.3077, FS, states that it is unlawful for any supplier to pump or otherwise deposit any motor fuel into a tank required to be registered with DEP, unless proof of valid registration is displayed on such tank itself or the dispensing or measuring device connected thereto or, where appropriate, in the office or kiosk of the facility where the tank is located.
