- 1** Campground (Dogwood and Magnolia) - Upgrade utilities at each site and bathhouses and stabilize road loops within both campgrounds (1a and 1b).
- 2** Support Area- Reorganize support area and consolidate buildings into two large shop buildings. Develop volunteer village and add three pole barns.
- 3** Santa Fe Day Use Area - Maintain suspension bridge as needed, along with all CCC era structures.
- 4** Parkwide Trail System- Improve wayfinding and interpretation along all park trails. Replace all boardwalks as needed.
- 5** Group Cabin Complex - Add exterior lighting near cabins. Renovate bathhouse, dining hall, and craft building, along with other structures as needed.
- 6** Bible Camp Road- Coordinate road and boat ramp improvements with Columbia County
- 7** Old Bellamy Road Trailhead- Improve interpretation and wayfinding at trailhead with new panels.

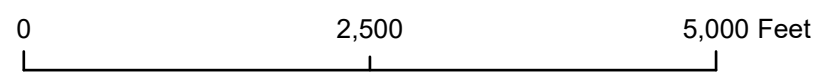

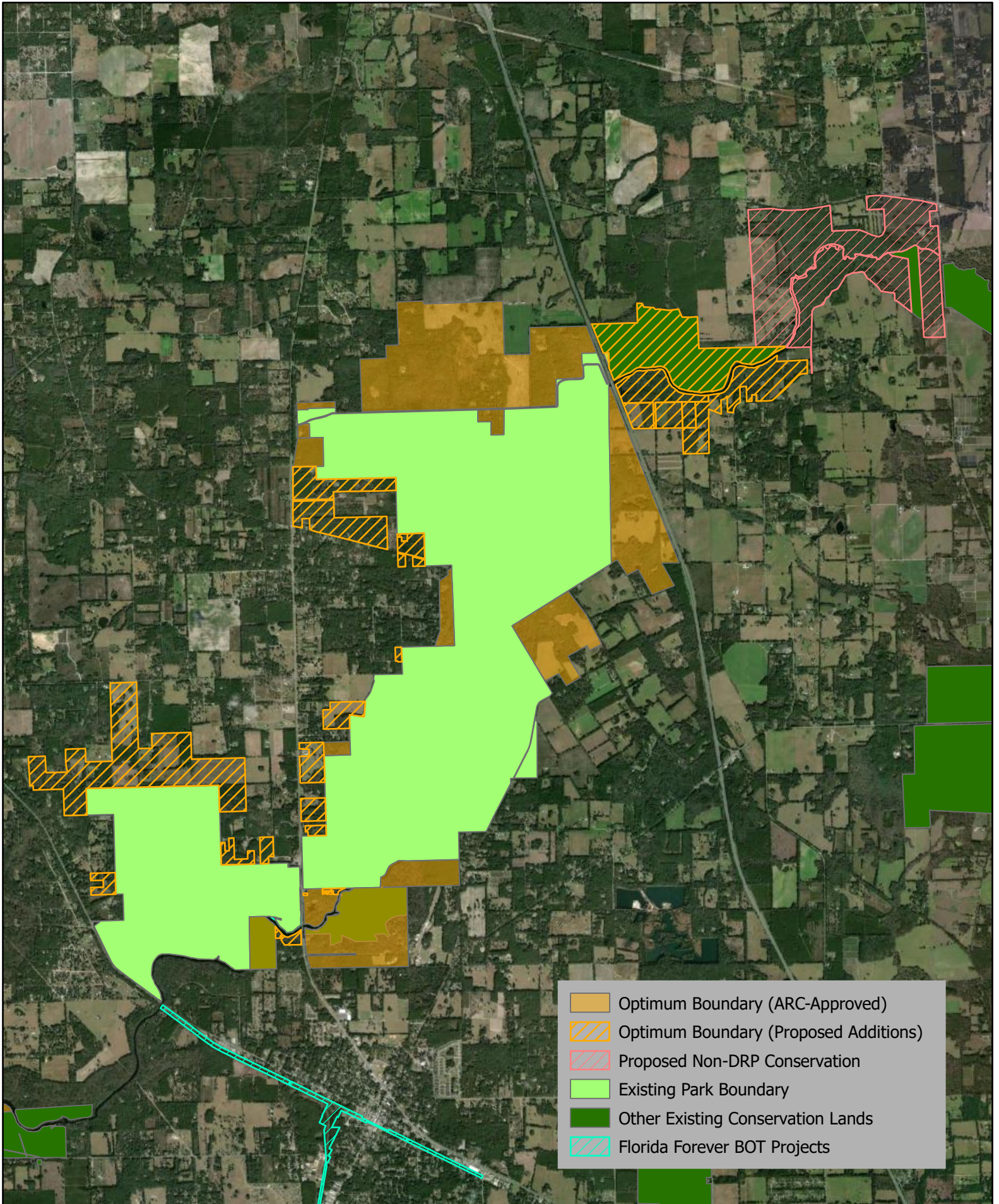


