Q: When do we need more than one quote?

A: When the aggregate from a subcontractor or vendor for the purchase order is greater than \$2,500.00 three quotes are required.

Q: Is Line Item 1-5 compensated for Right or Way Access?

A: Yes, Line Item 1-5 can be scoped and billed for Right of Way Access for FDOT or Local Roads that provide access permits in lieu of access agreements.

Q: How do I scope Carbon Treatment when the Carbon needed exceeds the amount listed for a Large System?

A: If the Carbon requirements exceed 2,000 pounds of granular activated carbon, then quotes must be obtained.

Q: Should ATCs sign quotes from Subcontractors or Vendors?

A: PRP - ATCs are not required to sign quotes from Subcontractors or Vendors. However, PRP - ATCs should: 1) assure all quotes contain defined consistent services/supplies; 2) do not contain proprietary or confidentiality claims without proper documentation; and 3) expiration dates must have an adequate timeframe for the work to be performed.
