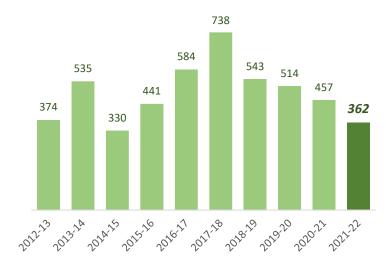

Discharge Closures by Fiscal Year

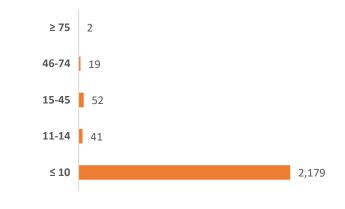

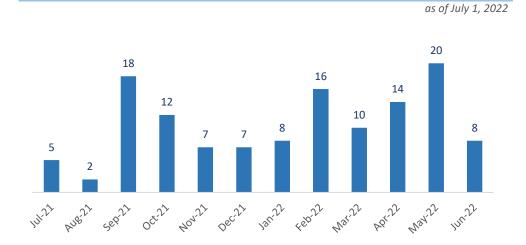

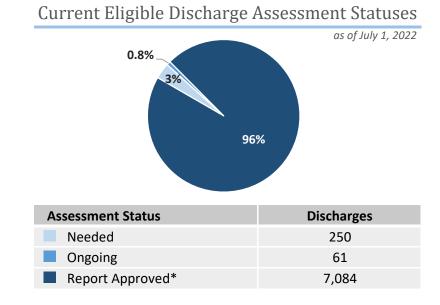
