

RECYCLING RECOGNITION PROGRAM

Purpose

The Recycling Recognition program recognizes outstanding recycling efforts by private businesses, institutions, schools, public organizations and citizens. This is to encourage and increase recycling in order to reach Florida's recycling goal of 75% by 2020. If you can document a recycling rate at or above the current interim recycling goal of 40% your business or organization will be recognized.

Reporting

The Department has an easy tool, called Re-TRAC, for organizations to track, compare and report their recycling efforts. Through the website, which includes free registration, organizations can track different types of recycling efforts and produce reports on how those efforts are helping to shrink their carbon footprint.

Recognizing

Recipients will receive a Recycling Recognition certificate as well as be listed on the Recycling Recognition webpage (www.dep.state.fl.us). The webpage listing will also highlight your organization's outstanding recycling efforts.
