Natural Communities - Existing Conditions



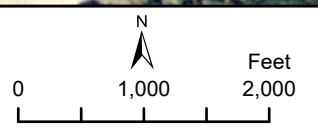










RAINBOW SPRINGS STATE PARK

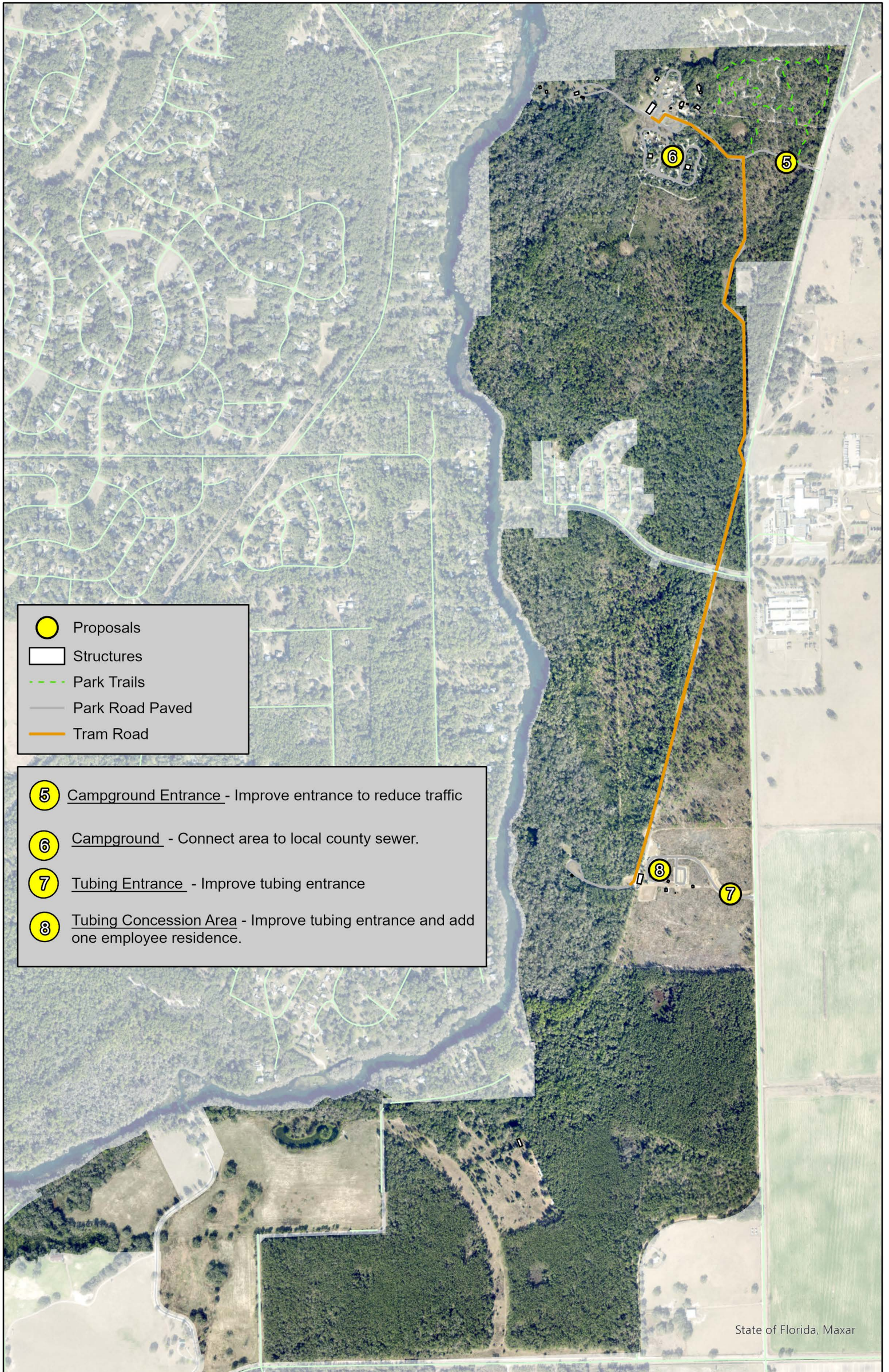
-  **1** Park Entrance - Add entrance station
-  **2** Parking Area - Redesign parking area and add wayfinding signs. Remove excess asphalt, and restore areas with natural vegetation.
-  **3** Headspring Use Area - Add paddle craft dock walkway, develop landscaping. Reduce footprint of ornamental gardens, and prioritize native vegetation planting.
-  **4** Group Camp - Develop two small group camps

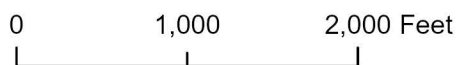
-  5 Campground Entrance - Improve entrance to reduce traffic

-  8 Tubing Concession Area - Improve tubing entrance and add one employee residence.

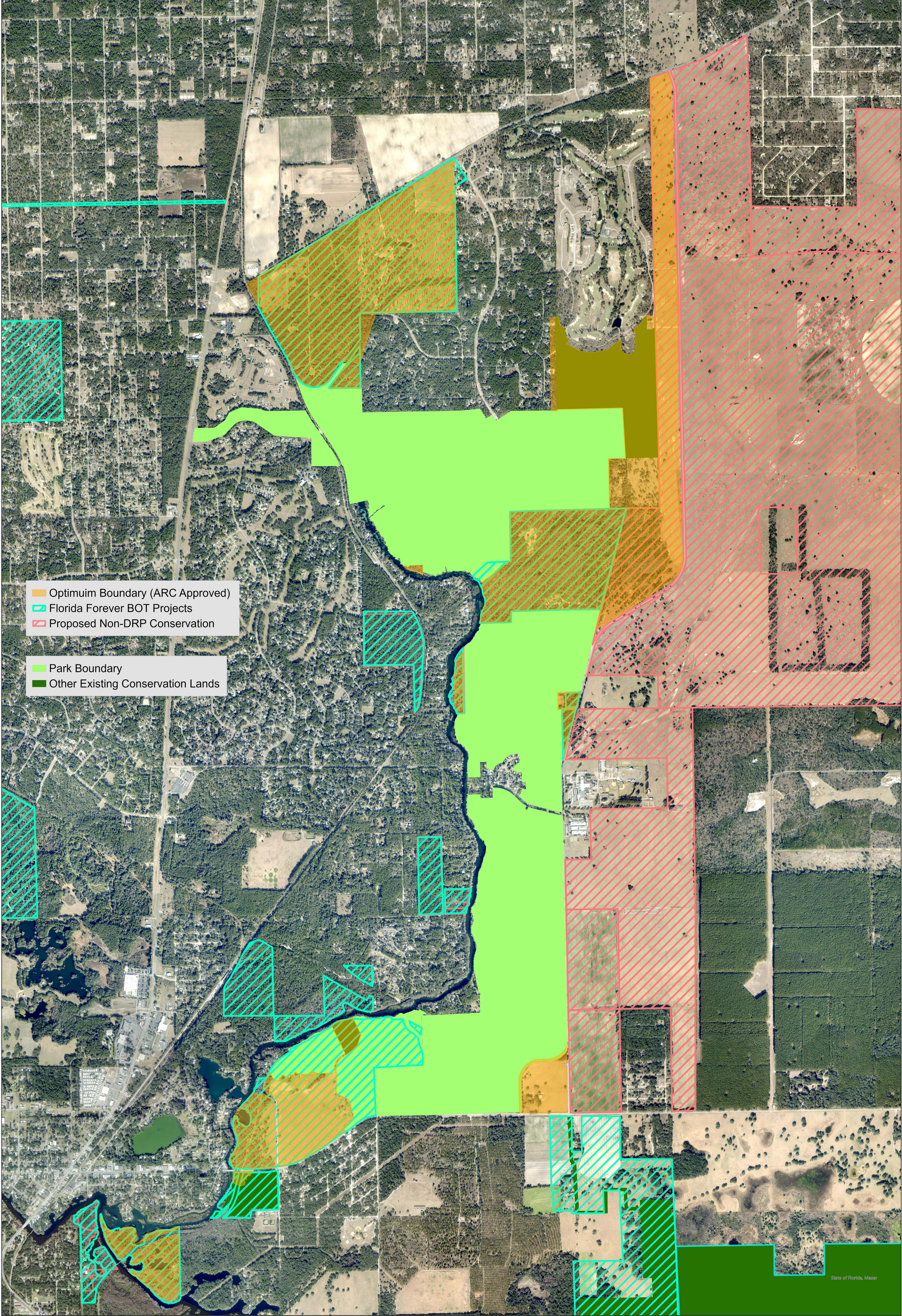

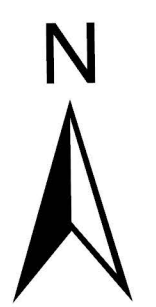
