Please be aware that Notices of Rule Development, Notices of Rule Workshops or Hearing, Notices of Proposed Rule, Notices of Change, Notices of Intent to Adopt a Rule and Notices of Withdrawal pertaining to specific Florida rule sections are published in the Florida Administrative Register (FAR) (available online at www.flrules.org). Although the Division's Air Regulatory Projects Update may coincide with open comment periods for specific rulemaking activities, the Update is not intended to serve as general or specific notice of any pending rulemaking activity or as a substitute for the public notices published in the FAR.

This Update lists Florida air rules recently adopted, revised or repealed, guidance memoranda issued, and Clean Air Act State Implementation Plan (SIP) revisions recently submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) by the Division.

Updates

Stationary Sources-General Requirements

On April 28, 2021, DEP published a Notice of Proposed Rule (NOPR) for Rule 62-210.300, F.A.C. The purpose of this NOPR is to update and expand the current categorical permit exemption for burning of drugs in boilers with a heat input of 250 million Btu per hour or more, to instead allow for law enforcement and other government agencies to incinerate drugs seized by law enforcement, prohibited agricultural food products, and animal carcasses in incinerators consistent with the state's incinerator rule, Rule 62-296.401, F.A.C., and federal incinerator regulations, 40 CFR Part 60, Subparts Eb, Cb, AAAA, BBBB, CCCC, DDDD, EEEE, adopted and incorporated by reference in Rule 62-204.800, F.A.C. The proposed revisions also include correcting a cross-reference in the permit exemption for brownfield remediation sites. The Notice of Rule Development was published on March 17, 2021.

Stationary Sources-Emission Standards

On April 21, 2021 DEP published a Notice of Withdrawal for Rules 62-296.402, 62-296.404, 62-296.405, and 62-296.570, F.A.C. On January 22, 2021, DEP published a Notice of Proposed Rule (NOPR) for Rules 62-296.402, 62-296.404, 62-296.405, and 62-296.570, F.A.C. The purpose of this NOPR was to revise Rules 62-296.402, 62-296.404, 62-296.405, and 62-296.570, F.A.C., to address air emissions during transient operation conditions for some source categories, deleting provisions that are outdated or superseded by federal standards, clarification of federal rule applicability and what an existing and new source in each rule that uses these terms. Other minor corrective or clarifying amendments were also proposed. The Notice of Rule Development was published on October 22, 2020.

Operation Permits for Major Sources of Air Pollution

The DEP filed the Certification Package with the Department of State on March 19, 2021. The effective date of the rule revisions is April 8, 2021. On January 6, 2021, DEP published a Notice of Proposed Rule (NOPR) for Rules 62-213.202, 62-213.420, 62-213.440 and 62-213.900, F.A.C. The purpose of this NOPR is to revise Chapter 62-213, F.A.C., to clarify language in Rule 62-213.202, F.A.C., regarding "Primary Responsible Official" and its use on the notification form, revise the Responsible Official Notification Form to add instructions, adopt and incorporate by reference the Statement of Compliance Form and Responsible Official Notification Form in the rules where they are referenced, clarify monitoring and related recordkeeping and reporting requirements, repeal rule section 62-213.900, F.A.C., and remove obsolete references to the federal Clean Air Interstate Rule (CAIR). The Notice of Rule Development was published on October 22, 2020.

Electrical Power Plant Siting

The DEP filed the Certification Package for Rule 62-17.211, F.A.C., with the Department of State on April 14, 2021. The effective date of the rule revisions is May 4, 2021. The DEP received comments from the Joint Administrative Procedures (JAPC) committee on January 21, 2021. Based on JAPC's comments, the DEP published a Notice of Change on March 12, 2021, for Rule 62-17.211, F.A.C., to amend the Notice of Intent to Transfer of Certification Form. DEP filed the Certification Package for Rules 62-17.021 and 61-17.191, F.A.C. with the Department of State on March 19, 2021. The effective date of the rule revisions is April 8, 2021.

On January 6, 2021, DEP published a Notice of Proposed Rule (NOPR) for Rules 62-17.021, 62-17.191, and 62-17.211, F.A.C. The purpose of this NOPR is to: delete definitions in Rule 62-17.021, F.A.C., that are already defined by statute or associated with a rule that has been repealed; revise existing definitions; update and clarify processes in Rule 62-17.191, F.A.C., for review of post-certification submittals in order

to determine compliance with the Conditions of Certification; and update and clarify processes in Rule 62-17.211, F.A.C., for modifying a certification and transferring a certification and to incorporate the Notice of Intent to Transfer of Certification Form into the rule section. The Notice of Rule Development was published on October 22, 2020.
