This is a rule development workshop to discuss and receive public input on the draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Construction Generic Permit (CGP). The proposed changes to the NPDES CGP include a new structure and format, the introduction of new requirements based on the 2022 U.S. Environmental Protection Agency CGP, and permit requirements that are clearer and more specific for both the regulated community and regulatory entities. The Notice of Rule Development on the above subject matter was published in the Florida Administrative Register on Feb. 18, 2025, (Vol. 51, No. 33).
