SMWWCO GRANT PROGRAM PROGRAM OVERVIEW AND PURPOSE

Stan Mayfield Working Waterfronts Florida Forever Grant Program

- The Stan Mayfield Working Waterfronts Florida
 Forever Grant Program was created by the 2008
 Florida Legislature.
- To fund the program, the Legislature provided 2.5% of the total Florida Forever program appropriation.






SMWWCO GRANT PROGRAM PROGRAM OVERVIEW AND PURPOSE


- The SMWWCO Grant Program was created to provide funding to assist commercial saltwater products, commercial saltwater wholesale dealers, retailer license holders and seafood houses in maintaining their operations.
- The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) administers the SMWWCO Grant Program to support the commercial fishing industry, including infrastructure for receiving or unloading seafood, for the purpose of supporting the seafood economy.

SMWWCO GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION CYCLE

FY 2024-25 SMWWCO Grant Program Application Cycle: July 15, 2024 – July 31, 2024

Applications must be submitted through DEP's Grantee Portal.

The Application Portal will go live on July 15, 2024.

Applications received after 5 p.m. EDT on July 31, 2024, will not be considered.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.




SMWWCO GRANT PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING

- Grants will be awarded on a first come, first served basis to eligible applicants submitting complete application forms for eligible projects during the grant application cycle.
- The minimum amount of grant funds an applicant may request is \$5,000. The maximum amount of grant funds an applicant may request is \$250,000. Grant recipients will not be required to provide a match.
- Funding will be provided on a reimbursement basis. Grant recipients will be required to submit invoices to DEP, who will conduct a site inspection to confirm the accuracy of the invoices.
- Expenditures made prior to the execution date will not be reimbursed.
- No work may begin until a grant agreement has been executed by the Department.

SMWWCO GRANT PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

An applicant may submit no more than one (1) application during the submission period.

Additionally, applicants must have one of the following active Florida business licenses/certificates:

- Commercial saltwater products
- Commercial saltwater wholesale dealer
- Retail license holder
- Seafood houses

SMWWCO GRANT PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

FY 2024-25 SMWWCO Application Cycle Ineligibility for Consulting Services

Some recipients may depend on consulting services to assist with project applications. However, prospective applicants are ultimately responsible for any awarded grant funds and all that an approved project may encompass.

Grant agreements are executed between the prospective applicant and DEP, and the recipient is ultimately responsible for all grant activities and will be held accountable. As such, only the entity listed on the provided active license/certification may submit an application.

Applications submitted by a third party, such as a consultant, will be declared ineligible for funding.



SMWWCO GRANT PROGRAM ELIGIBLE EXPENSES

Eligible costs and expenditures are divided into two project categories:

FIXED CAPITAL OUTLAY OPERATING CAPITAL OUTLAY

These include, but are not limited to:

- Repair and maintenance or replacement of equipment
- Repair and maintenance or replacement of water-adjacent facilities or infrastructure
- Construction or renovation of shore-side facilities.











SMWWCO GRANT PROGRAM ELIGIBLE EXPENSES

FIXED CAPITAL OUTLAY PROJECTS

Eligible fixed capital outlay costs/expenditures under the Stan Mayfield Working Waterfronts Capital Outlay Grant Program include the repair, maintenance or replacement of water-adjacent facilities or infrastructure, and the construction or renovation of shore-side facilities.

Examples include, but are not limited to:

- Davits
- Upland boat bunks
- Roofing
- o Fencing
- Signage
- o Lighting
- Upland native landscaping
- Upland debris removal







SMWWCO GRANT PROGRAM ELIGIBLE EXPENSES

OPERATING CAPITAL OUTLAY PROJECTS

Eligible Operating Capital Outlay costs/expenditures under the Stan Mayfield Working Waterfronts Capital Outlay Grant Program include the maintenance or replacement of equipment.

For the replacement of equipment, the following items are only eligible costs/expenditures when purchased in new, unused condition:

- Freezers
- Ice machines
- Air conditioners
- o Boats
- Trailers
- Motors
- o Refrigerated Trucks

- Processing Equipment
- Nets/pots
- Anchoring and docking equipment (boat side only)
- Technology (VHF radios, satellite, radar, electronics)










SETUP AN ACCOUNT



The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) has completed the review of your application for a Department of the Army permit received on April 27, 2023. Your application was assigned file number SAJ-2023-00988. A review of the information and drawings provided indicates that the proposed work would result in the discharge of fill material into a total of approximately 0.016 acre of wetlands at two crossing areas (Impact Area #1- 0.008- acre; Impact Area #2, 0.008- acre) for the construction of a recreational trail. The activities subject to this permit are authorized pursuant to authorities under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. § 1344). The project is located adjacent to the Matanzas River in Sections 47, 31, and 43, Township 8 and 7 south, Range 30 east, in St. Augustine, St. Johns County, Florida.






INSURANCE

- All facilities must be insured by carriers licensed in, or eligible to do business in, Florida, and must maintain applicable Commercial General Liability, Automobile Liability, and Workers' Compensation coverage. A current Certificate of Insurance must be submitted with the grant application.




lease renewal, through <u>December 2, 2024</u>, the expiration date of this lease renewal. The terms and conditions on and for which this lease renewal is granted are as follows:

- 1. USE OF PROPERTY: The Lessee is hereby authorized to operate a 19-slip commercial docking facility with 6 slips on state-owned submerced land and 13 slips on privately-owned submerged land to tockher with two marginal docks, to be used exclusively for mooring of commercial and recreational vessels in conjunction with an upland 110 dry slip storage facility, marina office and store, and a restaurant, with fueling facilities, with a sewage pumpour facility if rimests the regulatory requirements of the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection or State of Florida Department of Health, whichever agency has jurisdiction, and without liveaboards as defined in paragraph 26, as shown and conditioned in Attachment A. All of the foregoing subject to the remaining conditions of this lease.
- 2. LEASE FEES: The Lessee hereby agrees to pay to the Lessor an annual lease fee of \$1,584.64, plus sales tax pursuant to Section 212.031, Florida Statutes, if applicable, within 30 days of the date of receipt of the invoice. The annual fee for the remaining years of this lease shall be adjusted pursuant to provisions of Rule 18-21.011, Florida Administrative Code. The State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Division of State Lands (the "Division") will notify the Lessee in writing of the amount and the due date of each subsequent annual lease payment during the remaining term of this lease. All lease fees due hereunder shall be remitted to the Division as agent for the Lessor.



- Post completion requirements include annual reporting and periodic site inspections for a duration of four (4) years.


