1 500 million straws are used in the U.S. every day. That's enough to fill 125 school buses.



Straws and other plastic harm sea life, including fish, turtles and coral reefs.



- Plastic straws are among the Top Five items collected on the beach every year.
- Straws are easily carried away by the wind, ending up littering our beaches and in our oceans and waterways.
