- Change the final deliverable number from seven to another unused number, such as zero. Save.
- Change the Task Number for the actual deliverable which is the final one of the purchase order to seven. Save.
- Enter “W” for withdraw in the Status column. Save.

STCM: How to Withdraw Tasks

- Construction Drawings were the original final deliverable.
- Final deliverable changed from seven to zero.
- LSRAP Deliverable changed for final deliverable (seven).
- Construction Drawings deliverable status changed to “W” for withdrawn. (Date of Status change is optional).
