# **SW Facility Personnel Requirements**

- •62-701.200(82) FAC
  - –Requires properly-trained personnel at all permitted solid waste management facilities
  - Operator
- •62-701.320(15)(g) FAC

-Spotter



## **Training Personnel Requirements**

- Required by FDEP Solid Waste Regulations
  - <u>–Operators</u> are required to have <u>initial training</u> and shall <u>pass an examination</u> as part of that training.
  - -Spotters are required to have initial training

-Within three years after the initial training, and <u>every three years thereafter</u>, they shall complete <u>additional continued education (refresher)</u> <u>training</u>.


## **Training Personnel Requirements**

Classification	Initial Training	Continuing Education Hours or CEUs (Refresher)	
<u>Operators</u>			
Landfills / C&D	24 hours + Exam	16 hours	
Transfer Station	16 hours + Exam	8 hours	
Materials Recovery Facility (MRF)	16 hours + Exam	8 hours	
<u>Spotters</u>	8 hours, No Exam	4 hours	

## **Good Things to Know**

- Training **Expires** on the last day of the 3-year period.
- If you have the minimum required continuing education (refresher) training on your last day of the 3-year period, you will rollover to a new 3-year period. The continuing education training requirements restarts on your rollover anniversary date and you remain "Current" on your training.
- If you allow your training to expire:
  - Spotters are required to repeat the 8-hour initial training course
  - —Operators are required to complete the initial training course, and re-take the initial exam!
  - -There is not a grace period or extension allowed!

• You may acquire refresher training anytime between your initial training and before your rollover/anniversary date to a new 3-year period.

## **Training Requirements**

- If you are trained as an operator, you are also trained as a spotter. 62-701.320(15)(e)
- Operator → Landfill training ☑ ok at Landfill, CD
- Operator  $\rightarrow$  WPF training  $\square$  ok at WPF (TS/MRF)
- Operator  $\rightarrow$  Landfill training  $\boxtimes$  not trained for WPF (TS/MRF)
- Operator  $\rightarrow$  WPF training  $\boxtimes$  not trained for Landfill
- Spotter → Spotter training ☑ ok at Landfill, WPF (TS/MRF)



### **Training Requirements – Solid Waste Database**

### • What is the Solid Waste Database?

- A training tracking system for Solid Waste Operators and Spotters
- The UF TREEO Center maintains the database on behalf of FDEP
- How can I be added to Solid Waste Database?
  - You must attend an approved initial training course first
  - You or the course provider can submit your certificate
