Chief Foss mentioned that to his knowledge there has never been a drinking water well on the property and that they have always received their water from ECUA. Chief Foss allowed Lena Mollica and John Travis to walk up the burn tower to take aerial photographs of the site. Also, I asked if there was any old photographs of the site and Chief Foss said yes and that he would send those to me by email. SIS personnel left site around 1500 CST.
