2/25/19	Arrived on-site at 1330 CST to meet with Chief George Foss. Chief Foss arrived at 1415 CST. Clarification was made that this Fire Training Facility is indeed Station # 4. Chief Foss explained and pointed out areas of where previous foam might have been or was used. Chief Foss explained that he has been there 23 years and there has been minimal use of Class A foam. Chief Foss didn’t have any information or knowledge of Class B usage on the property. When Class A foam was used, the amount was between 15-20 gallons at a time. Also, for the past 15-16 years that Chief Foss has been present, Class A foam hasn't been used for any training exercises at this facility. When training is conducted, they use dawn dish detergent to mimic foam. Also, he stated that during the "Lieutenant Exam" was the only time Class A foam was used and in small amounts. Chief Foss mentioned that to his knowledge there has never been a drinking water well on the property and that they have always received their water from ECUA. Chief Foss allowed Lena Mollica and John Travis to walk up the burn tower to take aerial photographs of the site. Also, I asked if there was any old photographs of the site and Chief Foss said yes and that he would send those to me by email. SIS personnel left site around 1500 CST.</p>
