

Recycling Used Oil and Used Oil Filters: Compliance Guide

USED OIL

Clean up spills immediately.



Label all containers and tanks "Used Oil." If stored outside, containers and tanks should be closed or covered.



Do



↓ DO NOT discharge used oil or oily mop water onto the ground.



↓ Secondary Containment: 110% of the volume of the largest container or single-walled tank in an outside area.

(Containers that hold 55 gallons or less may not need additional secondary containment if properly stored inside a building.)

↓ Containers and tanks must be on an oil impervious surface and in good condition with no visible leakage.

USED OIL FILTERS

↓ Label all containers "Used Oil Filters." If stored outside, containers should be closed or otherwise protected from the weather.

↓ Containers should be stored on an oil-impervious surface.

Do



↓ Manage used oil filters in containers that are in good condition.

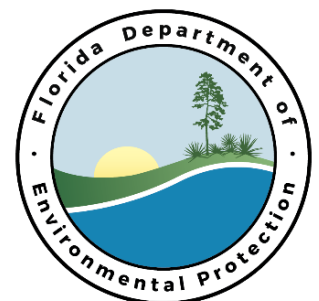
