Compliance Corner

2019 is the triennial sampling year for Non-Transient Non-Community Water Systems. Conduct sampling early in the year to allow time for repeat sampling if necessary.

Lead and Copper Tap samples must be collected from sites on the approved plan. If you have questions about sampling, or need to update your sampling plan, contact the Department.

Disinfection By-Product Samples must be collected during the month on your approved sampling plan. If you are unsure of when you should sample, or have any questions regarding sampling, contact the Department.
