Marion County is the 5th largest county in Florida and home to a significant portion of the Ocala National Forest, three State Parks, including the Cross Florida Greenway, two substantial State Forests, thousands of acres of Water Management Lands and local conservation lands, 36 percent of the county is classified as Conservation.
