Shared-use trail (up to 2 miles)
Trailhead (2)

Springhead Area

Redesign use area configuration
Increase parking capacity

Markham Woods

Biking trail (up to 5 miles)
Hiking trail (1 mile)

Pine Plantation

Shared-use trail (up to 1.5 miles)
Trailhead

Sand Lake Area

Redesign use area/parking area
Multi-purpose/special events pavilion
Improve trailhead
Nature trail (up to 1 mile)
