






Location

- White Springs is located in southeastern Hamilton County, just north of the Columbia County line.
- Approximately 20
 minutes east of Live
 Oak and 15-20 minutes
 northwest of Lake City.

- Suwannee River Wilderness Paddling Trail










Local Trails


- Brand new 16-foot directional pole sign downtown.

Amenities - Bike Racks

- Bike racks are available at the White Springs Public Library, Stephen Foster State Park, Big Shoals State Park, between the SBA HQ and Suwannee Hardware Store, and in the shared parking lot for Bud's Suds Laundry and Fat Bellies Restaurant.
- Nutrien is interested in sponsoring more bike racks and bike repair stations around town.
- Potential locations for future bike racks include DG Market, Wayside Park, Ahmoglee Okalee Town Park, the Post Office, and the Historic Spring House.







Amenities - Restrooms & Water

- Public restrooms are available at:
 - Willie Guy Turner town park and playground
 - Ahmoglee Okalee town park
 - White Springs Library
 - Stephen Foster & Big Shoals State Parks
 - Bailey F. Ogburn Recreational Facility
- Water spigot is available at the Agriculture Station at the entrance to Gar Pond (used by Florida Trail hikers).







Amenities – Food & Supplies

- Fat Bellies: local restaurant popular with residents and visitors. Offers a walk-up to-go window.
- Sun Stop & Munchies: Convenience stores/gas stations with ice, packaged snacks, drinks, and hot food options.
- DG Market: Small grocery with ice, produce, and other goods.
- Suwannee Hardware: Local foods (jams, sauces, spices, honey, etc.) and bottled drinks; carries some cycling and hiking supplies.

Amenities - Rentals

- American Canoe Adventures, located in downtown White Springs, offers kayak and canoe rentals as well as shuttling services for paddlers on the Suwannee River.
- Stephen Foster State Park offers bicycle rentals.









Local Support Groups

- White Springs Historic Preservation Society (WSHPS) was reactivated in 2023 to promote the town's ecotourism opportunities and historic character. The group includes a future Trail Town committee who will meet as needed.
- Suwannee Bicycle Association is headquartered in downtown White Springs and organizes events, rides, and trips for cyclists and paddlers. They also offer trail maps for the area.
- As a Gateway Community, the Florida Trail
 Association works with White Springs often.


