



round stems, dead stems dark gray




panicles narrow, 3-11 cm long; plants to 30 cm tall

segmented round stems, to 60 cm tall; spikelets solitary or 2-3

erect perennial to 2 m tall, leaves to 60 cm long, 5-15 mm wide; panicle large, spreading, 15-50 cm long


erect perennial to 3 m tall, leaves to over 1 meter long with saw toothed edges; inflorescence is branches and extends beyond the leaves; achene 2-3 cm long, wrinkled


perennial to 1 m tall panicle of 4-25 branches

spikelet 1-2 mm




erect perennial to 2 m tall, leaves to 60 cm long, 5-15 mm wide; panicle large, spreading, 15-50 cm long

achene 2-3 mm






Hibiscus grandiflorus

10-30 cm tall, flowers w 5 white to pink petals




Kostelezskya virginica

stems with sharp thorns; bright red fruit




Batis maritima

succulent with opposite, cylindrical leaves, arching growth to 45 cm tall



succulent with opposite, cylindrical leaves, prostrate growth, pink flowers






