OGT staff generally applied the criteria adopted by the FGTC to the list of regional trail systems with the FGTS priority network. At the Gainesville meeting on Monday, OGT staff will provide information regarding these projects to the council members. Using the information provided by staff, public comments and through discussion, the council will vote on those projects that will move forward for further detailed assessment. OGT staff will then assess those projects and provide the results to the FGTC in late March or early April for a final vote on the Regional Trail Systems. These projects will be prioritized and provided to DOT as the recommended project or projects for SUN Trail funding.
